**PLAYER TO WATCH - AARON BAKER**

The junior first baseman is riding a six-game hitting streak that features three multi-hit games and two multi-RBI performances. Baker is hitting .384 in that span with three homers. In addition, he leads the team with 23 walks, a mark that ranks second in the Big 12.

**NEBRASKA PREVIEW**

The Sooners (21-5 overall, 2-1 Big 12) have won their last three games and face Nebraska, who is coming off a 2-1 series victory over Oklahoma State last week, for a three-game Big 12 series in Norman this weekend.

OU moved up in each of the major polls and is ranked as high as No. 10 this week in the NCBWA poll. The Sooners come in at No. 11 in the USA Today/ESPN poll, No. 12 by Baseball America and No. 15 by Collegiate Baseball.

Nebraska (15-8-1) is 3-3 in Big 12 play after being picked seventh in the preseason coaches' poll. The Huskers return 15 letterwinners from a 2008 team that was 41-16-1 overall and finished third in the conference with a 17-9-1 mark.

**MORE ON THE OU-NEBRASKA SERIES**

The Sooners last met the Cornhuskers in a three-game series in 2008 at Hawks Field in Lincoln. OU lost the first two games of the series before tying NU in the finale. The game ended after 10 innings with a travel curfew.

OU has struggled against Nebraska since Big 12 play started, having won just three of the series meetings (2006, 2004 and 1997). Nebraska leads the Big 12 meetings, 23-12-1, but 21 of the contests have been decided by three runs or less, including 10 one-run games.

The last time OU won a series at home against Nebraska was in 1997. The Sooners are 41-25 at home against the Huskers since 1962.

### HEAD COACH SUNNY GOLLOWAY



Sunny Golloway has led the Sooners to three NCAA Regional Finals, 127 victories and a top 25 ranking in each of his four years at the helm of the OU program. In 2008, OU returned to the NCAA Tournament for the 31st time in program history, two years after Golloway became the second coach in

NCAA Division I history to guide his club to a Super Regional Appearance in his first year at the helm. The 2006 season was highlighted by the Sooners' 45-22 overall mark, a third-place finish in the Big 12 and an NCAA regional title, a program first since 1995.

The Sooners posted a 36-26-1 overall record during the 2008 campaign and advanced to the championship game of the NCAA Tempe Regional. Three Sooners, Aljay Davis, Aaron Baker and Mike Gosse were named to the all-tournament team giving OU such 13 honorees since Golloway took over at the end of the 2005 season.

Including eight seasons (1996-2003) as the head coach at Oral Roberts and his record at OU's helm, Golloway is 462-234-1 (.664). The winning percentage ranks in the top 25 nationally among active head coaches with a minimum of five years of experience.

In 2006, his first full year as head coach, Golloway guided the Sooners to a 45-22 mark, a third-place finish in the Big 12, an NCAA regional title and the program's first Super Regional appearance (format originated in 1999).

The Sooners' run in 2006 was the best in Norman since the 1994 and 1995 teams made back-to-back appearances in the College World Series. OU was one win away from reaching the program's 10th appearance in Omaha after Golloway and the Sooners dropped a best of three series to then-No. 1 Rice.

Not only did the Sooners enjoy a top 10 ranking for three weeks during the regular season, but they finished the year ranked No. 9 (Baseball America) and led the nation in fielding percentage with a .983 mark (highest in school history and the second best mark in NCAA history).

Golloway was named the eighth head baseball coach at the University of Oklahoma on July 15, 2005. His appointment was made after successful stints on the Sooner staff as an assistant and interim head coach, and a strong eight-year run as the head coach at Oral Roberts.

When Golloway took over the Sooners in 2005, the team was 23-20 with a seventh-place Big 12 mark of 7-11. The team won its last three Big 12 series to move its overall record to 35-26 and its Big 12 mark to 14-13, good for a fifth-place finish.

### TICKETS

### WEEKEND PROMOTIONS

On Saturday, the first 250 fans will receive an OU baseball t-shirt and the following 250 will receive an OU baseball stocking cap. In addition, the Sooners will sign autographs following the game, weather permitting. On Sunday, the first 500 fans will receive blow-up No. 1 OU fingers and kids can run the bases and play catch in the outfield, weather permitting. On Monday, the first 250 receive a free OU baseball cup with a free soft drink.

### BROADCAST INFORMATION

The series opener can be heard on KOKC 1520 AM with Chuck Kelly calling the play-by-play, while games two and three are still to be determined. All three games will be available on the internet via Oklahoma All-Access. A live webcast for each game will also be available on All-Access. Live stats will be provided on SoonerSports.com.

### LAST TIME OUT

OU trailed 1-0 after Central Arkansas' first at-bat but quickly countered in the bottom half with five runs en route to a 12-6 win at home on Tuesday. Garrett Buechele led the Sooner offense with three hits and three RBIs.

### UP NEXT

The Sooners have three days off before their next game at Missouri on Friday, April 3. The series continues with game two on Saturday, April 4 and concludes on Sunday, April 5.

### BIG 12 SERIES OPENERS

The series win over Kansas State marked the fourth time in five years that OU was victorious in its first conference series of the season. The last time OU won back-to-back conference series to begin a season was in 1997. The Sooners topped Iowa State and Kansas to begin that campaign.

### RECORDS FALL IN SOONERS' 29-4 VICTORY

The Sooners' school record 11 home runs in Sunday's finale at Kansas State tied a Big 12 record (OSU hit 11 versus Chicago State) and was two shy of tying an NCAA record. OU hit five home runs in the first inning of that game after putting 17 batters at the plate to score 13 runs (one run shy of tying school record). In the fifth inning, OU hit four more dingers to plate 11 more runs. Refer to page four of the notes for additional notes on the Sooners' homers.

### 29 RUNS!

The Sooners' 29 runs in Sunday's victory is tied for the fourth most runs scored in school history and the most since 1986. OU scored 20-plus runs for the second time this season and the sixth time under head coach Sunny Golloway, three of those games against Big 12 opponents.

### HITS GALORE

The Sooners' 27 hits on March 22 at KSU was the most hits recorded by an OU team since Feb. 17, 1991 (29 vs. Kearney State). The total is three shy of the school record of 30, set on March 22 1989 vs. Northern Iowa. The Sooners also had 27 hits on March 6, 1986 against Southwestern State. Under Golloway, OU has recorded 20 or more hits in nine games (two this season), including four against Big 12 opponents.

### TIME FOR A RALLY

The Sooners have come from behind to win 14 games this season, including two decisions in extra innings. Of Sunny Golloway's 147 wins at OU, 77 have been in come-from-behind fashion. Below is a breakdown of the 2009 comebacks:

### SCORING RUNS

The Sooners have scored 10 or more runs in 12 of the 26 games this season with a 10 runs/game average. OU is 12-0 when they score 10-plus runs in a game in 2009. In addition, the Sooners are averaging 12.27 hits per game with double digit hits in all but eight games. The Sooners are 17-1 when they connect for 10-plus hits in a contest. OU ranks third nationally in total hits and runs this season.

**13-0 AT HOME**

Oklahoma won its 13th home game in as many chances on March 24. The perfect start is the second best by an OU team at home. The 1974 Sooners started the home campaign 17-0. In 1975, Oklahoma opened the home slate with a 12-0 mark.

**OU IN BIG 12 RANKS**

The Sooners can be found up and down the Big 12 statistics for overall games released on March 26. The Sooners' offense leads all conference teams in batting average (.348), runs (260), hits (319), doubles (63), homers (42) and RBIs (234). Turn to page 6 for national rankings.

**ONE-TWO PUNCH**

OU has a productive 1-2 punch at the top of the lineup and the proof is in the Big 12's overall statistics and the national rankings released on March 23. Johnson and Hernandez combine to rank atop seven different categories in the conference. Johnson leads the Big 12 in hits (43), runs (43), homers (9), triples (3), total bases (85) and slugging percentage. In addition, he leads the nation in runs scored and ranks in the top 10 in total bases (2nd), hits (4th), runs per game (7th) and homers (7th). Hernandez leads the Big 12 in hits (43) and batting average (.422). Hernandez ranks fourth in the country in hits and ninth in runs scored.

**JOHNSON LEADS OFF**

Jamie Johnson has been highly successful as OU's leadoff hitter this season and for a majority of 2008. So far in 2009, Johnson has already surpassed his home run total of five from a year ago. Johnson is tied for the Big 12 lead with nine and ranks seventh nationally. Seven of Johnson's 14 career bombs, have led off a game, including four this season.

**MORE ON JOHNSON'S HOMERS**

All but three of Jamie Johnson's team-leading nine homers this year have been game tying or go-ahead shots. His first HR against Western Illinois tied the game at one apiece. Against San Diego, his grand slam gave OU a 4-2 lead. In games 11 and 12 of the season against UALR, his leadoff homer gave OU a 1-0 lead. Johnson's solo homer against Bethune Cookman tied the game at one apiece. Finally, Johnson's leadoff homer in game three of the KSU series gave OU a 1-0 lead.

**EXTRA INNINGS UNDER GOLLOWAY**

OU is 2-0 this season in games played in extra innings with victories over Bethune Cookman (5-4 in 10 innings) and Washington State (game two, 9-7 in 11 innings). Since Golloway took over the helm of the Sooner program at the end of the 2005 season, OU is 14-1-1 in extra innings. The lone loss came against Missouri on April 19, 2009.

**10-PLUS WINNING STREAKS**

The Sooners' recent 10-game winning streak was the fourth under head coach Sunny Golloway since he took over the program four years ago. In addition, since 1962, OU has recorded 14 winning streaks over 10 games and Coach Golloway was at the head of three of those (13-2006, 11-2007 and 11-2008). The 13-game winning streak in 2006 is tied for the seventh best in school history.

**PORLIER'S RETURN**

Stephen Porlier tossed an inning of shutout baseball in the seventh inning (two strikeouts) against Central Arkansas on March 24 marking his first appearance in a Sooner uniform since May 25, 2007. The redshirt-junior missed the entire 2008 season due to surgery on a torn labrum. In 2007, Porlier was the Sooners' Friday night starter and was named to the All-Big 12 second team.

**WISE NAMED BIG 12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

Senior catcher J.T. Wise was named the Phillips 66 Big 12 Player of the Week on March 23 after he helped lead OU to three wins on the road over TCU and KSU. The award is the first for Wise and the second this season by a Sooner. Wise finished last week with eight hits in 15 plate appearances, good for a .533 batting average. In four games last week, Wise hit two home runs and drove in 11 runs while recording a .933 slugging percentage. In Sunday's finale at Kansas State, Wise tied a school record with five hits and hit homers.

**BAKER WALKING**

Aaron Baker is second in the Big 12 in walks with 23 on the season. He entered the week ranked 10th in the nation in that category. The total was boosted on March 3 during game one of the UALR doubleheader. Baker walked four times in that game, a first for a Sooner since Feb. 21, 2004 when Eric Thornton was also issued four walks.

**THE BIG INNING**

The Sooners have hit through the batting order on 15 occasions this year and scored five or more runs in 12 different frames. OU is 9-1 when the plate five or more runs in a game. The only loss came in the second game of the San Diego series. The Sooners had two big innings (5-plus runs) in game three of the Western Illinois series and game three of the Kansas State series.

**SOONERS ON TELEVISION**

The games on March 21 and 22 marked the first and second televised games for Oklahoma this season. The Sooners have three more games currently scheduled for telecasts.

On Saturday, April 4, Fox Sports Midwest and Metro Sports in Kansas City will aire the Sooners' contest at Missouri.

The Sooner Sports Network will carry the Texas Tech series opener from Norman on April 10 at 6:30 p.m. The game can be seen live on Cox Ch. 7 in OKC and Cox Ch. 3 in Tulsa.

Fox Sports Southwest (Cox Ch. 37 in OKC) will televise the Sooners' game at Baylor on April 25 from Waco at 1 p.m.

**BACK-TO-BACK COMPLETE GAMES**

Michael Rocha and C.J. Blue achieved a rare feat during Tuesday's doubleheader against Houston Baptist as both starters went the distance to allow a combined 11 hits and zero earned runs in 18 innings of action. The last time two Sooners threw back-to-back complete games was during the 2001 season. On April 27 of that year, Evan Greusel lasted nine innings (seven hits, zero runs) to top visiting Centenary. The next day, also against the Gents, Austin Mix went the distance after giving up one run off two hits.



### CLEARING THE FENCES

After 26 games, the Sooners lead the Big 12 with 42 home runs. That total is 12 shy of the 2008 season total, which was set after 63 games played. Eleven different Sooners have cleared the fences and below is a closer look at OU's homers in 2009:

After 26 games last season, the Sooners had 23 home runs, the most since knocking out 25 after 26 games in 2003.

Despite the 1.6 HR/game average this season, the 2009 Sooners are still behind the school record of 114 homers hit in 1998 (1.8/game). That team had 61 dingers after 26 games.

Since the NCAA schedule expanded in 1972, OU already has more homers this season than 10 previous Sooner teams since that year.

### SOONER DEBUTS

Several newcomers have enjoyed successful debuts for Oklahoma in 2009. Half of the position players recorded a hit in their first game but none were bigger than freshman Cameron Seitzer's three-run homer in his debut. Not only did the long ball come in his first game, but in his first collegiate at-bat. On the mound, four of the six hurlers blanked the opposition in their first appearance and Jason Chowning posted a win in his first outing.

### BAKER AND DOYLE NAMED TO WALLACE WATCH LIST

Juniors Aaron Baker and Andrew Doyle were named to the 2009 Preseason Brooks Wallace Award as announced by the College Baseball Foundation. The Wallace Award is presented annually to the nation's top collegiate baseball player in conjunction with the College Baseball Hall of Fame induction ceremonies. The 2009 award banquet will be at 7 p.m., Thursday, July 2, in the United Spirit Arena on the campus of Texas Tech University. The recognition marks the fifth consecutive year that a Sooner was named to the preseason list and the second consecutive season for Baker.

### TOUGH SCHEDULE

OU will face 12 opponents, for a total of 27 games, that participated in last year's NCAA Tournament, including nine teams that finished the season ranked in the top 25. Six of those teams (Nebraska, Oklahoma State, San Diego, TCU, Texas A&M, Wichita State) posted 40 wins a year ago, while Texas A&M and Wichita State both advanced to the Super Regional round. The Sooners will face seven of the teams ranked in *Baseball America's* preseason poll for a combined 18 games. Six of those contests will be played at L. Dale Mitchell Park with No. 12 UCLA (March 6-8) and No. 1 Texas A&M (May 15-17) coming to town for three-game series.

### FACILITY UPGRADES

The new year brought several new additions to L. Dale Mitchell Park. OU added a player developmental facility which includes indoor hitting cages and a full-size practice infield. In addition, the Sooners upgraded the fan experience as a new sound system consisting of 20-plus speakers was added to accompany the new scoreboard in left field. The scoreboard also includes a full LED video display board and the entire structure stands 50-feet high.

### DRAFTED SOONERS

Eleven current Sooners have been drafted in their careers, including four newcomers on the 2009 squad (Jason Chowning, Mehdi Djebbar, Kaleb Herren and J.R. Robinson). Below is a look at the 11 drafted Sooners.

### COMING BACK FOR MORE

OU returns 18 letterwinners from the 2008 squad that appeared in the final game of the NCAA Tempe Regional, including seven position starters and nine pitchers that started a game on the mound last season. The deep pitching staff is led by five hurlers that made at least five starts in 2008. That excludes junior Stephen Porlier, who led OU with 99 innings and 99 strikeouts in 2007 before missing last season with surgery.

### 5-0 STARTS

Following the Feb. 24 win at San Diego, OU improved to 5-0. The last time OU started a season 5-0 was in 1998 when it rattled off 12 straight wins to begin the campaign.

### NUMBER CHANGES

Two Sooners from the 2008 squad, Ryan Duke and Tyson Seng, will sport different numbers this season. Duke will go from No. 28 last season to No. 17 and Seng, No. 33 in 2008, will wear No. 8.

### SIGNING CLASS

The OU coaching staff inked 10 high school players, including four Oklahoma products, and six players from the junior college ranks. The Sooners concentrated on adding players to all areas of the field as the signing class features eight positions players and eight pitchers, including five left-handers. Overall, 11 of the recruits are rated by Perfect Game Crosschecker as prospects for the 2009 MLB Draft.

OU's signees feature some of the best prep stars from the state in Brandon Bargas (LHP) and Austin Kirk (LHP/1B) from Owasso High School, Jarek Pritchard (OF) from Charles Page H.S. and Ryan Gibson (LHP) from Yukon H.S.

Rounding out the group of high school recruits are six talented players from the state of Texas with Abel Baker (C/1B), the brother of current Sooner Aaron Baker, from Denton H.S., Drew Harrison (1B) from Waxahachie H.S., Jordan John (LHP) from Calallen H.S., Chad Kettler (SS) from Coppell H.S., Jack Mayfield (SS) from Del Rio H.S. and Drew Verhagen (RHP) from Heath H.S.

The Sooners' junior college recruits include Danny Black (INF/OF) from Feather River C.C. (Calif.), Anthony Collazo (LHP) from Howard College (Texas), Rickey Eisenberg (OF) from Cypress College (Calif.), Zach Neal (RHP) from Howard College (Texas), Eric Ross (OF) from Grayson College (Texas) and Bobby Shore (RHP) from Palomar College (Calif.).

### WEBCAST SCHEDULE

The OU Athletics Department will web cast 24 of the Sooners' 28 home games this season. The only games that will not be aired are; Feb. 21 (DH vs. Western Illinois), March 7 (UCLA) and April 11 (Texas Tech). The webcasts can be seen on Oklahoma All-Access, Soonersports.com's premium site.

### RADIO BROADCAST SCHEDULE

The entire 56-game regular season schedule will be broadcast live on the internet via Yahoo. In addition, KOKC 1520 AM will again serve as the flagship station of Sooner baseball and 40-plus games are scheduled to broadcast live.
