HEAD COACH JEFF CAPEL

Jeff Capel was named Oklahoma's 13th men's basketball head coach on April 11, 2006. Capel, 33, is 51-28 in his third year at OU and led the Sooners to a 23-12 record and second-round NCAA Tournament appearance last year.



Capel compiled a 79-41 (.658) record over four years as head coach at Virginia Commonwealth prior to arriving in Norman. His VCU squads posted a 50-22 (.694) record in Colonial Athletic Association play and a 47-11 overall home record for a staunch .811 winning percentage.

In 2003-04, VCU's CAA Tournament championship game victory over George Mason catapulted the Rams to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1996. VCU lost in the first round to Wake Forest, but not before putting a major scare into the fourth-seeded Demon Deacons, 79-78. Capel's 2004-05 squad, which finished 19-13, competed in the National Invitation Tournament, marking just the third time in program history that VCU made consecutive postseason appearances.

The Rams won at least 18 games each of Capel's four seasons in Richmond, with the 2003-04 squad registering a Capel-era best 23-8 record. His first team finished 18-10 in 2002-03. In 2005-06, VCU finished 19-10 overall.

In the summer of 2005, Capel served as an assistant coach on the gold-medal-winning USA Men's World University Games Team that finished 8-0 in Turkey in August. Villanova's Jay Wright was the head coach while Seton Hall's Bobby Gonzalez served as the other assistant. The squad featured, among others, Midwest City (Okla.) High School and Duke University standout Sheldon Williams.

Capel began his coaching career as an assistant at Old Dominion in 2000 before moving to VCU as an assistant for the 2001-02 season. In 2002, he became the youngest NCAA Division I head coach at age 27.

A four-year starter for Hall-of-Fame coach Mike Krzyzewski at Duke from the 1993-94 through 1996-97 campaigns, Capel earned Atlantic Coast Conference honors each of his seasons in Durham. The guard, who wore No. 5, averaged 12.4 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.4 assists and 1.7 3-pointers during his career and started in the 1994 national title game against Arkansas.

He ranks 22nd in career scoring at Duke (1,601 points), 16th in minutes played (3,774), sixth in 3-pointers (220), seventh in 3-point attempts (553), seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (.398) and 10th in assists (433).

Capel, who graduated from Duke with a bachelor of arts degree in history, and his wife, Kanika, wed in 2003. They have a daughter, Cameron, who was born in April 2007.

PREVIEWING SATURDAY'S GAME

Looking to bounce back from its first loss of the season, No. 4/4 Oklahoma (12-1) returns home following two road games to host Coppin State (2-10) on Saturday at 12:30 p.m. CST at Lloyd Noble Center. The Sooners, who lost 96-88 at Arkansas on Tuesday, have won 68 of their last 70 home non-conference games. Coppin State broke a 10-game losing streak with its 59-53 win over George Washington on Tuesday. Saturday's game will be televised by the Sooner Sports Network (FS Oklahoma across the state; KQCW Channel 19/Cox 12 in Tulsa; ESPN Full Court) with **Bob Carpenter** and **Mark Rodgers** announcing. It will air on the Sooner Radio Network (flagship KOKC AM 1520 in OKC; KTBZ AM 1430 in Tulsa; Sirius 123) with **Bob Barry, Sr.** and **Mike Houck** calling the action.

"NOTE" WORTHY

- ▶ With wins in its next two games against Coppin State and Maryland Eastern Shore, Oklahoma would post its best regular season non-conference record (14-1) since going 15-1 in 1987-88.
- ▶ The Sooners have won 68 of their last 70 home non-conference games dating back to the 1999-2000 season. The two losses during the span came to Villanova in 2006-07 and Stephen F. Austin last year.
- ▶ OU's No. 4 AP ranking is its highest since the final poll of the 2002-03 season (ranked No. 3 heading into the NCAA Tournament).
- ▶ **Willie Warren** has scored 31 and 35 points in the last two games, marking the first back-to-back 30-point performances by an OU true freshman since **Wayman Tisdale** in 1982-83. The last Sooner prior to this season (**Blake Griffin** did it earlier this year), regardless of class, to score 30 or more in consecutive games was senior **Jeff Webster** in the final two regular season games of the 1993-94 season.
- ▶ Warren's 66 combined points against Rice and Arkansas the last two outings represent the most by a Sooner over a two-game span since Webster scored 72 against Colorado (41) and Nebraska (31) in February 1994.
- ▶ Despite a modest .667 team free throw percentage, the Sooners have made four more foul shots than their opponents have attempted. OU is 254-for-381 from the stripe while foes are 170-for-250. That's an average of 10.1 more attempts per game than the opposition. Griffin has attempted 38 percent of the team's free throws (146 of its 381).
- ▶ Griffin leads the country in rebounding (14.0 rpg), ranks in the top 10 in field goal percentage (.669) and 13th in scoring (22.8 ppg). He has also registered at least one assist in every game and averages 2.5.
- ▶ Oklahoma is 12-0 all-time against Coppin State and 11-0 in Norman. All 12 games have been decided by double digits.

TUESDAY'S ARKANSAS RECAP

- ▶ Oklahoma's best start to a season (12 wins) since the 1989-90 campaign came to a halt with Tuesday's 96-88 loss at Arkansas.
- ▶ OU trailed by as many as 25 (72-47 with 11:50 remaining) before a 16-0 run cut the deficit to nine (72-63 with 9:08 left). After Arkansas went up by 12 (81-69 with 5:57 left), OU drew to within four on two occasions (81-77 and 83-79) but could get no closer.
- ▶ Arkansas' 96 points were the most surrendered by the Sooners since losing 96-91 to Washington on Nov. 26, 2004, in the Great Alaska Shootout. The previous high for points given up by OU under third-year head coach Jeff Capel was 91 last season in an overtime win over Baylor. The previous high for a regulation game under Capel was 85 points last year in a loss at Kansas.
- ▶ Oklahoma entered the game leading the Big 12 Conference in field goal percentage defense (.379), but allowed the Razorbacks to shoot .517 on the night. Arkansas was also 6-for-13 (.462) from 3-point land.
- ▶ The Sooners' 13 3-pointers were their most since draining 13 treys against Denver in last season's second game. OU has made at least 11 treys in each of its last four games against Arkansas.
- ▶ Freshman **Willie Warren**'s 35 points marked a career high, as did his seven 3-pointers, four rebounds and four assists (tied). He netted 20 of the team's 38 first-half points and scored eight more during a 45-second second-half span (5:10 to 4:25).
- ▶ **Blake Griffin** finished with 21 points and a game-high 13 rebounds for his 10th double-double in 13 games this year (he had 10 all of last season). The sophomore forward added four assists and three blocked shots.
- ▶ Junior guard **Tony Crocker** netted 18 points in 26 minutes of play, all on 3-pointers. Crocker, who picked up four fouls in 12 first-half minutes and didn't enter the second half until the 13:33 mark, tied a career high with six treys on 13 attempts.
- ▶ OU's loss snapped a five-game winning streak against Arkansas that dated back to the 1998-99 season. The Razorbacks improved to 13-10 in the all-time series.

WHO'S HOT

- ▶ A strong candidate for national-player-of-the-year honors, sophomore forward **Blake Griffin** has scored at least 18 points in 12 of 13 games this season, has netted at least 20 on nine occasions and surpassed 30 points twice. The 6-10, 251-pounder has registered 10 double-doubles to match his total from last season and has led OU in rebounding 11 times. Griffin now leads the Big 12 in scoring (22.8 ppg), rebounding (14.0 rpg) and field goal percentage (.669). For perspective, Big 12 players who rank second in the respective categories are Texas' A.J. Abrams (19.8 ppg) and Kansas' Cole Aldrich (9.6 rpg and .612). Griffin also ranks fifth in the Big 12 with his 1.4 blocked shots per game. Seven of his 18 rejections have come in the last two games.
- ▶ Griffin also leads the country with 146 free throw attempts on the season (an average of 11.2 a game). He is 80-for-124 (.645) over the last 11 games after going 9-for-22 (.409) over the first two contests.
- ▶ Freshman guard **Willie Warren**, who has scored in double figures in 10 of 13 outings, is averaging 20.0 points and 3.3 assists over the last six games while shooting .566 (43-for-76) from the field and .500 (17-for-34) from 3-point territory. His .500 season field goal percentage is tops among the team's guards and fourth among Big 12 backcourt players.
- ▶ Over the last two games, Warren is averaging 33.0 points and 3.5 assists while shooting .590 (23-for-39) from the field and .550 (11-for-20) from 3-point range. The 11 treys over two games are the most by a Sooner since **Michael Neal** went 13-for-20 against Iowa State and Texas Tech in February 2006.
- ▶ After scoring in double figures once in OU's first seven games, sophomore guard **Tony Crocker** has done it in five of the last six. He is averaging 13.2 points over the six outings and is shooting .417 from 3-point range (15-for-36) and .800 from the free throw

line (12-for-15). Crocker scored a career-high 26 points against VCU three games ago with the help of 5-for-6 3-point shooting.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- OU has used the same starting lineup in all 13 games (Austin Johnson, Willie Warren, Tony Crocker, Taylor Griffin, Blake Griffin).
- Oklahoma has made at least six 3-pointers in 11 of its 13 games, but is shooting just .335 from long range on the season to rank last among Big 12 teams. The worst 3-point shooting season in school history (.326) was recorded in 2006-07.
- Oklahoma has made at least one 3-pointer in 397 consecutive games (last one without a trey was at Memphis on Dec. 23, 1996).
- Brothers **Blake** and **Taylor Griffin** are a combined 144-for-234 (.615) from the field this year.
- Blake Griffin has accounted for 29 percent of OU's points, 39 percent of its rebounds and 44 percent of its defensive boards.
- Blake Griffin has registered at least three assists in 18 of 46 career games (seven times this year). He has recorded at least two assists 29 times in his career (10 times this season).
- Registering 54 blocked shots over his sophomore and junior seasons combined (the most ever during a two-year period by a Sooner standing under 6-foot-8), Taylor Griffin has 17 blocks already this year.
- Forty-three percent of Taylor Griffin's rebounds this year (37 of his 86) have come on the offensive end of the floor.
- **Cade Davis** made all 23 of his free throw attempts last year as a freshman and canned his first three attempts this year before finally missing against Davidson on Nov. 18. He is now 34-for-38 (.895) in his career.
- OU will play 21 of its 31 regular season games against teams that made the 2008 postseason (15 against NCAA Tournament teams, four against NIT squads and two against College Basketball Invitational teams). As of Friday, the Sooners are ranked No. 3 nationally by CollegeRPI.com.

NOTING OU'S 30-POINT PERFORMANCES

- Sophomore **Blake Griffin** and freshman **Willie Warren** have each posted back-to-back 30-point performances this season. Griffin netted a career-high 35 points against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22 before scoring 32 four days later against UAB. Warren went for 31 at Rice on Dec. 22 before pouring in a career-high 35 on Tuesday at Arkansas.
- The last time two Sooners each had back-to-back games of at least 30 points in the same season was in 1993-94 when senior forward **Jeff Webster** and junior guard/forward **Calvin Curry** did it.
- The last OU player to register two 30-point games his true freshman season was **Tim McCalister** in 1983-84.
- **Wayman Tisdale** holds the school record for most 30-point games by a freshman (nine in 1982-83).
- The last time a Sooner scored at least 30 points three times in a season was **Corey Brewer** in 1997-98.
- The last OU true freshman to register three 30-point games was Tisdale.

PREVIEWING COPPIN STATE

- Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference member Coppin State snapped a 10-game losing streak by beating George Washington, 59-53, Tuesday in the seventh-place game of the Outrigger Hotels Rainbow Classic in Hawaii. It is now 2-10 on the year.

► The Eagles, who have yet to play a home game, are 0-8 in road contests. They finished 16-21 last year and won the MEAC Tournament to make the NCAA Tournament's opening-round game (lost 69-60 to Mount St. Mary's).

► Coppin State is shooting .390 from the field, .322 from 3-point distance and .743 from the foul line. Its opponents are shooting .454 from the floor and .336 from long range.

► **Tywan McKee** leads the Eagles in several statistical categories, including scoring (19.3 ppg), rebounding (5.1 rpg), assists (3.2 apg), steals (3.3 spg), 3-pointers (27) and made free throws (34). The senior guard recorded 16 points, eight rebounds, four assists and three steals Tuesday against George Washington. McKee has earned first-team All-MEAC honors each of the last two seasons.

► Junior center **Sam Coleman** is averaging 10.3 points and 4.3 rebounds over the last three contests, his only games this season. Coleman, who is shooting .500 from the field, posted 14 points and four boards against George Washington.

► Freshman guard **Jordan Lee** is averaging 9.3 points, 3.1 rebounds and 1.2 steals per outing. Lee, who has not played the last two games, is shooting just .323 from the field but .810 (17-for-21) from the free throw line. He ranks second on the team with 16 treys and 53 attempts (.302).

► **Ron "Fang" Mitchell** is in his 23rd year as Coppin State's head coach and owns a 360-312 record. He's in his 31st year as a collegiate head coach and is 587-357.

OKLAHOMA-COPPIN STATE SERIES HISTORY

Oklahoma is 21-0 in its series with Coppin State with 11 of those games played in Norman (the other was played in Oklahoma City on Dec. 27, 1997). Oklahoma has beaten the Eagles by an average of 21.6 points in the series. The average score of the last six meetings has been 71-46 with Coppin State being held to less than 50 points in all six contests. Ron "Fang" Mitchell has served as Coppin State's head coach in all 11 previous meetings.

TWO YEARS AGO VERSUS THE EAGLES

► Oklahoma won its last meeting against Coppin State, a 64-47 decision on Dec. 9, 2006 (Jeff Capel's first season at OU).

► The Sooners shot .510 from the field while holding the Eagles to a .320 mark. OU also owned a 37-27 advantage on the glass.

► Coppin State held a 30-29 lead early in the second half. The Sooners held the Eagles without a field goal for the final 6:09.

► **Michael Neal** (19) and **Longar Longar** (15) accounted for more than half of OU's points. Neal made four 3-pointers on the night. **Tony Crocker** added nine points and **Taylor Griffin** scored eight.

► A first-team Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference selection that year, Coppin State's **Tywan McKee** started the game but played only five minutes. He scored one point on 0-for-4 shooting and committed three fouls and a turnover.

► The Eagles were led by **Julian Conyers'** 14 points. **Antwan Harrison** added 13.

MORE BLAKE

► Blake Griffin scored at least 18 points in each of the season's first nine games, marking OU's longest such streak since guard **Corey Brewer** netted at least 18 in 15 consecutive outings during the 1997-98 season. Griffin's lone game under 18 points this year was an 11-point performance against Utah when he played a season-low 23 minutes and attempted only three field goals.

► Lost in Griffin's gaudy scoring and rebounding statistics are some pretty impressive assist numbers. The forward ranks third on the team with 2.5 assists per game this season and has registered at least one handout in all 13 outings. Last season, Griffin became the first Sooner standing 6-foot-10 or taller to ever dish at least three assists in a game 11 times. He has recorded at least three assists seven times already this year.

► Griffin (14.0 rpg) is on pace to shatter the school record for rebounding average in a season. The standard of 13.3 boards per game was set by **Alvan Adams** in 1974-75. Griffin is also averaging a nation-leading 11.2 free throw attempts a game, a figure that would break **Stacey King's** 1988-89 school record of 8.9 foul shots per outing.

► Griffin has three games of at least 20 rebounds this season. No other player in the country has more than one.

► Griffin has 35 dunks on the season, good for an average of 2.7 per game.

► Griffin owns the best vertical leap (no step) on the team at 37.5 inches, as well as the best max leap (no limit on steps) by reaching 27 inches above the rim. He also owns an 84.5-inch wingspan (seven feet and one-half inch).

CAPEL SIGNS FIVE; GROUP RANKED FOURTH BY ESPN

Third-year Oklahoma men's basketball head coach Jeff Capel signed a five-man list of high school seniors in November, giving OU the fourth-rated class nationally by ESPN. Headlining the group are top-25 players **Tommy Mason-Griffin** (Houston, Texas/Madison HS) and **Keith "Tiny" Gallon** (Houston, Texas/Oak Hill [Va.] Academy). Scout.com lists Mason-Griffin as the third best point guard in the 2009 class while ESPN rates Gallon as the country's third best center. Joining them as Sooners next year will be forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** (Baltimore, Md./Brewster [N.H.] Academy), forward **Kyle Hardrick** (Oklahoma City, Okla./Putnam City HS) and guard **Steven Pledger** (Chesapeake, Va./Atlantic Shores Christian School).

UNDERRATED AUSTIN

A Sooner who tends to get lost among OU's higher-profile players is senior point guard **Austin Johnson**. The 6-3, 176-pounder ranks just fifth on the team with his 7.2 points per outing but ranks among the Big 12's leaders in several other categories. Johnson ranks second in the league in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.9-to-1), seventh in assists (4.4), seventh in steals (1.8) and just outside the top 10 in blocked shots (0.9). He is also shooting .800 from the free throw line (16-for-20).

DEFENSE, DEFENSE

- ▶ OU has held its last six foes to a combined .368 field goal mark. Four opponents in those six games (Tulsa, Maine, Utah and Rice) shot .340 or below.
- ▶ Since USC went 8-for-11 from 3-point range on Dec. 4, OU's last six opponents are a combined 32-for-109 (.294) from long distance.
- ▶ OU ranks third in the Big 12 in steals per game (9.0), fourth in field goal percentage defense (.389) and fourth in blocked shots (4.5). Austin Johnson ranks seventh in the league with 1.7 steals per outing while Blake and Taylor Griffin (1.6) rank 11th and Willie Warren (1.5) ranks fifth. Blake Griffin ranks fifth in blocked shots (1.4).

AWARDS CENTRAL

Blake Griffin couldn't be off to a better start in terms of turning his Big 12 Preseason Player-of-the-Year honor into the league's postseason player-of-the-year award. The sophomore forward was named the Phillips 66 Big 12 Player of the Week on Dec. 1 for the third time in three weeks to start the season. Griffin, who is only the second player in conference history to earn the weekly honor three straight times (Texas Tech's **Andre Emmett** did it during the 2003-04 campaign), averaged 25.0 points, 18.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists in wins over UAB and Purdue to help OU claim the Dick's Sporting Goods NIT Season Tip-Off title. Similarly, freshman guard **Willie Warren** has been named Phillips 66 Big 12 Rookie of the Week three times (Nov. 24, Dec. 1 and Dec. 29), more than any other player. Warren was the unanimous choice as Big 12 Preseason Freshman of the Year.

GRIFFIN NAMED AP PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN

Sophomore **Blake Griffin** became the first Sooner in 13 years to be named an AP preseason first-team All-American (Nov. 3). The last OU player to receive the honor was forward **Ryan Minor** prior to the 1995-96 season. Griffin was joined on the five-man team by North Carolina forward **Tyler Hansbrough**, Davidson guard **Stephen Curry**, Notre Dame forward **Luke Harangody** and UCLA guard **Darren Collison**.

UNANIMOUS PICKS

Blake Griffin and **Willie Warren** were unanimous selections as Big 12 Preseason Player and Freshman of the Year, respectively, the conference office announced Oct. 14. The players were selected by the league's head coaches, who were not permitted to vote for their own players. Griffin is OU's third Big 12 Preseason Player of the Year (**Hollis Price** in 2002-03 and **Taj Gray** in 2005-06 were the others), while Warren is the second OU player to be named Big 12 Preseason Freshman of the Year (**Drew Lavender** was recognized prior to the 2003-04 season).

OU BASKETBALL TRADITION

- ▶ This is the 102nd season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ OU owns a 1,480-937 (.612) all-time record, ranking it 30th in NCAA Division I in wins and 40th in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ OU has made 25 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. Its 21 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 26 years rank as the seventh most in the nation.
- ▶ No team in the country has made more postseason appearances over the last 26 years than Oklahoma's 25.
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and entered this season with the 12th best winning percentage (.726) since 2000.
- ▶ Nineteen different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 29 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim eight times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ Wayman Tisdale was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 72 times.
- ▶ The Sooners own a winning record against 10 of the other 11 members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).

PLAYER NOTES

1 RYAN WRIGHT (6-9, 234, JUNIOR, FORWARD)

- ▶ Averaging 2.8 points and 2.5 rebounds in 9.7 minutes a game (avg. 12.2 minutes in last 6).
- ▶ Has a season-high 6 rebounds in 2 of the last 4 games.
- ▶ Has made 13 of his last 17 free throw attempts going back to the Dec. 4 USC game.
- ▶ A transfer from UCLA (Final Fours in 2006 and 2007) who sat out last season.
- ▶ Saw action in 59 games at UCLA and averaged 1.9 points, 1.2 rebounds in 7.7 minutes.
- ▶ Hails from Mississauga, Ontario, where he was a first-team *Toronto Sun* all-star as a senior at Loyola Catholic Secondary School in 2004-05 (averaged 21 points and 10 rebounds).

3 T.J. FRANKLIN (5-11, 161, FRESHMAN, GUARD)

- ▶ Has played in 4 games (8 total minutes) and has 1 point and 2 assists.
- ▶ A walk-on who teamed with Willie Warren at North Crowley High School in Fort Worth, Texas, to go 38-1 last year and win the Class 5A state title.
- ▶ Averaged 4.5 points, 4.4 assists and 2.4 steals per game as a high school senior.
- ▶ A Texas Association of Basketball Coaches Academic All-State selection last year.
- ▶ An electrical engineering major at OU who graduated No. 7 in his high school class.

5 TONY CROCKER (6-6, 206, JUNIOR, GUARD)

- ▶ Averaging 9.6 points, 3.1 rebounds and 1.1 assists in 28.4 minutes a game.
- ▶ Made 5 second-half 3-pointers at Arkansas Tuesday (6 total) and finished with 18 points.
- ▶ Has scored in double figures in 5 of last 6 games (did it once in first 7 outings) and is shooting .417 (15-for-36) from behind the arc in those 6.
- ▶ Recorded a career-high 26-point game against VCU Dec. 20 in which he went 5-for-6 from 3-point range (entered the game shooting .273 from long distance on the season).
- ▶ Averaged 11.3 points, 3.8 rebounds and 1.9 assists last year (started a team-high 34 games).
- ▶ Shot .532 (50-for-94) from 3-point range in wins last year but just .246 (14-for-57) in losses.

11 OMAR LEARY (5-11, 173, SENIOR, GUARD)

- ▶ Averaging 1.1 points and 1.0 assist in 9.6 minutes per contest.
- ▶ Has 12 assists and 7 turnovers for a 1.7 ratio.
- ▶ Ranked 7th on team last year by averaging 3.9 points in 16.8 minutes per outing.
- ▶ Shot .375 from 3-point range (27-for-72) as a junior.
- ▶ A first-team All-American at Northeastern (Colo.) Junior College in 2006-07.
- ▶ Averaged 21.5 points and 5.5 assists over 4 games at the national junior college tournament.

12 JUAN PATTILLO (6-6, 216, JUNIOR, FORWARD)

- ▶ Will redshirt the 2008-09 season.
- ▶ Regarded as the No. 3 juco player in the country last year by analyst Van Coleman.
- ▶ Averaged a team-high 17.4 points in 22.1 minutes a game at College of Southern Idaho.
- ▶ Led Golden Eagles to a 30-2 record and No. 3 final regular season ranking.

13 WILLIE WARREN (6-4, 207, FRESHMAN, GUARD)

- ▶ The Nov. 24, Dec. 1 and Dec. 29 Big 12 Rookie of the Week.
- ▶ Has scored in double figures in 10 of 13 games and is averaging 16.5 points (2nd on team).
- ▶ Has at least 31 points in each of last 2 games (averaging 33.0) and is 11-for-20 from deep.
- ▶ Over the last 6 games is averaging 20.0 points and 3.3 assists (.500 3-point shooting).
- ▶ First OU true freshman to score at least 30 points since Tim McCalister in 1983-84.
- ▶ The only 2008 McDonald's All-American to sign with a Big 12 program.
- ▶ Scored a game-high 23 points in 22 minutes at McDonald's All-American Game.
- ▶ Averaged 24.9 points, 3.5 rebounds and 4.7 assists for 38-1 North Crowley HS last year.

20 AUSTIN JOHNSON (6-3, 176, SENIOR, GUARD)

- ▶ Averaging 7.2 points and a team-high 4.4 assists a game.
- ▶ Ranks 2nd in the Big 12 with his 2.9 assist-to-turnover ratio, 7th in steals (1.7), 7th in assists (4.4). Also ranks 3rd on team with 12 blocked shots in 13 games.
- ▶ Over the last 8 games is averaging 7.9 points (.451 FG and .370 3FG shooting) and 4.3 assists.
- ▶ Scored a season-high 17 points against USC on Dec. 4 (was 3-for-7 on 3-pointers).
- ▶ OU is 24-4 since start of his sophomore year when he scores in double figures (14-1 last year).
- ▶ Started 33 of 35 games last year and averaged 8.6 points, 2.7 rebounds and 2.7 assists.
- ▶ Shot .444 from 3-point land last year in 11 true road games but .266 in 17 home games.

21 ORLANDO ALLEN (6-11, 267, SOPHOMORE, CENTER)

- ▶ Totaled 8 points in first 2 games on 3-for-3 shooting and has scored 2 points since (4 games).
- ▶ Averaging 5.5 minutes in his 6 outings.
- ▶ Junior college transfer who has 3 years of eligibility remaining.
- ▶ Did not play last year as a sophomore in junior college due to knee and leg injuries.
- ▶ Began playing basketball his junior year in high school in Cincinnati, Ohio.

23 BLAKE GRIFFIN (6-10, 251, SOPHOMORE, FORWARD)

- ▶ Earned the first 3 Big 12 Player-of-the-Week awards this season.
- ▶ Averaging 22.8 points, 14.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.6 steals while shooting .669 from field.
- ▶ Leads Big 12 with 10 double-doubles on the year (had 10 all of last season).
- ▶ Has scored at least 18 points in 12 of 13 games and at least 20 points in 9 outings.
- ▶ On pace to shatter single-season OU rebound average record (13.3, Alvan Adams, 1974-75).
- ▶ Has pulled down at least 15 boards in 6 of 13 games and at least 18 in 5 contests.
- ▶ First Big 12 player to ever record back-to-back games of at least 20 points and 20 rebounds.
- ▶ Unanimous Big 12 Preseason Player of the Year.
- ▶ OU's first AP preseason first-team All-American since Ryan Minor in 1995.
- ▶ A first-team All-Big 12 pick last year (OU's first first-team all-league freshman since 1983).
- ▶ Led team in both scoring (14.7 ppg) and rebounding (9.1 rpg) last season.

31 KYLE CANNON (6-8, 236, SOPHOMORE, FORWARD)

- ▶ Averaging 1.4 points and 1.8 rebounds in 6.6 minutes a contest.
- ▶ Juco transfer who has 3 years of eligibility remaining.
- ▶ A preseason first-team juco All-American last year who played in only 4 games (knee injury).
- ▶ Averaged 14.8 points and 7.5 rebounds as a freshman at San Jacinto (Texas) JC.
- ▶ Attended Worcester (Mass.) Academy in 2005-06 (originally from Baltimore, Md.).

32 TAYLOR GRIFFIN (6-7, 238, JUNIOR, FORWARD)

- ▶ Averaging 9.4 points, 6.6 boards, 1.3 blocks and 1.7 steals in 32.1 minutes a game.
- ▶ Blocks and steals averages rank 2nd on team.
- ▶ Ranks second on the team with his .513 field goal percentage (shot .428 over first 3 years).
- ▶ Scored 16 points against No. 21 Davidson and 19 versus No. 10 Purdue (1 shy of career high).
- ▶ Started 20 of 35 games last year, including 14 of the last 18 (came off the bench the last 3).
- ▶ Recorded a career-high 20 points (7-for-8 shooting) and game-high 6 boards vs. OSU Jan. 28.
- ▶ Won two Class 3A state titles at Oklahoma Christian School, both of them with his brother, Blake (coached by father, Tommy).

34 CADE DAVIS (6-5, 208, SOPHOMORE, GUARD)

- ▶ Averaging 6.3 points in 19.6 minutes a contest and has made 20 treys (.317 from 3).
- ▶ Has scored 35 of his 49 points the last 7 games after halftime (71 percent).
- ▶ Has scored in double figures in 3 of his first 5 outings but not in the last 7 games.
- ▶ Has made at least one trey in all but 2 of his 12 games and at least 2 in 6 contests.
- ▶ Missed a free throw for first time in his career Nov. 18 and is now 34-for-38 (.895).
- ▶ Averaged 3.7 points in 13.3 minutes a contest last season as a true freshman.
- ▶ Started 4 of last season's final 7 games (made 6 starts on the year).

41 RAY WILLIS (6-6, 172, FRESHMAN, GUARD)

- ▶ Averaging 4.0 points in 7.6 minutes a game (21.2 points when projected to 40 minutes).
- ▶ Registered a 13-point, career-high 5-rebound outing against Maine 3 games ago.
- ▶ Averaged 27.5 points and 7.0 rebounds a game as a high school senior.
- ▶ Ranked No. 61 in the 2008 recruiting class by Scout.com and No. 109 by Rivals.com.
- ▶ Owns an 83.5-inch wingspan (6 feet, 11.5 inches).

45 BEAU GERBER (6-8, 228, JUNIOR, FORWARD)

- ▶ Has scored 2 points and grabbed 3 rebounds in his 10 minutes this year (played in 4 games).
- ▶ A third-year walk-on who has earned great respect from the staff and his teammates.
- ▶ Scored 2 points in his 33 minutes of game time last year (played in 15 games).
- ▶ A first-team 5A All-State selection at Winfield (Kan.) High School in 2006.
- ▶ Was a second-team All-State pick as a high school junior.
- ▶ Posted a 3.94 high school GPA and is a mechanical engineering major at OU.

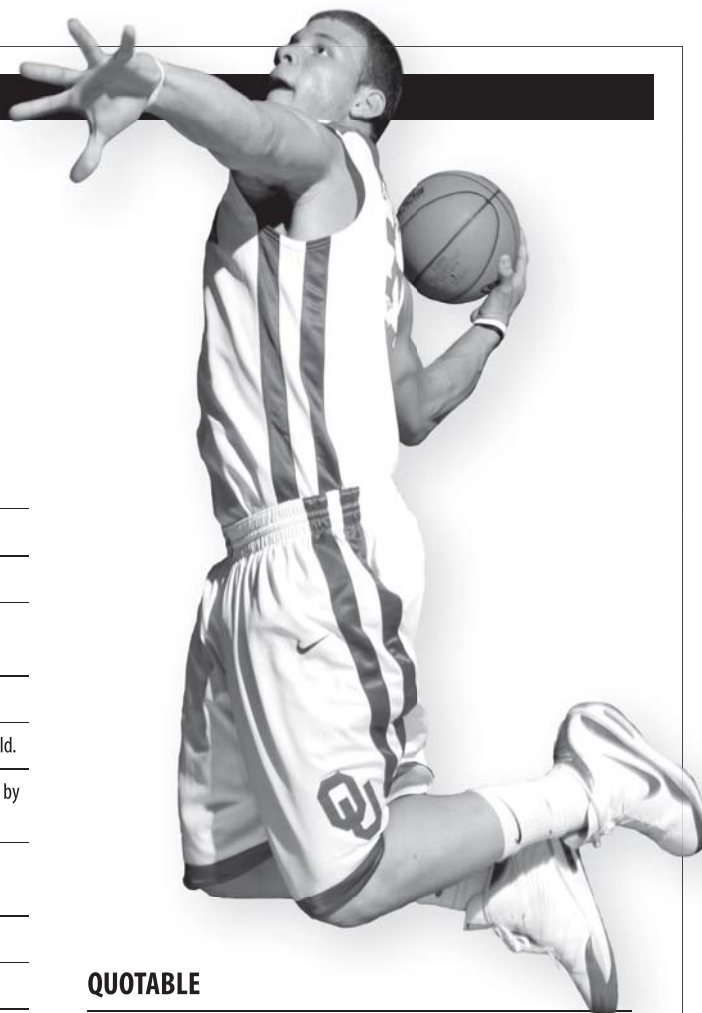

- First Big 12 player to ever record back-to-back games of at least 20 points and 20 rebounds (25 points and 21 rebounds Nov. 18 vs. Davidson; 35 points and 21 boards Nov. 22 vs. Gardner-Webb).
- First Sooner to ever grab at least 18 rebounds in four straight games (18, 19, 21 and 21). No player had ever done it in more than two consecutive outings.
- Third Sooner to ever register six straight double-doubles (Alvan Adams and Garfield Heard).
- Has accounted for 29 percent of Oklahoma's points on the year, 39 percent of its rebounds, 44 percent of its defensive boards and 38 percent of its free throw attempts.
- Is already 60 percent of the way to his rebound total as a freshman (182 this year; 301 last year).
