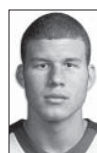

HEAD COACH JEFF CAPEL

Jeff Capel was named Oklahoma's 13th men's basketball head coach on April 11, 2006. Capel, 33, is 59-28 in his third year at OU and led the Sooners to a 23-12 record and second-round NCAA Tournament appearance last year.



Capel compiled a 79-41 (.658) record over four years as head coach at Virginia Commonwealth prior to arriving in Norman. His VCU squads posted a 50-22 (.694) record in Colonial Athletic Association play and a 47-11 overall home record for a staunch .811 winning percentage.

In 2003-04, VCU's CAA Tournament championship game victory over George Mason catapulted the Rams to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1996. VCU lost in the first round to Wake Forest, but not before putting a major scare into the fourth-seeded Demon Deacons, 79-78. Capel's 2004-05 squad, which finished 19-13, competed in the National Invitation Tournament, marking just the third time in program history that VCU made consecutive postseason appearances.

The Rams won at least 18 games each of Capel's four seasons in Richmond, with the 2003-04 squad registering a Capel-era-best 23-8 record. His first team finished 18-10 in 2002-03. In 2005-06, VCU finished 19-10 overall.

In the summer of 2005, Capel served as an assistant coach on the gold-medal-winning USA Men's World University Games Team that finished 8-0 in Turkey in August. Villanova's Jay Wright was the head coach while Seton Hall's Bobby Gonzalez served as the other assistant. The squad featured, among others, Midwest City (Okla.) High School and Duke University standout Shelden Williams.

Capel began his coaching career as an assistant at Old Dominion in 2000 before moving to VCU as an assistant for the 2001-02 season. In 2002, he became the youngest NCAA Division I head coach at age 27.

A four-year starter for Hall-of-Fame coach Mike Krzyzewski at Duke from the 1993-94 through 1996-97 campaigns, Capel earned Atlantic Coast Conference honors each of his seasons in Durham. The guard, who wore No. 5, averaged 12.4 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.4 assists and 1.7 3-pointers during his career and started in the 1994 national title game against Arkansas.

He ranks 22nd in career scoring at Duke (1,601 points), 16th in minutes played (3,774), sixth in 3-pointers (220), seventh in 3-point attempts (553), seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (.398) and 10th in assists (433).

Capel, who graduated from Duke with a bachelor of arts degree in history, and his wife, Kanika, wed in 2003. They have a daughter, Cameron, who was born in April 2007.

PREVIEWING SATURDAY'S GAME

Looking to run its winning streak to nine games, No. 4/5 Oklahoma (20-1, 6-0) plays at Iowa State (12-8, 1-4) on Saturday at 12:30 p.m. CST. The Sooners, who are 5-1 on the road, are coming off an 89-81 win at Oklahoma State Monday. Iowa State, which is 10-3 at home, lost 55-49 at Colorado Tuesday. Saturday's game will be regionally televised by the Big 12 Network (KOCB Ch. 34/Cox 11 in OKC; KJRH Ch. 2/Cox 9 in Tulsa; ESPN Full Court) with **Mitch Holthus** and **Rich Zvosec** announcing. It will air on the Sooner Radio Network (flagship KRXO FM 107.7 in OKC; KTBS AM 1430 in Tulsa) with **Bob Barry, Sr.** and **Mike Houck** calling the action. The game is also part of the Coaches vs. Cancer "Suits and Sneakers Awareness Weekend," a collaborative initiative of the National Association of Basketball Coaches and the American Cancer Society. Coaches from both OU and Iowa State will wear sneakers instead of dress shoes to demonstrate their support for the American Cancer Society and the fight against cancer.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- ▶ At 20-1, Oklahoma is tied with Utah State for the best record in the country. No other team has 20 wins entering weekend play.
- ▶ The Sooners are off to their best start in 23 years (the 1985-86 team began 21-1).
- ▶ OU's 20-1 start is tied as the third best with one loss in Big 12 history (Kansas also started 20-1 in 2004-05). Only the Jayhawks have posted better one-loss starts (34-1 in 1996-97 and 23-1 in 2007-08).
- ▶ OU has clinched its 28th consecutive winning season, topped only by Syracuse (the Orangemen have clinched their 39th straight).
- ▶ Oklahoma owns a 107-77 series lead against Iowa State and has won two straight meetings, six of the last eight and nine of the last 13. **Jeff Capel** is 2-1 against the Cyclones as the Sooners' head coach (0-1 in Ames).
- ▶ Oklahoma has used the same starting lineup in all 21 games. In Big 12 play, all five starters are averaging at least 9.7 points per contest. **Blake Griffin** is averaging 23.0 points and is followed by **Austin Johnson** (14.2), **Willie Warren** (11.7), **Tony Crocker** (9.8) and **Taylor Griffin** (9.7).
- ▶ Junior college transfer **Juan Pattillo**, who came out of a redshirt season in time for the Jan. 12 Texas game but had totaled four minutes in three OU outings prior to this past Saturday, registered nine points and three boards in 14 minutes versus Baylor and 12 points and three boards in 23 minutes at Oklahoma State. He was 8-for-11 from the field (.727) and 5-for-5 at the foul line.
- ▶ Blake Griffin and Warren have accounted for 56 percent of OU's points in its six road games. Griffin is averaging 23.0 points (shooting .596) and 12.2 rebounds in those contests while Warren is averaging 18.3 points (shooting .559) and 3.7 assists.
- ▶ During their current eight-game winning streak, the Sooners are outshooting their opponents from the field, .507 to .366.
- ▶ Blake Griffin leads the Big 12 in scoring (22.3 ppg) and rebounding (14.0 rpg), while ranking second in field goal percentage (.630), fourth in blocks (1.4 bpg) and 12th in steals (1.4 spg). The 6-10 sophomore also averages 2.5 assists per contest, more than any other league player taller than 6-5. He has recorded at least two assists in 17 of 21 games and at least three in 11 outings.
- ▶ Nationally, Blake Griffin ranks first in rebounding and double-doubles (17), second in free throw attempts (9.9 per game), ninth in field goal percentage (.630) and 13th in scoring.
- ▶ Blake Griffin's 26 points and 19 rebounds at Oklahoma State Monday gave him his 10th 20-point, 15-rebound game of the year, more than any player nationally since the 1996-97 season. Tim Duncan (Wake Forest in 1996-97) and Paul Millsap (Louisiana Tech in 2005-06) registered nine 20/15 games.
- ▶ Blake Griffin has accounted for 28 percent of OU's points, 37 percent of its rebounds and 41 percent of its defensive boards in 16 percent of the team's minutes played.
- ▶ Brothers Blake and Taylor Griffin are shooting a combined .592 from the field this year and have teamed to pull down 20.4 rebounds a game (55 percent of the team's total).

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- ▶ The Sooners are shooting .485 from the field. The last time OU shot better for an entire season was 20 years ago (.491 in 1988-89).
- ▶ Over the last 11 games, the Sooners are shooting .401 from 3-point range and averaging 7.5 treys. Over the first 10 games this season, they shot .311 from behind the arc and averaged 6.4 3-pointers.
- ▶ **Tony Crocker** and **Willie Warren** have combined for 49 treys over the last 11 games. Warren is 24-for-50 (.480) from deep in those 11 outings while Crocker is 25-for-60 (.417). Prior to the stretch, each owned a .273 season 3-point figure (12-for-44).
- ▶ **Austin Johnson** has scored in double figures in four of the last five games (15.8 ppg in those five) after doing it three times in the season's first 16 contests. OU is 21-1 over the last two seasons when Johnson scores at least 10 points.
- ▶ In OU's 15 non-conference games, Johnson was 13-for-47 (.277) from 3-point range. In six league outings, he is 15-for-30 (.500).
- ▶ **Blake Griffin** has registered at least three assists in 22 of 54 career games (11 times this year). He has recorded at least two assists 36 times in his career (17 times this season).
- ▶ Warren is shooting .505 from the field on the season (he would rank seventh in the Big 12 but is two makes shy of qualifying in the category). The last OU guard to shoot at least .500 from the field for an entire year was **Nolan Johnson** (.559) in 1999-00.
- ▶ **Cade Davis** made all 23 of his free throw attempts last year as a freshman and canned his first three attempts this year before finally missing against Davidson on Nov. 18. He is now 39-for-45 (.867) in his career.
- ▶ Despite a modest .678 team free throw percentage (they rank ninth in the Big 12), the Sooners have made 13 more foul shots than their opponents have attempted. OU has shot 200 more free throws than its foes, good for an average of 9.5 more per game. Griffin has attempted 36 percent of the team's free throws (207 of its 581).
- ▶ Oklahoma has made at least one 3-pointer in 405 consecutive games (last one without a trey was at Memphis on Dec. 23, 1996).

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- ▶ Oklahoma leads the Big 12 (all games) with its .380 field goal percentage defense. The last time OU held opponents to a lower collective figure for an entire season was 48 years ago (.377 in 1960-61).
- ▶ The Sooners have held their first six Big 12 opponents to a combined .379 field goal mark, with Kansas State (.327) and Texas

(.338) shooting season lows and Baylor (.346) posting its second worst mark of the season.

► OU has held nine of its last 14 foes to a field goal mark under .360.

► Over the last five games, **Taylor Griffin** has recorded 11 blocked shots and nine steals. He ranks third in Big 12 play with his 1.8 blocks per game and sixth with his 1.7 steals. Registering 54 rejections over his sophomore and junior seasons combined (the most ever during a two-year period by a Sooner standing under 6-foot-8), the senior has 28 blocks already this year (1.3 per game).

MONDAY'S OKLAHOMA STATE RECAP

► OU shot .580 from the field and posted a 38-18 rebounding advantage in an 89-81 win in at Oklahoma State Monday night. It was the Sooners' fourth straight victory against the Cowboys and sixth in the last seven meetings, and marked OU's third win in its last four games in Stillwater.

► The Sooners' field goal figure was their second best of the season (they shot .583 the previous game versus Baylor).

► **Blake Griffin**, playing for the first time at OSU (he missed last year's game there due to injury), finished with 26 points, 19 rebounds and three assists. He was 9-for-11 from the field and 8-for-13 from the free throw line. Twelve of his free throw attempts came in the second half.

► Griffin outrebounded the Cowboys by himself, 19-18.

► **Austin Johnson** scored nine of OU's first 13 points and finished with a career-high 22 with the help of 5-for-8 3-point shooting. Johnson's fourth trey came with 6:54 remaining, after OSU had cut OU's 14-point lead to one (64-63). The Sooners led by at least three the rest of the way.

► **Juan Pattillo** came off the bench to score 12 points and grab three rebounds in 23 minutes. He was 4-for-6 from the field (three dunks) and made all four of his free throw attempts.

► **Willie Warren** netted 11 points while **Taylor Griffin** contributed seven points, four boards and a season-high five assists.

► The win improved **Jeff Capel's** record to 4-1 against Oklahoma State as OU's head coach (2-1 in Stillwater).

WHO'S HOT

► A strong candidate for national-player-of-the-year honors, sophomore forward **Blake Griffin** has scored at least 20 points in 15 of 21 games this season and at least 25 on eight occasions. The 6-10, 251-pounder has registered 17 double-doubles (last year he had 10) and has led OU in rebounding 19 times. Griffin leads the Big 12 in scoring (22.3 ppg) and rebounding (14.0 rpg). Big 12 players who rank second in the respective categories are Iowa State's Craig Brackins (19.6 ppg) and Kansas' Cole Aldrich (9.8 rpg). Griffin also ranks second in the Big 12 in field goal percentage (.630), fourth in blocks (1.4) and 12th in steals (1.4).

► After averaging 6.6 points and 4.3 assists per game in non-conference play, senior guard **Austin Johnson** is averaging 14.2 points and 5.2 assists in six league games. He has scored at least 15 points in four of the last five contests. Johnson is 15-for-30 from 3-point range in OU's six Big 12 outings, owns a 2.8 assist-to-turnover ratio and has blocked five shots.

► Over the last 10 games, freshman **Willie Warren** is averaging 16.5 points and 2.8 assists. He is shooting .547 from the field and .468 (22-for-47) from behind the arc in those contests.

► After scoring in double figures once in OU's first seven games, junior guard **Tony Crocker** has done it in 10 of the last 14. He is averaging 12.3 points over the 14 outings and is shooting .403 from 3-point range (29-for-72). By comparison, Crocker averaged 6.6 points and shot .250 from 3-point territory over OU's first seven games this year.

► Senior forward **Taylor Griffin** is averaging 11.0 points over the last four games after averaging 7.3 over the previous seven.

PREVIEWING IOWA STATE

► Iowa State enters Saturday's game with a 12-8 overall record and a 1-4 Big 12 mark following Tuesday's 55-49 loss at Colorado. The Cyclones are 1-1 at home in league play with a 65-53 victory over Nebraska and an 82-67 loss to Kansas.

► ISU averages a Big 12-low 65.4 points a game, shoots .436 from the field (ranks 11th), .351 from behind the 3-point arc (ninth) and .702 from the free throw line (fourth). It ranks third in scoring defense (62.1 ppg) and field goal percentage defense (.389).

► Sophomore forward **Craig Brackins** is the only Cyclone who scores in double figures. The reigning Big 12 Player of the Week is averaging team highs of 19.6 points (ranks second in Big 12), 9.1 rebounds (fourth) and 1.0 blocked shot. Brackins is shooting .498 from the field and leads the team with his 118 free throw attempts (shooting .669).

► Sophomore guard **Diante Garrett** averages 9.7 points, 3.9 boards and a team-high 5.1 assists an outing. He ranks second on the team with 77 free throw attempts.

► Fellow sophomore guard **Lucca Staiger** contributes 8.8 points per contest and has made a team-high 50 3-pointers on 120 attempts (shooting a team-high .417). From Germany, Staiger is averaging 10.0 points in Big 12 play.

► No other Cyclone averages more than 6.2 points or 4.3 rebounds.

► **Greg McDermott** is in his third year as Iowa State's head coach and owns a 41-42 (.494) record there. The 1988 Northern Iowa graduate is in his 15th year as a collegiate head coach and owns a 262-169 (.608) career mark.

SERIES WITH IOWA STATE

► Oklahoma owns a 107-77 all-time record against Iowa State but trails 45-35 in Ames.

► The Sooners have won nine of the last 13 overall meetings but have lost two in a row in Ames and three of the last four. Their last win at Hilton Coliseum came in 2003.

► OU is 9-5 against Iowa State since the inception of the Big 12 (that includes a 1-1 record in the league tournament).

► In the last meeting in Ames two seasons ago, Oklahoma dropped a 58-51 decision. The Sooners shot .300 from the field in the first half and trailed 32-17 at intermission before drawing to within four (53-49). They got no closer, though, and their four-game winning streak came to a halt. **Jiri Hubalek** scored a career-high 26 points for Iowa State while **Longar Longar** paced OU with 20.

LAST YEAR AGAINST THE CYCLONES

► Solid 3-point (7-for-17) and free throw (25-for-29) shooting helped OU to a 76-64 home win over Iowa State on Feb. 13, 2008.

► **Tony Crocker** was 10-for-10 at the free throw line and finished with 22 points and a career-high-tying nine rebounds.

► **Blake Griffin** and **Austin Johnson** each tallied 13 points. Griffin pulled down eight boards while Johnson logged three assists.

► **Cade Davis** came off the bench to supply a season-high 11 points with the help of 3-for-3 shooting from behind the arc.

► **Jiri Hubalek** led the Cyclones with 23 points while **Diante Garrett** and **Wesley Johnson** netted 10 apiece.

► OU's win was its sixth straight against Iowa State in Norman.

NOTING OU'S 30-POINT PERFORMANCES

► Sophomore **Blake Griffin** and freshman **Willie Warren** have each posted back-to-back 30-point performances this season. Griffin netted a career-high 35 points against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22 before scoring 32 four days later against UAB. Warren went for 31 at Rice on Dec. 22 before pouring in a career-high 35 on Dec. 30 at Arkansas. Only one other team in the country has had a player combo accomplish the feat this season (Notre Dame's Luke Harangody and Kyle McAlarney).

► The last time two Sooners each had back-to-back games of at least 30 points in the same season was in 1993-94 when senior forward **Jeff Webster** and junior guard/forward **Calvin Curry** did it.

► The last OU player to register two 30-point games his true freshman season was **Tim McCalister** in 1983-84. The last OU true frosh to register at least three 30-point games was **Wayman Tisdale** in 1982-83 (he had a freshman-record nine).

MORE BLAKE

► **Blake Griffin** scored at least 18 points in each of the season's first nine games, marking OU's longest such streak since guard **Corey Brewer** netted at least 18 in 15 consecutive outings during the 1997-98 season. Griffin's lone three games under 18 points this year were an 11-point performance against Utah Dec. 13 when he played a season-low 23 minutes (attempted only three field goals), a 14-point effort against Coppin State Jan. 3, and a 16-point afternoon Jan. 17 at Texas A&M.

► Lost in Griffin's gaudy scoring and rebounding statistics are some pretty impressive assist numbers. The forward ranks third on the team with 2.5 assists per game this season and has registered at least one handout in all 21 outings. Last season, Griffin became the first Sooner standing 6-foot-10 or taller to ever dish at least three assists in a game 11 times. He has recorded at least three assists 11 times already this year.

► Griffin (14.0 rpg and .630 FG%) is on pace to shatter single-season school records for rebounding average and field goal percentage. The standards of 13.3 boards per game and .627 from the field were set by **Alvan Adams** in 1974-75 and **Al Beal** in 1978-79. Griffin is also averaging 9.9 free throw attempts a game (ranks second nationally), a figure that would break **Stacey King's** 1988-89 school record of 8.9 foul shots per outing.

► Griffin has 54 dunks on the season, good for an average of 2.6 per game.

► Griffin owns the best vertical leap (no step) on the team at 37.5 inches, as well as the best max leap (no limit on steps) by reaching 27 inches above the rim. He also owns an 84.5-inch wingspan (seven feet and one-half inch).

UNDERRATED AUSTIN

A Sooner who tends to get lost among OU's higher-profile players is senior point guard **Austin Johnson**. The 6-3, 176-pounder ranks fifth on the team with his 8.8 points per outing but ranks among the Big 12's leaders in several other categories. Johnson leads the league (ranks in the top 10 nationally) in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.1-to-1) and ranks seventh in assists (4.5), and 14th in blocked shots (0.9). Oklahoma State's James Anderson is the only Big 12 guard who averages more rejections per game (1.0).

OU BASKETBALL TRADITION

► This is the 102nd season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).

► OU owns a 1,488-937 (.614) all-time record, ranking it 30th in NCAA Division I in wins and 40th in winning percentage.

► Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).

► OU has made 25 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. Its 21 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 26 years rank as the seventh most in the nation.

► No team in the country has made more postseason appearances over the last 27 years than Oklahoma's 26.

► The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 crowns).

► The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and own the 10th best winning percentage (.741) in the 2000s.

► Nineteen different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 29 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim eight times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.

► Wayman Tisdale was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).

► Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 72 times.

► The Sooners own a winning record against 10 of the other 11 members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).

► OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).

- ▶ Posted a 3.94 high school GPA and is a mechanical engineering major at OU.

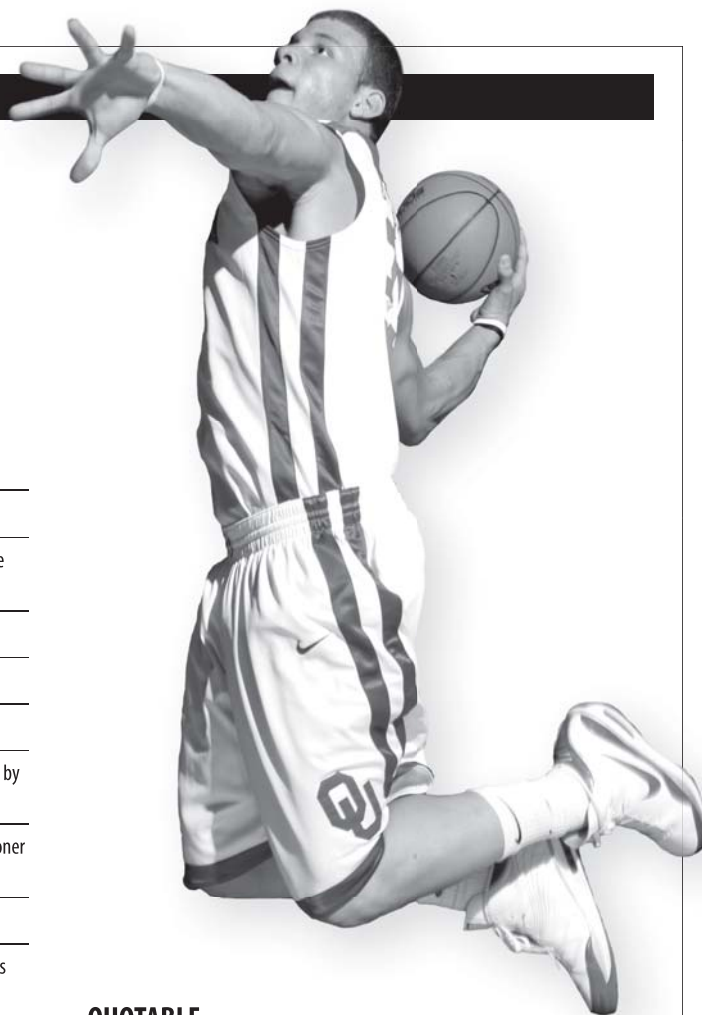

- Unanimous choice as Big 12 Preseason Player of the Year.
- Named Big 12 Player of the Week four times, including each of the season's first three weeks. Only one other player in history (Texas Tech's Andre Emmett in 2003-04) has won the honor three straight times.
- Ranks first nationally with his 14.0 rebounds a game and 13th with his 22.3 points a contest.
- Averages 2.5 assists (ranks third on team), 1.4 blocks and 1.4 steals while shooting .630 from the field.
- No Big 12 player taller than 6-5 averages more assists than Griffin's 2.5 per game.
- On pace to shatter OU's single-season record for rebounding average (record of 13.3 per game was set by Alvan Adams in 1974-75) and field goal percentage (.627 by Al Beal in 1978-79).
- Has scored at least 20 points in 15 of 21 games (finished with 18 twice and 19 once). Became first Sooner to score at least 18 points in nine consecutive games since 1997-98 (guard Corey Brewer).
- Has pulled down 21 rebounds three times (versus Davidson, Gardner-Webb and Purdue).
- First Big 12 player to ever record back-to-back games of at least 20 points and 20 rebounds (25 points and 21 rebounds Nov. 18 vs. Davidson; 35 points and 21 boards Nov. 22 vs. Gardner-Webb).
- Has 10 20-point, 15-rebound games, the most in a season nationally since 1996-97 (Wake Forest's Tim Duncan in 1996-97 and Louisiana Tech's Paul Millsap in 2005-06 each had nine such games).
- First Sooner to ever grab at least 18 rebounds in four straight games (18, 19, 21 and 21). No player had ever done it in more than two consecutive outings. Has seven games of at least 18 boards on the year.
- Third Sooner to register six straight double-doubles (Alvan Adams, Garfield Heard). He has done it twice.
- Has accounted for 28 percent of Oklahoma's points on the year, 37 percent of its rebounds, 41 percent of its defensive boards and 36 percent of its free throw attempts (has played 16 percent of OU's minutes).
- Is already 98 percent of the way to his rebound total as a freshman (295 this year; 301 last year).
- Averaging 9.9 free throw attempts per game to rank second in the nation (Stacey King set OU's current single-season record of 8.9 attempts per contest in 1988-89).
- Needs 47 points to join Wayman Tisdale, Alvan Adams and Jeff Webster as the only Sooners to reach 1,000 during their sophomore season (would take him three more games at his current pace of 22.3 ppg).
- Boasts nine of OU's 13 highest scoring games and its 18 highest rebounding games.
- Had a career-high six steals versus Mississippi Valley State and a career-high four blocks twice.
- Has registered at least three assists in 22 of 54 career games (11 times this year) and has at least two assists in 36 career contests (17 times this season).
