Head Coach Jeff Capel



Jeff Capel was named Oklahoma's 13th men's basketball head coach on April 11, 2006. Capel, 34, is 81-42 in his fourth year at OU and led the Sooners to a 30-6 record and an NCAA Tournament Elite Eight appearance in 2008-09.

Capel, who coached OU to a 23-12 mark and to the NCAA Tournament second round from 2007-08, compiled a 79-41 (.658) record over four years as head coach at Virginia Commonwealth prior to arriving in Norman. His squads went 50-22 (.694) in Colonial Athletic Association play.

In 2003-04, VCU's CAA Tournament championship game victory over George Mason catapulted the Rams to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1996. VCU lost in the first round to Wake Forest, but not before putting a major scare into the fourth-seeded Demon Deacons, 79-78. Capel's 2004-05 squad, which finished 19-13, competed in the National Invitation Tournament, marking just the third time in program history that VCU made consecutive postseason appearances.

The Rams won at least 18 games each of Capel's four seasons in Richmond, with the 2003-04 squad registering a Capel-era-best 23-8 record. His first team finished 18-10 in 2002-03. In 2005-06, VCU finished 19-10 overall.

In the summer of 2005, Capel served as an assistant coach on the gold-medal-winning USA Men's World University Games Team that finished 8-0 in Turkey in August. Villanova's Jay Wright was the head coach while Seton Hall's Bobby Gonzalez served as the other assistant. The squad featured, among others, Midwest City (Okla.) High School and Duke University standout Shelden Williams.

Capel began his coaching career as an assistant at Old Dominion in 2000 before moving to VCU as an assistant for the 2001-02 season. In 2002, he became the youngest NCAA Division I head coach at age 27.

A four-year starter for Hall-of-Fame coach Mike Krzyzewski at Duke from the 1993-94 through 1996-97 campaigns, Capel earned Atlantic Coast Conference honors each of his seasons in Durham. The guard, who wore No. 5, averaged 12.4 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.4 assists and 1.7 3-pointers during his career and started in the 1994 national title game against Arkansas.

He ranks 22nd in career scoring at Duke (1,601 points), 16th in minutes played (3,774), sixth in 3-pointers (220), seventh in 3-point attempts (553), seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (.398) and 11th in assists (433).

Capel, who graduated from Duke with a bachelor of arts degree in history, and his wife, Kanika, wed in 2003. They have two daughters, Cameron and Sydney.

SATURDAY'S GAME BASICS

Oklahoma (12-9 overall, 3-4 Big 12) plays the first of two straight home games when it hosts No. 9/10 Texas (19-3, 5-2) Saturday at 3 p.m. CST. The Sooners are 10-0 at home this year and have won 30 of their last 31 in Norman. Texas, coming off a 72-60 win at Oklahoma State on Monday, is 4-2 in true road games and is the first ranked opponent to visit Norman this year. Saturday's game will air on the Sooner Radio Network with **Bob Barry Sr.** and **Mike Houck** announcing. It will be televised by ESPN with **Ron Franklin** and **Fran Fraschilla** calling the action.

NOTEWORTHY

- ▶ The Oklahoma athletics department will celebrate the life and playing career of all-time leading scorer and rebounder **Wayman Tisdale** on Saturday. Tisdale's family, as well as former teammates, coaches and band mates, will be in attendance. Tisdale passed away last May from cancer at the age of 44.
- ▶ OU is 46-28 all-time against Texas and 22-9 in Norman.
- ▶ The Sooners are averaging 8.3 3-point makes per game. The school record for average 3-pointers per contest in a season is 8.5 (in 1998-99). Five Sooners have made at least 25 treys (no other Big 12 school has more than three players).
- ▶ OU ranks second in the Big 12 and 26th nationally with its .739 free throw mark.
- ▶ Over the last four games, **Tommy Mason-Griffin** is averaging 23.5 points and 4.0 assists. He is 14-for-28 (.500) from 3-point range during the stretch.
- ▶ Mason-Griffin has made at least one 3-pointer in 20 of 21 games, and at least two treys in 14 of the last 17 outings. He ranks second in the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage (.446), fourth in assists (4.6 apg) and sixth in 3-pointers per game (2.1).
- ▶ In OU's seven conference games, Mason-Griffin is shooting .489 (22-for-45) from 3-point range. The rest of the team is shooting .245 (27-for-110).
- ▶ Last week, Mason-Griffin became the first OU guard to score at least 20 points in three consecutive games since first-team All-American **Hollis Price** did it in 2002-03 as a senior. **Tim McCalister** in 1983-84 was the last OU freshman (regardless of position) to pull off the feat.
- ▶ Senior guard **Tony Crocker**, who has started his last 86 games, has recorded his only six career double-doubles over his last 14 outings.
- ▶ Crocker needs eight rebounds to become just the second Sooner to ever record 1,000 points, 500 boards and 150 3-pointers in a career (**Ryan Minor** is the other).
- ▶ Junior guard **Cade Davis** has scored at least 13 points four times in the last eight games and is averaging 11.8 points over the stretch (he averaged 7.7 points in the team's first 13 games). A .391 field goal shooter on the year, Davis has shot .500 or better in five of the last eight outings. Over the last two games, he is averaging 18.5 points and is 7-for-15 (.467) from behind the arc.
- ▶ Sophomore guard **Willie Warren** is averaging 14.1 points over his last nine games (4.3 free throw attempts per contest) after averaging 19.6 points over his first nine (7.9 free throw attempts per game).

SATURDAY'S NEBRASKA RECAP

- ▶ Oklahoma posted season lows in points (46), field goals (15), field goal attempts (43) and free throw makes (8) in its 63-46 loss at Nebraska Saturday.
- ▶ The Sooners fell behind 11-3 almost seven minutes into the game, rallied to

tie the score at 15-15 with 6:00 left in the half and later watched the Huskers use an 8-0 half-ending run to lead 29-20 at intermission. OU, which still trailed by nine (53-44) with 4:50 to go in the second half, was outscored 10-2 over the game's final 4:30.

► **Cade Davis** was the only Sooner who scored in double figures. He was 3-for-6 from 3-point range and netted 13 points in 22 minutes (played just three minutes in the first half after picking up two quick fouls).

► **Tommy Mason-Griffin** was 2-for-5 from behind the arc and finished with nine points and a team-high four assists.

► The Sooners registered 13 assists on their 15 field goals.

► **Tony Crocker** (five points in 25 minutes) and **Willie Warren** (four points in 28 minutes) returned to the lineup after being injured.

► The Sooners allowed Nebraska to shoot .517 from the field in the second half. It marked the third straight game an OU opponent shot better than .500 after halftime.

PREVIEWING TEXAS

Texas, ranked No. 9 in the AP poll and No. 10 in the ESPN/USA Today version, is 19-3 on the year and 5-2 in Big 12 play. It was ranked No. 1 in both polls just two weeks ago after winning its first 17 games. The Longhorns lost three out of four games after reaching No. 1 status, but rebounded for a 72-60 win at Oklahoma State on Monday. In conference play, UT ranks No. 2 in scoring offense (81.6 ppg), No. 9 in scoring defense (75.7 ppg), No. 3 in field goal percentage (.457), No. 5 in 3-point percentage (.372) and No. 12 in free throw percentage (.609).

Senior forward **Damion James** leads a trio of Longhorns who average double figures in points. James, who originally signed a letter of intent with Oklahoma, produces 18.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and 1.8 steals per game. He ranks sixth in the Big 12 in scoring, first in rebounding and fourth in steals. Freshman guard **Avery Bradley** averages 12.1 points and 2.3 assists per game. A McDonald's All-American last year, Bradley ranks second on the team with his 29 3-point makes (shooting .392 from behind the arc). He sports a .480 free throw mark (24-for-50). Senior center **Dexter Pittman** is averaging 11.6 points, 5.9 rebounds and a team-high 2.2 blocks in just 19.6 minutes a contest. The 6-10, 290-pounder is averaging 6.6 points and 4.0 boards in league play (19.7 minutes per game). Freshmen **J'Covan Brown** and **Jordan Hamilton** rank fourth and fifth on the squad in scoring. Brown, a guard, averages 9.7 points and 2.3 assists a contest, and is shooting .926 from the free throw line (50-for-54). Hamilton supplies 9.3 points and 3.2 rebounds in 17.4 minutes an outing, and leads the team with his 35 treys (shooting .380 from long distance). Hamilton is coming off a career-high 27 point game at Oklahoma State in which he went 11-for-16 from the field (5-for-8 from 3-point range) in just 19 minutes of action. His previous career high was 17 points.

Rick Barnes is in his 12th year as Texas' head coach and is 289-108 (.747). He owns a 491-242 (.670) career record.

OU-TEXAS SERIES HISTORY

Oklahoma owns a 46-28 series advantage against Texas despite losing seven of the last eight meetings. OU is 22-9 against the Longhorns in Norman and is 13-6 at Lloyd Noble Center. Since the start of the Big 12 in 1996-97, OU is 17-15 against Texas (8-5 in Norman). **Jeff Capel** is 1-6 against the Longhorns as OU's head coach (1-2 in Norman).

LAST YEAR AGAINST THE LONGHORNS (LAST YEAR'S BOX SCORES/CUMULATIVE STATS ON PAGE 13)

Oklahoma and Texas split their two meetings last year, with OU posting a 78-63 win in Norman on Jan. 12 and UT claiming a 73-68 triumph in Austin on Feb. 21. In the first matchup, **Blake Griffin** recorded 20 points, 10 rebounds and three assists for the Sooners while **Willie Warren** added 17 points, **Tony Crocker** 16 and **Austin Johnson** 15. OU, which jumped out to a 24-8 lead and shot .509 from the field on the night, held Texas to .338 field goal and .217 (5-for-23) 3-point shooting. **A.J. Abrams** led the Longhorns with 22 points but was 8-for-27 (.296) from the floor and 3-for-15 (.200) from behind the arc. The Sooners saw their 13-game winning streak end in the rematch in Austin, as Griffin sustained a first-half concussion and scored just two points in 11 total minutes. Warren, who was 6-for-12 from 3-point distance and scored 27 points, led a charge that put OU up 61-56 with 5:00 remaining. Texas outscored the Sooners 17-7 the rest of the way, however. Abrams, who scored 18 of Texas' final 20 points, finished with a team-high 23. **Damion James** added 16 points and 10 boards.

MASON-GRIFFIN ON A ROLL

► Over the last six games, freshman point guard **Tommy Mason-Griffin** has played 237 out of 245 possible minutes and is averaging 19.3 points, 3.7 rebounds and 4.0 assists while shooting .488 from 3-point range (20-for-41).

► Mason-Griffin recorded career scoring highs in three straight games ending with the Jan. 27 game against Iowa State (21 at Texas A&M, 26 at Texas Tech and 38 vs. Iowa State). He averaged 28.3 points over the three outings and went 12-for-23 (.522) from behind the arc.

► The 5-11, 203-pounder ranks second in the Big 12 in 3-point percentage (.446), fourth in assists (4.6 apg), sixth in 3-pointers per game (2.1) and 11th in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.0). In Big 12 play, he ranks second in treys per contest (3.1) and third in 3-point percentage (.489).

► Mason-Griffin leads OU and all Big 12 freshmen with his 17.4 scoring average in conference play.

► With nine regular season games remaining, Mason-Griffin already ranks fourth on OU's all-time freshman list in 3-point makes (45) and sixth in assists (97). No Oklahoma freshman has ever shot better from 3-point range for a season than Mason-Griffin's current .446 mark.

► Only one freshman in school history averaged more minutes per game than Mason-Griffin's current 34.1. That was **Wayman Tisdale** (averaged 34.5) in 1982-83.

MASON-GRIFFIN'S STELLAR NIGHT

Two games ago against Iowa State (Jan. 27), freshman **Tommy Mason-Griffin** propelled the Sooners to an 89-84 home win on a night in which OU played without **Willie Warren** and **Tony Crocker** due to ankle injuries (the pair was averaging a combined 30 points a game). Mason-Griffin finished with 38 points and six assists while playing all 40 minutes (he battled leg cramps the final 3:45). The point guard was 13-for-21 from the field, 5-for-10 from 3-point range and 7-for-7 from the free throw line. His 38 points were....

► Five more than any other Big 12 player has scored this year.

► The most scored by an OU freshman since **Wayman Tisdale** in 1982-83.

► The most scored by a freshman guard in school history.

► Tied for the most scored by a point guard in school history (**Mookie Blaylock** also scored 38 against Iowa State in 1988-89).

► Tied for the fifth most by a freshman in Big 12 history (only Kansas State's **Michael Beasley** scored more).

► The second most scored by a Sooner since the 1993-94 season (**Blake Griffin** scored 40 last year).

OU opponents in **bold****THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN WINS AND LOSSES**

- ▶ In their 12 wins, the Sooners are holding opponents to .402 field goal and .323 3-point shooting. In OU's nine losses, foes have shot .484 from the field and .441 from behind the arc.
- ▶ The Sooners have outrebounded their opponents by 3.1 per game in wins but have been outboarded by an average of 4.3 in losses.
- ▶ **Cade Davis** is averaging 12.3 points (.379 from 3-point range) in wins compared to 5.1 points (.250 from behind the arc) in losses. In three Big 12 wins, Davis is averaging 16.0 points (.513 field goal shooting). In four Big 12 losses he is averaging 6.8 points (.292 shooting).
- ▶ **Tony Crocker** is averaging 14.8 points (.478 from 3-point range) and 8.0 boards in wins (not including the Missouri game when he played only five minutes due to injury) compared to 10.0 points (.265 from deep) and 5.6 boards in losses. Five of his six double-doubles have come in victories.

PICK YOUR POISON

Five different Sooners have each made at least 25 treys through the team's first 21 games. No other Big 12 team has more than three players with at least 25 3-point makes each heading into the weekend. **Tommy Mason-Griffin** leads OU with 45 makes (2.1 per game) and is followed by **Cade Davis** with 34 (1.6 per outing), **Tony Crocker** with 31 (1.6 per game), **Steven Pledger** with 29 (1.4 per contest) and **Willie Warren** with 25 (1.4 per game). OU ranks second in the Big 12 with its 8.3 treys per outing.

GUARDS SHOULDERING THE LOAD

Five of OU's top six scorers, including its top three, are guards. The Sooners' backcourt has accounted for 1,171 of the team's 1,545 points, or 76 percent. Three guards average double figures in scoring while two more average at least 6.4 points. **Willie Warren** averages 16.8 points per outing and is followed by **Tommy Mason Griffin** (12.7), **Tony Crocker** (11.9), **Cade Davis** (9.2) and **Steven Pledger** (6.4). All five of those players have surpassed the 20-point mark at least twice this year (Warren has done it seven times, Mason-Griffin four times, Crocker three times and Davis and Pledger twice each). Mason-Griffin (twice), Crocker and Davis have all scored at least 20 points in a half this season. Last year, guards accounted for 52 percent of OU's points.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

The freshman foursome of **Tommy Mason-Griffin** (12.7 ppg), **Tiny Gallon** (10.6), **Steven Pledger** (6.4) and **Andrew Fitzgerald** (3.7) has combined to score 687 of the team's 1,545 points this year, or 44 percent. Mason-Griffin ranks second in the league with his .448 3-point field goal percentage and fourth with his 4.6 assists per game. Gallon, who is shooting .547 from the field, ranks sixth in the Big 12 in rebounds per game (8.4) and seventh with six double-doubles (he missed out on another by one rebound). Pledger has knocked down 29 treys and has two games of more than 20 points. Fitzgerald has made four starts and is averaging 3.7 points on .500 field goal shooting.

CROCKER CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Senior guard **Tony Crocker** entered the year ranked 34th in school history in points (1,008) and seventh in 3-point makes (158). With a strong start to the season, the 6-6 San Antonio, Texas, product has vaulted to the No. 18 spot in points (1,246) and the No. 4 spot in 3-pointers (189). Crocker, who has started his last 86 games, needs 32 points to tie **Blake Griffin** (2008-09) for 17th place in scoring. At his current pace of 11.9 points per game, Crocker would finish the regular season ranked 15th on the Sooners' all-time scoring chart. Crocker's next target on the career 3-point makes list is **Tim Heskett** (1997-01). He needs 26 makes to tie Heskett for third on that list.

Crocker also has a chance to make a run at the top spot on OU's games played list. He entered the year with 102 career appearances and would finish the regular season with 131 if he plays in every remaining game. Depending on the Sooners' postseason fortunes, Crocker could challenge the record of 137 career games played by **Darryl "Choo" Kennedy** (1984-87).

Also, Crocker is eight rebounds shy of becoming just the second Sooner (and first of the Big 12 era) to register at least 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 150 3-pointers in a career. Forward **Ryan Minor** (1993-96) racked up 1,946 points, 767 rebounds and 170 treys.

QUANTIFYING OU'S BASKETBALL TRADITION

- ▶ This is the 103rd season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ OU owns a 1,510-951 (.614) all-time record, ranking it 29th in NCAA Division I history in wins and 38th in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ OU has made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. Its 22 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 27 years rank as the sixth most in the nation.
- ▶ No team in the country has made more postseason appearances over the last 28 years than Oklahoma's 27.
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and the ninth best (.738) in the 2000s.
- ▶ Twenty different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 30 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim nine times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ Wayman Tisdale was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 73 times.
- ▶ The Sooners own a winning record against 10 of the other 11 members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).

1 RYAN WRIGHT (6-9, 241, SENIOR, FORWARD)

- ▶ Averaging 3.7 points and 4.1 rebounds in 17.6 minutes a game (has started 7 games).
- ▶ Had best game as a Sooner Jan. 16 vs. Missouri (career highs of 12 points and 8 rebounds).
- ▶ Averaging 4.7 points (.667 FG%) and 4.9 boards in 19.3 minutes a game in Big 12 play.
- ▶ Shooting a team-best .587 from the field after posting a .341 mark last year.

3 T.J. FRANKLIN (5-11, 166, SOPHOMORE, GUARD)
