## Head Coach Jeff Capel



Jeff Capel was named Oklahoma's 13th men's basketball head coach on April 11, 2006. Capel, 34, is 82-43 in his fourth year at OU and led the Sooners to a 30-6 record and an NCAA Tournament Elite Eight appearance in 2008-09.

Capel, who coached OU to a 23-12 mark and to the NCAA Tournament second round in 2007-08, compiled a 79-41 (.658) record over four years as head coach at Virginia Commonwealth prior to arriving in Norman. His squads went 50-22 (.694) in Colonial Athletic Association play.

In 2003-04, VCU's CAA Tournament championship game victory over George Mason catapulted the Rams to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1996. VCU lost in the first round to Wake Forest, but not before putting a major scare into the fourth-seeded Demon Deacons, 79-78. Capel's 2004-05 squad, which finished 19-13, competed in the National Invitation Tournament, marking just the third time in program history that VCU made consecutive postseason appearances.

The Rams won at least 18 games each of Capel's four seasons in Richmond, with the 2003-04 squad registering a Capel-era-best 23-8 record. His first team finished 18-10 in 2002-03. In 2005-06, VCU finished 19-10 overall.

In the summer of 2005, Capel served as an assistant coach on the gold-medal-winning USA Men's World University Games Team that finished 8-0 in Turkey in August. Villanova's Jay Wright was the head coach while Seton Hall's Bobby Gonzalez served as the other assistant. The squad featured, among others, Midwest City (Okla.) High School and Duke University standout Shelden Williams.

Capel began his coaching career as an assistant at Old Dominion in 2000 before moving to VCU as an assistant for the 2001-02 season. In 2002, he became the youngest NCAA Division I head coach at age 27.

A four-year starter for Hall-of-Fame coach Mike Krzyzewski at Duke from the 1993-94 through 1996-97 campaigns, Capel earned Atlantic Coast Conference honors each of his seasons in Durham. The guard, who wore No. 5, averaged 12.4 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.4 assists and 1.7 3-pointers during his career and started in the 1994 national title game against Arkansas.

He ranks 22nd in career scoring at Duke (1,601 points), 16th in minutes played (3,774), sixth in 3-pointers (220), seventh in 3-point attempts (553), seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (.398) and 11th in assists (433).

Capel, who graduated from Duke with a bachelor of arts degree in history, and his wife, Kanika, wed in 2003. They have two daughters, Cameron and Sydney.

## TUESDAY'S GAME BASICS

Oklahoma (13-10 overall, 4-5 Big 12) will go for its fourth regular season sweep of Oklahoma State (15-7, 4-5) in the last five years when it travels to Stillwater for Saturday's 1 p.m. CST game at Gallagher-Iba Arena. The Sooners, who beat OSU 62-57 in overtime in Norman on Jan. 11, are 1-5 in true road games this year. The Cowboys have lost three straight contests after a 15-4 start to the season. Saturday's game, part of the Bedlam Series and sponsored by Oklahoma Farm Bureau and The Oklahoman, will air on the Sooner Radio Network with **Bob Barry Sr.** and **Mike Houck** calling the action. It will be televised by ESPN with **Ron Franklin** and **Fran Fraschilla** announcing.

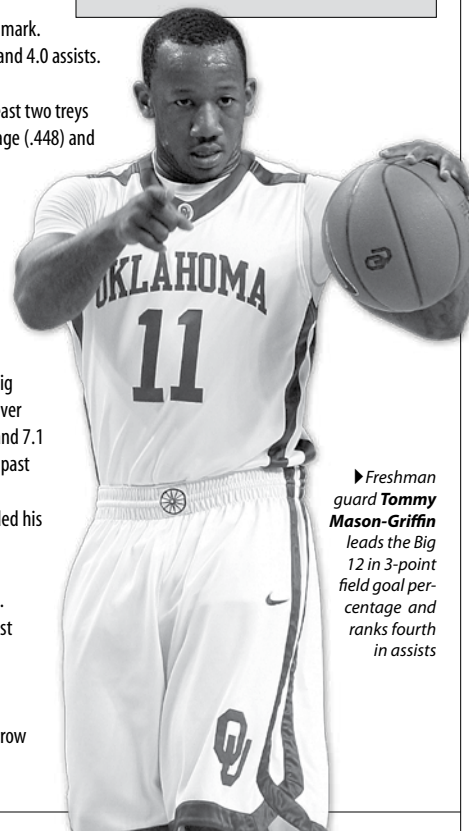
## NOTEWORTHY

- ▶ Oklahoma has won six of the last 7 meetings against Oklahoma State (the lone loss came by one point) and nine of the last 12. The Sooners have won each of the last two years in Stillwater and in three of the last four.
- ▶ In its six true road games this year (1-5 record), OU is averaging 63.3 points and is shooting .370 from the field and .289 (37-for-128) from 3-point range.
- ▶ The Sooners are averaging 8.3 3-point makes per game. The school record for average 3-pointers per contest in a season is 8.5 (in 1998-99). Five Sooners have made at least 25 treys (no other Big 12 school has more than three players).
- ▶ OU ranks second in the Big 12 and 30th nationally with its .737 free throw mark.
- ▶ Over the last six games, **Tommy Mason-Griffin** is averaging 21.2 points and 4.0 assists. He is 21-for-43 (.488) from 3-point range during the stretch.
- ▶ Mason-Griffin has made at least one 3-point in 22 of 23 games, and at least two treys in 16 of the last 19 outings. He leads the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage (.448) and ranks fourth in assists (4.6 avg) and fifth in treys per game (2.3).
- ▶ In OU's nine conference games, Mason-Griffin is shooting .483 (29-for-60) from 3-point range. The rest of the team is shooting .248 (36-for-145).
- ▶ Mason-Griffin did not lead OU in scoring in any of its first 17 games. He has done it four times in the last six outings.
- ▶ Junior guard **Cade Davis** is averaging 16.3 points and 4.0 rebounds over the last four outings. He is 12-for-32 (.375) from behind the arc during the stretch and has made at least three 3-pointers in four of the last six games.
- ▶ Senior forward **Ryan Wright** is averaging 5.7 points and 5.9 rebounds in Big 12 play after averaging 3.2 points and 3.7 boards in non-conference action. Over the last seven games, he is averaging 6.7 points (.621 field goal percentage) and 7.1 rebounds. He had 11 points and a career-high 14 boards (10 in first half) this past Saturday in a win over No. 9 Texas.
- ▶ Senior guard **Tony Crocker**, who has started his last 88 games, has recorded his only seven career double-doubles over his last 16 outings.
- ▶ On Tuesday, Crocker became just the second Sooner to ever record 1,000 points, 500 boards and 150 3-pointers in a career (**Ryan Minor** is the other).
- ▶ Sophomore guard **Willie Warren**, who has battled a sprained ankle the last couple of weeks (missed two games), scored 18 points Tuesday against Texas Tech. It was his highest output since Jan. 16.
- ▶ Warren is averaging 13.5 points over his last 11 games (4.3 free throw attempts per contest) after averaging 19.6 points over his first nine (7.9 free throw attempts per game).

- ▶ Oklahoma lost for just the second time in its last 33 home games by dropping a 72-71 decision to Texas Tech on Tuesday. The defeat snapped a 31-game home winning streak against unranked (AP) opponents.
- ▶ OU trailed by eight at halftime, by 12 points with 8:30 remaining in the second half and by 10 with 5:20 to go before rallying late. It missed two 3-pointers on its final possession, including one by **Tommy Mason-Griffin** at the buzzer.
- ▶ The Sooners shot .419 from the field, .231 (6-for-26) from 3-point distance and .722 (13-for-18) from the free throw line. Texas Tech recorded respective figures of .441, .625 (5-for-8) and .938 (15-for-16).
- ▶ **Willie Warren** recorded team highs of 18 points and five assists. His 18 points were his most in his last four games.
- ▶ **Tony Crocker** notched his seventh double-double of the year with 16 points and 11 rebounds. It was his second against Tech this year.
- ▶ **Tiny Gallon** scored in double figures for the first time in five games. He was 6-for-9 from the field and tallied 13 points in 23 minutes.
- ▶ Texas Tech's John Roberson scored a game-high 22 points and added four assists. He was 3-for-4 from deep and 7-for-7 at the foul line.

**PREVIEWING OKLAHOMA STATE**

Oklahoma State enters Saturday's contest with a 16-7 overall record and a 4-5 Big 12 mark. The Cowboys, who have lost their last three games, are 11-1 at home on the season (only loss was to Texas). They are coming off an 81-74 loss at Texas Tech on Saturday, a game in which they outboarded the Red Raiders by nine but had 21 turnovers. OSU ranks eighth in the Big 12 in scoring offense (74.2), sixth in scoring defense (66.8), 11th in field goal percentage (.444), 11th in 3-point field goal percentage (.329) and fifth in free throw percentage (.675).

Junior guard **James Anderson** leads three Cowboys who average double figures in points. Anderson is scoring a Big 12-high 22.2 points per contest and adds 5.8 rebounds, 2.4 assists and a team-high 1.3 steals an outing. The 6-6, 210-pounder was held to a season-low 10 points at Texas Tech on Saturday. Senior guard **Obi Muonelo** is averaging 12.5 points and 5.3 rebounds per game and is shooting a team-high .432 (48-for-111) from 3-point range to rank fourth in the Big 12. Junior forward **Marshall Moses** averages 10.4 points and a team-high 9.7 boards. Sophomore guard **Keiton Page** adds 9.7 points a contest and has canned 46 treys on the year (shooting .354 from long range).

**Travis Ford** is 39-19 (.672) in his second year as OSU's head coach. He's in his 13th year as a college head coach and is 229-193 (.543).

**OU-OKLAHOMA STATE SERIES HISTORY**

Oklahoma owns a 126-90 series advantage against Oklahoma State and has won six of the last seven meetings and nine of the last 12. The Sooners have won the last two years and three of the last four in Stillwater, but trail 58-42 in the series there. Since the start of the Big 12 in 1996-97, OU is 16-13 against the Cowboys and 5-8 in Stillwater. The Sooners have swept the regular season series three of the last four years. **Jeff Capel** is 6-2 against Oklahoma State as OU's head coach (2-1 at Gallagher-Iba Arena).

**EARLIER THIS YEAR AGAINST THE COWBOYS (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 13)**

- ▶ Oklahoma won for the sixth time in its last seven games against Oklahoma State, but it took overtime to get the 62-57 win on Jan. 11.
- ▶ OU trailed 42-34 with 13 minutes left in the second half before using a 13-0 run to take a 47-42 lead with 6:30 to go. Down by five with 30 seconds left, the Cowboys hit a 3 with 18 seconds remaining and a follow-up 2-pointer with 3.7 seconds to go to force overtime.
- ▶ OSU scored the first two points of overtime (4:35 left) but managed just one point the rest of the way.
- ▶ **Tiny Gallon** scored 13 points and grabbed an OU-season-high 18 rebounds in a career-high 35 minutes of action.
- ▶ **Tommy Mason-Griffin** hit a 25-foot 3-pointer with three minutes left in overtime that put the Sooners up for good. He was 4-for-7 from 3-point range (the rest of the team was 2-for-15) and finished with 14 points, three assists and no turnovers in 43 minutes.
- ▶ **Willie Warren** countered his seven turnovers with 15 points, seven assists (second most of his career) and five boards.
- ▶ The Sooners held Oklahoma State to a .275 field goal mark (lowest by an OU opponent in 58 games) and a .200 (5-for-25) 3-point mark.
- ▶ OU won despite shooting just .379 from the field, .273 (6-for-22) from 3-point range and .522 (12-for-23) from the free throw line. It went 1-for-6 from the foul line in the second half (missed three free throws in the final 1:48).

**MASON-GRIFFIN ON A ROLL**

- ▶ Over the last eight games, freshman point guard **Tommy Mason-Griffin** has played 315 out of 325 possible minutes and is averaging 18.6 points, 3.8 rebounds and 4.0 assists while shooting .482 from 3-point range (27-for-56).
- ▶ Mason-Griffin has led OU in scoring in four of the last six games (averaging 21.2 over the six contests). He did not pace the team in scoring in any of its first 17 games (averaged 10.2 points in those 17).
- ▶ The 5-11, 203-pounder leads the Big 12 (all games) in 3-point percentage (.448) and ranks fourth in assists (4.6 apg) and fifth in 3-pointers per game (2.3). In Big 12 play, he ranks first in 3-point percentage (.483) and second in treys per contest (3.2).
- ▶ Mason-Griffin leads OU and ranks second among all Big 12 newcomers with his 17.2 scoring average in conference play.
- ▶ With nine regular season games remaining, Mason-Griffin already ranks fourth on OU's all-time freshman list in 3-point makes (52) and sixth in assists (105). No Oklahoma freshman has ever shot better from 3-point range for a season than Mason-Griffin's current .448 mark.
- ▶ Only one freshman in school history averaged as many minutes per game than Mason-Griffin's current 34.5. That was **Wayman Tisdale** (also averaged 34.5 in 1982-83).

**MASON-GRIFFIN'S STELLAR NIGHT**

Four games ago (Jan. 27), freshman **Tommy Mason-Griffin** propelled the Sooners to an 89-84 home win over Iowa State. On a night in which OU played without **Willie Warren** and **Tony Crocker** due to ankle injuries (the pair was averaging a combined 30 points a game), Mason-Griffin finished with 38 points and six assists while playing all 40 minutes (he battled leg cramps the final 3:45). The point guard was 13-for-21 from the field, 5-for-10 from 3-point range and 7-for-7 from the free throw line. His 38 points were....

- ▶ Five more than any other Big 12 player has scored this year.
- ▶ The most scored by an OU freshman since **Wayman Tisdale** in 1982-83.
- ▶ The most scored by a freshman guard in school history.
- ▶ Tied for the most scored by a point guard in school history (**Mookie Blaylock** also scored 38 against Iowa State in 1988-89).
- ▶ Tied for the fifth most by a freshman in Big 12 history (only Kansas State's **Michael Beasley** scored more).
- ▶ The second most scored by a Sooner since the 1993-94 season (**Blake Griffin** scored 40 last year).

- ▶ In their 13 wins, the Sooners are holding opponents to .403 field goal and .320 3-point shooting. In OU's 10 losses, foes have shot .479 from the field and .449 from behind the arc.
- ▶ The Sooners have outrebounded their opponents by 2.7 per game in wins but have been outboarded by an average of 3.6 in losses.
- ▶ **Cade Davis** is averaging 12.9 points (.377 from 3-point range) in wins compared to 5.4 points (.238 from behind the arc) in losses. In four Big 12 wins, Davis is averaging 17.0 points (.473 field goal shooting). In five Big 12 losses he is averaging 7.0 points (.294 shooting).
- ▶ OU is averaging 9.2 3-point field goals per game in wins (.388 shooting) compared to 7.0 in losses (.295 shooting).

**PICK YOUR POISON**

Five different Sooners have each made at least 25 treys through the team's first 23 games. No other Big 12 team has more than three players with at least 25 3-point makes each heading into the weekend. **Tommy Mason-Griffin** leads OU with 52 makes (2.3 per game) and is followed by **Cade Davis** with 39 (1.7 per outing), **Tony Crocker** with 32 (1.5 per game), **Steven Pledger** with 30 (1.4 per contest) and **Willie Warren** with 27 (1.4 per game). OU ranks second in the Big 12 with its 8.3 treys per outing (the school record is 8.5 in 1998-99).

**GUARDS SHOULDERING THE LOAD**

Five of OU's top six scorers, including its top three, are guards. The Sooners' backcourt has accounted for 1,284 of the team's 1,696 points, or 76 percent. Four guards average at least 9.7 points a game while another averages 6.5. **Willie Warren** averages 16.2 points per outing and is followed by **Tommy Mason Griffin** (13.0), **Tony Crocker** (11.8), **Cade Davis** (9.7) and **Steven Pledger** (6.5). All five of those players have surpassed the 20-point mark at least twice this year (Warren has done it seven times, Mason-Griffin five times, Crocker and Davis three times each and Pledger twice). Mason-Griffin (twice), Crocker and Davis have all scored at least 20 points in a half this season. Last year, guards accounted for 52 percent of OU's points.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT**

The freshman foursome of **Tommy Mason-Griffin** (13.0 ppg), **Tiny Gallon** (10.4), **Steven Pledger** (6.5) and **Andrew Fitzgerald** (3.7) has combined to score 749 of the team's 1,696 points this year, or 44 percent. Mason-Griffin leads the Big 12 with his .448 3-point field goal percentage and ranks fourth with his 4.6 assists per game. Gallon, who is shooting .542 from the field, ranks seventh in the Big 12 in rebounds per game (8.0) and eighth with six double-doubles (he missed out on another by one rebound). Pledger has knocked down 30 treys and has two games of more than 20 points. Fitzgerald has made five starts and is averaging 3.7 points on .500 field goal shooting.

**CROCKER CLIMBING THE CHARTS**

Senior guard **Tony Crocker** entered the year ranked 34th in school history in points (1,008) and seventh in 3-point makes (158). With a strong start to the season, the 6-6 San Antonio, Texas, product has vaulted to the No. 18 spot in points (1,268) and the No. 4 spot in 3-pointers (190). Crocker, who has started his last 88 games, needs 10 points to tie **Blake Griffin** (2008-09) for 17th place in scoring. At his current pace of 11.8 points per game, Crocker would finish the regular season ranked 15th on the Sooners' all-time scoring chart. Crocker's next target on the career 3-point makes list is **Tim Heskett** (1997-01). He needs 25 makes to tie Heskett for third on that list.

Crocker also has a chance to make a run at the top spot on OU's games played list. He entered the year with 102 career appearances and would finish the regular season with 131 if he plays in every remaining game. Depending on the Sooners' postseason fortunes, Crocker could challenge the record of 137 career games played by **Darryl "Choo" Kennedy** (1984-87).

On Tuesday, Crocker became just the second Sooner (and first of the Big 12 era) to register at least 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 150 3-pointers in a career. Forward **Ryan Minor** (1993-96) racked up 1,946 points, 767 rebounds and 170 treys.

**QUANTIFYING OU'S BASKETBALL TRADITION**

- ▶ This is the 103rd season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ OU owns a 1,511-952 (.613) all-time record, ranking it 29th in NCAA Division I history in wins and 38th in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ OU has made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. Its 22 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 27 years rank as the sixth most in the nation.
- ▶ No team in the country has made more postseason appearances over the last 28 years than Oklahoma's 27.
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and the ninth best (.738) in the 2000s.
- ▶ Twenty different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 30 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim nine times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ Wayman Tisdale was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 73 times.
- ▶ The Sooners own a winning record against 10 of the other 11 members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).
