Head Coach Jeff Capel



Jeff Capel was named Oklahoma's 13th men's basketball head coach on April 11, 2006. Capel, 35, is 82-47 in his fourth year at OU and led the Sooners to a 30-6 record and an NCAA Tournament Elite Eight appearance in 2008-09.

Capel, who coached OU to a 23-12 mark and to the NCAA Tournament second round in 2007-08, compiled a 79-41 (.658) record over four years as head coach at Virginia Commonwealth prior to arriving in Norman. His squads went 50-22 (.694) in Colonial Athletic Association play.

In 2003-04, VCU's CAA Tournament championship game victory over George Mason catapulted the Rams to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1996. VCU lost in the first round to Wake Forest, but not before putting a major scare into the fourth-seeded Demon Deacons, 79-78. Capel's 2004-05 squad, which finished 19-13, competed in the National Invitation Tournament, marking just the third time in program history that VCU made consecutive postseason appearances.

The Rams won at least 18 games each of Capel's four seasons in Richmond, with the 2003-04 squad registering a Capel-era-best 23-8 record. His first team finished 18-10 in 2002-03. In 2005-06, VCU finished 19-10 overall.

In the summer of 2005, Capel served as an assistant coach on the gold-medal-winning USA Men's World University Games Team that finished 8-0 in Turkey in August. Villanova's Jay Wright was the head coach while Seton Hall's Bobby Gonzalez served as the other assistant. The squad featured, among others, Midwest City (Okla.) High School and Duke University standout Shelden Williams.

Capel began his coaching career as an assistant at Old Dominion in 2000 before moving to VCU as an assistant for the 2001-02 season. In 2002, he became the youngest NCAA Division I head coach at age 27.

A four-year starter for Hall-of-Fame coach Mike Krzyzewski at Duke from the 1993-94 through 1996-97 campaigns, Capel earned Atlantic Coast Conference honors each of his seasons in Durham. The guard, who wore No. 5, averaged 12.4 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.4 assists and 1.7 3-pointers during his career and started in the 1994 national title game against Arkansas.

He ranks 22nd in career scoring at Duke (1,601 points), 16th in minutes played (3,774), sixth in 3-pointers (220), seventh in 3-point attempts (553), seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (.398) and 11th in assists (433).

Capel, who graduated from Duke with a bachelor of arts degree in history, and his wife, Kanika, wed in 2003. They have two daughters, Cameron and Sydney.

SATURDAY'S GAME BASICS

Oklahoma (13-14 overall, 4-9 Big 12) will try to snap a five-game losing streak when it hosts No. 24 Baylor (21-6, 8-5) Saturday at 12:30 p.m. CST. The Sooners, who have lost two straight at home after notching 11 wins at Lloyd Noble Center to start the year, are tied with Texas Tech for eighth place in the Big 12 standings. Baylor, coming off a 70-66 victory over No. 22 Texas A&M, has won four of its last five games. The Bears are in a three-way tie for fourth place in the conference race with Texas and Texas A&M. Saturday's game will air on the Sooner Radio Network with **Bob Barry Sr.** and **Mike Houck** calling the action. It will be televised regionally by the Big 12 Network with **Bob Carpenter** and **Bryndon Manzer** announcing.

NOTEWORTHY

- ▶ Oklahoma is 35-6 all-time against Baylor and has won 30 of the last 31 meetings. OU is 17-2 against the Bears in Norman (has won 14 straight there).
- ▶ Baylor's last win in Norman came on Dec. 6, 1977 (75-67).
- ▶ OU has won its 13 Big 12 home games vs. Baylor by an average of 23.5 points.
- ▶ In OU's last five games (all losses), opponents are averaging 82.0 points and shooting .507 from the field, .500 from 3-point range (40-for-80).
- ▶ Due to injuries, an illness and suspensions, the Sooners have used seven different starting lineups in their 13 conference games.
- ▶ OU entered the week ranked first in the Big 12 and 16th nationally with its 8.4 3-point makes per game. The school record for average 3-pointers per contest in a season is 8.5 in 1998-99. Five Sooners have made at least 30 treys each.
- ▶ Four of Oklahoma's top seven scorers are freshmen.
- ▶ OU is the only Big 12 team with five players who each average double figures in scoring.
- ▶ Over the last 10 games, **Tommy Mason-Griffin** is averaging 20.9 points and 4.5 assists. He is 34-for-75 (.453) from 3-point range during the stretch.
- ▶ Mason-Griffin has made at least one 3-pointer in 26 of 27 games, and at least two treys in 12 of 13 league outings. On the year, he ranks fourth in the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage (.439), fourth in assists (4.7 apg) and fourth in 3-point makes per game (2.4).
- ▶ In OU's 13 league contests, Mason-Griffin is shooting .457 from 3-point range (42-for-92). The rest of the team is shooting .280 (58-for-207).
- ▶ Mason-Griffin did not lead OU in scoring in any of its first 17 games. He has done it eight times in the last 10 outings.
- ▶ Mason-Griffin has played at least 38 minutes in 11 of the last 12 games (35 in the other). He has logged 40 or more minutes six times in those 12 outings.
- ▶ Junior guard **Cade Davis** is averaging 14.5 points and 4.8 rebounds over the last eight outings. He is 23-for-58 (.397) from behind the arc during the stretch and has made at least three treys in six of the last 10 games.
- ▶ Senior guard **Tony Crocker**, who has started his last 92 games, has recorded his only seven career double-doubles over his last 20 outings. Crocker leads all Big 12 guards in rebounding (6.4 rpg) and double-doubles.
- ▶ Crocker is just the second Sooner to ever record 1,000 points, 500 boards and 150 3-point makes in a career (**Ryan Minor** is the other).
- ▶ OU's leading scorer on the year (16.3 ppg), sophomore guard **Willie Warren** has missed five Big 12 games (ankle, illness), including the last two. He ranks ninth in the league in scoring and seventh in assists (4.1 apg).

- ▶ Oklahoma began Monday's game at No. 1 Kansas by going 0-for-11 from the field and fell behind 9-0. Afterward, the Sooners shot .500 from the field and were outscored by four (72-68) in an 81-68 loss. OU outscored the Jayhawks 39-37 in the second half.
- ▶ Freshmen combined for 45 of OU's 68 points, 14 of its 33 rebounds and 11 of its 14 assists.
- ▶ The Sooners trailed 37-28 late in the first half but watched Kansas score six straight to lead 44-29 at halftime. KU led by as many as 23 points just past the midway point of the second half before OU drew to within 12 multiple times in the final minutes.
- ▶ Freshman forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** played a career-high 37 minutes and finished with career highs of 16 points and six rebounds.
- ▶ Freshman guard **Tommy Mason-Griffin** led OU with 17 points and eight assists (his second highest career total).
- ▶ Junior guard **Cade Davis** contributed 13 points, a team-high eight boards and a season-high-tying three assists.
- ▶ The Sooners scored eight fast break points while not allowing any.

PREVIEWING BAYLOR

Baylor enters Saturday's game with a 21-6 overall record and an 8-5 Big 12 mark (three-way tie for fourth place). It is 2-4 in league road games with wins over Texas (by three in overtime) and Nebraska (by two), and losses to Colorado (by seven), Kansas (by six), Texas A&M (by seven) and Oklahoma State (by seven). The Bears have won four of their last five games and six of their last eight. In Big 12 play, they rank first in field goal percentage (.471), free throw percentage (.765) and blocked shots (6.5 bpg), second in 3-point field goal percentage (.387) and fourth in 3-pointers per game (7.2).

Junior guard **LaceDarius Dunn** leads a trio of Bears who average double figures in scoring. Dunn ranks second in the Big 12 with his 19.1 points a game (20.8 in league play) and is shooting .417 from behind the arc (league-high 3.3 makes per outing) and .853 from the free throw line (ranks second in Big 12). He has scored at least 20 points 12 times on the year. Senior guard **Tweety Carter**, who missed the team's first four games due to a suspension, is averaging 16.0 points and a league-high 6.1 assists over his 23 contests. Carter, who is shooting .391 from long range (2.7 makes per game), scored 25 points last Saturday at Oklahoma State but was held to eight in Wednesday's win over Texas A&M. Junior forward/center **Ekpe Udoh**, who transferred after playing two years at Michigan, has been a welcome addition on the inside. The 6-10, 240-pounder from Edmond (Okla.) Santa Fe High School is averaging 13.3 points, 10.3 rebounds, 2.6 assists and a conference-best 4.3 blocks per game. He ranks second in the Big 12 with 13 double-doubles.

Scott Drew is 102-101 (.502) in his seventh year as Baylor's head coach. His BU squads have posted a 34-75 (.312) record in Big 12 play.

OU-BAYLOR SERIES HISTORY

Oklahoma owns a 35-6 series advantage against Baylor and has won 30 of the last 31 meetings. The Sooners possess a 17-2 series lead in games played in Norman and have won 14 straight there. The last Baylor win in Norman came on Dec. 6, 1977 (75-67). OU is 26-1 against the Bears since the inception of the Big 12 Conference and has won its 13 series home games during the span by an average of 23.5 points.

EARLIER THIS YEAR AGAINST THE BEARS (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 13)

- ▶ Oklahoma dropped a 90-61 decision at Baylor to open Big 12 play on Jan. 9. The loss broke OU's 30-game winning streak against the Bears and snapped its 16-game victory streak in Waco. Baylor had not beaten OU since Dec. 6, 1977.
- ▶ OU went 7-for-10 from the field and held a 20-11 lead after the game's first eight minutes, but shot just .118 (2-for-17) the rest of the half as Baylor went on a 30-6 run over the final 12 minutes to go up 41-26 at the break. OU never got closer than 12 points in the second half.
- ▶ Baylor shot an OU opponent season high of .586 from the field and knocked down 10 of its 20 3-point attempts. The Sooners shot .357 from the field and .250 from behind the arc (5-for-20) for their second worst marks of the season.
- ▶ **Tiny Gallon** led OU with 17 points and grabbed a team-high-tying five rebounds in 30 minutes of play.
- ▶ **Tony Crocker** was 3-for-6 from 3-point range and finished with 16 points and a season-high five assists.
- ▶ **LaceDarius Dunn** went 6-for-8 from behind the arc and scored a game-high 28 points for Baylor.

MASON-GRIFFIN ON A ROLL

- ▶ Freshman point guard **Tommy Mason-Griffin** has led OU in scoring in eight of the last 10 games after not pacing the team in any of its first 17 games (averaged 10.2 points in those 17). Over those last 10 outings, he is averaging 20.9 points and 4.5 assists while shooting .453 (34-for-75) from 3-point range and .841 (37-for-44) from the free throw line in an average of 38.9 minutes.
- ▶ The 5-11, 203-pounder ranks third in the Big 12 (all games) in 3-point percentage (.438), fourth in assists (4.7 apg) and fourth in 3-pointers per game (2.4). In Big 12 play, he ranks second in treys per contest (3.2) and third in 3-point percentage (.457).
- ▶ Mason-Griffin leads OU and all Big 12 newcomers with his 18.2 scoring average in conference play.
- ▶ With three regular season games remaining, Mason-Griffin already ranks second on OU's all-time freshman list in both 3-point makes (65) and assists (126). He needs three 3-pointers and 16 assists to claim sole possession of first place in both categories.
- ▶ No Oklahoma freshman has ever shot better from 3-point range for a season than Mason-Griffin's current .439 mark or has averaged more than his current 35.2 minutes per outing.

MASON-GRIFFIN'S STELLAR NIGHT

On Jan. 27, freshman **Tommy Mason-Griffin** propelled the Sooners to an 89-84 home win over Iowa State. On a night in which OU played without **Willie Warren** and **Tony Crocker** due to ankle injuries (the pair was averaging a combined 30 points a game), Mason-Griffin finished with 38 points and six assists while playing all 40 minutes (he battled leg cramps the final 3:45). The point guard was 13-for-21 from the field, 5-for-10 from 3-point range and 7-for-7 from the free throw line. His 38 points were....

- ▶ Five more than any other Big 12 player has scored this year.
- ▶ The most scored by an OU freshman since **Wayman Tisdale** in 1982-83.
- ▶ The most scored by a freshman guard in school history.
- ▶ Tied for the most scored by a point guard in school history (**Mookie Blaylock** also scored 38 against Iowa State in 1988-89).
- ▶ Tied for the fifth most by a freshman in Big 12 history (only Kansas State's **Michael Beasley** scored more).
- ▶ The second most scored by a Sooner since the 1993-94 season (**Blake Griffin** scored 40 last year).

- ▶ In their four Big 12 wins, the Sooners have held opponents to .401 field goal and .301 3-point shooting (6.3 makes per game). In OU's nine Big 12 losses, foes have shot .493 from the field and .482 from behind the arc (7.6 makes per game).
- ▶ **Cade Davis** is averaging 17.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per Big 12 win (shooting .473 from the field) compared to 9.6 points and 3.9 rebounds in league losses (shooting .386).
- ▶ **Ryan Wright** is averaging 7.5 points and 7.5 rebounds per Big 12 victory compared to 3.7 points and 4.3 rebounds in league losses.

PICK YOUR POISON

Five different Sooners have each made at least 30 treys through the team's first 27 games. No other Big 12 team has more than three players with at least 30 3-point makes each heading into the weekend. **Tommy Mason-Griffin** leads OU with 65 makes (2.4 per game) and is followed by **Cade Davis** with 50 (1.9 per outing), **Tony Crocker** with 36 (1.4 per game), **Steven Pledger** with 34 (1.3 per contest) and **Willie Warren** with 30 (1.4 per game). OU ranks first in the Big 12 and in the top 20 nationally with its 8.3 treys per outing (the school record is 8.5 in 1998-99).

GUARDS SHOULDERING THE LOAD

Five of OU's top six scorers, including its top four, are guards. The Sooners' backcourt has accounted for 1,490 of the team's 1,975 points, or 75 percent. **Willie Warren** leads the guard charge by averaging 16.3 points per outing and is followed by **Tommy Mason Griffin** (14.1), **Tony Crocker** (11.5), **Cade Davis** (10.1) and **Steven Pledger** (6.0). All five of those players have surpassed the 20-point mark at least twice this year (Warren has done it seven times, Mason-Griffin six times, Crocker and Davis three times each and Pledger twice). Mason-Griffin (three times), Crocker and Davis have all scored at least 20 points in a half this season. Last year, guards accounted for 52 percent of OU's points.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

The freshman foursome of **Tommy Mason-Griffin** (14.1 ppg), **Tiny Gallon** (10.0), **Steven Pledger** (6.0) and **Andrew Fitzgerald** (4.9) has combined to score 904 of the team's 1,975 points this year, or 46 percent. Mason-Griffin ranks fourth in the Big 12 with his .439 3-point field goal percentage and fourth with his 4.7 assists per game. Gallon, who is shooting .532 from the field, ranks seventh in the Big 12 in rebounds per game (8.0) and eighth with six double-doubles (he missed out on another by one rebound). Pledger has knocked down 34 treys and has two games of more than 20 points. Fitzgerald has made eight starts and is shooting .537 from the field.

CROCKER CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Senior guard **Tony Crocker** entered the year ranked 34th in school history in points (1,008) and seventh in 3-point makes (158). With a solid final season, the 6-6 San Antonio, Texas, product has vaulted to the No. 17 spot in points (1,308) and the No. 4 spot in 3-pointers (194). Crocker, who has started his last 92 games, needs 30 points to tie **Mookie Blaylock** (1988-89) for 16th place in scoring. At his current pace of 11.5 points per game, Crocker would finish the regular season ranked 15th on the Sooners' all-time scoring chart.

Crocker also has a chance to make a run at the top spot on OU's games played list. He entered the year with 102 career appearances and would finish the regular season with 131 if he plays in every remaining game. Depending on the Sooners' postseason fortunes, Crocker could challenge the record of 137 career games played by **Darryl "Choo" Kennedy** (1984-87).

On Feb. 9 against Texas Tech, Crocker became just the second Sooner (and first of the Big 12 era) to register at least 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 150 3-pointers in a career. Forward **Ryan Minor** (1993-96) racked up 1,946 points, 767 rebounds and 170 treys.

QUANTIFYING OU'S BASKETBALL TRADITION

- ▶ This is the 103rd season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ OU owns a 1,511-956 (.612) all-time record, ranking it 29th in NCAA Division I history in wins and 38th in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ OU has made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. Its 22 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 27 years rank as the sixth most in the nation.
- ▶ No team in the country has made more postseason appearances over the last 28 years than Oklahoma's 27.
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and the ninth best (.738) in the 2000s.
- ▶ Twenty different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 30 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim nine times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ Wayman Tisdale was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 73 times.
- ▶ The Sooners own a winning record against 10 of the other 11 members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).

1 RYAN WRIGHT (6-9, 241, SENIOR, FORWARD)

- ▶ Averaging 4.0 points and 4.5 rebounds in 18.4 minutes a game (has started 7 of last 9 games).
- ▶ Posted first career double-double Feb. 6 vs. Texas (11 points and career-high 14 boards).
- ▶ Averaging 4.8 points (.550 FG%) and 5.3 boards in 20.2 minutes a game in Big 12 play.
- ▶ Shooting a team-best .549 from the field after posting a .341 mark last year.
- ▶ A transfer from UCLA (played 2 years there and competed in 2006 and 2007 Final Fours).
- ▶ Hails from Mississauga, Ontario, and graduated last May (International and Area Studies).

2 STEVEN PLEDGER (6-4, 217, FRESHMAN, GUARD)

- ▶ Went 19-for-40 (.475) from 3-point range over first 6 games but is 15-for-69 (.217) since.
- ▶ Scored 21 points in opener vs. Mount St. Mary's and 23 vs. Houston (20 in first half).
- ▶ Rated by ESPN.com as the nation's No. 84 overall recruit last year.

3 T.J. FRANKLIN (5-11, 166, SOPHOMORE, GUARD)

- ▶ A walk-on who has played a total of 22 minutes in 12 games (has 2 points and 4 assists).
- ▶ Played in 12 games last year (27 total minutes) and recorded 3 points and 6 assists.
- ▶ Teamed with Willie Warren at North Crowley High School in Fort Worth, Texas, to go 38-1 two years ago and win the Class 5A state title.
- ▶ A Texas Association of Basketball Coaches Academic All-State selection as a senior.
- ▶ An electrical engineering major at OU who graduated No. 7 in his high school class.

4 ANDREW FITZGERALD (6-8, 258, FRESHMAN, FORWARD)

- ▶ Averaging 4.9 points (.543 field goal shooting) in an average of 15.0 minutes a game on year.
- ▶ Averaging 13.0 points over the last 3 games (all starts) on .594 field goal shooting.
- ▶ Had career highs of 16 points, 6 boards and 37 minutes Monday at No. 1 Kansas.
- ▶ Lone 8 starts have come over last 15 games (averaging 8.0 points and 3.0 rebounds in the 8).
- ▶ Ranked No. 68 last year by ESPN.com, No. 70 by Rivals.com and No. 85 by Scout.com.

5 TONY CROCKER (6-6, 209, SENIOR, GUARD)

- ▶ Averaging 11.5 points, 6.4 rebounds and 1.7 assists in 32.0 minutes a contest.
- ▶ Ranks 11th in Big 12 and leads all guards in rebounding (6.4) and double-doubles (7).
- ▶ Is 8-for-33 (.242) from field and 1-for-11 from 3-point range over the last 3 games.
- ▶ His only 7 career double-doubles have come over his last 20 games.
- ▶ Recorded a career-high 33-point game (also had 13 rebounds) Dec. 9 vs. Centenary in which he set a Big 12 record for points in a half (29 in first) and tied the record for treys in a half (7).
- ▶ Has started 121 of his 128 career games, including each of his last 92.
- ▶ Ranks 17th in OU career scoring with 1,308 points (needs 30 to tie for 16th place).
- ▶ Ranks 4th on OU's career 3-point makes list with 194.

11 TOMMY MASON-GRIFFIN (5-11, 203, FRESHMAN, GUARD)

- ▶ Two-time Phillips 66 Big 12 Rookie of the Week (Feb. 1 and 8).
- ▶ Averaging 14.1 points, 3.0 rebounds and 4.7 assists per game (ranks 4th in Big 12 in assists).
- ▶ Leads team and all Big 12 newcomers with his 18.2 points per league game.
- ▶ Turned in a 38-point, 6-assist game vs. LSU Jan. 27 (most points ever by an OU freshman guard).
- ▶ Recorded a 30-point, 5-assist game at Oklahoma State Feb. 13 (5-for-10 on 3-pointers).
