Head Coach Lon Kruger

- ► Lon Kruger was named Oklahoma's 14th head men's basketball coach on April 1, 2011.
- ▶ Owns a 486-305 (.614) collegiate record over 25 years.
- ► Has coached at Texas-Pan American (52-59 record from 1982-86), Kansas State (81-46 from 1986-90), Florida (104-80 from 1990-96), Illinois (81-48 from 1996-00) and UNLV (161-71 from 2004-11).
- ► Served as head coach of NBA's Atlanta Hawks from 2000-03 (69-122 record) and was an assistant for New York Knicks (2003-04 season).
- Averaged 25.4 wins at UNLV over the last five years (four NCAA appearances and one NIT trip) and won at least 21 games each of those five seasons.
- ▶ Coached UNLV to a 55-25 (.688) Mountain West Conference record the last five seasons.
- ▶ Has taken teams to 13 NCAA Tournaments (14-13 record) and four NITs (4-5 record).
- ▶ Coached Florida to the 1994 Final Four, Kansas State to the 1988 Elite Eight and UNLV to the 2007 Sweet 16.
- ▶ Has led all five of the college programs he has coached to 20-win seasons.
- ▶ Is one of five coaches in Division I college basketball history to take four different schools to the NCAA Tournament and is one of three coaches to win an NCAA Tournament game at four schools.
- ▶ Is one of just two head coaches in Division I history to lead at least four different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament wins.
- ▶ Is one of four coaches to lead three different schools to NCAA Sweet 16 appearances.

SATURDAY'S GAME BASICS

Oklahoma (7-1) plays in the All-College Classic for the 29th straight year when it meets Houston (4-4) Saturday at 7 p.m. CT at Oklahoma City's Chesapeake Energy Arena. The Sooners, winners of three straight, are coming off a 78-63 victory over Arkansas on Saturday. The Cougars haven't played since Dec. 6 when they lost 81-78 at Texas State. Saturday's contest will air on the Sooner Radio Network (KOKC AM 1520 in Oklahoma City; KTBZ AM 1430 in Tulsa; Sirius 137) with **Toby Rowland** and **Mike Houck** announcing. The game will be televised by ESPNU with **Marc Kestecher** and **Doug Gottlieb** calling the action.

SOONER UPDATE

- ▶ Oklahoma entered the week ranked No. 8 nationally (out of 338 Division I teams) in rebounding margin (+9.8), No. 15 in 3-point field goal percentage (.419), No. 40 in scoring (78.1 ppg), No. 45 in scoring margin (+12.0) and No. 46 in free throw percentage (.735).
- ▶ Only one OU team in last 16 seasons averaged more points for a season than the current average of 78.1 (78.7 in 2008-09).
- ▶ The Sooners' 7-1 start is their second best in last eight seasons (surpassed only by the 12-0 start during **Blake Griffin's** sophomore year of 2008-09).
- ▶ OU's wins over Sacramento State (by 29 points), Coppin State (27), Arkansas (15), Washington State (15) and Oral Roberts (14) represent those teams' largest margins of defeat of the year .

▶ Since sustaining its only loss of the season to Saint Louis in the 76 Classic championship game on Nov. 27, Oklahoma has shot .532 from the field, .512 (22-for-43) from 3-point range and .782 (43-for-55) from the free throw line in double-digit wins over Sacramento State, Oral Roberts and Arkansas. The Sooners held those three foes to combined .379 field goal and .264 (14-for-53) 3-point shooting, and won by an average of 19.3 points.

▶ OU's top five scorers over the last three games are each shooting at least .522 from the field during the stretch. Junior guard **Steven Pledger** is averaging 18.0 points on .679 field goal and .600 (6-for-10) 3-point shooting.

▶ Pledger has scored in double figures in all seven of his games and is shooting a team-high .577 from the field (ranks second nationally among guards) and .472 from 3-point range (ranks fourth in Big 12). He shot .386 from the field and .345 from long distance over his first two seasons combined. Pledger averaged 13.6 points per 40 minutes last season but is averaging 25.1 per 40 minutes this year. He ranks third in the Big 12 in scoring (17.9 ppg), sixth in treys per game (2.4) and eighth in steals (1.6 spq).

▶ Junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** has made more field goals in each of the last three games than he did in any of OU's first five contests. He is averaging 15.3 points on .583 shooting over the last three games after averaging 8.4 points on .400 shooting over the first five.

▶ The Sooners' pressure defense under new head coach **Lon Kruger** has boosted the team's offense through eight games. Opponents have averaged 15.5 turnovers, resulting in an

average of 18.0 points per contest for OU on the other end of the floor. Foes haven't been as opportunistic, averaging 12.5 points off the Sooners' 13.5 turnovers per game.

- ▶ Rebounding was mentioned by Kruger several times in the preseason as a concern of his for 2011-12. However, OU has outboarded seven of its eight opponents and ranks No. 8 nationally with its +9.8 margin per contest despite not starting anyone taller than 6-8. Included was a +34 effort against Coppin State (61-27). The Sooners own a 123-87 offensive rebounding advantage on the year (despite shooting .465 to their opponents' .414 mark) and have scored 112 second-chance points to their foes' 70.
- ▶ Junior forward **Romero Osby** leads the Big 12 with his 3.4 offensive rebounds per game and ranks fifth in the league with his 7.5 overall boards per outing. He is shooting .643 from the field during the team's three-game winning streak.
- ► Since sophomore guard **Calvin Newell** left the team on Dec. 1, sophomore forward **Tyler Neal** has seen his minutes and production jump significantly. Neal is averaging 10.3 points, 3.7 rebounds and 2.0 assists in an average of 22.0 minutes the last three games, and is shooting .529 from the field and .500 (7-for-14) from 3-point range. In OU's first five games before Newell announced he was transferring Neal averaged 5.0 points, 3.2 rebounds and 0.4 assists in an average of 14.0 minutes. He shot .438 from the field.
- ▶ After averaging 3.0 points on .167 (3-for-18) field goal shooting in OU's first two games, sophomore guard **Cameron Clark** has scored in double figures in five of the last six outings and is shooting .491 from the field during the stretch.
- ► Saturday's 0U win over Arkansas leaves Kruger just 14 victories shy of 500 for his career. He ranks second among current Big 12 head coaches with 486 career wins (Texas' **Rick Barnes** has 532 victories).

SATURDAY'S ARKANSAS RECAP (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 11 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ Oklahoma fell behind 4-0 then went on a 22-3 run to go up by 15 eight minutes into the game in an eventual 78-63 home win over Arkansas on Saturday. OU's 37-25 halftime lead was whittled to six points (41-35) with 15:21 left but the Sooners answered with a 7-0 spurt to go back up by 13. The Razorbacks got no closer than 10 the rest of the way.
- ▶ 0U shot .520 from the floor, .500 (8-for-16) from 3-point range and .783 from the free throw line. Arkansas shot .345 from the field and .259 (7-for-27) from long distance.
- ▶ Junior guard **Steven Pledger** led 0U in scoring for the fourth time in his seven games with 22 points (19 after halftime). He was 9-for-12 from the field and 3-for-5 from 3-point range (8-for-8 and 2-for-2 in the second half).
- Sophomore forward **Tyler Neal** subbed for fellow sophomore **Cameron Clark** (two fouls in first 1:25) and went on to post career highs of 18 points, four 3-pointers (on eight attempts) and four assists in a career-high-tying 28 minutes. He was 5-for-9 from the field and also pulled down five rebounds. Neal also drained all four of his free throw attempts to remain perfect on the year (12-for-12).
- Celebrating his 21st birthday, junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** scored a season-high 17 points and pulled down a game-high eight rebounds in just 23 minutes. He scored all of his points and grabbed all but one of his rebounds in the first half (battled foul trouble after halftime). Fitzgerald made his first six field goal attempts and finished 7-for-11.
- ▶ After averaging 17.0 points the previous two games, Clark went scoreless in 13 minutes (foul issues). He was 0-for-3 from the field.
- ▶ Oklahoma committed 17 turnovers to Arkansas' 13, but 0U posted a 19-10 advantage in points off turnovers. The Sooners also outrebounded the Razorbacks by 12 (38-26).

PREVIEWING HOUSTON

- ▶ After starting 3-0, Houston has lost four of its last five games by a total of seven points (three of the losses came by a total of four points). The Cougars are coming off an 81-78 defeat at Texas State on Dec. 6 and also lost at home to Oakland (76-74), TCU (81-80) and LSU (59-58) in late November. Their signature win thus far was an 87-78 victory at Arkansas in the third game of the year.
- ▶ Houston is shooting .473 from the field and .368 from 3-point range while holding opponents to respective .399 and .296 marks.
- Sophomore forward **Alandise Harris** leads the Cougars with his 16.0 scoring average (shooting .568 from the field) and ranks second with his 6.5 rebounds per game. He has scored in double figures in all but one game and has three outings of at least 20 points.
- ▶ Junior guard **Jonathon Simmons** is averaging 13.6 points (shooting .581) and 4.8 boards per game. He is coming off a 26-point outing at Texas State in which he went 8-for-11 from the field and 8-for-10 at the free throw line.
- ▶ Junior forward **Kirk Van Slyke** comes off the bench to supply 11.6 points and 5.1 rebounds a contest. He is 21-for-22 (.955) at the foul line on the year.
- ▶ Former Texas Tech head coach and Oklahoma State assistant **James Dickey** is in his second year as head coach at Houston and owns a 16-22 (.421) record there. He is in his 12th year overall and is 180-145 (.554).

OU-HOUSTON SERIES HISTORY

Saturday's game will mark the third between Oklahoma and Houston, with each team owning a victory. The Sooners won the first meeting, 55-51, at Houston on Dec. 15, 1960. The most recent matchup came two seasons ago in the second round of the Great Alaska Shootout and resulted in a 100-93 Cougars win.

TWO YEARS AGO VS. THE COUGARS (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 11 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ Oklahoma got off to a blazing start in the second round of the Great Alaska Shootout two years ago and led 20-6 after six minutes thanks to five 3-pointers and solid zone defense. Houston cut the margin to five by halftime (52-47) and later used a 23-6 spurt to go ahead 90-75 in what wound up as a 100-93 win in Anchorage.
- ▶ Kelvin Lewis (28) and Aubrey Coleman (27) combined for 55 points for a Houston squad that shot .583 from the field and .600 (6-for-10) from 3-point range after halftime. OU lost despite shooting .536 on the night and making 11 treys.

OU'S ALL-COLLEGE HISTORY

This year's All-College Classic marks the 34th such event for Oklahoma and the 29th straight. The Sooners own a 50-11 (.820) all-time record in the All-College and have claimed 24 championships. They have won 15 of their last 18 games in the event but have lost the last two (Cincinnati last season and UTEP two years ago). This marks the 11th consecutive year that the All-College features a "classic" or non-tournament format. THE OSBY SHOW

Junior forward **Romero Osby** has begun his OU career with a bang following a two-year stint at Mississippi State where he averaged 4.2 points and 2.6 rebounds. The 6-8, 232-pounder, who sat out last season for the Sooners after transferring and was labeled the team's best player in practice by former head coach **Jeff Capel**, is averaging 10.6 points and a team-high 7.5 rebounds (ranks fifth in Big 12) in 26.4 minutes per contest through eight outings. He is shooting .508 from the floor and .793 (23-for-29) from the free throw line. He recorded double-doubles in each of OU's first two games, registering career highs of 17 points, 10 rebounds and four assists in 31 minutes versus Idaho State and 11 points and 10 boards against Coppin State in only 22 minutes. Osby leads the Big 12 with his 3.4 offensive rebounds per game.

PLEDGER A MODEL OF EFFICIENCY

Junior guard **Steven Pledger** has been extremely productive in his seven appearances and has almost doubled his points per minute from last year. Pledger is averaging 17.9 points in 28.4 minutes per outing for a 25.1 40-minute scoring average. Last year, he averaged 10.9 points in 30.0 minutes a contest, good for a 13.6 40-minute average. Pledger is shooting .577 from the field to rank second nationally among guards and .472 (17-for-36) from 3-point range to rank fourth in the Big 12 after posting respective marks of .393 and .350 last season. He also ranks sixth in the Big 12 in 3-pointers per game (2.4) and eighth in steals per outing (1.6).

SOONER TIP INS

- ▶ For the first time this season, Oklahoma received votes this week in one of the major top-25 polls (four votes in ESPN/USA Today poll).
- ▶ 0U has recorded 29 dunks in its eight games (3.6 average) and junior forward **Romero Osby** has 14 of them.
- ▶ Osby (four) and fellow junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** (three) lead the Sooners in charges taken. The team total is 14.
- ▶ Fitzgerald is averaging more rebounds per game this year than last year (5.8 to 5.0), despite averaging 6.4 fewer minutes per contest.
- ▶ Twenty-seven of Osby's 60 rebounds (45 percent) have come on the offensive end.
- ▶ Junior point guard **Sam Grooms** ranks third in the Big 12 with his 4.8 assists per game and fourth with his 2.2 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- ▶ In five home games, **Carl Blair** (6-for-12), **Tyler Neal** (10-for-20) and **Steven Pledger** (9-for-18) are each shooting .500 from 3-point range. **Cameron Clark** is shooting .455 (5-for-11) from deep at home.
- ▶ OU's top four scorers at home are shooting a combined .562 (86-for-153) from the field in those five outings. Pledger is shooting .643 (27-for-42) in home games this season and is followed by Osby (.581), Blair (.500) and Neal (.500).
- Last year, Pledger averaged 15.4 points in 0U's wins and 7.4 points in its losses. This year, the junior guard is averaging 19.0 points in wins (he missed the season-opening victory) and was held to 11 points in the loss to Saint Louis.
- ▶ Senior forward **C.J. Washington's** three assists against Coppin State on Nov. 18 were more than he had all of last season (two).

QUANTIFYING OU'S BASKETBALL TRADITION

- ▶ This is the 105th season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ 0U owns a 1,532-979 (.610) all-time record, ranking it 30th in NCAA Division I history in wins and 41st in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ OU has made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. Its has made 22 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 29 years.
- ▶ Oklahoma has made 27 postseason appearances over the last 30 years (22 NCAA Tournaments and five NITs).
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 Big 12 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and the eighth best (.738) in the 2000s.
- ▶ Twenty different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 30 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim nine times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ **Wayman Tisdale** was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 73 times.
- ▶ The Sooners own a winning record against eight of the other nine members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).
