- ▶ Owns a 489-307 (.614) collegiate record over 25 years.
- ► Has coached at Texas-Pan American (52-59 record from 1982-86), Kansas State (81-46 from 1986-90), Florida (104-80 from 1990-96), Illinois (81-48 from 1996-00) and UNLV (161-71 from 2004-11).
- ► Served as head coach of NBA's Atlanta Hawks from 2000-03 (69-122 record) and was an assistant for New York Knicks (2003-04 season).
- Averaged 25.4 wins at UNLV over the last five years (four NCAA appearances and one NIT trip) and won at least 21 games each of those five seasons.
- ► Coached UNLV to a 55-25 (.688) Mountain West Conference record the last five seasons.
- ▶ Has taken teams to 13 NCAA Tournaments (14-13 record) and four NITs (4-5 record).

SATURDAY'S GAME BASICS

Oklahoma (10-3, 0-1) plays its Big 12 Conference home opener Saturday at 1 p.m. CT when Kansas (11-3, 1-0) visits Lloyd Noble Center. The Sooners, who lost 87-49 at No. 7 Missouri on Tuesday, are 7-0 at home this season. The No. 14/15 Jayhawks, are coming off a 67-49 home win over Kansas State on Wednesday. Saturday's contest will air on the Sooner Radio Network (KOKC AM 1520 in Oklahoma City; KTBZ AM 1430 in Tulsa; Sirius 92; XM 194) with **Toby Rowland** and **Mike Houck** announcing. The game will be televised by ESPNU with **Dave Flemming** and **Fran Fraschilla** calling the action.

SOONER UPDATE

- ▶ Picked to finish last (tied with Texas Tech) by Big 12 coaches in the league's preseason poll, Oklahoma finished non-conference play with a 10-2 record (fourth best in the league).
- ► The Sooners are 10-5 in Big 12 home openers. They have won 19 of their last 23 overall home games.
- ▶ In seven home games this year (all wins), the Sooners are shooting .472 from the field, .422 from behind the arc and .755 from the free throw line. Opponents are shooting .382, .253 and .639, respectively. OU also owns a +14.0 rebounding advantage at home this year.

▶ The junior trio of **Steven Pledger** (.574), **Andrew Fitzgerald** (.541) and **Romero Osby** (.526) is shooting a combined .548 from the field at home this year. The threesome has accounted for 51 percent of the team's points at Lloyd Noble Center.

▶ Oklahoma had been impressive defensively over a seven-game stretch prior to Tuesday night's loss at Missouri. In those seven games, OU held opponents to an average of 59.4 points on .367 field goal and .257 3-point shooting. On Tuesday, Missouri scored 87 points with the help of .593 field goal and .571 (11-for-21) 3-point shooting.

▶ Out of 338 Division I teams, OU ranks No. 11 nationally in rebounds per game (40.7), No. 12 in offensive rebounds per game (15.4), No. 14 in 3-point field goal percentage (.402), No. 30 in free throw percentage (.741) and No. 65 in scoring (74.9 ppq).

▶ The Sooners have scored at least 75 points eight times in their 13 games (62 percent) after doing it seven times in its 32 contests last year (22 percent).

▶ 0U has shot better than .500 from 3-point range in four of its last eight games. However, the Sooners are averaging just 3.7 treys over their last three.

▶ OU's wins over Sacramento State (by 29 points), Coppin State (27), Arkansas (15), Washington State (15), Oral Roberts (14) and Houston (5) represent those teams' largest margins of defeat this year. The Sooners also handed South Carolina State (35 points) its second worst defeat.

▶ Rebounding was mentioned by Kruger several times in the preseason as a concern of his for 2011-12. However, OU has outboarded 11 of its 13 opponents and ranks second in the Big 12 with its +8.5 margin per contest despite not starting anyone taller than 6-8. Included were a +34 effort against Coppin State (61-27) on Nov. 18 and a +27

performance against South Carolina State (63-36) on Dec. 21. The Sooners own a 202-146 offensive rebounding advantage on the year (despite shooting considerably better than their opponents (.446 to .409).

PLEDGER OFF TO SIZZLING START

After averaging 8.6 points and shooting .386 from the field and .345 from long distance over his first two seasons, junior guard **Steven Pledger** is averaging 18.2 points this year and is shooting .532 from the field and .484 from 3-point range (single-season school record is .473 by **Tim Heskett** in 1998-99). Pledger ranks third in the Big 12 in scoring, second in 3-point field goal percentage, fourth in 3-pointers per game (2.8) and fifth in field goal percentage and free throw percentage (.857).

- ▶ To help put Pledger's .532 field goal performance into perspective, the only OU guard since the start of the 3-point era in 1986-87 (25 years ago) to shoot at least .500 from the field over the course of an entire season was **Nolan Johnson** in 1999-00. Johnson shot .559 that year but only attempted two 3-point field goals and made none. Pledger has attempted 70 treys (made 34).
- ▶ Pledger has scored in double figures in each of his 12 outings and has shot at least .500 from the field in eight games. He has scored at least 20 points five times after doing it three times all of last season.
- ▶ Pledger averaged 13.6 points per 40 minutes last season but has significantly increased that projection this year (23.5).
- ▶ Pledger has made 74 field goals this year, already putting him at 66 percent of last year's total (112).

MORE INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- ▶ Junior guard **Sam Grooms** has been strong at the point, ranking No. 2 in the Big 12 in assists (5.5) and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.6). He has recorded one or zero turnovers five times in 13 games and ranks second on the team in minutes (28.8). Over the last five outings, Grooms has 34 assists (6.8 average) and 11 turnovers (3.1 ratio). Only one Sooner in the last 15 years averaged more assists per game for an entire season than Grooms' current 5.5 average (6.9 by **Terrell Everett** in 2005-06).
- ▶ Junior forward **Romero Osby** ranks second in the Big 12 with his 2.9 offensive rebounds per game and third with his 8.3 overall boards per outing. He has recorded at least 10 rebounds on six occasions this year (his career high entering the season was eight). He pulled down a career-high 18 boards vs. South Carolina State on Dec. 21 and followed with 12 at Cincinnati Dec. 29.
- ▶ Junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** has scored in double figures in each of the last eight games (averaging 15.4 during stretch on .530 shooting) after doing it just twice in OU's first five outings (averaged 8.4 points on .400 shooting). He has scored at least 13 points in seven of the last eight games, including season highs of 18 points in two of the last three.
- ▶ OU's lone senior on scholarship, forward **C.J. Washington** has provided a big lift off the bench the last two home outings. In games against South Carolina State and Northwestern State, Washington averaged 6.5 points and 8.5 rebounds in an average of just 13.5 minutes. Projected to 40 minutes per game, those scoring and rebounding averages jump to 19.3 and 25.2, respectively.
- ▶ Head coach **Lon Kruger** is just 11 victories shy of 500 for his career. He ranks second among current Big 12 head coaches with 489 career wins (Texas' **Rick Barnes** has 534 victories).

CLEANING THE GLASS

- ▶ 0U leads the Big 12 in rebounds per game at 40.7 (ranks No. 11 nationally), offensive rebounds per game at 15.4 (ranks No. 12 nationally) and offensive rebounding percentage at 43 percent. It ranks second in the league in average rebounding margin at +8.5 (Kansas is at +9.1).
- ▶ The Sooners have outrebounded all but two of their 13 opponents (Washington State and Missouri).
- ▶ Oklahoma's top two rebounding totals of the 16-year Big 12 era have been recorded this year (63 vs. S.C. State and 61 vs. Coppin State).
- ▶ 0U has pulled down double-digit offensive rebounds in all but the Sacramento State and Missouri games and is averaging 15.4 offensive boards per contest to its opponents' 11.4. The Sooners are averaging 13.5 second-chance points while foes are averaging 10.9.
- ▶ The Sooners are averaging 6.9 more offensive rebounds per game this year than last (15.4 to 8.5).

TUESDAY'S MISSOURI RECAP (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 11 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ Oklahoma's Big 12 opener was not a memorable one, as the Sooners lost 87-49 at No. 7/6 Missouri on Tuesday. The Tigers, who entered the game ranked No. 1 in the country in field goal percentage, shot .593 on the night and drained 12 of their 21 3-point attempts (.571). They held OU to .333 field goal and .273 (3-for-11) 3-point shooting.
- ▶ Missouri became just the second team to outrebound 0U in 13 games this year. The Tigers posted a 38-23 advantage on the glass and held the Sooners to their lowest offensive rebounding total of the year (seven).
- ▶ The Sooners committed a season-high 18 turnovers but outrebounded the Demons 38-30.
- ▶ Missouri led 43-25 at halftime and scored on 10 of its first 11 possessions of the second half to go ahead 68-36.
- ▶ Junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** matched a career high with eight field goals and tied a season high with 18 points. At 8-for-15, he was the only Sooner who shot at least .500 from the field.
- ▶ Junior guard **Steven Pledger** made all three of OU's 3-pointers (on six attempts) and netted 11 points to tie a season low.
- ▶ On a bright note, OU made all 10 of its free throw attempts and committed a season-low-tying eight turnovers.

PREVIEWING KANSAS

▶ Ranked No. 14 and No. 15 in the AP and coaches' polls, 11-3 Kansas picked up a 67-49 home win over No. 23/22 Kansas State on Wednesday in the Big 12 opener for both teams. The Jayhawks held K-State to .316 shooting and outrebounded it 50-26.

- ► KU is 8-0 at home and 3-3 away from Allen Fieldhouse. Its losses have come to Kentucky (75-65 in New York), Duke (68-61 in Hawaii) and Davidson (80-74 in Kansas City).
- ► The Jayhawks average 75.4 points per game (rank fifth in Big 12) and are shooting .479 from the field (fourth), .357 from 3-point distance (sixth) and .689 from the free throw line (seventh). They lead the league in rebounding margin (+9.1 per game).
- ▶ Junior forward **Thomas Robinson**, a teammate of OU's **Andrew Fitzgerald** at Brewster Academy in New Hampshire, ranks fourth in the Big 12 in scoring (17.5 ppg) and first in rebounding (12.3 rpg; ranks No. 2 nationally). Robinson's 10 double-doubles are six more than the league's second-highest total (four by OU's **Romero Osby**). The reigning Big 12 Player of the Week is averaging 22.5 points and 17.0 rebounds the last two games.
- ► Senior guard **Tyshawn Taylor** averages 15.1 points and a team-high 5.1 assists per game (ranks fourth in league). A career .360 3-point shooter entering the season. Taylor has made 18 of his 36 attempts this season (.500).
- ▶ Junior guards **Elijah Johnson** and **Travis Releford** average 9.7 and 8.8 points per game, respectively. Johnson also averages 3.8 assists, while Releford is coming off his first career double-double (16 points, 11 rebounds vs. Kansas State).
- ▶ Bill Self is in his ninth year as Kansas' head coach and owns a 248-49 record. He's in his 19th year overall.

OU-KANSAS SERIES HISTORY

Kansas is the only Big 12 program with a winning record against Oklahoma. The Jayhawks own a 136-64 series advantage and are 46-40 in Norman. The Sooners had won three of the five overall meetings in the series and four of the seven prior to Kansas' current six-game victory streak. OU is 4-15 against the Jayhawks since the formation of the Big 12 Conference (2-6 in Norman). They have won two of the last five against KU in Norman (won 77-70 in 2003 and 71-63 in 2005).

LAST YEAR VS. THE JAYHAWKS (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 11 OF THESE NOTES)

Kansas' **Marcus Morris** (23 and nine) and **Markieff Morris** (19 and 10) combined for 42 points and 19 rebounds as the Jayhawks posted an 82-70 win in Norman on Feb. 26 of last season. KU shot .568 from the field (.708 in the first half) and made 26 of 35 free throw attempts. The Sooners committed a season-low six turnovers, but also recorded a season-low 16 rebounds (to KU's 35). **Cade Davis** led OU with 19 points (10-for-11 on free throws) while **Andrew Fitzgerald** netted 16 points and **Cameron Clark** (10).

SOONER TIP INS

- ▶ The last time Oklahoma beat a top-15 team was Feb. 6, 2009 (defeated No. 9 Texas 80-71).
- ▶ While head coach at Kansas State from 1987-90, **Lon Kruger** compiled a 4-7 record against Kansas. Two of the losses came in overtime and another was by one point. OU assistant coach **Steve Henson** played in all 11 of those contests.
- ▶ Oklahoma has recorded 40 dunks in its 13 games (3.1 average) and junior forward **Romero Osby** has 22 of them (55 percent).
- ▶ Osby has grabbed at least six rebounds in 10 of 13 games this year. In his 35 games at Mississippi State as a sophomore in 2009-10, Osby pulled down at least six boards on three occasions.
- ▶ Osby and fellow junior Andrew Fitzgerald lead the team with five charges taken each.
- Last year, **Steven Pledger** averaged 15.4 points in 0U's wins and 7.4 points in its losses. This year, the junior guard is averaging 20.6 points in wins and 11.0 in defeats (scored 11 in each of three losses).
- ▶ Pledger is the only Sooner to make a 3-pointer the last two games (three treys in each).
- ▶ Oklahoma and Texas are the only two Big 12 schools who have eight players each averaging at least 3.0 rebounds.

UP NEXT

The Sooners have a quick turnaround and play at Oklahoma State on Monday at 6 p.m. CT. The game will be televised by ESPNU.

QUANTIFYING OU'S BASKETBALL TRADITION

- ▶ This is the 105th season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ 0U owns a 1,535-980 (.610) all-time record, ranking it 30th in NCAA Division I history in wins and 41st in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ OU has made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. It has made 22 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 29 years.
- ▶ Oklahoma has made 27 postseason appearances over the last 30 years (22 NCAA Tournaments and five NITs).
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 Big 12 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and the eighth best (.738) in the 2000s.
- ▶ Twenty different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 30 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim nine times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ **Wayman Tisdale** was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 73 times.
- ► The Sooners own a winning record against eight of the other nine members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).

- ▶ Point guard who's averaging 7.0 points, 3.3 boards and 5.5 assists in 28.8 minutes a contest.
- ▶ Ranks second in Big 12 in assists and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.5).
- ▶ Has registered 34 assists and 11 turnovers (3.1 ratio) during the last five games.
- ▶ Recorded 17 assists and 4 turnovers (4.3 ratio) in three 76 Classic games Nov. 24-27.
- ▶ Point guard who transferred from Chipola College in Florida.
- ▶ Rated as nation's third-best junior college player in 2010-11 by JucoRecruiting.com.
- ▶ Started 50 games in his two seasons at Chipola (averaged 11.1 points, 5.9 assists last year).

2 STEVEN PLEDGER (6-4, 222, JUNIOR, GUARD)

- ▶ Averaging 18.2 points (ranks No. 3 Big 12), 4.0 rebounds and 1.8 assists in 30.9 minutes.
- ▶ Ranks second among Big 12 guards with his .532 field goal percentage.
- ▶ Ranks ninth nationally with his .486 3-point percentage (.523 last 8 games).
- ▶ Averaging 20.6 points in team's wins and has scored 11 in each of three losses.
- ▶ Recorded first career double-double vs. Houston on Dec. 17 (31 points, 10 rebounds).

4 ANDREW FITZGERALD (6-8, 247, JUNIOR, FORWARD)

- ▶ Averaging 12.7 points and 5.4 rebounds (ranks second on team in both categories).
- ▶ Has recorded a season-high 18 points twice in the last three outings.
- Averaging 15.4 points the last eight games after averaging 8.0 the first five.
- \blacktriangleright Shooting .530 from field the last eight outings after shooting .400 the first five.
- ▶ Averaged 7.3 boards in three 76 Classic games (tied for second most in tournament).
- OU's leading returning scorer (12.6) and rebounder (5.0) from last season. Also led team with his 21 blocked shots and 34 steals in an average of 30.8 minutes per game.
- ▶ An honorable mention All-Big 12 selection as a sophomore last season.
- ▶ Started all 32 games last year and scored at least 10 points 22 times (at least 20 four times).
- ▶ Arrived at OU in summer 2009 weighing 273 pounds but entered 2011-12 season at 247.

5 C.J. WASHINGTON (6-7, 230, SENIOR, FORWARD)

- ▶ Averaging 2.6 points and 3.8 rebounds in 10.1 minutes a game (DNP in season opener).
- ▶ Averaging 6.5 points and 8.5 rebounds last two home games in 13.5 minutes per contest.
- ▶ Seven of his career-high 12 boards (in 13 min.) against South Carolina State were offensive.
- ▶ Leads team in rebounds per minute (40-minute projection is 15.2 boards).
- ▶ Handed out 3 assists vs. Coppin State in his first game of year (recorded 2 all of last season).
