



Head Coach Lon Kruger

- ► Lon Kruger was named Oklahoma's 14th head men's basketball coach on April 1, 2011.
- ▶ Owns a 491-311 (.612) collegiate record over 25 years.
- ► Has coached at Texas-Pan American (52-59 record from 1982-86), Kansas State (81-46 from 1986-90), Florida (104-80 from 1990-96), Illinois (81-48 from 1996-00) and UNLV (161-71 from 2004-11).
- ▶ Served as head coach of NBA's Atlanta Hawks from 2000-03 (69-122 record) and was an assistant for New York Knicks (2003-04 season).
- Averaged 25.4 wins at UNLV over the last five years (four NCAA appearances and one NIT trip) and won at least 21 games each of those five seasons.
- ► Coached UNLV to a 55-25 (.688) Mountain West Conference record the last five seasons.
- ▶ Has taken teams to 13 NCAA Tournaments (14-13 record) and four NITs (4-5 record).
- ▶ Coached Florida to the 1994 Final Four, Kansas State to the 1988 Elite Eight and UNLV to the 2007 Sweet 16.
- ▶ Has led all five of the college programs he has coached to 20-win seasons.
- ▶ Is one of five coaches in Division I college basketball history to take four different schools to the NCAA Tournament and is one of three coaches to win an NCAA Tournament game at four schools.
- ▶ Is one of just two head coaches in Division I history to lead at least four different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament wins.
- ▶ Is one of four coaches to lead three different schools to NCAA Sweet 16 appearances.

SATURDAY'S GAME BASICS

Oklahoma head coach **Lon Kruger** will coach against his alma mater in Manhattan, Kan., for the first time when his Sooners (12-7 overall, 2-5 Big 12) take on No. 22/24 Kansas State (15-4, 4-3) Saturday at 6 p.m. CT. OU is coming off a 77-65 home loss to No. 6 Baylor, the first of three straight games against top-25 opponents. The Wildcats, a 69-47 victor at Texas Tech Wednesday, have won three straight after a 1-3 league start. Saturday's contest will air on the Sooner Radio Network (KOKC AM 1520 in Oklahoma City; KTBZ AM 1430 in Tulsa) with **Toby Rowland** and **Mike Houck** announcing. The game will be televised by FS Midwest (carried by FS Oklahoma on state cable systems and by ESPN Full Court) with **Ben Boyle** and **Stan Weber** calling the action.

SOONER STORYLINES

▶ Oklahoma holds a 103-91 all-time series lead against Kansas State but is 35-55 versus the Wildcats in Manhattan. OU won the first meeting this year, 82-73. on Jan. 14 in Norman.

▶ Lon Kruger will be making his first coaching appearance in Manhattan against his alma mater on Saturday. A 1975 Kansas State graduate, he holds a 3-2 record against the Wildcats, but none of those games took place on the KSU campus. He is 1-0 vs. K-State as head coach at OU, went 1-1 while at UNLV, 1-0 while at Illinois and 0-1 while at UT-Pan American). He was the 1973 and 1974 Big Eight

Player of the Year as a Wildcat and saw his No. 12 jersey retired in 2006.

▶ Oklahoma assistant coach **Steve Henson** broke 21 school records as a player at Kansas State (1987-90) and still holds KSU career standards for assists (582), assists per game (4.6), free throw percentage (.900), minutes (4,474), minutes per game (35.2), starts (118), consecutive games played (127) and consecutive starts (118). He is the only K-State player to participate in four consecutive NCAA Tournaments.

▶ Out of 338 Division I teams, OU ranks No. 18 nationally in offensive rebounds per game (14.6), No. 36 in total rebounds per game (38.6) and No. 32 in free throw percentage (.743).

▶ 0U has been held to a total of 25 3-point makes over the last eight games (3.1 average) and junior guard **Steven Pledger** has 19 of the conversions during the stretch. The Sooners averaged 6.7 treys over their first 11 games.

▶ In OU's wins, Pledger is averaging 20.0 points on .569 field goal shooting. In the team's losses, Pledger is averaging 12.7 points on .333 shooting.

▶ 0U is the only school in the Big 12 that has three players ranked in the top 14 in scoring in league play. **Andrew Fitzgerald** averages 15.0 points a game and is followed by fellow juniors Pledger (14.6) and **Romero Osby** (14.3). The trio has combined for 307 of the team's 461 points (67 percent) in conference play.

▶ In Big 12 games, Oklahoma leads the league with its +2.9 average turnover margin. OU averages just 11.0 turnovers while opponents average 13.9. The Sooners have outscored league foes 119-94 off turnovers.

▶ The Sooners have scored at least 75 points 10 times in their 19 games after doing it seven times in their 32 contests last year.

▶ Oklahoma has been superb at the free throw line in Big 12 play with its .765 mark (ranks third). Pledger (20-for-20), **Cameron Clark** (16-for-19) and **Carl Blair** (16-for-19) are a combined 52-for-58 (.897) at the stripe. Pledger has missed one free throw since Dec. 10 (36 for his last 37).

▶ Rebounding was a major strength for OU in non-conference play. The Sooners finished that portion of their schedule with a +10.4 average rebounding margin. They have been outboarded in five of their seven league games, however, and own a -5.3 average margin in those seven. OU boasts a 277-230 offensive rebounding advantage on the year.

KRUGER VS. HIS ALMA MATER

A 1975 Kansas State graduate, OU head coach **Lon Kruger** is 3-2 all-time against his alma mater after the Sooners' 82-73 win over the Wildcats on Jan 14. The Big Eight Conference Player of the Year his junior and senior seasons (1972-73 and '73-74), Kruger, whose No. 12 K-State iersey is retired, also coached the Wildcats from the 1986-87 through '89-90 seasons.

As a coach, he led the Wildcats to an 81-46 record and to NCAA Tournament appearances each of his four years in Manhattan, including the Elite Eight in 1988. As UNLV's head coach, Kruger posted a 1-1 record against KSU (won 63-59 last season in Kansas City; lost 95-80 in 2009-10 in Las Vegas). He also notched an 81-48 home win during the 1999-00 season as Illinois' head coach. His Texas-Pan American team lost a 75-68 contest to the Wildcats in 1984-85 in the Runnin' Rebel Classic in Las Vegas.

PLEDGER AMONG BIG 12'S OFFENSIVE LEADERS

- After averaging 8.6 points and shooting .386 from the field and .345 from 3-point range over his first two seasons, junior guard **Steven Pledger** is averaging 17.2 points this year while shooting .473 from the field and .427 from long distance. Pledger ranks fourth in the Big 12 in scoring, free throw percentage (.900; 10th nationally) and 3-pointers per game (2.6), sixth in 3-point field goal percentage and eighth in field goal percentage.
- ▶ Pledger has scored in double figures in 17 of his 18 outings (held to nine Jan. 9 at Oklahoma State). He has scored at least 20 points five times after doing it three times all of last season, and has netted at least 15 points on seven other occasions.
- ▶ Pledger has made 104 field goals this year, already putting him at 93 percent of last year's total (112).

MORE INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- ▶ Junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** has scored in double figures in each of the last 14 games (averaging 15.0 points during the stretch on .514 shooting) after doing it just twice in OU's first five outings (averaged 8.4 points on .400 shooting). He has scored at least 17 points in five of the last 10 outings, including a season-high 21 Jan. 14 against Kansas State when he made a career-high nine field goals on 10 attempts. Fitzgerald leads the team and ranks 12th in the Big 12 with his 15.0 scoring average in league play. He also ranks fifth in the Big 12 (all games) with his .493 field goal percentage.
- ▶ Junior point guard **Sam Grooms** leads the Big 12 in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.8) and ranks fourth in assists (5.5). He has recorded one or zero turnovers nine times in 19 games, including each of the last three outings. Only one Sooner in the last 15 years averaged more assists per game for an entire season than Grooms' current 5.5 average (6.9 by **Terrell Everett** in 2005-06).
- ▶ Junior forward **Romero Osby** leads the Big 12 with his 3.2 offensive rebounds per game and ranks third with his 8.3 overall boards per outing. He is also tied for second with six double-doubles. He has recorded at least 10 rebounds on eight occasions this year (his career high entering the season was eight rebounds). Osby, who pulled down a career-high 18 boards vs. South Carolina State on Dec. 21, is averaging 17.0 points and 8.0 rebounds over the last five games (shooting .585 from the field during the stretch). He has scored a career-high 18 points in four of the last eight outings, including OU's Jan. 14 win over Kansas State.
- Sophomore guard **Cameron Clark** returned to the starting lineup Tuesday against Baylor after coming off the bench the previous three games (the only non-starts of his career). Clark, who has been held to single-digit scoring eight times in the last 10 games after scoring at least 10 points in six of the previous seven outings, is averaging 8.3 points on .389 shooting this year. Last season, he averaged 9.3 points on .474 shooting. All five of his 3-point makes this year came in back-to-back December games.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- ▶ 0U ranks second in the Big 12 and 36th nationally in rebounds per game (38.6). It also ranks No. 2 in the league and No. 18 nationally with its 14.6 offensive rebounds per game, and No. 3 in the conference in offensive rebounding percentage at .400. The tallest Sooner in the starting lineup is 6-8.
- ▶ The Sooners have been outrebounded just six times on the year, but five of those occasions have taken place in seven Big 12 games.
- ▶ Oklahoma's top two rebounding totals of the 16-year Big 12 era have been recorded this year (63 vs. S.C. State and 61 vs. Coppin State). They are the two highest totals among Big 12 teams on the season.
- ▶ 0U has pulled down double-digit offensive rebounds in 15 of 19 games and is averaging 14.6 offensive boards per contest to its opponents' 12.1.
- ▶ The Sooners are averaging 6.1 more offensive rebounds per game this year than they did last season (14.6 to 8.5).

PREVIEWING KANSAS STATE

▶ After going 1-3 to start Big 12 play, No. 22/24 Kansas State has reeled off three straight wins and is tied for fourth place in the league with lowa State. The Wildcats are 9-1 at home, with their only defeat coming by two points (75-73) to then-No. 4 Baylor on Jan. 10. They are coming off a 69-47 victory at Texas Tech on Wednesday, a game in which they outscored the Red Raiders 27-7 off turnovers.

- ▶ One of the best rebounding teams in the Big 12, Kansas State leads the league in rebounds per game (39.8), offensive rebounds per game (15.7) and offensive rebounding percentage (.433). It ranks second in average rebounding margin (+6.9).
- ▶ Junior guard **Rodney McGruder** averages a Big 12-best 20.6 points per conference game, as well as a team-high 6.4 rebounds. He is shooting .500 from the field, .444 (12-for-27) from 3-point range and .824 (28-for-34) from the free throw line in league outings. McGruder is averaging 27.7 points in K-State's three Big 12 home games on .625 (30-for-48) field goal shooting.
- Senior forward **Jamar Samuels** averages 10.5 points and a team-high 6.5 boards per game on the season, while sophomore guard **Will Spradling** contributes 10.4 points and 2.7 assists per contest. Spradling is shooting a team-high .386 from 3-point range on the year but is 5-for-22 (.227) over the last five games (was 3-for-12 against Oklahoma).
- ▶ Frank Martin is in his fifth year as a collegiate head coach, all at Kansas State. He owns a 110-47 (.701) record.

OU-KANSAS STATE SERIES HISTORY

Oklahoma owns a 103-91 series advantage against Kansas State but is 35-55 against the Wildcats in Manhattan. OU is 11-6 against K-State since the start of the Big 12 in 1996-97 (4-4 in Manhattan). KSU has won four of the last six overall meetings.

JAN. 14 VS. THE WILDCATS (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 13 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ Oklahoma turned in its third best shooting performance of the season (.549) and overcame its worst rebounding deficit in 13 seasons (44-24) to post an 82-73 home win over 18th-ranked Kansas State. The Sooners, who shot .700 from the field in the second half (14-for-20), held the Wildcats to .391 shooting on the day and forced them into 19 turnovers (their second highest total of the season).
- ▶ OU's 20-rebound deficit was its largest in victory in 20 years (was outboarded by 30 by Nebraska in a 79-76 home win in 1991-92).
- ▶ Junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** enjoyed his best shooting day as a Sooner, knocking down a career-high nine field goals on 10 attempts en route to a season-high 21 points.
- ▶ Junior forward **Romero Osby** hit six of his eight shots and all six of his free throws to finish with a career-high-tying 18 points.
- ▶ Junior guard **Steven Pledger** netted 18 points with the help of 2-for-3 3-point and 6-for-6 free throw shooting. He shared team-high rebounding honors (six) with 0sby.
- ▶ Junior point guard **Sam Grooms** registered nine assists against three turnovers and added a pair of steals.

TUESDAY'S BAYLOR RECAP (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 12 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ Oklahoma trailed No. 6 Baylor by just two, 62-60, but was outscored 13-5 over the final four minutes of a 77-65 home loss. The Bears shot .540 from the field, .500 (9-for-18) from 3-point range and .824 (14-for-17) from the free throw line to improve to 18-2 overall.
- ▶ Baylor shot .640 from the field after halftime (16-for-25) and hit four of its five field goal attempts during its 13-5 game-ending run.
- ▶ Baylor's win was just its fourth ever in Norman (against 18 losses) and just its second ever at Lloyd Noble Center (against 16 defeats).
- ▶ Junior guard **Steven Pledger** led 0U in scoring for the 10th time this year, finishing with 17 points on 7-for-15 field goal and 3-for-9 3-point shooting. He added six rebounds and four assists.
- ▶ Junior forward **Romero Osby** finished with 16 points and a team-high 11 rebounds for his sixth double-double of the year (second most in the Big 12) and eighth game with at least 10 boards. He added a pair of blocked shots and took three charges (has a team-high eight on the year).
- ▶ Junior forward Andrew Fitzgerald scored in double figures for the 14th straight game, finishing with 13 points on 6-for-14 shooting.
- ▶ Junior guard **Sam Grooms** tallied seven points and seven assists without registering a turnover.

UP NEXT

Oklahoma plays the second of two straight road games when it faces No. 5 Kansas on Wednesday at 8 p.m. CT (televised by ESPNU).

QUANTIFYING OU'S BASKETBALL TRADITION

- ▶ This is the 105th season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ OU owns a 1,537-984 (.610) all-time record, ranking it 30th in NCAA Division I history in wins and 41st in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ 0U has made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. It has made 22 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 29 years.
- ▶ Oklahoma has made 27 postseason appearances over the last 30 years (22 NCAA Tournaments and five NITs).
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 Big 12 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and the eighth best (.738) in the 2000s.
- ▶ Twenty different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 30 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim nine times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ **Wayman Tisdale** was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 73 times.
- ► The Sooners own a winning record against eight of the other nine members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).
