- ▶ Owns a 492-313 (.611) collegiate record over 25 years.
- ► Has coached at Texas-Pan American (52-59 record from 1982-86), Kansas State (81-46 from 1986-90), Florida (104-80 from 1990-96), Illinois (81-48 from 1996-00) and UNLV (161-71 from 2004-11).
- ► Served as head coach of NBA's Atlanta Hawks from 2000-03 (69-122 record) and was an assistant for New York Knicks (2003-04 season).
- Averaged 25.4 wins at UNLV over the last five years (four NCAA appearances and one NIT trip) and won at least 21 games each of those five seasons.
- ► Coached UNLV to a 55-25 (.688) Mountain West Conference record the last five seasons.
- ▶ Has taken teams to 13 NCAA Tournaments (14-13 record) and four NITs (4-5 record).

MONDAY'S GAME BASICS

Oklahoma (13-9,3-7) will try to snap a two-game losing streak when it hosts No. 4/4 Missouri (21-2,8-2) on Monday at 6 p.m. CT. The Sooners, coming off a 77-70 home loss to lowa State on Saturday, are 9-3 at Lloyd Noble Center this year. The Tigers, tied for first place in the Big 12 with Baylor and Kansas, beat the eighth-ranked Jayhawks 74-71 Saturday. Monday's contest will air on the Sooner Radio Network (KOKC AM 1520 in Oklahoma City; KTBZ AM 1430 in Tulsa; Sirius 92; XM 190) with **Toby Rowland** and **Mike Houck** announcing. The game will be televised by ESPNU with **Mark Jones** and **Sean Farnham** calling the action.

SOONER STORYLINES

- ▶ Oklahoma holds a 112-96 all-time advantage over Missouri and is 64-21 against the Tigers in Norman. The Sooners have won seven of the last nine meetings at home, but MU has won eight of the last 12 overall meetings.
- ▶ In the Big 12 opener for both teams on Jan. 3 in Columbia, Missouri shot .593 from the field and .571 (12-for-21) from 3-point range in an 87-49 win.
- ▶ OU's top three scorers on the year **Steven Pledger** (.489), **Andrew Fitzgerald** (.528) and **Romero Osby** (.540) are shooting a combined .517 from the field and .843 from the free throw line at Lloyd Noble Center.

▶ Oklahoma is the only school in the Big 12 with three players ranked in the top 15 in scoring in league play. Pledger averages 16.6 points a game (ranks seventh) and is followed by Fitzgerald (14.9; ranks 10th) and Osby (14.5; 12th). The trio has combined for 457 of the team's 656 points (70 percent) in conference play.

▶ Including Monday's game vs. Missouri, seven of OU's first 11 conference contests will have been played against ranked opponents. Only one of the Sooners' final seven league games is against a team currently ranked in the top 25 (Feb. 25 at Baylor).

▶ Out of 338 Division I teams, OU ranks No. 22 in offensive rebounds per game (14.0), No. 29 in free throw percentage (.746) and No. 45 in total rebounds per game (37.8).

▶ 0U has been held to a total of 34 3-point makes in Big 12 play (3.4 average) and Pledger has 26 of the conversions (76 percent) during the stretch. The Sooners averaged 6.4 treys in their 12 non-conference games. Big 12 opponents have made more than twice as many 3-pointers (78) as 0U.

▶ In OU's wins, Pledger is averaging 20.8 points on .578 field goal shooting. In the team's losses, he is averaging 13.3 points on .350 shooting.

▶ In Big 12 games, Oklahoma ranks second in the league with its +2.2 average turnover margin. OU averages just 11.6 turnovers while opponents average 13.8. The Sooners have outscored league foes 160-129 off turnovers in Big 12 play.

▶ The Sooners have scored at least 75 points 10 times in their 22 games after doing it seven times in their 32 contests last year.

▶ Oklahoma has been superb at the free throw line in Big 12 play with its .767 mark. Pledger (27-for-28) and **Carl Blair** (18-for-21) are a combined 45-for-49 (.918) at the stripe. Pledger has missed two free throws since Dec. 10 (44 for his last 46).

▶ Rebounding was a major strength for OU in non-conference play. The Sooners finished that portion of their schedule with a +10.4 average rebounding margin. They have been outboarded in six of their 10 league games, however, and own a -3.2 average margin in those 10. OU boasts a 309-251 offensive rebounding advantage on the year.

PLEDGER AMONG BIG 12'S OFFENSIVE LEADERS

- ▶ After averaging 8.6 points and shooting .386 from the field and .345 from 3-point range over his first two seasons, junior guard **Steven Pledger** is averaging 17.6 points this year while shooting .477 from the field and .449 from long distance. Pledger leads the Big 12 in 3-pointers per game (2.7) and ranks third in free throw percentage (.897; eighth nationally), third in 3-point field goal percentage and seventh in field goal percentage.
- ▶ Pledger, the Dec. 19 and Jan. 30 Big 12 Player of the Week, has scored in double figures in 20 of his 21 outings (held to nine Jan. 9 at OSU). He has scored at least 20 points six times after doing it three times all of last year, and has netted at least 15 points on eight other occasions.
- ▶ Pledger has already made 14 more field goals (126) in 21 games this year than he did in 32 games last season (112). He has played 309 fewer minutes this season than last.

MORE INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- ▶ Junior point guard **Sam Grooms** leads the Big 12 (ranks in top 10 nationally) in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.0) and ranks third in the league in assists (5.7 apg). He has recorded one or zero turnovers 10 times in 22 games, including in four of the last six outings. During the current six-game stretch, Grooms has handed out 40 assists while committing just seven turnovers (5.7 ratio). Only one Sooner in the last 15 years averaged more assists for an entire season than Grooms' current 5.7 average (6.9 by **Terrell Everett** in 2005-06).
- ▶ Junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** has scored in double figures in 16 of the last 17 games and is averaging 14.9 points on .512 shooting over those 17 outings (he averaged just 8.4 points on .400 shooting over the season's first five games). He has scored at least 17 points in six of the last 13 contests, including a career-high 27 points Saturday against lowa State. Fitzgerald has committed at least four fouls in six of the last nine games.
- ▶ Junior forward **Romero Osby** leads the Big 12 with his 3.0 offensive rebounds per game and ranks fourth with his 7.8 overall boards per outing. He is also tied for second with six double-doubles. He has recorded at least 10 rebounds on eight occasions this year (his career high entering the season was eight rebounds). Osby, who pulled down a career-high 18 boards vs. South Carolina State on Dec. 21, is averaging 16.3 points over the last eight games on .517 shooting. He has scored at least 15 points in seven of the last eight outings, including a career-high 19 points against No. 8 Kansas last Wednesday. His scoring surge can be partially attributed to his ability to get to the free throw line. He has 48 free throw attempts over the last eight games (made 37 for a .771 mark), exactly twice as many as the next highest total on the team during the span (24 attempts by **Andrew Fitzgerald**).
- Sophomore guard **Cameron Clark** returned to the starting lineup four games ago against Baylor after coming off the bench the previous three games (the only non-starts of his career). Clark, who has been held to single-digit scoring 10 times in the last 13 games after scoring at least 10 points in six of the previous seven outings, is averaging 8.0 points on .383 shooting this year. Last season, he averaged 9.3 points on .474 shooting. All five of his 3-point makes this year came in back-to-back December games.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- ▶ 0U ranks second in the Big 12 and 48th nationally in rebounds per game (37.8). It also ranks No. 2 in the league and No. 24 nationally with its 14.0 offensive rebounds per game, and No. 3 in the conference in offensive rebounding percentage at .388. The tallest Sooner in the starting lineup is 6-8.
- ▶ The Sooners have been outrebounded seven times in 22 games, but six of those occasions have taken place in 10 Big 12 games.
- ▶ Oklahoma's top two rebounding totals of the 16-year Big 12 era have been recorded this year (63 vs. South Carolina State and 61 vs. Coppin State). They are the two highest totals among Big 12 teams on the season.
- ▶ The Sooners are averaging 5.5 more offensive rebounds per game this year than they did last season (14.0 to 8.5).

PREVIEWING MISSOURI

- ▶ Ranked No. 4 in both major polls last week, Missouri is 21–2 overall and tied with Baylor and Kansas for first place in the Big 12 at 8–2. The Tigers are coming off a 74–71 home win over eighth-ranked Kansas on Saturday, scoring the game's final 11 points over the last two minutes. Missouri ranks fourth in the country in field goal percentage (.499), No. 5 in free throw percentage (.774), No. 7 in scoring (80.9 ppg), No. 9 in steals (9.1 spg) and No. 38 in 3-point field goal percentage (.382).
- Missouri is led by the senior guard duo of **Marcus Denmon** and **Kim English**. Denmon, who went 6-for-9 from 3-point range and tallied 29 points and nine rebounds versus Kansas, averages 17.7 points, 5.5 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game while shooting .394 from 3-point range and .899 from the free throw line. He ranks third in the Big 12 in scoring and second in 3-pointers per game (2.7). English averages 14.3 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.5 assists while shooting .509 from the field and a Big 12-best .482 from 3-point range.
- Senior forward **Ricardo Ratliffe** leads the country with his .747 field goal percentage, and averages 14.3 points and a team-high 6.6 rebounds per game. He has shot 50 percent or better from the field in 22 of 23 games, including 21 straight.
- Sophomore point guard **Phil Pressey** averages 9.5 points and Big 12 highs of 5.9 assists and 2.3 steals per game. He also ranks second in the league with his 2.5 assist-to-turnover ratio
- Junior guard Michael Dixon comes off the bench to average 12.2 points and 2.8 assists in 25.6 minutes a game. He has scored at least

15 points eight times on the year and ranks fourth in the Big 12 with his .897 free throw percentage.

▶ Head coach **Frank Haith** is in his first year at Missouri after quiding Miami (Fla.) to a 129-101 (.561) record the last seven seasons.

OU-MISSOURI SERIES HISTORY

Oklahoma leads 112-96 in the all-time series with Missouri and holds a 64-21 advantage in Norman. Missouri has won eight of the last 12 overall meetings since OU rattled off nine straight victories from 1998 to 2002 (the nine-game streak culminated with an NCAA Tournament Elite Eight win in San Jose, Calif.). The Sooners have won seven of the last nine meetings in Norman, including a 66-61 decision two years ago.

JAN. 3 VS. THE TIGERS (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 13 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ Oklahoma's Big 12 opener was not a memorable one as No. 7/6 Missouri posted an 87-49 home win on Jan. 3. The Tigers, who entered the game ranked No. 1 in the country in field goal percentage, shot .593 on the night and drained 12 of their 21 3-point attempts (.571) while holding OU to .333 field goal and .273 (3-for-11) 3-point shooting.
- ▶ Missouri became just the second team to outrebound OU in its first 13 games this year. The Tigers posted a 38-23 advantage on the glass and held the Sooners to their then-lowest offensive rebounding total of the year (seven).
- ▶ Missouri led 43-25 at halftime and scored on 10 of its first 11 possessions of the second half to go ahead 68-36.
- ▶ Junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** matched a then-career high with eight field goals and tied a then-season high with 18 points. At 8-for-15, he was the only Sooner who shot at least .500 from the field.
- ▶ Junior quard **Steven Pledger** made all three of OU's 3-pointers (on six attempts) and netted 11 points to tie a then-season low.
- ▶ On a bright note, OU made all 10 of its free throw attempts and committed a season-low-tying eight turnovers.

SATURDAY'S IOWA STATE RECAP (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 12 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ lowa State hit an Oklahoma-opponent-record 15 3-pointers on 30 attempts and held on for a 77-70 road win Saturday, snapping the Sooners' five-game winning streak over the Cyclones. OU had won seven straight against ISU in Norman (last home loss came in 1996 in the final year of the Big Eight Conference).
- ► Six Cyclones made at least one 3-pointer and five made at least two. **Chris Babb**, who was 5-for-28 from long distance over the last six games, went 4-for-7.
- ▶ Oklahoma held just three leads in the game, each in the first half and each by one point. The Cyclones scored on their ensuing possession all three times to go back on top. After trailing by 10 (50-40), the Sooners rallied to tie the game at 56 with 7:49 remaining but were outscored 21-14 the rest of the way.
- ▶ Junior forwards **Andrew Fitzgerald** and **Romero Osby** teamed to score 44 of 0U's 70 points on 17-for-28 (.607) shooting. Fitzgerald was 11-for-19 from the field and finished with a career-high 27 points (previous high was 22). Osby was 6-for-9 from the floor and tallied 17 points. It was his seventh performance of at least 15 points in the last eight outings.
- Sophomore guard **Cameron Clark's** 11 rebounds tied a career high and were his most since the first game of his collegiate career (last year vs. Coppin State).
- ▶ Junior point guard **Sam Grooms** handed out nine assists (one shy of his career high) against just two turnovers. It was his sixth straight game of two or fewer turnovers.

UP NEXT

Oklahoma travels to Lubbock, Texas, to take on Texas Tech on Saturday at 7 p.m. CT. The game will be televised by the Red Raider Sports Network.

QUANTIFYING OU'S BASKETBALL TRADITION

- ▶ This is the 105th season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ OU owns a 1,538-987 (.609) all-time record, ranking it 30th in NCAA Division I history in wins and 41st in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ 0U has made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. It has made 22 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 29 years.
- ▶ Oklahoma has made 27 postseason appearances over the last 30 years (22 NCAA Tournaments and five NITs).
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 Big 12 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and the eighth best (.738) in the 2000s.
- ▶ Twenty different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 30 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim nine times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ **Wayman Tisdale** was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 73 times.
- ► The Sooners own a winning record against eight of the other nine members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).
