Head Coach Lon Kruger

- ► Lon Kruger was named Oklahoma's 14th head men's basketball coach on April 1, 2011.
- ▶ Owns a 492-314 (.610) collegiate record over 25 years.
- ► Has coached at Texas-Pan American (52-59 record from 1982-86), Kansas State (81-46 from 1986-90), Florida (104-80 from 1990-96), Illinois (81-48 from 1996-00) and UNLV (161-71 from 2004-11).
- ► Served as head coach of NBA's Atlanta Hawks from 2000-03 (69-122 record) and was an assistant for New York Knicks (2003-04 season).
- Averaged 25.4 wins at UNLV over the last five years (four NCAA appearances and one NIT trip) and won at least 21 games each of those five seasons.
- ▶ Coached UNLV to a 55-25 (.688) Mountain West Conference record the last five seasons.
- ▶ Has taken teams to 13 NCAA Tournaments (14-13 record) and four NITs (4-5 record).
- ▶ Coached Florida to the 1994 Final Four, Kansas State to the 1988 Elite Eight and UNLV to the 2007 Sweet 16.
- ▶ Has led all five of the college programs he has coached to 20-win seasons.
- ▶ Is one of five coaches in Division I college basketball history to take four different schools to the NCAA Tournament and is one of three coaches to win an NCAA Tournament game at four schools.
- ▶ Is one of just two head coaches in Division I history to lead at least four different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament wins.
- ▶ Is one of four coaches to lead three different schools to NCAA Sweet 16 appearances.

SATURDAY'S GAME BASICS

Oklahoma (13-10, 3-8) tries to stop a three-game losing streak when it visits Texas Tech (7-16, 0-11) on Saturday at 7 p.m. CT. The Sooners, who lost 71-68 to fourth-ranked Missouri on Monday, are 1-4 on the road in Big 12 play and are tied with Texas A&M for eighth place in the league race. The Red Raiders, coming off a 65-46 loss at Kansas State on Tuesday, went 6-0 at home in non-conference play but are 0-5 in league action at United Spirit Arena. Saturday contest will air on the Sooner Radio Network (KOKC AM 1520 in Oklahoma City; KTBZ AM 1430 in Tulsa) with **Toby Rowland** and **Mike Houck** announcing. The game will be televised by the Texas Tech Sports Network with **Brian Jensen** and **John Harris** calling the action. It will be carried by the Sooner Sports Network (KAUT Ch. 43 in OKC; Cox Channel 3 in Tulsa), FS Oklahoma and ESPN Full Court.

SOONER STORYLINES

- ▶ Oklahoma holds a 31-19 all-time advantage over Texas Tech but trails 12-10 in Lubbock. The Sooners have won seven of the last 10 overall meetings, but have lost six of the last 10 in Lubbock, including each of the last two.
- ▶ A win Saturday would be the Sooners' second on the road in Big 12 play this season, more than they totaled the last two seasons combined (won last year at lowa State). Also, a victory would be OU's 14th of the year, matching last season's total and surpassing the previous year's 13 wins.

▶ In the first OU-Texas Tech meeting Jan. 17 in Norman, the Sooners posted a 64-55 win despite shooting just .389 from the field and going 1-for-11 (.091) from 3-point range. OU held the Red Raiders to .326 field goal shooting and outscored them 22-7 off turnovers.

- ➤ The junior trio **Steven Pledger**, **Andrew Fitzgerald** and **Romero Osby** has accounted for 69 percent of the team's points in Big 12 play (500 of 724) and 50 percent of its rebounds (166 of 334).
- ▶ OU is the only school in the Big 12 with three players ranked in the top 15 in scoring in league play. Pledger averages 16.8 points a game (ranks seventh) and is followed by Fitzgerald (14.6; ranks 11th) and Osby (14.0; 14th).
- ▶ 0U has been held to an average of 3.7 3-point makes in Big 12 play and Pledger has 31 of the team's 41 conversions (76 percent). The players with the next two highest percentages of their team's 3-pointers in conference play are Texas' **J'Covan Brown** (48 percent) and Oklahoma State's **Keiton Page** (46 percent). OU's Big 12 opponents have made more than twice as many 3-pointers (85) as the Sooners.
- ► Seven of OU's first 11 conference contests were played against ranked opponents. Only one of the Sooners' final seven league games is against a team currently ranked in the top 25 (Feb. 25 at Baylor).
- ▶ In OU's wins, Pledger is averaging 20.8 points on .578 field goal shooting. In the team's losses, he is averaging 14.2 points on .374 shooting.
- ▶ The Sooners have scored at least 75 points 10 times in their 23 games after doing it seven times in their 32 contests last year.
- ▶ Rebounding was a major strength for OU in non-conference play. The Sooners finished

that portion of their schedule with a +10.4 average rebounding margin. They have been outboarded in six of their 11 league games, however, and own a -1.6 average margin in those 11. OU boasts a 322-254 offensive rebounding advantage on the year.

PLEDGER AMONG BIG 12'S OFFENSIVE LEADERS

- ▶ After averaging 8.6 points and shooting .386 from the field and .345 from 3-point range over his first two seasons, junior quard **Steven Pledger** is averaging 17.8 points this year while shooting .482 from the field and .456 from long distance. Pledger leads the Big 12 in 3-pointers per game (2.8) and ranks third in 3-point field goal percentage, fourth in free throw percentage (.861) and seventh in field goal percentage.
- ▶ Pledger, the Dec. 19 and Jan. 30 Big 12 Player of the Week, has scored in double figures in 21 of his 22 outings (held to nine Jan. 9 at OSU). He has scored at least 20 points seven times after doing it three times all of last year, and has netted at least 15 points on eight other occasions.
- ▶ Pledger has already made 22 more field goals (134) in 22 games this year than he did in 32 games last season (112). He has played 271 fewer minutes this season than last.
- ▶ Pledger needs just 73 points to become the 38th player in OU history to score 1,000 in a career. Only 28 players in school history reached 1,000 points prior to their fourth playing year. He already ranks seventh at OU in career 3-point makes with 168. He needs one trey to tie Mookie Blaylock (1988-89) for sixth and two to tie Ryan Minor (1993-96) for fifth.

MORE INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- ▶ Junior point guard Sam Grooms leads the Big 12 (ranks in top 10 nationally) in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.1) and ranks second in the league in assists (5.9 apg). He has recorded two or fewer turnovers 16 times in 23 games, including in each of the last seven outings. During the current seven-game stretch, Grooms has 50 assists against just nine turnovers (5.6 ratio). Only one Sooner in the last 15 years averaged more assists for an entire season than Grooms' current 5.9 average (6.9 by Terrell Everett in 2005-06).
- ▶ Junior forward Andrew Fitzgerald has scored in double figures in 17 of the last 18 games and is averaging 14.8 points on .511 shooting over those 18 outings (he averaged just 8.4 points on .400 shooting over the season's first five games). He has scored at least 17 points in six of the last 14 contests, including a career-high 27 points this past Saturday against lowa State. Fitzgerald has committed at least four fouls in six of the last 10 games.
- ▶ Junior forward Romero Osby leads the Big 12 with his 3.0 offensive rebounds per game and ranks third with his 7.7 overall boards per outing. He also ranks third with six double-doubles. He has recorded at least 10 rebounds on eight occasions this year (his career high entering the season was eight rebounds). Osby, who pulled down a career-high 18 boards vs. South Carolina State on Dec. 21, is averaging 15.4 points over the last nine games on .505 shooting. He has scored at least 15 points in seven of the last nine outings, including a career-high 19 points against No. 8 Kansas three games ago. His scoring surge can be partially attributed to his ability to get to the free throw line. He has 56 free throw attempts over the last nine games (6.2 average), more than twice as many as the next highest total on the team during the span (26 attempts by **Andrew Fitzgerald** and **Steven Pledger**).
- ▶ Sophomore guard **Cameron Clark** returned to the starting lineup five games ago against Baylor after coming off the bench the previous three games (the only non-starts of his career). Clark, who has been held to single-digit scoring 11 times in the last 14 games after scoring at least 10 points in six of the previous seven outings, is averaging 7.7 points on .381 shooting this year. Last season, he averaged 9.3 points on .474 shooting. All five of his 3-point makes this year came in back-to-back December games.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- ▶ OU ranks second in the Big 12 and 44th nationally in rebounds per game (37.7). It also ranks No. 2 in the league and No. 24 nationally with its 14.0 offensive rebounds per game, and No. 3 in the conference in offensive rebounding percentage at .389. The tallest Sooner in the starting lineup is 6-8.
- ▶ The Sooners have been outrebounded just seven times in 23 games, but six of those occasions have taken place in 11 Big 12 games.
- ▶ Oklahoma's top two rebounding totals of the 16-year Big 12 era have been recorded this year (63 vs. South Carolina State and 61 vs. Coppin State). They are the two highest totals among Big 12 teams on the season.
- ▶ The Sooners are averaging 5.5 more offensive rebounds per game this year than they did last season (14.0 to 8.5).

PREVIEWING TEXAS TECH

- ▶ Under the first-year direction of former UTEP, Texas A&M and Kentucky head coach Billy Gillispie, Texas Tech is the only Big 12 team with a losing record this season (7-16). The Red Raiders went 7-5 in non-conference play but are 0-11 in Big 12 action. Tech has lost each of its five conference home games by double digits. Its average margin of defeat in Big 12 home games (22.2 points) is actually 9.0 points higher than its average margin of defeat in league road games (13.2).
- ▶ In conference play, Texas Tech ranks last in scoring (53.5 ppg), last in field goal percentage (.377), seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (.336) and sixth in free throw percentage (.700).
- ▶ Freshman forward Jordan Tolbert leads the team in scoring (13.5 ppg), rebounding (6.1 rpg) and field goal percentage (.541). His 98 field goals are 30 more than the Red Raider with the second highest total. Tolbert, who has five performances of at least 20 points on the year and averaged 24.3 during a four-game December stretch, is averaging 8.0 points on .362 shooting in Big 12 play.
- ▶ Junior guard **Ty Nurse** ranks second on the team with his 8.7 points per game. He was held to two points Tuesday at Kansas State but averaged 14.3 points over the three previous outings. Nurse leads the squad with his 31 treys and is shooting .365 from behind the

- ▶ Sophomore guard **Javarez Willis** averages 8.0 points and 2.1 assists per outing, but has been held scoreless in each of the last two outings (both starts) in a total of 20 minutes of playing time (0-for-4 shooting).
- ▶ Gillispie is in his eighth year as a collegiate head coach and owns a 147-101 career record.

OU-TEXAS TECH SERIES HISTORY

Oklahoma owns a 31-19 series lead over Texas Tech and has won seven of the last 10 meetings. However, OU is 10-12 against the Red Raiders in Lubbock and has lost six of the last 10 meetings there, including each of the last two. Since the start of the Big 12 in 1996-97, OU is 22-11 against Texas Tech (9-6 in Lubbock). The Sooners posted a 4-2 record against Texas Tech head coach **Billy Gillispie** while he was head coach at Texas A&M.

JAN. 17 VS. THE RED RAIDERS (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 13 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ Oklahoma survived .389 field goal shooting and a 1-for-11 performance from 3-point range in a 64-55 home win over Texas Tech on Jan. 17. OU's field goal performance was its worst in victory since the season opener (shot .365 in win over Idaho State).
- ▶ Ahead 48-47, the Sooners outscored Texas Tech 16-8 over the final 3:30 to seal the win. They held the Red Raiders to .326 field goal shooting, the second worst mark by Tech on the year and the second worst by an OU opponent.
- ▶ Oklahoma forced 21 Texas Tech turnovers (15 in the first half) and outscored the Red Raiders 22-7 off turnovers.
- ▶ Junior forward **Romero Osby** went 7-for-8 from the foul line in the final 1:09 and finished with 15 points, a team-high eight rebounds and a career-high five blocked shots.
- ▶ Junior guard **Steven Pledger** scored a game-high 17 points thanks to 5-for-7 shooting from 2-point range and a 4-for-4 effort at the free throw line. He struggled from 3-point distance, going 1-for-6.
- ▶ Junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** netted 13 points and added four rebounds before fouling out.
- ► Texas Tech's **Javarez Willis** scored a team-high 16 points on 5-for-9 field goal and 4-for-6 3-point shooting while **Jaye Crockett** came off the bench to record 14 points and 10 boards in 21 minutes.

MONDAY'S MISSOURI RECAP (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 12 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ After losing by 38 to Missouri on Jan. 3 in the Big 12 opener for both teams, the Sooners dropped a 71-68 home contest to the fourth-ranked Tigers on Monday. **Steven Pledger's** potential game-tying 3-pointer was just off the mark at the buzzer.
- ▶ The Sooners led much of the first half (by as many 6 at 29-23) before falling behind by three at the break, 36-33. Missouri ballooned its lead to 10 (50-40) and held on as 0U crawled to within two points on multiple occasions, including with 1:30 to go.
- ▶ Oklahoma entered the game with a .746 free throw mark (.767 in Big 12 play) but went just 9-for-23 (.391). Its previous season low (at least 10 attempts) was .611 against Washington State in the third game of the year. OU missed its first eight attempts Monday.
- ▶ 0U went 7-for-12 (.583) from 3-point range, its most conversions in 15 games (went 8-for-16 Dec. 10 against Arkansas).
- ▶ Junior guard **Sam Grooms** scored a career-high 17 points (previous high was 12) and tied a career best with 10 assists while committing just two turnovers in 38 minutes. Grooms, who entered the game shooting .324 from the field, was 7-for-9 from the floor.
- ▶ Pledger scored a team-high 22 points on 8-for-14 field goal and 5-for-9 3-point shooting. It was his seventh game of at least 20 points this year and his five treys set an OU season high. Pledger was just 1-for-4 from the free throw line after entering the game with a .897 season mark (ranked eighth nationally). He had made 44 of his previous 46 attempts (27-for-28 in Big 12 play).

UP NEXT

Oklahoma returns home to host Texas on Tuesday at 7 p.m. The game will be televised by the Big 12 Network.

QUANTIFYING OU'S BASKETBALL TRADITION

- ▶ This is the 105th season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ OU owns a 1,538-988 (.609) all-time record, ranking it 30th in NCAA Division I history in wins and 41st in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ OU has made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. It has made 22 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 29 years.
- ▶ Oklahoma has made 27 postseason appearances over the last 30 years (22 NCAA Tournaments and five NITs).
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 Big 12 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and the eighth best (.738) in the 2000s.
- ▶ Twenty different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 30 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim nine times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ **Wayman Tisdale** was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 73 times.
- ► The Sooners own a winning record against eight of the other nine members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).

1 SAM GROOMS (6-1, 203, JUNIOR, GUARD)

- ▶ Point guard who is averaging 6.5 points, 3.0 boards and 5.9 assists in 31.3 minutes a contest.
- ▶ Ranks second in Big 12 in assists and first (top 10 nationally) in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.1).
- ▶ Has 50 assists and just 9 turnovers over the last seven games (5.6 ratio).
- ▶ Has recorded two or fewer turnovers 16 times in 23 games (each of last seven outings).
- ▶ Point guard who transferred from Chipola College in Florida.
- ▶ Rated as nation's third-best junior college player in 2010-11 by JucoRecruiting.com.
- ▶ Started 50 games in his two seasons at Chipola (averaged 11.1 points, 5.9 assists last year).

2 STEVEN PLEDGER (6-4, 222, JUNIOR, GUARD)

- ▶ Dec. 19 and Jan. 30 Big 12 Player of the Week.
- ▶ Averaging 17.8 points (ranks No. 4 Big 12), 4.0 rebounds and 1.6 assists in 32.7 minutes.
- ▶ Ranks third in Big 12 with his .456 3-point percentage and first with his 2.8 treys/game.
- ▶ Has drained at least three 3-pointers in 15 of his 22 games.
- ▶ Had made 44 of his last 46 FT attempts (.957) before going 1-for-4 vs. Missouri on Monday.
- ▶ Averaging 20.8 points in team's wins and 14.2 in losses.
