

Head Coach Lon Kruger

- ► Lon Kruger was named Oklahoma's 14th head men's basketball coach on April 1, 2011.
- ▶ Owns a 492-316 (.609) collegiate record over 25 years.
- ► Has coached at Texas-Pan American (52-59 record from 1982-86), Kansas State (81-46 from 1986-90), Florida (104-80 from 1990-96), Illinois (81-48 from 1996-00) and UNLV (161-71 from 2004-11).
- ▶ Served as head coach of NBA's Atlanta Hawks from 2000-03 (69-122 record) and was an assistant for New York Knicks (2003-04 season).
- Averaged 25.4 wins at UNLV over the last five years (four NCAA appearances and one NIT trip) and won at least 21 games each of those five seasons.
- ► Coached UNLV to a 55-25 (.688) Mountain West Conference record the last five seasons.
- ▶ Has taken teams to 13 NCAA Tournaments (14-13 record) and four NITs (4-5 record).
- ▶ Coached Florida to the 1994 Final Four, Kansas State to the 1988 Elite Eight and UNLV to the 2007 Sweet 16.
- ▶ Has led all five of the college programs he has coached to 20-win seasons.
- ▶ Is one of five coaches in Division I college basketball history to take four different schools to the NCAA Tournament and is one of three coaches to win an NCAA Tournament game at four schools.
- ▶ Is one of just two head coaches in Division I history to lead at least four different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament wins.
- ▶ Is one of four coaches to lead three different schools to NCAA Sweet 16 appearances.

SATURDAY'S GAME BASICS

Looking to snap a five-game losing streak, Oklahoma (13-12,3-10) goes back to the site of last year's lone road win when it plays at lowa State (18-8,8-5) on Saturday at 12:30 p.m. CT. The Sooners, coming off a 69-58 home loss to Texas on Tuesday, are 1-6 in true road games this season. The Cyclones have lost two of their last three outings after winning five of their previous six. They are 13-2 at home on the year. Saturday's contest will air on the Sooner Radio Network (KOKC AM 1520 in Oklahoma City; KTBZ AM 1430 in Tulsa) with **Toby Rowland** and **Mike Houck** announcing. The game will be televised by the Big 12 Network (KOCB Ch. 34 in OKC; KTUL Ch. 8 in Tulsa; ESPN Full Court) with **Chad McKee** and **Rich Zvosec** calling the action.

SOONER STORYLINES

- ▶ Oklahoma holds a 110-78 all-time advantage over lowa State and is 37-45 against the Cyclones in Ames. The Sooners have won five of the last six overall meetings and each of the last two at Hilton Coliseum.
- ▶ lowa State posted a 77-70 win over 0U in Norman on Feb. 4 with the help of 15-for-30 3-point shooting. The Cyclones' 15 treys were an 0U opponent record.
- Last year in Ames, OU's **Steven Pledger** scored 12 of his career-high 38 points in overtime and led the Sooners to an 82-76 win (their only road win of the season). He was 7-for-13 from 3-point range and scored 17 of the Sooners' final 21 points. The 38 points were fifth most by a guard in OU history.

▶ A win Saturday would be the Sooners' 14th this season, matching last season's total and surpassing the previous year's 13 victories.

▶ In its three Big 12 wins, Oklahoma has held opponents to .379 field goal shooting. In OU's 10 Big 12 losses, opponents are shooting .494 from the field.

▶ The junior trio of Pledger, **Andrew Fitzgerald** and **Romero Osby** has accounted for 68 percent of the team's points in Big 12 play (564 of 829) and 49 percent of its rebounds (193 of 395).

▶ 0U is the only school in the Big 12 with three players ranked in the top 15 in scoring in league play. Pledger averages 15.9 points a game (ranks seventh) and is followed by Fitzgerald (13.9; ranks 11th) and 0sby (13.5; 14th).

▶ OU has been held to an average of 3.7 3-point makes in Big 12 play (ranks last in league) and Pledger has 33 of the team's 48 conversions (69 percent).

OU's Big 12 opponents have made twice as many 3-pointers (95) as the Sooners. lowa State averages a league-high 8.8 treys per Big 12 game.

▶ In OU's wins, Pledger is averaging 20.8 points on .578 field goal shooting. In the team's losses, he is averaging 13.7 points on .376 shooting. Last year he averaged 15.4 points in wins and 7.4 points in defeat.

▶ Rebounding was a major strength for Oklahoma in non-conference play. The Sooners finished that portion of their schedule with a +10.4 average rebounding margin. They have been outboarded in seven of their 13 league games, however, and own a -1.4 average margin in those 13. OU boasts a 347-275 offensive rebounding advantage on the year.

FITZGERALD, HONORÉ, NEAL EARN ACADEMIC ALL-BIG 12 HONORS

Forwards **Andrew Fitzgerald**, **Barry Honoré** and **Tyler Neal** were each named to the Academic All-Big 12 Men's Basketball Team on Thursday as members of the second team. They were among 20 league honorees (11 first-team, nine second-team). It was the first such honor for each of the three.

PLEDGER AMONG BIG 12'S OFFENSIVE LEADERS

- ▶ After averaging 8.6 points and shooting .386 from the field and .345 from 3-point range over his first two seasons, junior guard **Steven Pledger** is averaging 17.3 points this year while shooting .474 from the field and .432 from long distance. Pledger ranks second in the Big 12 in 3-pointers per game (2.7), fourth in 3-point field goal percentage, fourth in scoring, fifth in free throw percentage (.849) and seventh in field goal percentage.
- ▶ The Dec. 19 and Jan. 30 Big 12 Player of the Week, Pledger has scored in double figures in 22 of his 24 outings. He has scored at least 20 points seven times after doing it three times all of last year, and has netted at least 15 points on nine other occasions.
- ▶ Pledger has already made 32 more field goals (144) in 24 games this year than he did in 32 games last season (112). He has played 204 fewer minutes this season than last.
- ▶ Pledger needs just 51 points to become the 38th player in 0U history to score 1,000 in a career. Only 28 players in school history reached 1,000 points prior to their fourth playing year. He already ranks fifth (tied with **Ryan Minor**) at 0U in career 3-point makes with 170.

MORE INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- ▶ Junior point guard **Sam Grooms** leads the Big 12 in assists (6.2 apg) and assist-to-turnover ratio (3.1; ranks fourth nationally). He has been on a tear of late, averaging 8.0 assists and just 1.6 turnovers (4.9 ratio) over the last eight games. He has recorded at least six assists and no more than three turnovers in all eight of those outings. Grooms, who scored a career-high 17 points against Missouri three games ago, has registered two or fewer turnovers 17 times in 25 games, including eight of the last nine outings. Only one Sooner in the last 15 years averaged more assists for an entire season than Grooms' current 6.2 average (6.9 by **Terrell Everett** in 2005-06).
- ▶ Junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** has scored in double figures in 18 of the last 20 games and is averaging 14.3 points on .504 shooting over those 20 outings (he averaged just 8.4 points on .400 shooting over the season's first five games). He poured in a careerhigh 27 points Feb. 4 against lowa State when he drained a career-high 11 field goals on 19 attempts. Fitzgerald ranks second on the team in rebounds per game (4.7) and has almost as many offensive boards (58) as defensive (59).
- ▶ Junior forward **Romero Osby** leads the Big 12 with his 3.0 offensive rebounds per game and ranks fourth with his 7.6 overall boards per outing. He also ranks third with six double-doubles. He has recorded at least 10 rebounds on eight occasions this year (his career high entering the season was eight rebounds). Osby, who pulled down a career-high 18 boards vs. South Carolina State on Dec. 21, is averaging 14.6 points over the last 11 games on .491 shooting. He has scored at least 15 points in seven of the last 11 outings, including a career-high 19 points at No. 8 Kansas on Feb. 1. His scoring surge can be partially attributed to his ability to get to the free throw line. Osby has 68 free throw attempts over the last 11 games (6.2 average), more than twice as many as the next highest total on the team during the span (27 attempts by **Steven Pledger**).
- ▶ Sophomore guard **Cameron Clark** had his best offensive performance in Big 12 play Tuesday against Texas, registering 13 points (his most in 16 games) on 6-for-9 shooting. He also led the team with seven rebounds. Clark, who has started 54 of his 57 career games, had been held to single-digit scoring 12 times in 15 games prior to Tuesday's performance. He is averaging 7.8 points on .393 shooting this season after averaging 9.3 points on .474 shooting last year.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- ▶ Oklahoma ranks second in the Big 12 and 44th nationally in rebounds per game (37.5). It also ranks No. 2 in the league and No. 26 nationally with its 13.9 offensive rebounds per game, and No. 3 in the conference in offensive rebounding percentage at .384. The tallest Sooner in the starting lineup is 6-8.
- ▶ OU has been outrebounded just eight times in 25 games, but seven of those occasions have taken place in 13 Big 12 outings.
- ▶ Oklahoma's top two rebounding totals of the 16-year Big 12 era have been recorded this year (63 vs. South Carolina State and 61 vs. Coppin State). They are the two highest totals among Big 12 teams on the season.
- ▶ The Sooners are averaging 5.4 more offensive rebounds per game this year than they did last season (13.9 to 8.5).

PREVIEWING IOWA STATE

- ▶ After going 16-16 overall and 3-13 in the Big 12 last season, lowa State is off to an 18-8 start this year and is in fourth place in the league race with an 8-5 mark (one game behind Baylor and one game ahead of Texas). The Cyclones are 13-2 at home with their two defeats coming to Northern Iowa (69-62) and Missouri (76-69).
- ▶ One of the most dangerous 3-point shooting teams in the country, the Cyclones lead the Big 12 with their 8.8 treys per game. They are one of only two squads in the nation to have four players each with at least 40 makes from behind the arc.
- ▶ Sophomore forward **Royce White** is the only player in the nation to lead his team in points (13.2), rebounds (9.2), assists (4.8), blocks (1.1) and steals (1.2). The 6-8, 270-pound Minnesota transfer ranks second in the Big 12 with seven double-doubles, and recorded the fourth triple-double in school history with his 10 points, 18 rebounds and 10 assists Feb. 7 at Texas A&M.

Sam Grooms' Assists and Turnovers In Big 12 Play

- ▶ Senior guards **Chris Allen** (12.3) and **Scott Christopherson** (10.8) also average double figures in scoring. Allen, a transfer from Michigan State, has made 59 treys and is shooting .383 from long range (ranks second in Big 12 play with his .407 mark). He was held to three points Monday at Baylor after averaging 23.5 the previous two games against Oklahoma State and Texas A&M (was 11-for-18 from deep). Christopherson, a transfer from Marquette, has 42 3-point makes and is shooting .429 from behind the arc.
- ▶ Junior guard **Chris Babb**, another long-range threat, contributes 8.8 points per game. The Penn State transfer has a team-high 56 makes from 3-point range and is shooting .348 from deep. He is 4-for-17 (.235) from behind the arc over the last three games.
- ▶ **Fred Hoiberg** is in his second year as a collegiate head coach and owns a 34-24 record. He was a 1995 third-team All-American at lowa State and is the school's third-leading all-time scorer (1,993 points). The Ames native played 10 years in the NBA.

OU-IOWA STATE SERIES HISTORY

Oklahoma owns a 110-78 all-time series lead against lowa State and is 37-45 in games played in Ames. The Sooners have won five of the last six meetings over the Cyclones and nine of the last 12, including the last two in Ames and three of the last five there. OU is 12-6 against lowa State since the start of the Big 12 Conference (4-4 at Hilton Coliseum).

FEB. 4 VS. THE CYCLONES (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 13 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ lowa State hit an Oklahoma-opponent-record 15 3-pointers on 30 attempts and held on for a 77-70 road win Feb. 4, snapping the Sooners' five-game winning streak over the Cyclones. OU had won seven straight against ISU in Norman.
- ► Six Cyclones made at least one 3-pointer and five made at least two. **Chris Babb**, who was 5-for-28 from long distance over the previous six games, went 4-for-7.
- ▶ Oklahoma held just three leads in the game, each in the first half and each by one point. The Cyclones scored on their ensuing possession all three times to go back on top. After trailing by 10 (50-40), the Sooners rallied to tie the game at 56 with 7:49 remaining but were outscored 21-14 the rest of the way.
- ▶ Junior forwards **Andrew Fitzgerald** and **Romero Osby** teamed to score 44 of OU's 70 points on 17-for-28 (.607) shooting. Fitzgerald was 11-for-19 from the field and finished with a career-high 27 points (previous high was 22). Osby was 6-for-9 from the floor and tallied 17 points. It was his seventh performance of at least 15 points in the last eight outings.
- ▶ Sophomore guard Cameron Clark's 11 rebounds tied a career high and were his most since the first game of his collegiate career.
- ▶ Junior point guard **Sam Grooms** handed out nine assists (one shy of his career high) against just two turnovers.

TUESDAY'S TEXAS RECAP (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 12 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ Oklahoma led 33-28 at halftime but was outscored 41-25 after the break in a 69-58 home loss to Texas on Tuesday.
- ▶ 0U made four more field goals than the Longhorns (24-20), but was outscored by 19 at the free throw line. Texas was 24-for-29 at the charity stripe while 0U was 5-for-8.
- ▶ The Sooners were outscored 21-5 off turnovers. After committing just three turnovers in the first half that led to only two Texas points, OU racked up 10 turnovers after halftime that resulted in 19 points.
- ▶ Texas' .385 field goal percentage was the second worst against OU in Big 12 play this year and second worst by an opponent in victory the entire season.
- ▶ A .380 field goal shooter entering the game, guard **Cameron Clark** went 6-for-9 and finished with 13 points (his most in 16 games) and a team-high seven rebounds. Guard **Steven Pledger** netted 18 points while forward **Romero Osby** contributed 13. Point guard **Sam Grooms** was scoreless but tied a career high with 10 assists, and forward **Tyler Neal's** eight points were his most in Big 12 play.

UP NEXT

Oklahoma returns home to host Oklahoma State on Wednesday at 7 p.m. CT. The game will be televised by the Big 12 Network.

QUANTIFYING OU'S BASKETBALL TRADITION

- ▶ This is the 105th season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ 0U owns a 1,538-990 (.608) all-time record, ranking it 30th in NCAA Division I history in wins and 41st in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ 0U has made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. It has made 22 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 29 years.
- ▶ Oklahoma has made 27 postseason appearances over the last 30 years (22 NCAA Tournaments and five NITs).
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 Big 12 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and the eighth best (.738) in the 2000s.
- ▶ Twenty different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 30 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim nine times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ **Wayman Tisdale** was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 73 times.
- ► The Sooners own a winning record against eight of the other nine members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).

- ▶ The Dec. 19 and Jan. 30 Big 12 Player of the Week.
- Averaging 17.3 points (ranks No. 4 Big 12), 4.1 rebounds and 1.5 assists in 32.8 minutes.
- ▶ Ranks fourth in Big 12 with his .432 3-point percentage and second with his 2.7 treys/game.
