- ▶ Owns a 493-318 (.608) collegiate record over 25 years.
- ► Has coached at Texas-Pan American (52-59 record from 1982-86), Kansas State (81-46 from 1986-90), Florida (104-80 from 1990-96), Illinois (81-48 from 1996-00) and UNLV (161-71 from 2004-11).
- ► Served as head coach of NBA's Atlanta Hawks from 2000-03 (69-122 record) and was an assistant for New York Knicks (2003-04 season).
- Averaged 25.4 wins at UNLV over the last five years (four NCAA appearances and one NIT trip) and won at least 21 games each of those five seasons.
- ► Coached UNLV to a 55-25 (.688) Mountain West Conference record the last five seasons.
- ▶ Has taken teams to 13 NCAA Tournaments (14-13 record) and four NITs (4-5 record).

#### WEDNESDAY'S GAME BASICS

Playing its final Big 12 road game of the season, Oklahoma (14-14, 4-12) takes on Texas (18-11, 8-8) on Wednesday at 8 p.m. CT in Austin. The Sooners, coming off a 70-60 loss at Baylor on Saturday, are 1-7 in Big 12 road games (lone win at Kansas State). The Longhorns, who won 71-67 at Texas Tech in overtime on Saturday, are 5-3 in conference home games. Wednesday's contest will air on the Sooner Radio Network (KOKC AM 1520 in Oklahoma City; KTBZ AM 1430 in Tulsa; Sirius/XM 91) with **Toby Rowland** and **Mike Houck** announcing. The game will be televised by ESPN2 with **Jon Sciambi** and **Fran Fraschilla** calling the action.

### **SOONER STORYLINES**

- ▶ Oklahoma holds a 47-33 all-time advantage over Texas and is 16-17 against the Longhorns in Austin. However, the Sooners have lost each of the last six seasons there (66-46 last year).
- ▶ Texas posted a 69-58 win over 0U in Norman on Feb. 14. The Sooners led 33-28 at halftime but were outscored 41-25 after the break. The Longhorns went 24-for-29 from the free throw line while 0U went 5-for-8.
- ▶ A win Wednesday would be the OU's 15th this season, surpassing last year's 14.
- ▶ In its four Big 12 wins, Oklahoma has held opponents to .376 field goal shooting. In OU's 12 Big 12 losses, opponents are shooting .487 from the field.

▶ 0U has actually made more field goals than its opponent in five of its Big 12 losses, including in two of its last three defeats (24-20 vs. Texas and 23-21 at Baylor). In those five losses, the Sooners have been outscored by 66 points from 3-point range and by 39 points at the free throw line.

► The junior trio of **Steven Pledger, Andrew Fitzgerald** and **Romero Osby** has accounted for 64 percent of the team's points in Big 12 play (664 of 1,035) and 50 percent of its rebounds (252 of 504).

▶ Over the last three seasons, the Sooners are 2-22 in Big 12 road games. They beat Kansas State this year and Iowa State last season.

- ▶ After combining to average 7.8 points over 0U's first 12 conference games, the sophomore duo of **Cameron Clark** (13.8) and **Tyler Neal** (7.3) is averaging 21.1 points over the last four outings on combined .523 shooting.
- ▶ The Big 12's leader in assists (6.1 apg), junior **Sam Grooms** has led 0U in the category in each of the last 13 games and in 22 of 28 contests on the year.
- ▶ OU has been held to an average of 3.5 3-point makes in Big 12 play (ranks last in league) and Pledger has 36 of the team's 56 conversions (64 percent). OU's Big 12 opponents have made more than twice as many 3-pointers (127), for a difference of 213 points (13.3 per game).
- ▶ In OU's wins, Pledger is averaging 20.5 points on .587 field goal shooting. In the team's losses, he is averaging 13.7 points on .373 shooting. Last year he averaged 15.4 points in wins and 7.4 points in defeat.

year. Only two opponents in the last 12 games have outscored OU in second-chance points.

▶ The Sooners will be either the No. 8 or No. 9 seed in next week's Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship in Kansas City and will face Texas A&M in Wednesday's first round at 6 p.m. CT.

### **PLEDGER AMONG BIG 12'S OFFENSIVE LEADERS**

- ▶ After averaging 8.6 points and shooting .386 from the field and .345 from 3-point range over his first two seasons, junior guard **Steven Pledger** is averaging 17.0 points this year while shooting .471 from the field and .416 from long distance. Pledger ranks fourth in the Big 12 in scoring, fifth in field goal percentage and 3-pointers per game (2.5), sixth in 3-point field goal percentage and seventh in free throw percentage (.837).
- ▶ The Dec. 19 and Jan. 30 Big 12 Player of the Week, Pledger has scored in double figures in 24 of his 27 outings. He has scored at least 20 points eight times after doing it three times all of last year, and has netted at least 15 points on 10 other occasions.
- ▶ Pledger has already made 48 more field goals (160) in 27 games this year than he did in 32 games last season (112). He has played 103 fewer minutes this season than last.
- ▶ Pledger needs just six points to become the 38th player in 0U history to score 1,000 in a career. Only 28 players in school history reached 1,000 points prior to their fourth playing year. He already ranks sixth at 0U in career 3-point makes with 173.

### **MORE INDIVIDUAL NOTES**

- ▶ Sophomore guard **Cameron Clark** has had his four best offensive performances in Big
- 12 play the last four games, registering 13 points Feb. 14 vs. Texas, 16 points (his most in 19 games) Feb. 18 at lowa State, 14 points last Wednesday at Oklahoma State and 12 points Saturday at Baylor. Clark, who had been held to single-digit scoring in nine of OU's first 12 league games, is averaging 13.8 points on 25-for-43 (.581) shooting during the four-game stretch. He is also averaging 5.3 rebounds in those outings. A starter in 57 of his 60 career games, Clark is averaging 8.5 points on .417 shooting this season after averaging 9.3 points on .474 shooting last year.

- ▶ Junior point guard **Sam Grooms** leads the Big 12 in assists (6.1 apg) and assist-to-turnover ratio (3.1; ranks fourth nationally). No other player in the Big 12 owns an assist-to-turnover ratio greater than 2.5. Grooms has been on a tear of late, averaging 7.4 assists and just 1.8 turnovers (4.1 ratio) over the last 11 games. He has recorded at least five assists and no more than three turnovers in all 11 of those outings. Grooms, who has also scored in double figures three times over the last six games (he was held to single digits in his previous 10 games), has registered two or fewer turnovers 19 times in 28 contests, including 10 of the last 12 outings. Only one Sooner in the last 15 years averaged more assists for an entire season than Grooms' current 6.1 average (6.9 by **Terrell Everett** in 2005-06).
- ▶ Junior forward **Romero Osby** ranks second in the Big 12 with his 2.8 offensive rebounds per game and third with his 7.7 overall boards per outing. He also ranks third with seven double-doubles. He has recorded at least 10 rebounds on nine occasions this year (his career high entering the season was eight rebounds). Osby, who turned in a 16-point, 13-rebound effort against Oklahoma State last Wednesday, is averaging 14.4 points over the last 14 games and has scored at least nine points in all 14 (including a career-high 19 points at No. 8 Kansas on Feb. 1). His scoring surge can be partially attributed to his ability to get to the free throw line. Osby has 75 free throw attempts over the last 14 games (5.4 average), almost twice as many as the next highest total on the team during the span (40 attempts by **Steven Pledger**).
- ▶ Junior forward **Andrew Fitzgerald** has scored in double figures in 18 of the last 23 games but not in any of the last four. After averaging 14.7 points on .506 shooting over a 19-game stretch, he is averaging 5.8 points on .273 (9-for-33) shooting the last four outings against Texas, lowa State, Oklahoma State and Baylor. Fitzgerald, who poured in a career-high 27 points Feb. 4 against lowa State when he drained a career-high 11 field goals on 19 attempts, ranks second on the team in scoring (12.3 ppg) and rebounding (5.0 rpg). He has the same number of offensive boards (70) as defensive.

### **CLEANING THE GLASS**

- ▶ Oklahoma ranks second in the Big 12 and 42nd nationally in rebounds per game (37.5). It also ranks No. 2 in the league and No. 33 nationally with its 13.5 offensive rebounds per game, and No. 4 in the conference in offensive rebounding percentage at .370.
- ▶ OU has been outrebounded just nine times in 28 games (eight times in 16 Big 12 outings).
- ▶ Oklahoma's top two rebounding totals of the 16-year Big 12 era have been recorded this year (63 vs. South Carolina State and 61 vs. Coppin State). They are the two highest totals among Big 12 teams on the season.
- ▶ The Sooners are averaging 5.0 more offensive rebounds per game this year than they did last season (13.5 to 8.5).

### **PREVIEWING TEXAS**

- ▶ Tied with Kansas State for fifth place in the Big 12 at 8-8, Texas has won five of its last seven games after enduring a stretch of five losses in six contests. The Longhorns, 18-11 overall, are 5-3 in conference road games, with their losses coming to Kansas (69-66), Missouri (67-66) and Baylor (77-72). Eight of their 11 losses have come by six points or fewer, or in overtime.
- ▶ Texas is coming off a 71-67 overtime win at Texas Tech on Saturday, a game in which it turned 20 Red Raider turnovers into 23 points.
- ▶ In conference play, Texas ranks fifth in scoring (69.8 ppg), seventh in field goal percentage (.421), fifth in 3-point field goal percentage (.336) and fourth in free throw percentage (.742).
- ▶ Junior guard J'Covan Brown leads the Big 12 in scoring with his 19.5 season average. He has led the team in scoring 19 times in 29

games (nine times in the last 13 outings) and has tallied at least 20 points on a league-high 15 occasions. Brown has three games of at least 30 points this season, including a 34-point performance at Missouri when he went 6-for-7 from 3-point range.

- ▶ Freshman guard **Sheldon McClellan** ranks second on the team with his 11.2 points per contest. Coming off the bench in 22 of 29 games, he has made 26 treys (shooting .299) and 84 free throws (.757). He has scored in double figures in six of the last seven games.
- Freshman point guard **Myck Kabongo** averages 10.4 points per game and ranks fourth in the Big 12 with his 5.1 assists per outing. He leads the team with his 164 free throw attempts on the year and is averaging 14.4 points over the last five games.
- ▶ Senior center **Clint Chapman** averages 7.2 points and a team-high 5.3 rebounds per game. He is shooting .507 from the field and .805 from the free throw line, and is coming off a 12-point, 7-rebound performance at Texas Tech.
- ▶ Rick Barnes is in his 14th year as Texas' head coach and owns a 340-134 record there.

#### **OU-TEXAS SERIES HISTORY**

Oklahoma owns a 47-33 series lead against Texas despite losing each of the last five and 12 of the last 14 meetings. OU is 16-17 against the Longhorns in Austin but has lost the last six meetings there. Since the start of the Big 12 in 1996-97, OU is 18-20 against Texas (5-10 in Austin). UT won 66-46 last year at the Erwin Center.

#### FEB. 14 VS. THE LONGHORNS (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 13 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ Oklahoma led 33-28 at halftime but was outscored 41-25 after the break in a 69-58 home loss to Texas on Feb. 14.
- ▶ 0U made four more field goals than the Longhorns (24-20), but was outscored by 19 at the free throw line. Texas was 24-for-29 at the charity stripe while 0U was 5-for-8.
- ▶ The Sooners were outscored 21-5 off turnovers. After committing just three turnovers in the first half that led to only two Texas points, OU racked up 10 turnovers after halftime that resulted in 19 points.
- ► Texas' .385 field goal percentage was the second worst against OU in Big 12 play this year and second worst by an opponent in victory the entire season.
- ▶ A .380 field goal shooter entering the game, guard **Cameron Clark** went 6-for-9 and finished with 13 points (his most in 16 games) and a team-high seven rebounds. Guard **Steven Pledger** netted 18 points while forward **Romero Osby** contributed 13. Point guard **Sam Grooms** was scoreless but tied a career high with 10 assists, and forward **Tyler Neal's** eight points were his most in Big 12 play.

### SATURDAY'S BAYLOR RECAP (BOX SCORE ON PAGE 12 OF THESE NOTES)

- ▶ Oklahoma led 34-31 at halftime at No. 13/14 Baylor and was down by just one (49-48) with nine minutes left, but was outscored 21-12 down the stretch in a 70-60 road loss Saturday.
- ▶ The Sooners lost despite holding Baylor to .389 field goal shooting and outrebounding the Bears 37-36.
- ▶ Baylor finished with a 24-point advantage from 3-point range. It went 8-for-23 from behind the arc while 0U was 0-for-12. It marked the first time in 511 games (Dec. 23, 2006, at Memphis) that the Sooners went without a 3-point make.
- ▶ The Sooners led for the majority of the first half. Baylor didn't take the lead for good until **Pierre Jackson's** 3-pointer with 10:48 remaining made the score 49-46.
- ▶ Guard **Steven Pledger** scored a game-high 21 points on 8-for-17 shooting. He was 0-for-5 from 3-point range but 8-for-12 from inside the arc. He also made all five of his free throw attempts after going 6-for-13 over the five previous games.

#### **UP NEXT**

OU closes the regular season at home against Texas A&M on Saturday at 3 p.m. CT. The game will be televised by the Big 12 Network. It will be the last home game for seniors **T.J. Franklin, Barry Honoré** and **C.J. Washington**.

### **QUANTIFYING OU'S BASKETBALL TRADITION**

- ▶ This is the 105th season of Oklahoma varsity basketball (the program's first game was Nov. 26, 1907).
- ▶ 0U owns a 1,539-992 (.608) all-time record, ranking it 30th in NCAA Division I history in wins and 41st in winning percentage.
- ▶ Oklahoma has participated in four NCAA Final Fours (1939, 1947, 1988 and 2002) and in two NCAA championship games (it lost to Holy Cross in 1947 and to Kansas in 1988).
- ▶ 0U has made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven postseason NIT showings. It has made 22 NCAA Tournament appearances over the last 29 years.
- ▶ Oklahoma has made 27 postseason appearances over the last 30 years (22 NCAA Tournaments and five NITs).
- ▶ The Sooners have won 14 regular season conference championships (most recently in 2005) and seven conference tournament titles (including the 2001, 2002 and 2003 Big 12 crowns).
- ▶ The Sooners posted the eighth best NCAA Division I winning percentage (.731) in the 1980s and the eighth best (.738) in the 2000s.
- ▶ Twenty different Sooners have earned All-America honors a total of 30 times. They have earned consensus first-team All-America acclaim nine times and consensus second-team honors on four occasions.
- ▶ **Wayman Tisdale** was a three-time consensus first-team All-American during his three seasons at OU (1983-85).
- ▶ Oklahoma players have earned first-team all-conference accolades a total of 73 times.
- ► The Sooners own a winning record against eight of the other nine members of the Big 12 Conference (Kansas is the only league program with a series lead against OU).
- ▶ OU has played its home games in four different venues: the OU Gymnasium (1907-1919), the R.O.T.C. Armory (1919-1928), the OU Field House (1928-75) and Lloyd Noble Center (1975-present).
