**Recap**

**NORMAN, Okla.** – The No. 14 Oklahoma Sooners earned their first Sweet 16 appearance since 2010 on Saturday afternoon, downing the North Carolina State Wolfpack by a score of 4-0 in the second round of the 2013 NCAA Men's Tennis Championship.

OU used a fast start on the doubles courts to take an early 1-0 lead over the Wolfpack. Guillermo Alcorta and Axel Alvarez Llamas claimed an 8-1 victory at the No. 2 position, and the No. 1 pairing of Costin Paval and Dane Webb followed with an 8-3 decision to clinch the point for the Sooners.

Paced by the middle of Head Coach John Roddick's singles lineup, Oklahoma rattled off three wins in quick succession to secure their victory. Axel Alvarez Llamas boosted the Sooners' lead to 2-0 with a 6-2, 6-1 win at the No. 3 position, and Guillermo Alcorta followed with his 6-4, 6-1 victory on the No. 2 courts.

For the second time on the afternoon, Dane Webb stepped forward to secure victory for the Sooners. Webb locked up OU's sweep with his 6-4, 6-0 effort at the No. 4 position.

Oklahoma's victory will send the Sooners to their second Sweet 16 appearance under Roddick. OU will take on the No. 3 seed Georgia Bulldogs at the Khan Tennis Complex in Urbana, Ill. The match will take place on Thursday, May 16 at 9 a.m. CT.
