First Pitch... A five-game homestand to open the 2014 season continues for the Oklahoma baseball team with contests against Arkansas Pine Bluff Tuesday and Wednesday at 3:00 pm.

About the Sooners... Oklahoma is 2-1 following its season-opening series against Seton Hall. As a team, the Sooners hits .297 and totaled 28 runs to the Pirates 15. Redshirt-junior right fielder **Taylor Alspaugh** leads the way early on with a .455 (5-for-11) batting average to go with three runs, three RBI and a triple. Sophomore catcher **Anthony Hermelyn** is close behind at .417 (5-for-12) with four runs, three RBI and his first career home run. The OU pitching staff owns a 3.81 earned run average as a unit and struck out 21 batters in 26 innings of work.

On the Air... The voice of the Sooners Toby Rowland returns for the 2014 season to provide play-by-play on KREF Sports Talk 1400. Joining him on the sidelines will be color commentator Chris Plank.

Weekend Recap... Following an opening day loss to Seton Hall, 7-5 on Friday, Oklahoma reeled off wins of 8-2 and 15-6 to take the series. Hermelyn's first career home run came on the heels of freshman third baseman **Sheldon Neuse's** first career homer in the seventh inning of Saturday's contest. Neuse's was a three-run shot as the Sooners put up five runs in the inning. It marked the first time OU players hit back-to-back home runs since **Cody Reine** and **Chris Ellison** did so against Oklahoma State on May 7, 2010. In the finale, Oklahoma totaled 18 hits in a rout of SHU. Junior catcher **Mac James** led the way with a four-hit day, while sophomore left fielder **Hunter Haley** added a three-run jack.

Scouting the Golden Lions... Arkansas Pine Bluff comes to Norman with a 0-4 record after getting swept at Tulane over the weekend. Junior outfielder **Andre Davis** hit an impressive .545 (6-for-11) on the weekend. Junior infielder **Joshua Cassidy** drove in two runs and hit .250. UAPB's staff owns a 6.00 ERA and anchored by its pen, which had three pitchers throw at least one shut-out inning. Senior LHP **Jim Ploeger** made two appearances and owns a 2.70 ERA in 3.1 innings.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

All-Time vs. UAPB... Oklahoma is 12-0 all-time against Arkansas Pine Bluff in a series that dates back to 2005. The Sooners won that first meeting 21-8 and have scored 20 or more runs on three occasions. The two teams have squared off twice per season since 2010.

Last Time They Met.. OU took both ends of a mid-week doubleheader on February 19, 2013 by scores of 2-4 and 11-1. Game two ended after just eight innings. **Hector Lorenzana** went 3-for-3 with two doubles, while **Matt Oberste** crushed a three-run home run and went 2-for-4. Right-hander **Drew Krittenbrink** lasted four innings in a no-decision start, surrendering just two hits and striking out four.

Opening the Gates... Oklahoma's season-opening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Who's on First?... In the first weekend of action, the Sooners started three different first basemen. Freshman **Niko Buentello** made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. Junior utility man **Keach Ballard** appeared at first in game two and Hermelyn, who started 48 games at catcher in 2013, made his first collegiate start at first on Sunday. Freshman **Austin O'Brien** is waiting in the wings for a shot at first after making two pinch-hit appearances.

Crooked Numbers... Through the first three games, Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning eight times and three or more six times. In game two against Seton Hall, the Sooners set a season-high with five runs scored in the seventh.

Up Next... Oklahoma hits the road this weekend for three games at the UCF Tournament in Orlando, Fla. The action gets underway Friday morning against Citadel.

Defending Big 12 Champs... The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman **Hector Lorenzana** is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

WEEKLY AWARDS

Big 12

Freshman All-America Trio... Oklahoma's core is built around a trifecta of Freshman All-Americans from 2013 in left-hander **Jacob Evans**, catcher **Anthony Hermelyn** and center fielder **Craig Aikin**. Evans took the hill primarily as the Sooner closer as a rookie and notched nine saves along with seven wins with a 2.06 earned run average. Hermelyn hit .275 with 26 RBI, while Aikin owns the highest returning average at .286 with 42 runs and a team-leading 16 stolen bases.

New Man on the Top Step... Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

Season Openers... Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Opening Day Starter... Sophomore lefty **Jacob Evans** made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since **Zach Neal** in 2010. Evans is also the third straight lefty to start on opening day, following **Dillon Overton** in 2012 and 2013.

In the Polls... Oklahoma enters 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the *USA Today*/ESPN Coaches' Poll, landing three spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches.

Super Regional... The Sooners last took the field for the NCAA Baton Rouge Super Regional against LSU. After losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel in game one, Oklahoma was eliminated by the Tigers, 11-1 in game two. Right-hander **Jonathan Gray** tossed 7.1 innings and allowed just two runs, while striking out nine as OU went down in the opener.

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 7-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 3-2, 11-inning win over TCU last season. OU has won three of its last four conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

TW(OU)B History... In 2010, the Sooners road to Omaha got off to a 4-0 start with a road sweep at San Diego State. Oklahoma outscored the Aztecs, 38-16 for the weekend, highlighted by a 17-5 victory in game two. In that game, **Tyler Ogle** came off the bench to hit a grand slam in the ninth inning. **Caleb Bushyhead** and **Ross Hubbard** each contributed three RBI in the win.

Preseason Poll... Oklahoma landed fifth in the 2014 Big 12 Preseason Poll as voted on by the league's coaches. The Sooners received 37 points in the poll. The top five spots were separated by only six points. Defending regular season champion Kansas State (56) took the top spot, followed by Oklahoma State (51), TCU (51) and Texas (50).

MLB Draft Picks... Six Sooners were taken in the 2013 MLB First Year Player Draft, led by right-hander **Jonathan Gray** being selected overall by the Colorado Rockies, matching the program's highest draft pick with **Bobby Witt** (Texas, 1985). Left-hander **Dillon Overton** was drafted 63rd overall in the second round by the Oakland Athletics and first baseman **Matt Oberste** went 206th to the New York Mets in the seventh round.

Later Round Lefties... Three left-handed pitchers were taken in the MLB Draft, beginning with **Billy Waltrip** (12, 349) to the Rockies. **Ethan Carnes** (21, 644) went to the New York Yankees, while **Jake Fisher** (22, 664)

rounded out the draft class by going to the Los Angeles Dodgers.

Big 12 Tournament... The 2014 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship will be held at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City, May 21-25.

On the Hill... The OU pitching staff looks to replace nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. The eight pitchers that remain from over a year ago combined to post a 17-7 record and a 3.31 collective ERA.

New Faces in the Dugout... Coach Hughes brings to Norman a completely new coaching staff, which includes two assistants with Division I head coaching experience. Former Nebraska head coach, **Mike Anderson** brings Omaha-level experience as the hitting coach, while former Bryant and William & Mary skipper **Jamie Pinzino** takes over as the pitching coach after reaching a NCAA Regional final in 2013. **Ryan Connolly** joins the staff as the volunteer assistant after a one-year stint as an assistant at Radford. Coordinator of baseball operations **Ryan Gaines** is the lone holdover from last season's staff.

All-Big 12 Returners... The Sooners lost both First Team honorees to the MLB Draft in Gray and Oberste. Sophomores **Craig Aikin** and **Jacob Evans** both earned spots on the Second Team and Freshman Team, while fellow classmates **Anthony Hermelyn**, who was also named Honorable Mention, and **Ralph Garza Jr.** were placed on the Freshman Team.

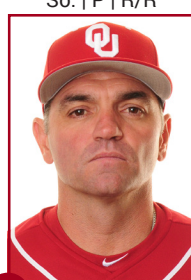
