First Pitch... The Oklahoma baseball team hits the road for the first time in the 2014 season for the UCF Tournament in Orlando, Fla. this weekend. The action gets underway when the Sooners face Citadel on Friday at 11:00 am. OU then plays the host Golden Knights on Saturday at 5:00 pm and Ohio State on Sunday at 9:00 am.

About the Sooners... Oklahoma is 4-1 following its season-opening homestand. As a team, the Sooners are hitting .335 and outscoring opponents, 55-21. Junior catcher Mac James is hitting a team-high .533 (8-for-15) with six RBI, five runs and three RBI. Sophomore left fielder Hunter Haley is hitting .313 with a .875 slugging percentage with three home runs and a team-leading 10 RBI. Nine OU hitters are batting .300 or better with at least 10 at-bats. The Sooner pitching staff owns a 2.66 earned run average, led by a bullpen that has a combined 2.25 ERA. Sophomore left-hander Jacob Evans is expected to start on Friday night. He tossed a career-high 5.1 innings in his first career start in the season opener against Seton Hall.

On the Air... Oklahoma's sports information director Brendan Flynn will handle the play-by-play duties on SoonerSports.tv all weekend long.

Midweek Recap... The Sooners totaled 30 hits and 27 runs in a midweek sweep of Arkansas Pine Bluff by scores of 16-6 and 11-0. Haley homered twice and drove in a career-high six runs in the win on Tuesday. On Wednesday, seven OU pitchers combined for the shutout and totaled 11 strikeouts, while surrendering zero walks. Freshman infielder Sheldon Neuse combined to hit 4-for-6 with a home run, four RBI and three runs in the two games. James went 4-for-7 with four RBI, three runs and three doubles.

Scouting the Bulldogs... Citadel is 2-2 on the young season, opening with wins over Virginia Tech and No. 13 Louisville. Outfielder Hughston Armstrong is hitting a team-best .583 (7-for-12) with three runs and two RBI. The Bulldog hitters are hitting .270 as a unit. First baseman Bo Thompson has driven in a team-high four runs. Left-hander Logan Cribb is 0-0 in one start with a 4.76 ERA and seven strikeouts in 5.2 innings of work.

### **HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES**

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98)

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Golden Knights... UCF opened the season with three wins over Siena before falling to Florida on Tuesday night. Infielder **Dylan Moore** is batting .438 (7-for-16) with three runs, while fellow infielder Tommy Williams trails him at .412 (7-for-17) with two doubles, a home run and four RBI. Righty Spencer Davis owns a 1-0 record and 3.60 ERA with four strikeouts in five innings pitched.

Scouting the Buckeyes... Ohio State got off to a quick start with wins over Connecticut and Auburn but evened its record at 2-2 with a pair of losses to Indiana State. Outfielder Tim Wetzel is hitting .364 (4-for-11) with three doubles and three RBI. The Buckeyes are hitting just .235 as a team through their first four games. Left-hander Zach Farmer took the loss on Saturday and is 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA.

Opening the Gates... Oklahoma's seasonopening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Who's on First?... In the first week of action, the Sooners started three different first basemen. Freshman Niko Buentello made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. Junior utility man Keach Ballard appeared at first in game two and Hermelyn, who started 48 games at catcher in 2013, made his first collegiate start at first on Sunday. Freshman Austin O'Brien became the fourth Sooner at first base with a late-inning appearance against Arkansas Pine Bluff on February 18.

Crooked Numbers... Through the first five games, Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 14 times and three or more 11 times. In game one against Arkansas Pine Bluff, the Sooners set a season-high with seven runs in the first inning.

Up Next... Oklahoma is back on the road next weekend for a four-game tournament hosted by Arizona State in Surprise, Ariz. The Sooners first match-up will be against Manhattan on Thursday, February 27.

Return of the Mac... Junior Mac James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared in just nine games, earning nine at-bats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, he has started four games; two at

catcher, one at DH and his season-debut in left field. In his four appearances, James is hitting a team-high .533, slugging .733 and has driven in six runs, which ranks third on the team.

**Defending Big 12 Champs...** The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman **Hector Lorenzana** is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

Freshman All-America Trio... Oklahoma's core is built around a trifecta of Freshman All-Americans from 2013 in left-hander Jacob Evans, catcher Anthony Hermelyn and center fielder Craig Aikin. Evans took the hill primarily as the Sooner closer as a rookie and notched nine saves along with seven wins with a 2.06 earned run average. Hermelyn hit .275 with 26 RBI, while Aikin owns the highest returning average at .286 with 42 runs and a team-leading 16 stolen bases.

New Man on the Top Step... Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

**Season Openers...** Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale

Mitchell.

Opening Day Starter... Sophomore lefty Jacob Evans made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since Zach Neal in 2010. Evans is also the third straight lefty to start on opening day, following Dillon Overton in 2012 and 2013.

In the Polls... Oklahoma enters 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll, landing three spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches.

Super Regional... The Sooners last took the field for the NCAA Baton Rouge Super Regional against LSU. After losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel in game one, Oklahoma was eliminated by the Tigers, 11-1 in game two. Righthander Jonathan Gray tossed 7.1 innings and allowed just two runs, while striking out nine as OU went down in the opener.

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 7-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 3-2, 11-inning win over TCU last season. OU has won three of its last four conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

Preseason Poll... Oklahoma landed fifth in the 2014 Big 12 Preseason Poll as voted on by the league's coaches. The Sooners received 37 points in the poll. The top five spots were separated by only six points. Defending regular season champion Kansas State (56) took the top spot, followed by Oklahoma State (51), TCU (51) and

Texas (50).

MLB Draft Picks... Six Sooners were taken in the 2013 MLB First Year Player Draft, led by right-hander Jonathan Gray being selected overall by the Colorado Rockies, matching the program's highest draft pick with Bobby Witt (Texas, 1985). Left-hander Dillon Overton was drafted 63rd overall in the second round by the Oakland Athletics and first baseman Matt Oberste went 206th to the New York Mets in the seventh round.

Later Round Lefties... Three lefthanded pitchers were taken in the MLB Draft, beginning with Billy Waltrip (12, 349) to the Rockies. Ethan Carnes (21, 644) went to the New York Yankees, while Jake Fisher (22, 664) rounded out the draft class by going to the Los Angeles Dodgers.

On the Hill... The OU pitching staff looks to replace nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. The eight pitchers that remain from over a year ago combined to post a 17-7 record and a 3.31 collective ERA.

New Faces in the Dugout... Coach Hughes brings to Norman a completely new coaching staff, which includes two assistants with Division I head coaching experience. Former Nebraska head coach, Mike Anderson brings Omaha-level experience as the hitting coach, while former Bryant and William & Mary skipper Jamie Pinzino takes over as the pitching coach after reaching a NCAA Regional final in 2013. Ryan Connolly joins the staff as the volunteer assistant after a oneyear stint as an assistant at Radford. Coordinator of baseball operations Ryan Gaines is the lone holdover from last season's staff.
