First Pitch... Oklahoma continues a stretch of five home games in five days when it hosts Rutgers for a three-game weekend series. The action begins with a Friday doubleheader. First pitch of game one is set for 3:00 pm.

About the Sooners... Winners of four of their last five and 6-1 at home, Oklahoma is 9-4 overall this season. Junior Mac James leads the offense with a .457 batting average to go with 12 runs and 11 RBI. Sophomore left fielder Hunter Haley is hitting .372, while leading the Sooners with 16 runs scored, 13 driven in and four home runs. The Oklahoma pitching staff owns a 2.50 earned run average and 3.42 strikeout-to-walk ratio. Freshman RHP Jake Elliott owns the best numbers among starting pitchers with a 2.79 ERA and 15 strikeouts in 19.1 inning of work, despite a 1-2 record.

On the Air... Each game will be broadcast with both audio and video on SoonerSports.tv. Only game two will be carried on KREF Sports Talk 1400. Chris Plank calls the action on Friday and joined by Toby Rowland on Sunday.

Midweek Recap... The Sooners won a pair of low-scoring games against Abilene Christian during the midweek. Oklahoma picked up wins of 4-1 and 3-1; the first wins of the season when scoring less than eight runs. Haley and redshirt-junior right fielder Taylor Alspaugh homered on Wednesday and five pitchers combined to allow just one unearned run on six hits. On Thursday, the Sooners scored three runs in the fourth and sophomore LHP Jacob Evans came on in relief to throw 3.1-scoreless innings to get the win as he struck out a career-high six batters.

Scouting the Scarlet Knights... Rutgers is 3-6 on the season and has been off since last playing on Sunday. The Scarlet Knights have been on the road for series against FIU, Jacksonville and Old Dominion. Thirty-year head coach Fred Hill stepped down in February at the age of 79. He finished with 941 career wins and was replaced by assistant and former Wagner head coach Joe Litterio. First baseman Brian O'Grady is batting a team-high .471 with 11 runs, seven RBI and five extra-base hits. LHP Howie Brey has earned two of the team's three wins and owns a 1.04 ERA.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98)

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Winning Streaks... After an opening day loss to Seton Hall, the Sooners rattled off five consecutive wins for their first fivegame win streak of the season. OU last won five or more in a row when it won eight, beginning with the 2013 regular season finale at Kansas State and finishing with a win in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional Final against Virginia Tech. Since losing on opening day, the Sooners have won six straight at home.

Crooked Numbers... Through the first eight games, Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 26 times and three or more 16 times. In game one against Arkansas Pine Bluff, the Sooners set a season-high with seven runs in the first inning.

Up Next... Oklahoma heads down to Texas for a non-conference game against UTA at the Ballpark at Arlington on Tuesday at 7:00

Backup Plan... The Sooner bullpen is 3-0 with a 2.05 ERA and has recorded 64 strikeouts in 52.2 innings to just 19 walks. Oklahoma's bullpen put up a string of 15 straight scoreless innings that was snapped in the eighth inning against The Citadel (2/21). For the season, OU relievers have tossed 40 shutout innings in the 50 complete innings pitched.

Lords of the Flies... Through 11 games, Oklahoma led the country in sacrifice flies with 12. The Sooners entered the week tied for first in the nation with The Citadel. Sophomore Kolbey Carpenter is the team-leader at three, which is tied for the third most on the young season.

Opening the Gates... Oklahoma's seasonopening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Mac of All Trades... On Wednesday, James made his first career start at first base. He has now started at four different positions this season; including catcher, left field and designated hitter.

Who's on First?... The Sooners have started four different first basemen. Freshman Niko Buentello made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. He leads the team with seven starts at first. Sophomore catcher Anthony Hermelyn has started four

games there, while James and junior **Keach Ballard** have each started one. Freshman **Austin O'Brian** has also appeared at first base off the bench in three games.

On the Hunt for Home Runs... Haley leads the OU power attack with four home runs and 13 RBI. He is sluging a team-high .698, which ranks second in the Big 12. Last season, Haley slugged .389 and hit two home runs in 48 games.

Return of the Mac... James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared in just nine games, earning nine atbats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, he has started games at catcher (five), designated hitter (three), left field (three) and first base (one). James is hitting a teamhigh .457, slugging .674 and has driven in 11 runs, which ranks third at OU.

Lineup on Shuffle... In the first 13 games of the season, Oklahoma has yet to repeat a lineup; using 13 different starting lineups. Sophomore center fielder Craig Aikin is the only player to start all 13 games at the same position. Redshirt-junior Taylor Alspaugh has started in right field in 12 of 13 games.

Taking First Hacks... The Sooners are outscoring opponents 19-2 in the first inning. **Only twice, has OU allowed a first-inning run.** Santa Clara became the second team to do so on Friday. When scoring in the first inning, Oklahoma is 4-1 and is 6-3 when scoring first.

TWI(OU)B History... In 2003, Oklahoma hosted Michigan for a three-game series between Match 7-9. The Sooners came away with a pair of victories after dropping the opener to the Wolverines. In game two, Buddy Blair pitched a complete game and struck out nine in the victory. Third baseman Jay Yaconetti went 6-for-12 with seven RBI and six runs scored in the series.

More Runs=More Wins... In each of Oklahoma's first seven wins, the Sooners scored at least eight runs. They are 7-0 when scoring eight or more, including a season-high 16 against UAPB (2/18). When scoring five runs or less, OU is 2-4.

Defending Big 12 Champs... The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament

Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman **Hector Lorenzana** is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

Freshman All-America Trio... Oklahoma's core is built around a trifecta of Freshman All-Americans from 2013 in left-hander Jacob Evans, catcher Anthony Hermelyn and center fielder Craig Aikin. Evans took the hill primarily as the Sooner closer as a rookie and notched nine saves along with seven wins with a 2.06 earned run average. Hermelyn hit .275 with 26 RBI, while Aikin owns the highest returning average at .286 with 42 runs and a team-leading 16 stolen bases.

New Man on the Top Step... Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

Season Openers... Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Opening Day Starter... Sophomore lefty Jacob Evans made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since Zach Neal in 2010. Evans is also the

third straight lefty to start on opening day, following **Dillon Overton** in 2012 and 2013.

In the Polls... Oklahoma entered 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll, landing three spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches.

Super Regional... The Sooners last took the field for the NCAA Baton Rouge Super Regional against LSU. After losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel in game one, Oklahoma was eliminated by the Tigers, 11-1 in game two. Righthander Jonathan Gray tossed 7.1 innings and allowed just two runs, while striking out nine as OU went down in the opener.

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 7-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 3-2, 11-inning win over TCU last season. OU has won three of its last four conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

Preseason Poll... Oklahoma landed fifth in the 2014 Big 12 Preseason Poll as voted on by the league's coaches. The Sooners received 37 points in the poll. The top five spots were separated by only six points. Defending regular season champion Kansas State (56) took the top spot, followed by Oklahoma State (51), TCU (51) and Texas (50).

MLB Draft Picks... Six Sooners were taken in the 2013 MLB First Year Player Draft, led by right-hander Jonathan Gray being selected overall by the Colorado Rockies, matching the program's highest draft pick with Bobby

Witt (Texas, 1985). Left-hander Dillon Overton was drafted 63rd overall in the second round by the Oakland Athletics and first baseman Matt Oberste went 206th to the New York Mets in the seventh round.

Later Round Lefties... Three left-handed pitchers were taken in the MLB Draft, beginning with Billy Waltrip (12, 349) to the Rockies. Ethan Carnes (21, 644) went to the New York Yankees, while Jake Fisher (22, 664) rounded out the draft class by going to the Los Angeles Dodgers.

On the Hill... The OU pitching staff looks to replace nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. The eight pitchers that remain from over a year ago combined to post a 17-7 record and a 3.31 collective ERA.

New Faces in the Dugout... Coach Hughes brings to Norman a completely new coaching staff, which includes two assistants with Division I head coaching experience. Former Nebraska head coach, Mike Anderson brings Omaha-level experience as the hitting coach, while former Bryant and William & Mary skipper Jamie Pinzino takes over as the pitching coach after reaching a NCAA Regional final in 2013. Ryan Connolly joins the staff as the volunteer assistant after a one-year stint as an assistant at Radford. Coordinator of baseball operations Ryan Gaines is the lone holdover from last season's staff.

Big 12 Tournament... The 2014 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship will be held at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City, May 21-25.

All-Big 12 Returners... The Sooners lost both First Team honorees to the MLB Draft in Gray and Oberste. Sophomores Craig Aikin and Jacob Evans both earned spots on the Second Team and Freshman Team, while fellow classmates Anthony Hermelyn, who was also named Honorable Mention, and Ralph Garza Jr. were placed on the Freshman Team.

2013 in Review... Oklahoma finished 43-21 overall and 13-11 in the Big 12 a year ago. The Sooners took home the hardware, winning their second Big 12 Tournament. In the NCAA Tournament, OU swept through the Blacksburg Regional with wins over Coastal Carolina, Connecticut and Virginia Tech to move on to the Baton Rouge Super Regional. The Sooners' season ended with a pair of losses to LSU by scores of 2-0 and 11-1.

CONFERENCE NOTES

- Big 12 teams will play one more full week of non-conference contests before league play opens up next weekend, March 14, with Kansas at Texas and Texas Tech at Baylor.
- Kansas, K-State and West Virginia have yet to play a home game. The Jayhawks were originally scheduled to hold their home opener on Tuesday, but the contest vs. Creighton has been pushed back to March 12. Kansas State has its opening series this weekend (vs. lowa). The Mountaineers, whose home field is undergoing upgrades, won't host a home game until March 25.
- Texas posted a 4-0 record last week, including a 3-0 mark to win the Houston College Classic with victories over Sam Houston State, No. 10 Rice and Houston. Longhorn pitching posted a 0.71 mark on the week, allowing just three earned runs. Texas' starting rotation of Parker French, Dillon Peters and Nathan Thornhill occupy three of the top five spots on the Big 12 ERA leaderboard. All three hurlers have ERAs at or under 1.00.
- WVU pitching also contributed to an undefeated week for the Mountaineers who posted a 1.33 ERA in three contests last week to sweep the field at the Caravelle Resort Tournament in Myrtle Beach, S.C.
- With a 3-1 weekend, the Jayhawks improved to 11-1 for the best start in school history. KU leads the Big 12 in hitting with a .370 clip.
- Texas owns the league's highest national ranking entering the week. The Longhorns sit in 10th on *Baseball America*'s poll. It's the first time they have been ranked in BA's top 10 since the end of the 2011 season. Oklahoma State checks in at No. 12 on two polls, while TCU ranks as high as 21st. Kansas (No. 26, *Collegiate Baseball*) and Texas Tech (No. 30, NCBWA) are also ranked in the top 30.
- Baylor and Oklahoma State host ranked California teams this weekend as third-ranked Cal State Fullerton visits Waco and 24th-ranked San Diego travels to Stillwater during a weekend in which seven of nine league teams will be at home.
- •The NCAA released the first set of national stats for the 2014 season. KU ranks fifth in batting average, while Oklahoma State ranks third in walks. Three league teams are in the top 10 for strikeout to walk ratio (4. WVU, 5. TCU, 9. OSU). Individually, Kansas' Connor McKay is second in RBI and TCU's Brandon Finnegan is first in strikeouts.
- This season, TTU has four wins over top 10 teams in 12 games. The previous four wins over top 10 teams spanned 143 games (2010-12).
