First Pitch... Oklahoma travels down I-35 to the Ballpark at Arlington, home of the Texas Rangers. for a 7:00 pm match-up with Texas-Arlington on Tuesday night.

About the Sooners... Oklahoma had a modest four-game winning streak snapped on Sunday afternoon and enter Tuesday's contest at 11-5 overall. Junior Mac James, who has started at four different positions, is hitting a robust .517 with 16 runs scored and 16 driven in. He is slugging .776 with nine doubles and two home runs. Six of the nine Sooner starters are hitting .300 or better. Sophomore left fielder Hunter Haley is second on the team at .400, while leading the team with 20 runs scored and tied with James for the team lead in RBI. As a team, Oklahoma is hitting .306 and holding its opponents to a .256 average.

On the Air... Veteran OU broadcasters Toby Rowland (play-by-play) and Chris Plank (sideline) will be on the call for KREF Sports Talk 1400. Tuesday's game will also be the first of the season televised by Sooner Sports TV and will appear on FSSW+ and FCSC with Brett Dolan (p-b-p) and Ross Hubbard (color) on the call.

Weekend Recap... The Sooners swept a doubleheader with Rutgers at home on Friday; 16-11 and 7-5. Oklahoma matches its highest offensive output of the season in the opener, fueled by 19 hits. In the nightcap, the Sooners rallied from four down in the eighth with six runs for the comeback victory. James went 5-for-8 with four RBI on the night. Relievers Robert Tasin (2-0) and Kyle Hayes (2-0) picked up the wins out of the bullpen. In the opener, freshman DH Niko Buentello and Haley each drove in three runs. Buentello blasted his second career home run, a shot over the batter's eye in center field, which at its base is 411' away.

Scouting the Mavs... UTA is 4-10 on the season after a 1-2 weekend in the Hilton Invitational. which it hosted at Clay Gould Ballpark. Infielder Peter Cuomo is batting a team-high .359 with seven RBI. Catcher Greg McCall leads the team with 13 RBI and three home runs. The Mavericks pitching staff owns a 4.09 earned run average. Out of the bullpen, lefty Chase Weaver has tossed 15.2 innings in six relief appearances to a 3.45 ERA.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98)

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

MAC ATTACK... James was named the Big 12 Player of the Week after hitting .684 (13for-19) in five games last week. He owned a 1.000 slugging percentage and .714 on-base percentage. James is riding an eight-game hitting streak and finished the weekend with a 4-for-4 day, his second of the season, to go with his second home run of the season.

Double Switch... Senior Hector Lorenzana had started all 75 of his career games at second base before last week. He has started each of the last five at shortstop, while junior Keach Ballard has taken over second. However, in double play situations with a runner on first and less than two outs, the two middle infielders have been trading positions.

Winning Streaks... After an opening day loss to Seton Hall, the Sooners rattled off five consecutive wins for their first fivegame win streak of the season. OU last won five or more in a row when it won eight, beginning with the 2013 regular season finale at Kansas State and finishing with a win in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional Final against Virginia Tech.

Vs. the Top-50... In games against the RPI Top-50, Oklahoma is 4-3 on the season. The Sooners took two-out-of-three from both Seton Hall (31) and Rutgers (46), while falling to Ohio State (9) at a neutral site.

Crooked Numbers... Through 16 games, Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 32 times and three or more 20 times. In game one against Arkansas Pine Bluff, the Sooners set a season-high with seven runs in the first inning.

Up Next... Oklahoma resumes its homestand with a three-game series against Belmont beginning Friday night at 6:00 pm.

Addition to the Schedule... The Sooners have added a home game against UTA on Tuesday, April 22 to replace the lost game in Surprise, Ariz. that was rained out. The game time is still to be determined.

Backup Plan... The Sooner bullpen is 5-1 with a 3.16 ERA and has recorded 69 strikeouts in 52.2 innings. Oklahoma's bullpen put up a string of 15 straight scoreless innings that was snapped in the eighth inning against The Citadel (2/21). For the season, OU relievers have tossed 43 shutout innings in the 59 complete innings pitched.

Lords of the Flies... Through 11 games, Oklahoma led the country in sacrifice flies with 12. The Sooners entered the week tied for first in the nation with The Citadel. Sophomore Kolbey Carpenter is the team-leader at three, which is tied for the third most on the young season.

Opening the Gates Oklahoma's
season-opening series against Seton
Hall was the second highest opening
weekend attendance total in program
history as 3,754 fans passed through
the gates. The previous record was
set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Soon-
ers face William & Mary, the season
after reaching the 2010 College World
Series. The single-game attendance
record on opening day was set after
the 1994 CWS National Champion-
ship team returned home to face Mis-
souri Southern in front of a crowd of
2,183 in 1995.

Mac of All Trades... On Wednesday, James made his first career start at first base. He has now started at four different positions this season; including catcher, left field and designated hitter.

Who's on First?... The Sooners have started four different first basemen. Freshman Niko Buentello made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. He leads the team with seven starts at first. Sophomore catcher Anthony Hermelyn has started four games there, while James and junior Keach Ballard have each started one. Freshman Austin O'Brian has also appeared at first base off the bench in three games.

On the Hunt for Home Runs... Haley leads the OU power attack with four home runs and 16 RBI. He is sluging a .709, which ranks second on the team. Last season, Haley slugged .389 and hit two home runs in 48 games. He has scored a league-leading 20 runs.

Return of the Mac... James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared in just nine games, earning nine at-bats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, he has started games at catcher (five), designated hitter (three), left field (three) and first base (one). James is hitting a team-high .517, slugging .776 and has driven in 16 runs.

Lineup on Shuffle... Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. The Sooners have used 13 different starting lineups. Sophomore center fielder Craig Aikin is the only player to start all 16 games at the same position. Redshirt-junior Taylor Alspaugh has started in right field in 15 of 16 games.

Taking First Hacks... The Sooners are outscoring opponents 21-5 in the

first inning. *Three times, has OU allowed a first-inning run.* Santa Clara became the second team to do so on Friday. When scoring in the first inning, Oklahoma is 4-1 and is 6-3 when scoring first.

TWI(OU)B History... The Sooners split a two-game series at No. 7 Arizona State on March 10 and 11, 1998. Oklahoma lost the opener, 7-6 and won the finale, 9-5. Casey Bookout homered in the win, while Geoff Geary improved to 6-0 on the season.

More Runs=More Wins... In each of Oklahoma's first seven wins, the Sooners scored at least eight runs. They are 8-0 when scoring eight or more, including a season-high 16 against UAPB (2/18). When scoring five runs or less, OU is 2-4.

Defending Big 12 Champs... The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman **Hector Lorenzana** is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

Freshman All-America Trio... Oklahoma's core is built around a trifecta of Freshman All-Americans from 2013 in left-hander Jacob Evans, catcher Anthony Hermelyn and center fielder Craig Aikin. Evans took the hill primarily as the Sooner closer as a rookie and notched nine saves along with seven wins with a 2.06 earned run average. Hermelyn hit .275 with 26 RBI, while Aikin owns the highest returning average at .286 with 42 runs and a team-leading 16 stolen bases.

New Man on the Top Step... Hughes was named the ninth head coach in

program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

Season Openers... Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Opening Day Starter... Sophomore lefty Jacob Evans made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since Zach Neal in 2010. Evans is also the third straight lefty to start on opening day, following Dillon Overton in 2012 and 2013.

In the Polls... Oklahoma entered 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll, landing three spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches.

Super Regional... The Sooners last took the field for the NCAA Baton Rouge Super Regional against LSU. After losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel in game one, Oklahoma was eliminated by the Tigers, 11-1 in game two. Righthander Jonathan Gray tossed 7.1 innings and allowed just two runs, while striking out nine as OU went down in the opener.

951-& 1994 NATIONAL CHAMPIONS // 1997 & 2013 BIG 12 CHAMPIO

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 7-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 3-2, 11-inning win over TCU last season. OU has won three of its last four conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

Preseason Poll... Oklahoma landed fifth in the 2014 Big 12 Preseason Poll as voted on by the league's coaches. The Sooners received 37 points in the poll. The top five spots were separated by only six points. Defending regular season champion Kansas State (56) took the top spot, followed by Oklahoma State (51), TCU (51) and Texas (50).

MLB Draft Picks... Six Sooners were taken in the 2013 MLB First Year Player Draft, led by right-hander Jonathan Gray being selected overall by the Colorado Rockies, matching the program's highest draft pick with Bobby Witt (Texas, 1985). Left-hander Dillon Overton was drafted 63rd overall in the second round by the Oakland Athletics and first baseman Matt Oberste went 206th to the New York Mets in the seventh round.

Later Round Lefties... Three left-handed pitchers were taken in the MLB Draft, beginning with Billy Waltrip (12, 349) to the Rockies. Ethan Carnes (21, 644) went to the New York Yankees, while Jake Fisher (22, 664) rounded out the draft class by going to the Los Angeles Dodgers.

On the Hill... The OU pitching staff looks to replace nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. The eight pitchers that remain from over a year ago combined to post a 17-7 record and a 3.31 collective ERA.

New Faces in the Dugout... Coach Hughes brings to Norman a completely new coaching staff, which includes two assistants with Division I head coaching experience. Former Nebraska head coach, Mike Anderson brings Omaha-level experience as the hitting coach, while former Bryant and William & Mary skipper Jamie Pinzino takes over as the pitching coach after reaching a NCAA Regional final in 2013. Ryan Connolly joins the staff as the volunteer assistant after a one-year stint as an assistant at Radford. Coordinator of baseball operations Ryan Gaines is the lone holdover from last season's staff.

Big 12 Tournament... The 2014 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship will be held at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City, May 21-25.

All-Big 12 Returners... The Sooners lost both First Team honorees to the MLB Draft in Gray and Oberste. Sophomores Craig Aikin and Jacob Evans both earned spots on the Second Team and Freshman Team, while fellow classmates Anthony Hermelyn, who was also named Honorable Mention, and Ralph Garza Jr. were placed on the Freshman Team.

2013 in Review... Oklahoma finished 43-21 overall and 13-11 in the Big 12 a year ago. The Sooners took home the hardware, winning their second Big 12 Tournament.
