First Pitch... Oklahoma resumes its homestand with a three-game weekend series against Belmont beginning Friday night at 6:00 pm. The Sooners will play eight straight games at L. Dale TV: Mitchell Park over the next 10 days.

About the Sooners... Oklahoma is 8-2 at home this season and 12-5 overall. Junior catcher Mac James pulled is multiple player of the week awards on Monday and is currently hitting .500 with 17 RBI and 17 runs scored. Sophomore left fielder Hunter Haley is second on the team at .383 and 16 RBI, while leading the Sooners with 20 runs scored. On the mound, sophomore RHP Corey Copping is 2-0 with a 2.51 earned run average. OU starters and relievers have accounted for six wins each. Redshirt-sophomore LHP Adam Choplick (2-1) and freshman RHP Jake Elliott (1-2) round out the Sooner rotation.

On the Air... Veteran OU broadcaster Chris Plank will handle the play-by-play for KREF Sports Talk 1400 AM and 98.5 FM this weekend. All three games will also be televised by Sooner Sports TV with Chad McKee (p-b-p) and George Frazier (color) on the call.

Night at the Ballpark... Redshirt-junior right fielder Taylor Alspaugh belted the first pitch of the 10th inning over the wall in right for the eventual game-winning home run of a 3-2 extra-inning win over Texas-Arlington on Tuesday. Freshman third baseman Sheldon Neuse went 4-for-4 on the night with two runs and two doubles. In relief, senior RHP Kindle Ladd pitched five scoreless innings and struck out three. Oklahoma held a onerun lead in the ninth that was erased on a one-out double to right-center by UTA's Darien McLemore.

Scouting the Bruins... Belmont is 7-9 on the season and coming off a 12-5 win over Memphis on Tuesday. Outfielder Drew Ferguson leads the offense with a .345 batting average and six home runs. Catcher Jamie Ritchie is hitting .340 with a team-leading five stolen bases. The Bruins' Friday starter, RHP Austin Coley is 1-1 with a 3.91 ERA to go with 25 strikeouts in 23 innings of work. He will be followed by LHP Dan Ludwig (0-3) and LHP Patrick McGrath (1-2).

#### **HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES**

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98)

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

MAC ATTACK... James was named the Big 12 Player of the Week after hitting .684 (13for-19) in five games last week. He owned a 1.000 slugging percentage and .714 onbase percentage. James is riding a ninegame hitting streak and finished the weekend with a 4-for-4 day, his second of the season, to go with his second home run of the season. James was also honored as the Louisville Slugger and NCBWA National Player of the Week.

Double Switch... Senior Hector Lorenzana had started all 75 of his career games at second base before last week. He has started each of the last five at shortstop, while juniors Keach Ballard and Joshua Ake have taken over second. However, in double play situations with a runner on first and less than two outs, the two middle infielders have been trading positions.

Shave for the Brave... On April 3, Oklahoma will join the fight against childhood cancer by hold a "Shave for the Brave" event following practice. Shave for the Brave works in conjunction with the Vs. Cancer Foundation to raise money for cancer research. The event will also serve as an opportunity for the Sooners in their countdown to 19 Ways.

Winning Streaks... After an opening day loss to Seton Hall, the Sooners rattled off five consecutive wins for their first fivegame win streak of the season. OU last won five or more in a row when it won eight, beginning with the 2013 regular season finale at Kansas State and finishing with a win in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional Final against Virginia Tech.

Vs. the Top-50... In games against the RPI Top-50, Oklahoma is 4-3 on the season. The Sooners took two-out-of-three from both Seton Hall (24) and Rutgers (40), while falling to Ohio State (10) at a neutral site.

Crooked Numbers... Through 17 games, Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 32 times and three or more 20 times. In game one against Arkansas Pine Bluff, the Sooners set a season-high with seven runs in the first inning.

Up Next... The Sooners remain at home for a pair of midweek games; first against TCU in non-conference action on Tuesday, March 18 followed by Arkansas-Little Rock on March 19.

Addition to the Schedule... The Sooners have added a home game against UTA on Tuesday, April 22 to replace the lost game in Surprise, Ariz. that was rained out. The game time is still to be determined.

# Backup Plan... The Sooner bullpen is 6-1 with a 2.97 ERA and has recorded 74 strikeouts in 69.2 innings. Oklahoma's bullpen put up a string of 15 straight scoreless innings that was snapped in the eighth inning against The Citadel (2/21). For the season, OU relievers have tossed 48 shutout innings in the 65 complete innings pitched.

Lords of the Flies... Entering the week, Oklahoma led the country in sacrifice flies with 15. Alspaugh is the team-leader at four, which is the fourth most in the nation on the young season.

Opening the Gates... Oklahoma's season-opening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Mac of All Trades... Against Abilene Christian (3/5), James made his first career start at first base. He has now started at four different positions this season; including catcher, left field and designated hitter.

Who's on First?... The Sooners have started four different first basemen. Freshman Niko Buentello made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. He leads the team with seven starts at first. Sophomore catcher Anthony Hermelyn has started four games there, while James and junior Keach Ballard have each started one. Freshman Austin O'Brien has also appeared at first base off the bench in three games.

On the Hunt for Home Runs... Haley leads the OU power attack with four home runs and 16 RBI. He is sluging .667, which ranks second on the team. Last season, Haley slugged .389 and hit two home runs in 48 games. Haley has scored a league-leading 20 runs.

Return of the Mac... James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared in just nine games, earning nine at-bats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, he has started games at catcher (five),

designated hitter (three), left field (three) and first base (one). James is hitting a team-high .517, slugging .776 and has driven in 16 runs.

Lineup on Shuffle... Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. The Sooners have used 14 different starting lineups. Sophomore center fielder Craig Aikin is the only player to start all 17 games at the same position. Redshirt-junior Taylor Alspaugh has started in right field in 16 of 17 games.

Taking First Hacks... The Sooners are outscoring opponents 22-5 in the first inning. Three times, has OU allowed a first-inning run. Santa Clara became the second team to do so on Friday. When scoring in the first inning, Oklahoma is 5-2 and is 8-3 when scoring first.

TWI(OU)B History... Oklahoma improved to 5-1 in league play during the first season of the Big 12 in 1997 with a three-game sweep over Kansas, March 15-16. The Sooners, who previously took two-out-of-three from lowa State, swept a doubleheader with the Jayhawks, 7-6 and 11-5 before taking the finale, 13-12.

More Runs=More Wins... In each of Oklahoma's first seven wins, the Sooners scored at least eight runs. They are 8-0 when scoring eight or more, including a season-high 16 against UAPB (2/18). When scoring five runs or less, OU is 2-4.

**Defending Big 12 Champs...** The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman **Hector Lorenzana** is

back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

Freshman All-America Trio... Oklahoma's core is built around a trifecta of Freshman All-Americans from 2013 in left-hander Jacob Evans, catcher Anthony Hermelyn and center fielder Craig Aikin. Evans took the hill primarily as the Sooner closer as a rookie and notched nine saves along with seven wins with a 2.06 earned run average. Hermelyn hit .275 with 26 RBI, while Aikin owns the highest returning average at .286 with 42 runs and a team-leading 16 stolen bases.

New Man on the Top Step... Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

Season Openers... Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Opening Day Starter... Sophomore lefty Jacob Evans made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since Zach Neal in 2010. Evans is also the third straight lefty to start on opening day, following Dillon Overton in 2012 and 2013.

In the Polls... Oklahoma entered 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll, landing three spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches.

Super Regional... The Sooners last took the field for the NCAA Baton Rouge Super Regional against LSU. After losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel in game one, Oklahoma was eliminated by the Tigers, 11-1 in game two. Right-hander Jonathan Gray tossed 7.1 innings and allowed just two runs, while striking out nine as OU went down in the opener.

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 7-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 3-2, 11-inning win over TCU last season. OU has won three of its last four conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

Preseason Poll... Oklahoma landed fifth in the 2014 Big 12 Preseason Poll as voted on by the league's coaches. The Sooners received 37 points in the poll. The top five spots were separated by only six points. Defending regular season champion Kansas State (56) took the top spot, followed by Oklahoma State (51), TCU (51) and Texas (50).

MLB Draft Picks... Six Sooners were taken in the 2013 MLB First Year Player Draft, led by right-hander Jonathan Gray being selected overall by the Colorado Rockies, matching the

program's highest draft pick with Bobby Witt (Texas, 1985). Left-hander Dillon Overton was drafted 63rd overall in the second round by the Oakland Athletics and first baseman Matt Oberste went 206th to the New York Mets in the seventh round.

Later Round Lefties... Three left-handed pitchers were taken in the MLB Draft, beginning with Billy Waltrip (12, 349) to the Rockies. Ethan Carnes (21, 644) went to the New York Yankees, while Jake Fisher (22, 664) rounded out the draft class by going to the Los Angeles Dodgers.

On the Hill... The OU pitching staff looks to replace nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. The eight pitchers that remain from over a year ago combined to post a 17-7 record and a 3.31 collective ERA.

New Faces in the Dugout... Coach Hughes brings to Norman a completely new coaching staff, which includes two assistants with Division I head coaching experience. Former Nebraska head coach, Mike Anderson brings Omaha-level experience as the hitting coach, while former Bryant and William & Mary skipper Jamie Pinzino takes over as the pitching coach after reaching a NCAA Regional final in 2013. Ryan Connolly joins the staff as the volunteer assistant after a one-year stint as an assistant at Radford. Coordinator of baseball operations Ryan Gaines is the lone holdover from last season's staff.

Big 12 Tournament... The 2014 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship will be held at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City, May 21-25.

2013 in Review... Oklahoma finished 43-21 overall and 13-11 in the Big 12 a year ago. The Sooners took home the hardware, winning their second Big 12 Tournament. In the NCAA Tournament, OU swept through the Blacksburg Regional with wins over Coastal Carolina, Connecticut and Virginia Tech to move on to the Baton Rouge Super Regional. The Sooners' season ended with a pair of losses to LSU by scores of 2-0 and 11-1.

- This Friday, March 14, begins conference play in the league with two series featuring three of the Big 12's top teams as Texas Tech travels to Baylor and Texas hosts Kansas.
- The Jayhawk offense, which leads the league, will face the Big 12's top pitching squad as Texas has a 1.99 ERA this season.
- UT is 13 Big 12 wins away from 300 league victories. The Longhorns are 287-172-1 in conference play all-time, which leads the league with a .625 winning percentage since play began in 1997.
- Baylor, which just took two of three from No. 4 Cal State Fullerton in Waco, will meet a TTU team that has won at least 14 games during the opening 17 games of the season for the seventh time in school history and the first time since 2005 (14-3). The complete series will be telecast on various FOX networks.
- Baylor's 2-1 series win at home over No. 4 Cal State Fullerton over the weekend was the program's first-ever series win against a non-conference, top-five opponent since Baseball America's rankings began in 1981. With the win on Saturday, the Bears were victorious in their 500th home game at Baylor Ballpark.
- Texas maintained its No. 10 national ranking from Baseball America and is in the top 15 of all four national polls. The Red Raiders cracked the top 25 of two polls, including a No. 23 ranking on the USA Today Coaches' Poll - the first time TTU has appeared on that list since 2005. Texas Tech has been nationally ranked for four consecutive weeks for the first time since 2005. Oklahoma State is in the top 20 of three polls, ranked as high as No. 15.
- The Red Raiders recorded five triples on Saturday night the most in a game since a schoolrecord six in 1975 during a 29-7 victory at Rice.
- K-State, Texas Tech and West Virginia enter the week with six-game winning streaks.
- UT's Mark Payton extended his active reached base streak to 56 games, which is the also the best in the nation. K-State's Nick Martini holds the Big 12 record after reaching base for 93 consecutive games from 2009-11. After five games last week, Payton surpassed TTU's Cameron Blair, who held the second-longest streak with 53 games from 2004-05.
- Mac James (Oklahoma), who leads the league in hitting, was named the Big 12 Player of the Week, while Josh Michalec became just the second BU reliever to claim the conference's Pitcher of the Week award. Adam Kirsch secured TTU's third straight Newcomer of the Week recognition.


