First Pitch... An eight-game homestand played in 10 days comes to a close with the opening of Big 12 play against Kansas State. Oklahoma baseball hosts the Wildcats for a three-game set at L. Dale TV: Mitchell Park beginning Friday at 6:00 pm.

About the Sooners... No. 30 Oklahoma is 16-6 on the season after having a five-game win streak snapped on Wednesday. Junior Mac James leads the Sooners with a .442 batting average to go with 18 runs scored and 18 driven in. Freshman third baseman Sheldon Neuse has been swinging a hot bat of late; lifting his average to .310. He has scored 20 runs and totaled a team-high 15 extrabase hits. Redshirt-sophomore LHP Adam Choplick (2-1) has struck out a team-high 27 batters in 28 innings and owns a 3.86 earned run average. Freshman RHP Jake Elliott (2-2) owns a staff-low 2.87 ERA among starters in 31.1 innings of work.

On the Air... Veteran OU broadcaster Chris Plank will handle the play-by-play duties on KREF Sports Talk 1400. Both games will also be televised by Sooner Sports TV with Chad McKee (p-b-p) and Jay Payton (color) on the call.

Midweek Recap... Oklahoma picked up a nonconference win over TCU on Tuesday, 9-5, and fell to Arkansas-Little Rock on Wednesday, 11-2. In the win over the Horned Frogs, the Sooners overcame a season-high five errors as they totaled 12 hits and broke a 3-3 tie with a four-run sixth inning. Neuse doubled twice, while sophomore left fielder **Hunter Haley** went 2-for-5 with two runs and a RBI. On Wednesday. Oklahoma was held to just five hits, but sophomore Anthony Hermelyn was able to extend his hit streak to nine games.

Scouting the Wildcats... Kansas State is 13-7 and winners of its last 12 games after a 1-7 start. The Wildcats, who are just 1-5 in road games, are led at the plate by shortstop Austin Fisher with a .387 batting average and 20 runs scored. Third baseman RJ Santigate is the second of seven starters with a batting average above .300. He is hitting .343 with 15 runs and seven steals. RHP Levi MaVorhis (3-1) is slated to start on Friday. He owns a team-leading 2.70 ERA and has held opponents to a .198 average, Saturday's starter, LHP Jared Moore (4-1) holds a 3.68 ERA.

### **HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES**

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98)

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Making Some Noise... Neuse was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Week after batting .529 (9-for-17) in four games. He slugged 1.000 with a .600 on-base percentage. Neuse went 4-for-4 with two doubles against UTA at Globe Life Ballpark in Arlington on Tuesday. He tripled twice on Saturday against Belmont and scored three times.

All-Time vs. K-State... Oklahoma leads the all-time series, 148-55, and holds a 34-15 advantage in Big 12 games.

Last Time They Met... The Sooners advanced to the Big 12 Championship title game with a 7-6 win over the Wildcats on May 25 of last year. Ralph Garza Jr. earned the win in 1.1 innings of relief, while Kyle Haves struck out the two batters he faced to earn the save. Garrett Carey went 2-for-5 with three RBI.

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 7-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 3-2, 11-inning win over TCU last season. OU has won three of its last four conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

What a Relief... Last week, the Sooner bullpen posted a 0.39 ERA in 23 innings of work. OU relievers combined for 24 strikeouts to just eight walks and held opponents to a .160 batting average. Garza made three appearances and recorded three runs, while giving up the only two runs, one unearned, by the unit. Senior RHP Kindle Ladd pitched eight-scoreless inning in two appearances.

MAC ATTACK... James was named the Big 12 Player of the Week a week ago after hitting .684 (13-for-19) in five games. He owned a 1.000 slugging percentage and .714 on-base percentage. James is riding a nine-game hitting streak and finished the weekend with a 4-for-4 day, his second of the season, to go with his second home run of the season. James was also honored as the Louisville Slugger and NCBWA National Player of the Week.

Double Switch... Senior Hector Lorenzana had started all 75 of his career games at second base before the Abilene Christian series. He has started each of the last nine at shortstop, while juniors Keach Ballard and Joshua Ake have taken over second. However, in double play situations with a runner on first and less than two outs, the two middle infielders have been trading positions.

Shave for the Brave... On April 3, Oklahoma will join the fight against childhood cancer by hold a "Shave for the Brave" event following practice. Shave for the Brave works in conjunction with the Vs. Cancer Foundation

Winning Streaks... After an opening day loss to Seton Hall, the Sooners rattled off five consecutive wins for their first five-game win streak of the season. OU last won five or more in a row when it won eight, beginning with the 2013 regular season finale at Kansas State and finishing with a win in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional Final against Virginia Tech. Oklahoma had its second five-game win streak of the season snapped against Arkansas-Little Rock (3/19).

Backup Plan... The Sooner bullpen is 9-1 with a 2.77 ERA and has recorded 109 strikeouts in 100.2 innings. Oklahoma's bullpen put up a string of 15 straight scoreless innings that was snapped in the eighth inning against Citadel (2/21). For the season, OU relievers have tossed 72 shutout innings in the 95 complete innings pitched.

Vs. the Top-50... In games against the RPI Top-50, Oklahoma is 4-3 on the season. The Sooners took twoout-of-three from both Seton Hall (28) and Rutgers (34), while falling to Ohio State (42) at a neutral site.

Crooked Numbers... Through 20 games, Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 39 times and three or more 24 times. In game one against Arkansas Pine Bluff, the Sooners set a season-high with seven runs in the first inning.

TWI(OU)B History... In the middle of an eight-game trip to Hawaii, in 1977, Oklahoma picked up a 7-4 win over Hawaii on March 21, followed by a 4-3 loss the next day. The Sooners trip ended with a 6-5 win over Tokai, Japan on March 22.

Up Next... The Sooners hit the road for a midweek game on Tuesday, March 25 against Oral Roberts at 6:30 pm in Tulsa.

Addition to the Schedule... The Sooners have added a home game against UTA on Tuesday, April 22 to replace the lost game in Surprise, Ariz. that was rained out. The game time is still to be determined.

Lords of the Flies... Entering the week, Oklahoma led the country in sacrifice flies with 18; tied with Kansas State. Alspaugh is the team-leader at five, which is the fourth most in the nation.

Opening the Gates... Oklahoma's season-opening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Mac of All Trades... Against Abilene Christian (3/5), James made his first career start at first base. He has now started at four different positions this season; including catcher, left field and designated hitter.

Who's on First?... The Sooners have started four different first basemen. Freshman Niko Buentello made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. He leads the team with seven starts at first. Sophomore catcher Anthony Hermelyn has started four games there, while James and junior Keach Ballard have each started one. Freshman Austin O'Brien has also appeared at first base off the bench in three games.

On the Hunt for Home Runs... Haley leads the OU power attack with four home runs and 17 RBI. He is sluging .638, which ranks second on the team. Last season, Haley slugged .389 and hit two home runs in 48 games. Haley has scored a league-leading 22 runs.

Return of the Mac... James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared in just nine games, earning nine atbats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, he has started games at catcher (eight), designated hitter (three), left field (four) and first base (four). James is hitting a leaguehigh .472, slugging .681 and has driven in 17 runs.

Lineup on Shuffle... Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. The Sooners have used 17 different starting lineups. Sophomore center fielder Craig Aikin is the only player to start all 22 games at the same position. Redshirtjunior Taylor Alspaugh has started in right field in 20 of 22 games.

Taking First Hacks... The Sooners are outscoring opponents 27-8 in the first inning. Six times, has OU allowed a first-inning run. Belmont did so in each of the first two games last weekend. When scoring in the first inning, Oklahoma is 8-3 and is 9-4 when scoring first.

TWI(OU)B History... In the midle of an eight-game trip to Hawaii, in 1977, Oklahoma picked up a 7-4 win over Hawaii on March 21, followed by a 4-3 loss the next day. The Sooners trip ended with a 6-5 win over Tokai, Japan on March 22.

second baseman Hector Lorenzana is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

Freshman All-America Trio... Oklahoma's core is built around a trifecta of Freshman All-Americans from 2013 in left-hander Jacob Evans, catcher Anthony Hermelyn and center fielder Craig Aikin. Evans took the hill primarily as the Sooner closer as a rookie and notched nine saves along with seven wins with a 2.06 earned run average. Hermelyn hit .275 with 26 RBI, while Aikin owns the highest returning average at .286 with 42 runs and a team-leading 16 stolen bases.

New Man on the Top Step... Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

Season Openers... Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Jacob Evans made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since Zach Neal in 2010. Evans is also the third straight lefty to start on opening day, following Dillon Overton in 2012 and 2013.

In the Polls... Oklahoma entered 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll, landing three spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches.

Super Regional... The Sooners last took the field for the NCAA Baton Rouge Super Regional against LSU. After losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel in game one, Oklahoma was eliminated by the Tigers, 11-1 in game two. Right-hander Jonathan Gray tossed 7.1 innings and allowed just two runs, while striking out nine as OU went down in the opener.

Preseason Poll... Oklahoma landed fifth in the 2014 Big 12 Preseason Poll as voted on by the league's coaches. The Sooners received 37 points in the poll. The top five spots were separated by only six points. Defending reqular season champion Kansas State (56) took the top spot, followed by Oklahoma State (51), TCU (51) and Texas (50).

MLB Draft Picks... Six Sooners were taken in the 2013 MLB First Year Player Draft, led by right-hander Jonathan Gray being selected overall by the Colorado Rockies, matching the program's highest draft pick with Bobby Witt (Texas, 1985). Left-hander Dillon Overton was drafted 63rd overall in the second round by the Oakland Athletics and first baseman Matt Oberste went 206th to the New York Mets in the seventh round.

Later Round Lefties... Three left-handed pitchers were taken in the MLB Draft, beginning with Billy Waltrip (12, 349) to the Rockies. Ethan Carnes (21, 644) went to the New York Yankees, while Jake Fisher (22, 664) rounded out the draft class by going to the Los Angeles Dodgers.

On the Hill... The OU pitching staff looks to replace nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. The eight pitchers that remain from over a year ago combined to post a 17-7 record and a 3.31 collective ERA.

New Faces in the Dugout... Coach Hughes brings to Norman a completely new coaching staff, which includes two assistants with Division I head coaching experience. Former Nebraska head coach, Mike Anderson brings Omaha-level experience as the hitting coach, while former Bryant and William & Mary skipper Jamie Pinzino takes over as the pitching coach after reaching a NCAA Regional final in 2013. Ryan Connolly joins the staff as the vol-

# **CONFERENCE NOTES**

- The conference season continues for Big 12 teams this weekend with three series on tap. Texas Tech will stay on the road and travel to TCU, while Baylor will host its second-straight league series with Oklahoma State visiting Waco. K-State and Oklahoma open conference play with a series in Manhattan where the Wildcats are 7-0 on the season. The entire OSU-BU series will be on FOX networks.
- The Bears and Jayhawks are each 2-1 in league play after winning series last weekend. The Bears edged Tech by one run in the first two games last weekend and were holding on to a 1-0 lead before the Red Raiders scored seven runs with two outs in the eighth inning to avoid the sweep in Sunday's series finale.
- The Jayhawks used late runs as well to clinch their first series win in Austin since 1996, scoring five in the ninth to clinch the series on Sunday, 6-1. The five runs snapped a streak of 30 consecutive scoreless innings by the UT bullpen.
- Four of the six conference games from last weekend were decided by one run with all but Sunday's games being one-run finals.
- Five league teams enter the week ranked in the top 25 of at least one national poll with the Longhorns appearing in all four, including as high as No. 15 (*Baseball America*). Kansas enters the top 25 for the first time this season with a No. 18 ranking from *Collegiate Baseball*. Oklahoma State sits at No. 20 on two lists, while TCU is 24th (NCBWA) and Texas Tech is 25th (USA Today).
- Seniors Ross Kivett (K-State) and Mark Payton (Texas) are approaching the 100 career RBI marks. Kivett is two shy while Payton needs five more. Payton also extended his active reached base streak to 60 games. It is the second-longest streak in conference history.
- West Virginia has three upperclassmen ranked in the top 10 in the league in batting Ryan McBroom (fifth, .365), Bobby Boyd (tied sixth, .362) and Billy Fleming (ninth, .349).
- After starting the season 1-7, K-State has rattled off 10 wins and is 11-7 entering the sixth week of the season. The K-State starting pitching corps is 8-0 with a 2.73 ERA during the Wildcats' current 10-game winning streak.
- Baylor's Dillon Newman was named the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week, the second straight honor for a BU hurler. With Josh Michalec earning the accolade last week, Baylor claims back-to-back Pitcher of the Week awards for the first time since the 2005 season. Mitch Meyer (K-State) was named Player of the Week while Oklahoma's Sheldon Neuse is the Newcomer of the Week.


