**First Pitch...** Bedlam comes to Norman for the first time since 2011 as the No. 30 Oklahoma baseball team hosts Oklahoma State, Tuesday at 6:00 pm at L. Dale Mitchell Park

**About the Sooners...** Oklahoma claimed its second Big 12 series in as many tries to improve to 4-2 in the league and 20-9 overall. Junior **Mac James** leads the way with a .402 batting average for a team that is hitting .295. Sophomore left fielder **Hunter Haley**, coming off a three-hit day on Sunday, is second on the team at .349. He leads the Sooners with 29 runs, 25 RBI and a .594 slugging percentage. Redshirt-junior RHP **Robert Tasin** is anticipated to make his second start of the season on Tuesday. He is 2-1 with a 3.78 earned run average to go with 13 strikeouts in 16.2 innings. Tasin made his first collegiate start last Tuesday at Oral Roberts.

**On the Air...** Veteran OU broadcasters **Toby Rowland** (play-by-play) and **Chris Plank** (sideline) will call the action on KREF Sports Talk 1400 AM and 98.5 FM. The game will be televised on FOX College Sports-Central with **Chad McKee** (p-b-p) and 10-year MLB veteran **Jay Payton** (color) on the call.

**Road Series Win...** Oklahoma won the first two games of a three-game set at Kansas over the weekend by identical scores of 2-1 before falling in the finale, 4-3. Redshirt-sophomore LHP **Adam Choplick** (3-1) lasted 5.2 innings and scattered four hits, yielding one run, while striking out six in the win on Saturday. Sophomore RHP **Ralph Garza Jr.** picked up his fifth save in relief of Choplick.

**Scouting the Cowboys...** Oklahoma State is 19-9 and 3-3 in the Big 12 after taking two games at home against TCU this weekend. Right fielder **Zach Fish** leads an OSU offense that is hitting .261 with a .333 average. He has belted five home runs and 20 RBI, while first baseman **Tanner Kriete** has a team-high six homers and 21 RBI, but hits just .209. Left-hander **Tyler Nurdin** (1-2) will make his sixth start of the season. He owns a 7.23 ERA and has 12 strikeouts in 18.2 innings of work. The Cowboys started the season 10-1 and are 9-8 since.

### HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

**Shave for the Brave...** On April 3, Oklahoma will join the fight against childhood cancer by hold a "Shave for the Brave" event following practice. Shave for the Brave works in conjunction with the Vs. Cancer Foundation to raise money for cancer research. The event will also serve as an opportunity for the Sooners in their countdown to 19 Ways.

**Third Straight Big 12 Award...** Lorenzana became the third Sooner in as many weeks to earn a Big 12 weekly award as he was named the Co-Player of the Week along with West Virginia's Billy Fleming. Lorenzana hit .474 (9-for-19) over a five-game week and scored five runs, while driving in three with three doubles for a .632 slugging percentage.

**All-Time vs. OSU...** Oklahoma holds a narrow edge over Oklahoma State in the all-time series, 137-130. The Sooners last hosted the Cowboys in Norman in 2011; an 8-3 win for the home team. In that game, left-hander **Dillon Overton** pitched 6.1 innings of scoreless relief to earn the win. Six Sooners recorded multi-hit games, including **Garrett Buechele**, who drove in four runs.

**Last Time They Met...** No. 13 Oklahoma salvaged the series finale, 5-4, against No. 19 Oklahoma State in Oklahoma City on May 12, 2013. Garza claimed the win in 2.2 innings of scoreless relief. **Kolbey Carpenter** went 3-for-4 with two RBI.

**Big 12 Openers...** The Sooners are 8-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-4 win over K-State (3/21/14). OU has won four of its last five conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

**Playing 'em Close...** Oklahoma is 5-1 in one-run games this season. The Sooners lost their first one-run game of the year in a walk-off at Kansas on Sunday. Three of Oklahoma's one-run wins have come in extra innings. In two-run games, OU is 3-3.

**Grand Finale...** Fans were treated to some early fireworks during Friday night's game as Haley drilled a fifth-inning home run over the wall in right. The home run was the fifth of the season for Haley as well as his first career grand slam. It was the first grand slam by a Sooner since **Ricky Eisenberg** against Kansas on May 8, 2011. The next day, James went deep to left for the second OU grand slam of the weekend. James' home run was his third of the season.

**Up Next...** Oklahoma is in non-conference action this weekend with a home series against CSU Bakersfield. Game one is Friday at 6:00 pm.

**Making Some Noise...** Freshman third baseman **Sheldon Neuse** was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Week after batting .529 (9-for-17) in four games. He slugged 1.000 with a .600 on-base percentage. Neuse went 4-for-4 with two doubles against UTA at Globe Life Ballpark in Arlington on Tuesday. He tripled twice on Saturday against Belmont and scored three times.

**Return to the Bigs...** Former Sooner **Jason Bartlett** made the Minnesota Twins out of spring training as a reserve infielder. The nine-year MLB veteran was out of baseball in 2013 and last played in the majors in 2012 for the San Diego Padres, but was limited due to a sprained right knee.

**MAC ATTACK...** James was named the Big 12 Player of the Week, for the week ending March 9, after hitting .684 (13-for-19) in five games. He owned a 1.000 slugging percentage and .714 on-base percentage. James is riding a nine-game hitting streak and finished the weekend with a 4-for-4 day, his second of the season, to go with his second home run of the season. **James was also honored as the Louisville Slugger and NCBWA National Player of the Week.**

**Get the Ladd a Win...** Senior RHP **Kindle Ladd** pitched just 0.1 innings against Kansas State on Saturday, but was credited with the first win of his career. The win came in 49th appearance of his career. He is now 1-0 on the season and 1-2 in his career.

**Double Switch...** Senior **Hector Lorenzana** had started all 75 of his career games at second base before the Abilene Christian series. He has started each of the last nine at short-stop, while juniors **Keach Ballard** and **Joshua Ake** have taken over second. However, in double play situations with a runner on first and less than two outs, the two middle infielders have been trading positions.

**Winning Streaks...** After an opening day loss to Seton Hall, the Sooners rattled off five consecutive wins for their first five-game win streak of the season. OU last won five or more in a row when it won eight, beginning with the 2013 regular season finale at Kansas State and finishing with a win in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional Final against Virginia Tech. Oklahoma had its second five-game win streak of the season snapped against Arkansas-Little Rock (3/19).

**Lords of the Flies...** As of last week, Oklahoma leads the country in sacrifice flies with 21; tied with Kansas State. Redshirt-junior right fielder **Taylor Alspaugh** is the team-leader at five, which is the seventh most in the nation.

**Backup Plan...** The Sooner bullpen is 12-2 with a 2.52 ERA and has recorded 125 strikeouts in 126.2 innings. Oklahoma's bullpen put up a string of 15 straight scoreless innings that was snapped in the eighth inning against Citadel (2/21). For the season, **OU relievers have tossed 93 shutout innings in the 120 complete innings pitched.**

**Crooked Numbers...** On the scoreboard, **Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 44 times** and three or more 26 times. In back-to-back games against K-State, the Sooners scored eight runs in a single inning; setting a new season-high.

**Addition to the Schedule...** The Sooners have added a home game against UTA on Tuesday, April 22 to replace the lost game in Surprise, Ariz. that was rained out. The game time is still to be determined.

**Mac of All Trades...** Against Abilene Christian (3/5), James made his first career start at first base. He has now started at four different positions this season; including catcher, left field and designated hitter.

**On the Hunt for Home Runs...** Haley leads the OU power attack with five home runs and 24 RBI. He is slugging .615, which ranks second on the team. Last season, Haley slugged .389 and hit two home runs in 48 games. **Haley has scored a league-leading 27 runs.**

**Return of the Mac...** James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared

in just nine games, earning nine at-bats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, he has started games at catcher (11), designated hitter (three), left field (four) and first base (six). James is hitting a league-high .432, slugging .648 and has driven in 22 runs.

**Opening the Gates...** Oklahoma's season-opening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

**Who's on First?...** The Sooners have started four different first basemen. Freshman **Niko Buentello** made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. He leads the team with seven starts at first. Sophomore catcher **Anthony Hermelyn** has started four games there, while James and junior **Keach Ballard** have each started one. Freshman **Austin O'Brien** has also appeared at first base off the bench in three games.

**Lineup on Shuffle...** Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. The Sooners have used 20 different starting lineups. Sophomore center fielder **Craig Aikin** was the only player to start each of the first 27 games at the same position.

**Taking First Hacks...** The Sooners are outscoring opponents 27-13 in the

first inning. **Nine times, OU has allowed a first-inning run, but is 7-2 in such contests.** When scoring in the first inning, Oklahoma is 8-3 and is 9-4 when scoring first.

**More Runs=More Wins...** In each of Oklahoma's first seven wins, the Sooners scored at least eight runs. They are 12-0 when scoring eight or more, including a season-high 16 against UAPB (2/18). When scoring five runs or less, OU is 4-6.

**Defending Big 12 Champs...** The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman **Hector Lorenzana** is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

**Freshman All-America Trio...** Oklahoma's core is built around a trifecta of Freshman All-Americans from 2013 in left-hander **Jacob Evans**, catcher **Anthony Hermelyn** and center fielder **Craig Aikin**. Evans took the hill primarily as the Sooner closer as a rookie and notched nine saves along with seven wins with a 2.06 earned run average. Hermelyn hit .275 with 26 RBI, while Aikin owns the highest returning average at .286 with 42 runs and a team-leading 16 stolen bases.

**New Man on the Top Step...** Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman

with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

**Season Openers...** Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

**Opening Day Starter...** Sophomore lefty **Jacob Evans** made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since **Zach Neal** in 2010. Evans is also the third straight lefty to start on opening day, following **Dillon Overton** in 2012 and 2013.

**In the Polls...** Oklahoma entered 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the *USA Today*/ESPN Coaches' Poll, landing three spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches.

**Super Regional...** The Sooners last took the field for the NCAA Baton Rouge Super Regional against LSU. After losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel in game one, Oklahoma was eliminated by the Tigers, 11-1 in game two. Right-hander **Jonathan Gray** tossed 7.1 innings and allowed just two runs, while striking out nine as OU went down in the opener.

**Preseason Poll...** Oklahoma landed fifth in the 2014 Big 12 Preseason Poll as voted on by the league's coaches. The Sooners received 37 points in the poll. The top five spots were separated by only six points. Defending regular season champion Kansas State (56) took the top spot, followed by Oklahoma State (51), TCU (51) and Texas (50).

**MLB Draft Picks...** Six Sooners were taken in the 2013 MLB First Year Player Draft, led by right-hander **Jonathan Gray** being selected overall by the Colorado Rockies, matching the program's highest draft pick with **Bobby Witt** (Texas, 1985). Left-hander **Dillon Overton** was drafted 63rd overall in the second round by the Oakland Athletics and first baseman **Matt Oberste** went 206th to the New York Mets in the seventh round.

**On the Hill...** The OU pitching staff looks to replace nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. The eight pitchers that remain from over a year ago combined to post a 17-7 record and a 3.31 collective ERA.
