First Pitch... Oklahoma baseball is at home for a non-conference series against CSU Bakersfield at L. Dale Mitchell Park this weekend. The series opener is Friday at 6:00 pm.

About the Sooners... Oklahoma is 20-10 overall and 4-2 in the Big 12. Over the last six games, the Sooners are 2-4 and averaging just 1.25 runs per game. Junior Mac James maintains a .400 batting average, while sophomore left fielder Hunter **Haley** is second on the team at .345 and leads the team in both runs and RBI and 29 and 25. The OU pitching staff owns a collective 3.16 earned run average. Sophomore right-hander Ralph Garza Jr. leads the team in both wins and saves at 4-0 and five. He also owns a 0.77 ERA in 23.1 innings to go with 21 strikeouts. Redshirt-sophomore LHP Adam Choplick is 3-1 with a 3.15 ERA, best among starters, and 37 strikeouts in 40 innings.

On the Air... Veteran OU broadcasters Toby Rowland (play-by-play) and Chris Plank (sideline) will call the action on KREF Sports Talk 1400 AM and 98.5 FM. Each game will be televised through Sooner Sports TV on FOX College Sports-Central as well as FSSW+ on Saturday with Chad McKee (p-b-p) and 10-year MLB veteran Jay Payton (color) on the call.

Bedlam in Norman... The Sooners matched a season-low for hits with three against Oklahoma State on Tuesday night. Redshirt-junior RHP Robert Tasin (2-2) took the loss in a 4.1-inning start. He surrendered two solo home runs in the second, but struck out a career-high seven batters. Oklahoma set a season-high with 1,941 in attendance in the first Bedlam game in Norman since 2011.

Scouting the Roadrunners... CSU Bakersfield is 11-16 overall after a 1-2 weekend at Utah Valley and a 6-1 loss to No. 5 Cal Poly on Tuesday. Second baseman Max Carter leads the way with a .358 batting average, while right fielder Chance Gusbeth has driven in a team-high 18 runs to support a .284 average. Left-hander Taylor Aikenhead (4-3) will start for the Roadrunners on Friday night. He holds a 2.91 ERA and has struck out 41 batters across 46.1 innings pitched. The one common opponent the two teams have played is Gonzaga, who Bakersfield fell to, 4-3.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98)

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Shave for the Brave... On Thursday, Oklahoma held its "Shave for the Brave" event to join the fight against childhood cancer. The Sooners, with a goal of \$20,000, raised over \$22,000 through the Vs. Cancer Foundation to raise money for cancer research. Half of the money donated will be dedicated to the OU Children's Hospital. The event also served as an opportunity for the Sooners in their countdown to 19 Ways.

Putting the Ball in Play... The Sooners strike out at the second lowest rate in the Big 12 at 4.63 per game; behind Kansas at 4.45. Mac James has struck out just three times and ranks seventh in the nation in "Toughest to Strikeout" at 34 at-bats per strikeout.

Third Straight Big 12 Award... Lorenzana became the third Sooner in as many weeks to earn a Big 12 weekly award as he was named the Co-Player of the Week along with West Virginia's Billy Fleming. Lorenzana hit .474 (9-for-19) over a five-game week and scored five runs, while driving in three with three doubles for a .632 slugging percent-

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 8-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-4 win over K-State (3/21/14). OU has won four of its last five conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

Playing 'em Close... Oklahoma is 5-1 in one-run games this season. The Sooners lost their first one-run game of the year in a walk-off at Kansas on Sunday. Three of Oklahoma's one-run wins have come in extra innings. In two-run games, OU is 3-3.

Grand Finale... Fans were treated to some early fireworks during Friday night's game as Haley drilled a fifth-inning home run over the wall in right. The home run was the fifth of the season for Haley as well as his first career grand slam. It was the first grand slam by a Sooner since Ricky Eisenberg against Kansas on May 8, 2011. The next day, James went deep to left for the second OU grand slam of the weekend. James' home run was his third of the season.

Up Next... Oklahoma remains at home for an intrastate re-match against Oral Roberts on Tuesday, April 8 at 6:00 pm.

Making Some Noise... Freshman third baseman Sheldon Neuse was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Week after batting .529 (9-for-17) in four games. He slugged 1.000 with a .600 on-base percentage. Neuse went 4-for-4 with two doubles against UTA at Globe Life Ballpark in Arlington on Tuesday. He tripled twice on Saturday against Belmont and scored three times.

Return to the Bigs... Former Sooner Jason Bartlett made the Minnesota Twins out of spring training as a reserve infielder. The nine-year MLB veteran was out of baseball in 2013 and last played in the majors in 2012 for the San Diego Padres, but was limited due to a sprained right knee. Bartlett is one of three former Sooners starting 2014 in MLB along with Greg Dobbs (MIA) and Garrett Richards (LAA).

In the Polls... Oklahoma entered 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the USA Today/ ESPN Coaches' Poll, landing three spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches. The Sooners are currently ranked No. 29 by NCBWA, No. 30 by Collegiate Baseball News and sit one spot out of the USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll Top-25.

MAC ATTACK... James was named the Big 12 Player of the Week, for the week ending March 9, after hitting .684 (13-for-19) in five games. He owned a 1.000 slugging percentage and .714 on-base percentage. James is riding a nine-game hitting streak and finished the weekend with a 4-for-4 day, his second of the season, to go with his second home run of the season. James was also honored as the Louisville Slugger and NCBWA National Player of the Week.

Get the Ladd a Win... Senior RHP Kindle Ladd pitched just 0.1 innings against Kansas State on Saturday, but was credited with the first win of his career. The win came in 49th appearance of his career. He is now 1-0 on the season and 1-2 in his career.

Double Switch... Senior Hector Lorenzana had started all 75 of his career games at second base before the Abilene Christian series. He has started each of the last nine at shortstop, while juniors Keach Ballard and Joshua Ake have taken over second. However, in double play situations with a runner on first and less than two outs, the two middle infielders have been trading positions.

Backup Plan... The Sooner bullpen is 12-2 with a 2.50 ERA and has recorded 129 strikeouts in 133.3 innings. Oklahoma's bullpen put up a string of 15 straight scoreless innings that was snapped in the eighth inning against Citadel (2/21). For the season, OU relievers have tossed 96 shutout innings in the 124 complete innings pitched.

Winning Streaks... After an opening day loss to Seton Hall, the Sooners rattled off five consecutive wins for their first five-game win streak of the season. OU last won five or more in a row when it won eight, beginning with the 2013 regular season finale at Kansas State and finishing with a win in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional Final against Virginia Tech. Oklahoma had its second five-game win streak of the season snapped against Arkansas-Little Rock (3/19).

Lords of the Flies... Oklahoma has dropped to third in the country in sacrifice flies with 22. Kansas State remains in the lead at 25. Redshirtjunior right fielder Taylor Alspaugh is the team-leader at five, which is the eighth most in the nation.

Crooked Numbers... On the scoreboard, Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 44 times and three or more 26 times. In back-toback games against K-State, the Sooners scored eight runs in a single inning; setting a new season-high.

Addition to the Schedule... The Sooners have added a home game against UTA on Tuesday, April 22 to replace the lost game in Surprise, Ariz. that was rained out.

Mac of All Trades... Against Abilene Christian (3/5), James made his first career start at first base. He has now started at four different positions this season; including catcher, left field and designated hitter.

On the Hunt for Home Runs... Haley leads the OU power attack with five home runs and 25 RBI. He is sluging .582, which ranks first on the team. Last season, Haley slugged .389 and hit two home runs in 48 games. Haley has scored a league-leading 27 runs.

Return of the Mac... James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared in just nine games, earning nine atbats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, he has started games at catcher (13), designated hitter (three), left field (seven) and first base (six). James is hitting a leaguehigh .400, slugging .581 and has driven in 22 runs.

Opening the Gates... Oklahoma's season-opening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Who's on First?... The Sooners have started four different first basemen. Freshman Niko Buentello made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. He leads the team with seven starts at first. Sophomore catcher Anthony Hermelyn has started 15 games there, while James and junior Keach Ballard have each started at first. Freshman Austin O'Brien has also appeared at first base off the bench in three games.

Lineup on Shuffle... Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. The Sooners have used 21 different starting lineups. Sophomore center fielder Craig Aikin was the only player to start each of the first 27 games at the same position.

Taking First Hacks... The Sooners are outscoring opponents 27-13 in the first inning. Nine times, OU has allowed a first-inning run, but is 7-2 in such contests. When scoring in the first inning, Oklahoma is 8-3 and is 9-4 when scoring first.

More Runs=More Wins... In each of Oklahoma's first seven wins, the Sooners scored at least eight runs. They are 12-0 when scoring eight or more, including a season-high 16 against UAPB (2/18). When scoring five runs or less, OU is 5-9.

Defending Big 12 Champs... The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman Hector Lorenzana is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

Freshman All-America Trio... Oklahoma's core is built around a trifecta of Freshman All-Americans from 2013 in left-hander Jacob Evans, catcher Anthony Hermelyn and center fielder Craig Aikin. Evans took the hill primarily as the Sooner closer as a rookie and notched nine saves along with seven wins with a 2.06 earned run average. Hermelyn hit .275 with 26 RBI, while Aikin owns the highest returning average at .286 with 42 runs and a team-leading 16 stolen bases.

New Man on the Top Step... Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

Season Openers... Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Opening Day Starter... Sophomore lefty Jacob Evans made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since Zach Neal in 2010. Evans is also the third straight lefty to start on opening day, following Dillon Overton in 2012 and 2013.

Super Regional... The Sooners last took the field for the NCAA Baton Rouge Super Regional against LSU. After losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel in game one, Oklahoma was eliminated by the Tigers, 11-1 in game two. Right-hander Jonathan Gray tossed 7.1 innings and allowed just two runs, while striking out nine as OU went down in the opener.

Preseason Poll... Oklahoma landed fifth in the 2014 Big 12 Preseason Poll as voted on by the league's coaches. The Sooners received 37 points in the poll. The top five spots were separated by only six points. Defending regular season champion Kansas State (56) took the top spot, followed by Oklahoma State (51), TCU (51) and Texas (50).

MLB Draft Picks... Six Sooners were taken in the 2013 MLB First Year Player Draft, led by right-hander Jonathan Gray being selected overall by the Colorado Rockies, matching the program's highest draft pick with Bobby Witt (Texas, 1985). Left-hander Dillon Overton was drafted 63rd overall in the second round by the Oakland Athletics and first baseman Matt Oberste went 206th to the New York Mets in the seventh round.

On the Hill... The OU pitching staff looks to replace nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. The eight pitchers that remain from over a year ago combined to post a 17-7 record and a 3.31 collective ERA.

CONFERENCE NOTES

- All nine Big 12 teams enter April with .500 or higher winning percentages. While West Virginia sits atop the league standings on the young conference season, Texas leads all league teams with a 22-7 overall mark and .759 winning percentage.
- The Longhorns snapped a streak of 12 consecutive series losses in the Big 12 with a 2-1 series win in Lubbock over the weekend a three-game series in which they batted .338 with 44 hits and 20 total runs.
- This weekend's Big 12 series include two in-state matchups with Baylor visiting Texas and Kansas State hosting Kansas. Texas Tech will visit Stillwater as the Red Raiders continue with three of their first four Big 12 series on the road. With TCU hosting WVU, Mountaineer head coach Randy Mazey will return to Fort Worth where he was an assistant from 2007-12.
- Oklahoma and Oklahoma State will meet in the first of five contests this season. The two league teams will face each other in a pair of non-conference games, the first of which is this Tuesday in Norman.
- •TTU'S first conference home series (last weekend vs. UT) on the season was record-breaking as the three-game series total attendance was 12,551, a Rip Griffin Park high. The previous mark was 11,709 against Texas in 2012.
- K-State's Ross Kivett, Big 12 Player of the Week, became the first Wildcat to hit for the cycle in nearly 17 years last week against Nebraska (last done by Heath Schesser on April 30, 1997). It was also the 15th cycle in Big 12 history. Kivett is one of three Wildcats with an active hitting streak of 12 or more games entering the week.
- League teams totaled four walk-off games last week. Oklahoma State had a pair, including a 12th-inning walk-off over Missouri State and a 2-1 victory over TCU on Saturday. WVU also had an extra-inning walk-off in the series opener vs. BU while Kansas avoided a sweep from Oklahoma with a 4-3 win in the last at-bat on Sunday.
- UT has climbed as high as No. 8 in the national rankings (*Baseball America*) and is ranked 11 or higher in all four polls. Oklahoma State (No. 20) and Texas Tech are the league's other two teams in the top 25 this week.
- With a 5-1 win over Texas State last week, UT head coach Augie Garrido surpassed Gordon Gillespie for the most wins (1,894) by any college baseball coach at any level.


