**First Pitch...** First place is on the line as Oklahoma's eight-game homestand continues with a three-game series against No. 7 Texas at L. Dale Mitchell Park. Game one is scheduled for 6:00 pm Friday, April 11.

**About the Sooners...** Oklahoma is 23-11 overall and 4-2 in the Big 12. The Sooner offense came to life over the weekend with a sweep of CSU Bakersfield, but fell to Oral Roberts on Tuesday, 2-0. Junior **Mac James** kept his average above .400 at .403 with 25 RBI and 23 runs. Freshman third baseman **Sheldon Neuse** has driven in a team-high 27 runs and is batting .314. Sophomore left fielder **Hunter Haley** is batting .352 with a league-leading 34 runs scored and 26 driven in. The OU pitching staff has a cumulative 3.05 earned run average and .240 batting average against; both ranking third in the Big 12. Sophomore RHP **Ralph Garza Jr.** is tied for second in the league with seven saves. He also leads the Sooners in wins at 4-0 with a 0.71 ERA.

**On the Air...** Veteran OU broadcasters **Toby Rowland** (play-by-play) and **Chris Plank** (sideline) will call all of the action on KREF Sports Talk 1400 AM and 98.5 FM this weekend. Friday night's game will air on FCSC with **Bruce Haertl** (p-b-p) and **Jay Payton** (color) on the call, while Sunday's game will air of ESPNU with OU alum **Dari Nowkhah** (p-b-p) and **Mike Rooney** bringing the action.

**Midweek Recap...** Oklahoma lost to intrastate rival Oral Roberts for the second time in three weeks on Tuesday night, 2-0. The Sooners out-hit the Golden Eagles, 8-4, but left 10 runners on base. Sophomore LHP **Jacob Evans** struck out a career-high seven in 3.2 innings of relief for OU.

**Scouting the Longhorns...** No. 7 Texas is 26-8 overall and 6-3 in conference play. The Longhorns swept Baylor at home last weekend and had a five-game win streak snapped on Tuesday vs. Rice, 7-2. Texas' weekend rotation owns a combined 1.80 ERA; led by RHP **Nathan Thornhill** (5-0) at 0.73. RHP **Parker French** (4-2) and LHP **Dillon Peters** (4-2) round out the rotation with ERAs of 1.93 and 2.72, respectively. Center fielder **Mark Payton** leads a Longhorn lineup that is hitting just .263 with a .361 average and 25 RBI.

## HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

**Shave for the Brave...** On April 3, Oklahoma held its "Shave for the Brave" event to join the fight against childhood cancer. **The Sooners, with a goal of \$20,000, raised over \$28,000 through the Vs. Cancer Foundation to raise money for cancer research.** Half of the money donated will be dedicated to the OU Children's Hospital. The event also served as an opportunity for the Sooners in their countdown to 19 Ways.

**Putting the Ball in Play...** The Sooners strike out at the second lowest rate in the Big 12 at 4.62 per game; behind Kansas at 4.52. **Mac James has struck out just three times and ranks third in the nation in "Toughest to Strikeout" at 39 at-bats per strikeout.**

**Not-So-Newcomer...** Neuse claimed his second Big 12 Newcomer of the Week award on April 7. He shared the honor with K-State's Tanner DeVinny. Neuse hit .389 (7-for-18) with nine RBI, including two three-run home runs. He slugged .833, stole two bases and pitched one scoreless inning. **Neuse's eight RBI in game two of the weekend marked the most RBI in a game for a Sooner since Chris Ebright had nine vs. Oklahoma City (3/28/87).**

**All-Time vs. Texas...** Oklahoma trails the all-time series to Texas, 125-44-2. Since becoming members of the Big 12 in 1997, the Longhorns hold a 33-12 advantage. From 2008-12, the Sooners won just twice in 16 tries before winning the series in Austin in 2013.

**Last Time They Met...** The Sooners took their first Texas series since 1998 with wins of 2-1 and 4-2. **Jonathan Gray** set the tone on Friday night with 6.2 innings of one-run ball and was backed by an RBI hit from **Anthony Hermelyn** as well as a **Matt Oberste** sac-fly to get the win. Texas won on Saturday, 1-0, despite eight strong-innings from **Dillon Overton**. OU claimed the series on Friday, erasing a one-run lead in the eighth, to take its first series in Austin since 1997. **Jack Mayfield** and **Max White** each recorded a three-hit day, while **Hector Lorenzana** drove in a pair.

**Big 12 Openers...** The Sooners are 8-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-4 win over K-State (3/21/14). OU has won four of its last five conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

**Playing 'em Close...** Oklahoma is 6-1 in one-run games this season. The Sooners lost their first one-run game of the year in a walk-off at Kansas (3/30/14). Three of Oklahoma's one-run wins have come in extra innings. In two-run games, OU is 4-4.

**Up Next...** Bedlam resumes on Tuesday, April 15 as the Sooners head to Stillwater to take on the Cowboys in a 6:30 pm non-conference tilt.

**Grand Finale...** Fans were treated to some early fireworks during a March 21 win over K-State as Haley drilled a fifth-inning home run over the wall in right. The home run was the fifth of the season for Haley as well as his first career grand slam. It was the first grand slam by a Sooner since **Ricky Eisenberg** against Kansas on May 8, 2011. The next day, James went deep to left for the second OU grand slam of the weekend. James' home run was his third of the season.

**Making Some Noise...** Freshman third baseman **Sheldon Neuse** was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Week on March 17, after batting .529 (9-for-17) in four games. He slugged 1.000 with a .600 on-base percentage. Neuse went 4-for-4 with two doubles against UTA at Globe Life Ballpark in Arlington on Tuesday. He tripled twice on Saturday against Belmont and scored three times.

**Return to the Bigs...** Former Sooner **Jason Bartlett** made the Minnesota Twins out of spring training as a reserve infielder. The nine-year MLB veteran was out of baseball in 2013 and last played in the majors in 2012 for the San Diego Padres, but was limited due to a sprained right knee. **Bartlett is one of three former Sooners starting 2014 in MLB along with Greg Dobbs (MIA) and Garrett Richards (LAA).**

**In the Polls...** Oklahoma entered 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the *USA Today*/ESPN Coaches' Poll, landing three spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches. The Sooners are currently ranked No. 28 by NCBWA, No. 26 by *Collegiate Baseball News* and sit two spots out of the *USA Today*/ESPN Coaches' Poll Top-25.

**MAC ATTACK...** James was named the Big 12 Player of the Week, on March 10, after hitting .684 (13-for-19) in five games. He slugged 1.000 and held a .714 on-base percentage. James finished the weekend with a 4-for-4 day, his second of the season, to go with his second home run of the season. **James was also honored as the Louisville Slugger and NCBWA National Player of the Week.**

**Get the Ladd a Win...** Senior RHP **Kindle Ladd** pitched just 0.1 innings against Kansas State (3/22), but was credited with the first win of his career. The win came in 49th appearance of his career. He is now 2-1 on the season and 2-3 in his career.

**Double Switch...** Senior **Hector Lorenzana** had started all 75 of his career games at second base before the Abilene Christian series. He has started each of the last nine at short-stop, while juniors **Keach Ballard** and **Joshua Ake** have taken over second. However, in double play situations with a runner on first and less than two outs, the two middle infielders have been trading positions.

**Backup Plan...** The Sooner bullpen is 15-2 with a 2.22 ERA and has recorded 148 strikeouts in 150.1 innings. Oklahoma's bullpen has pitched a season-best 19 shutout innings since the seventh inning against Oklahoma State (4/1). For the season, **OU relievers have tossed 112 shutout innings in the 140 complete innings pitched.**

**Winning Streaks...** After an opening day loss to Seton Hall, the Sooners rattled off five consecutive wins for their first five-game win streak of the season. OU last won five or more in a row when it won eight, beginning with the 2013 regular season finale at Kansas State and finishing with a win in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional Final against Virginia Tech. Oklahoma had its second five-game win streak of the season snapped against Arkansas-Little Rock (3/19).

**Lords of the Flies...** Oklahoma has dropped to fourth in the country in sacrifice flies with 24. Kansas State remains in the lead at 25. Redshirt-junior right fielder **Taylor Alspaugh** is the team-leader at six, which is the sixth most in the nation.

**Crooked Numbers...** On the scoreboard, **Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 50 times** and three or more 29 times. The Sooners scored a season-high 10 runs in the seventh inning in game one of a doubleheader vs. CSU Bakersfield (4/5/14), highlighted by three-run homers by Neuse and **Austin O'Brien**.

**Mac of All Trades...** Against Abilene Christian (3/5), James made his first career start at first base. He has now started at four different positions this season; including catcher, left field and designated hitter.

**On the Hunt for Home Runs...** Haley leads the OU power attack with five home runs and 26 RBI. He is slugging .608, which ranks first on the team. Last season, Haley slugged .389 and hit two home runs in 48 games. **Haley has scored a league-leading 34 runs.**

**Return of the Mac...** James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared in just nine games, earning nine at-bats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, he has started games at catcher (14), designated hitter (three), left field (nine) and first base (seven). James is hitting a league-high .402, slugging .573 and has driven in 25 runs.

**Opening the Gates...** Oklahoma's season-opening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

**Who's on First?...** The Sooners have started five different first basemen. Freshman **Niko Buentello** made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. He leads the team with seven starts at first. Sophomore catcher **Anthony Hermelyn** has started 15 games there, while James and junior **Keach Ballard** have each started at first. Freshman **Austin O'Brien** made his first career start at first vs. CSU Bakersfield (4/5).

**Lineup on Shuffle...** Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. **The Sooners have used 22 different starting lineups.** Sophomore center fielder **Craig Aikin** was the only player to start each of the first 27 games at the same position.

**Taking First Hacks...** The Sooners are outscoring opponents 27-14 in the first inning. **Ten times, OU has allowed a first-inning run, but is 8-2 in such contests.** When scoring in the first inning, Oklahoma is 8-3 and is 10-4 when scoring first.

**More Runs=More Wins...** In each of Oklahoma's first seven wins, the Sooners scored at least eight runs. They are 13-0 when scoring eight or more, including a season-high 17 against CSU Bakersfield (4/5). When scoring five runs or less, OU is 8-10.

**Defending Big 12 Champs...** The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament

Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman **Hector Lorenzana** is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

**Freshman All-America Trio...** Oklahoma's core is built around a trifecta of Freshman All-Americans from 2013 in left-hander **Jacob Evans**, catcher **Anthony Hermelyn** and center fielder **Craig Aikin**. Evans took the hill primarily as the Sooner closer as a rookie and notched nine saves along with seven wins with a 2.06 earned run average. Hermelyn hit .275 with 26 RBI, while Aikin owns the highest returning average at .286 with 42 runs and a team-leading 16 stolen bases.

**New Man on the Top Step...** Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

**Season Openers...** Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

**Opening Day Starter...** Sophomore lefty **Jacob Evans** made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since **Zach Neal** in 2010. Evans is also the third straight lefty to start on opening day, following **Dillon Overton** in 2012 and 2013.

**Super Regional...** The Sooners last took the field for the NCAA Baton Rouge Super Regional against LSU. After losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel in game one, Oklahoma was eliminated by the Tigers, 11-1 in game two. Right-hander **Jonathan Gray** tossed 7.1 innings and allowed just two runs, while striking out nine as OU went down in the opener.

**Preseason Poll...** Oklahoma landed fifth in the 2014 Big 12 Preseason Poll as voted on by the league's coaches. The Sooners received 37 points in the poll. The top five spots were separated by only six points. Defending regular season champion Kansas State (56) took the top spot, followed by Oklahoma State (51), TCU (51) and Texas (50).

## CONFERENCE NOTES

• Winners of 11 of their last 12 and ranked in the top 10 of all four national polls, the Longhorns lead the Big 12 with a 6-3 conference mark after a weekend sweep of Baylor. UT is ranked as high as No. 7 nationally and leads the Big 12 and is tied for fourth nationally with a 1.98 ERA

• UT meets second-place Oklahoma this weekend in Norman after a midweek contest against 20th-ranked Rice. OU has won its two conference series on the year - vs. K-State and at Kansas - and leads the league in batting average and ERA for Big 12-only contests. Sunday's game will be featured on ESPN.

• In other conference action this weekend, TCU, which earned its first sweep in Big 12 play last week at home against West Virginia, will visit KU, which is coming off a series win over the Wildcats - a feat the Jayhawks had not accomplished since 2008. 18th-ranked Oklahoma State will make its first trip to Morgantown., while K-State will visit Texas Tech.

• TCU became the first team to earn the Big 12 Player and Pitcher of the Week honors in the same week this season with Derek Odell claiming the player honor and Preston Morrison taking the pitcher accolade.

• OU freshman Sheldon Neuse recorded a Big 12 season-high eight RBI and 11 total bases on Saturday against CSU Bakersfield. Neuse shares this week's Big 12 Newcomer of the Week honor with Tanner DeVinny.

• TCU junior Brandon Finnegan ranks second nationally with 80 strikeouts, which is also 29 more than the second-place leader in the Big 12, while BU's Josh Michalec is second nationally in saves. His 11 on the year is nine shy of the Big 12 record for a single-season (20, Jeff Bajenaru, Oklahoma, 1999).

• Eight of the nine Big 12 teams enter the week with winning percentages, including six above .600.

• Along with the Longhorns, OSU is also ranked nationally with a No. 18 and No. 19 spot entering the week. The Sooners are 26th by *Collegiate Baseball* and 28th by the NCBWA, while TTU is 30th on the NCBWA list.

• Tech and TCU are the only Big 12 programs to rank among the top five in the Big 12 in hitting, pitching and defense.

• Five Big 12 programs rank in the top 50 nationally for average attendance - 6. Texas, 13. TCU, 18. K-State, 25. Texas Tech and 26. Baylor.
