First Pitch... The Oklahoma baseball team snapped a four-game slide on Tuesday night and now returns home for a three-game Big 12 set against West Virginia. The series gets underway Thursday night at 6:00 pm.

About the Sooners... Oklahoma improved to 24-14 overall with a wild 12-9 victory at Oklahoma State in 18 innings on Tuesday night. The Sooners have three hitters above .300 in the lineup, led by junior **Mac James** at .372 with 27 RBI and 25 runs. Sophomore left fielder **Hunter Haley** is second at .315 with a team-high 36 runs and 26 RBI, while freshman third baseman **Sheldon Neuse** rounds out the group with a .306 average and 30 runs and a team-leading 31 RBI. Each hold a slugging percentage of .500 or better.

On the Air... Veteran OU broadcasters **Toby Rowland** (play-by-play) and **Chris Plank** (sideline) will call the games on KREF Sports Talk 1400 AM and 98.5 FM. Sooner Sports TV will broadcast each game on FOX College Sports-Central as well as FOX Sports Oklahoma on Saturday. **Chad McKee** (p-b-p) will work the first two games, while **Bruce Haertl** will fill in on Saturday. **Jay Payton** (color) and **Jessica Coody** (sideline) will also work the broadcasts.

Bedlam Personified... Ten minutes past minute, **Kolbey Carpenter** ripped a double to left that scored the go-ahead run in the top of the 18th as Oklahoma pulled away for a 12-9 win over No. 13 Oklahoma State on the road Tuesday night. **The win was the longest game in OU history and first in Stillwater since 1992.** RHP **Kindle Ladd** (3-1) pitched brilliantly in relief; scattering two hits and two walks, while striking out four over six innings of shutout relief. In the 18th, **Austin O'Brien** drew a one-out walk to start the rally and scored the game-winning run. **Hector Lorenzana** and **Craig Aikin** added RBI singles to push the score to 12-9. Neuse moved to the mound for the bottom of the 18th and worked around a walk to record the first save of his career. In what felt like a different game, the Sooners jumped out to an early lead on a first-inning grand slam by O'Brien. After the Cowboys hit two homers in the first, Oklahoma answered with four more runs in the second. OU led 9-4 after a Carpenter homer in the seventh.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Mountaineers... West Virginia is 17-15 overall and 2-6 in the Big 12. As a team, the Mountaineers are only batting .274, but three players are hitting above .340. Center fielder **Bobby Boyd** (.353) leads the way with 31 runs and 14 stolen bases. First baseman **Ryan McBroom** (.352) has slugged six homers and notched 36 RBI, while second baseman **Billy Fleming** (.349) owns a team-high .420 on-base percentage. Defending conference Pitcher of the Year, left-hander **Harrison Musgrave** (3-2) holds a 1.73 earned run average and has 56 strikeouts in 62.1 innings of work. Musgrave will start on Friday, while LHP **John Means** (4-1) and RHP **Sean Carley** (5-1) will start on Thursday and Saturday, respectively.

Shave for the Brave... On April 3, Oklahoma held its "Shave for the Brave" event to join the fight against childhood cancer. **The Sooners, with a goal of \$20,000, raised over \$28,000 through the Vs. Cancer Foundation to raise money for cancer research.** Half of the money donated will be dedicated to the OU Children's Hospital. The event also served as an opportunity for the Sooners in their countdown to 19 Ways.

Putting the Ball in Play... The Sooners strike out at the lowest rate in the Big 12 at 4.68 per game; taking over the lead from Kansas at 4.81. **Mac James has struck out just five times and ranks fifth in the nation in "Toughest to Strikeout" at 32.5 at-bats per strikeout.**

Not-So-Newcomer... Neuse claimed his second Big 12 Newcomer of the Week award on April 7. He shared the honor with K-State's Tanner DeVinny. Neuse hit .389 (7-for-18) with nine RBI, including two three-run home runs. He slugged .833, stole two bases and pitched one scoreless inning. **Neuse's eight RBI in game two of the weekend marked the most RBI in a game for a Sooner since Chris Ebright had nine vs. Oklahoma City (3/28/87).**

All-Time vs. WVU... Oklahoma faced West Virginia for the first time in 2012 at the NIKE Invitational in Eugene, Ore. and registered a 5-2 victory. In 2013, the Mountaineers joined the Big 12 conference and claimed a home series over the Sooners to tie the all-time series, 2-2.

Last Time They Met... **Jonathan Gray** and **Musgrave** went toe-to-toe in the opener and the Sooners came out on top in the 10th, 4-3. Aikin drove in the go-ahead run for Oklahoma in the 10th. The Mountaineers earned the series win by scores of 9-3 and 9-6 over the next two days. Aikin finished the series 5-for-11 at the plate. In the finale, **Jack Mayfield** went 5-for-5 with three RBI, one run and a double.

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 8-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-4 win over K-State (3/21/14). OU has won four of its last five conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

Playing 'em Close... Oklahoma is 6-1 in one-run games this season. The Sooners lost their first one-run game of the year in a walk-off at Kansas (3/30/14). Three of Oklahoma's one-run wins have come in extra innings. In two-run games, OU is 4-6.

Up Next... Oklahoma added a home game against UT-Arlington on Tuesday, April 22 at 6:00 pm. The game was added to the schedule to replace a rained out game against Arizona State on March 1.

Pack The Dale... Oklahoma set a series record in attendance vs. Texas (4/11-13) with a three-game total of 7,269. The previous high was 6,689 against Texas in 2004. **On April 12, the Sooners hosted the second largest crowd in program history with 4,102 in attendance.** Oklahoma has had four-figure attendance figures in 11 home games and are averaging 1,122 per game.

Backup Plan... The Sooner bullpen is 16-3 with a 2.42 ERA and has recorded 168 strikeouts in 182.1 innings. Oklahoma's bullpen pitched a season-best 24 shutout innings (4/1-11). For the season, **OU relievers have tossed 134 shutout innings in the 171 complete innings pitched.**

Return to the Bigs... Former Sooner **Jason Bartlett** made the Minnesota Twins out of spring training as a reserve infielder. The nine-year MLB veteran was out of baseball in 2013 and last played in the majors in 2012 for the San Diego Padres, but was limited due to a sprained right knee. **Bartlett is one of three former Sooners starting 2014 in MLB along with Greg Dobbs (MIA) and Garrett Richards (LAA).** Right-hander **Daniel McCutchen** was recalled by the Texas Rangers on April 7, but designated for assignment on April 14, after spending 2013 in AAA.

Get the Ladd a Win... Senior RHP **Kindle Ladd** pitched just 0.1 innings against Kansas State (3/22), but was credited with the first win of his career. The win came in 49th appearance of his career. He is now 3-1 on the season and 3-3 in his career.

In the Polls... Oklahoma entered 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the *USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll*, landing three spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches. The Sooners are currently out of the polls, but have received votes in both the *USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll* and NCBWA Top-30.

MAC ATTACK... James was named the Big 12 Player of the Week, on March 10, after hitting .684 (13-for-19) in five games. He slugged 1.000 and held a .714 on-base percentage. James finished the weekend with a 4-for-4 day, his second of the season, to go with his second home run of the season. **James was also honored as the Louisville Slugger and NCBWA National Player of the Week.**

Grand Finale... Fans were treated to some early fireworks during a March 21 win over K-State as Haley drilled a fifth-inning home run over the wall in right. The home run was the fifth of the season for Haley as well as his first career grand slam. It was the first grand slam by a Sooner since **Ricky Eisenberg** against Kansas on May 8, 2011. The next day, James went deep to left for the second OU grand slam of the weekend. James' home run was his third of the season.

Making Some Noise... Freshman third baseman **Sheldon Neuse** was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Week on March 17, after batting .529 (9-for-17) in four games. He slugged 1.000 with a .600 on-base percentage. Neuse went 4-for-4 with two doubles against UTA at Globe Life Ballpark in Arlington on Tuesday. He tripled twice on Saturday against Belmont and scored three times.

Double Switch... Senior **Hector Lorenzana** had started all 75 of his career games at second base before the Abilene Christian series. Beginning with the 10th game of the season, he has started each at shortstop, while juniors **Keach Ballard** and **Joshua Ake** have taken over second. However, in double play situations with a runner on first and less than two outs, the middle infielders trade positions.

Winning Streaks... After an opening day loss to Seton Hall, the Sooners rattled off five consecutive wins for their first five-game win streak of the season. OU last won five or more in a row when it won eight, beginning with the 2013 regular season finale at Kansas State and finishing with a win in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional Final against Virginia Tech. Oklahoma had its second five-game win streak of the season snapped against Arkansas-Little Rock (3/19).

Lords of the Flies... Oklahoma has dropped to eighth in the country in sacrifice flies with 25. Kansas State remains in the lead at 29. Redshirt-junior right fielder **Taylor Alspaugh** is the team-leader at six, which is the eighth most in the nation.

Crooked Numbers... On the scoreboard, **Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 55 times** and three or more 33 times. The Sooners scored a season-high 10 runs in the seventh inning in game one of a doubleheader vs. CSU Bakersfield (4/5/14), highlighted by three-run homers by Neuse and **Austin O'Brien**.

Lineup on Shuffle... Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. **The Sooners have used 25 different starting lineups.** Center fielder **Craig Aikin** was the only player to start each of the first 27 games at the same position.

Mac of All Trades... Against Abilene Christian (3/5), James made his first career start at first base. He has now started at four different positions this season; including catcher, left field and designated hitter. James made his debut at third base late in the game against Texas (4/13).

On the Hunt for Home Runs... Haley leads the OU power attack with five home runs and 26 RBI. He is slugging .608, which ranks first on the team. Last season, Haley slugged .389 and hit two home runs in 48 games. **Haley has scored a league-leading 36 runs.**

Return of the Mac... James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared in just nine games, earning nine at-bats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, he has started games at catcher, designated hitter, left field and first base.

Opening the Gates... Oklahoma's season-opening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Who's on First?... The Sooners have started five different first basemen. Freshman **Niko Buentello** made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. He leads the team with seven starts at first. Sophomore catcher **Anthony Hermelyn** has started 15 games there, while James and junior **Keach Ballard** have each started at first. Freshman **Austin O'Brien** made his first career start at first vs. CSU Bakersfield (4/5). Sophomore **Kolbey Carpenter** became the sixth Sooner to start at first when he did so against Texas (4/12). It was his first start at first since facing Dallas Baptist (4/30/13).

More Runs=More Wins... In each of Oklahoma's first seven wins, the Sooners scored at least eight runs. They are 13-1 when scoring eight or more, including a season-high 17 against CSU Bakersfield (4/5). The only loss with eight or more came vs. Texas (4/11). When scoring five runs or less, OU is 8-12.

Defending Big 12 Champs... The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman **Hector Lorenzana** is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

New Man on the Top Step... Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

Season Openers... Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Opening Day Starter... Sophomore lefty **Jacob Evans** made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since **Zach Neal** in 2010. Evans is also the third straight lefty to start on opening day, following **Dillon Overton** in 2012 and 2013.

Big 12 Tournament... The 2014 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship will be held at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City, May 21-25.

CONFERENCE NOTES

- Texas was one of three teams to sweep a Big 12 series on the weekend. UT hit .310 and scored 25 runs in the series win at Oklahoma. The Horns have won 10 straight in Norman and pushed their conference record to 9-3 to remain atop the league standings. Texas ranks first in the league in batting (.284) and ERA (2.43) in Big 12-only contests.

- For the second week in a row, UT remains ranked in the top 10 of all four national polls, including its highest ranking of the year - No. 4 by *Collegiate Baseball*. Oklahoma State is ranked as high as No. 13 while Texas Tech is ranked as high as No. 24. Oklahoma and TCU are receiving votes.

- Texas Tech swept Kansas State in Lubbock and surpassed its win total and home win total from a year ago with the three wins on the weekend. The 28-11 record is its best mark through 39 games since 1999.

- Oklahoma State also recorded a sweep, taking the series from the Mountaineers in Morgantown. The Cowboys sit in second-place in the league standings and are winners of five straight. Closer Brendan McCurry notched his 17th career save on Sunday, which ties the senior right-hander with Jordy Mercer for the top spot on the Cowboys' all-time list.

- Mark Payton (Texas) and Bryant Bureson (Texas Tech) each recorded three doubles on Sunday in their respective contests while Kansas' Connor McKay totaled four home runs last week, including three on Saturday during the Jayhawks' DH vs. TCU.

- With four more conference victories, UT head coach Augie Garrido will have totaled 300 Big 12 wins in his career. Garrido will be the only league coach to achieve the feat. Garrido has coached UT during its entire time in the Big 12 and has a league record of 296-175-1.

- With three stolen bases last week, K-State senior Ross Kivett entered the Big 12 career top 10 for steals. With 72, Kivett sits in ninth place.

- Three league teams rank in the top 10 nationally in sacrifice bunts - UT (1st), KU (6th) and OSU (8th).

- Five conference teams rank in the top 26 in the nation in average attendance - 6. Texas, 14. TCU, 17. K-State, 24. Baylor, and 26. Texas Tech.

- Five weekend conference series remain on the schedule before the 2014 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City. All-session and weekend session tickets are on sale through the RedHawks box office and Big12Sports.com.
