First Pitch... The Oklahoma baseball team ends a string of 12 home games over its last 13 with a non-conference tilt against Texas-Arlington at L. Dale Mitchell Park at 6:00 pm on Tuesday night. Admission to the game is free.

About the Sooners... Oklahoma improved to 25-16 overall and 5-7 in the Big 12. The Sooners have three hitters above .300 in the lineup, led by junior Mac James at .374 with 32 RBI and 27 runs. Freshman third baseman Sheldon Neuse is second at .307 with a team-high 26 extra-base hits to go with 32 runs and 31 RBI. Sophomore left fielder Hunter Haley is hitting .306 and snapped a 0-for-18 stretch with his team-leading sixth home run on Saturday. He has scored a team-high 37 runs and driven in 27.

On the Air... Veteran OU broadcaster Toby Rowland will handle all of the play-by-play on KREF Sports Talk 1400 AM and 98.5 FM. Each game will be broadcast on the FOX family of networks, including Saturday's game on FOX College Sports-Central with Brett Dolan (p-b-p) and OU alum George Frazier (color) on the call.

Midweek Recap... Oklahoma scored twice in the eighth and ninth innings, but ultimately fell short against Texas-Arlington, 6-5, at home on Tuesday night. The Sooners had the potential game-tying and winning runs on base when the game ended. Sophomore center fielder Craig Aikin went 2-for-3 with a walk a matched his career-high with three runs scored. Neuse was just 1-for-5 at the plate, but drove in both runs in the bottom of the ninth after pitching a perfect top of the ninth in his fifth pitching appearance of the season.

Scouting the Red Raiders... Texas Tech is rolling along at 32-13 overall, 8-7 in the league and at No. 21 in the USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll. xxx Eric Gutierrez is batting a team-high .329 with seven home runs, 37 RBI amd 36 runs. xxx Adam Kirsch is hitting .298 with six homer, 35 RBI and 27 runs. Right-hander Ryan Moseley (1-1) is scheduled to make his second start of the year on Friday night. He owns a 2.30 ERA in 31.1 innings of work. Lefthanders Chris Sadberry (3-1) and Dylan Dusek (5-0) round out the rotation. Sadberry holds a 2.47 ERA, while Dusek leads the team at 2.31.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98)

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

All-Time vs. Tech... Oklahoma leads the alltime series with Texas Tech, 48-28-1, dating back to a 3-0 win for the Sooners in 1976. Oklahoma has won five of the last six and nine of the last 11 match-ups, including three wins in four tries in 2013.

Last Time They Met... Dillon Overton earned the win in five innings of work, while striking out five and Max White went 3-for-5 at the plate as OU shutout TTU, 8-0, in the second game of pool play at the 2013 Big 12 Championship in Oklahoma City. The Sooners held a narrow 1-0 lead after seven innings before pouring in two in the eighth and five in the ninth as they totaled 13 hits on the day to the Red Raiders' four. Matt Oberste and Kolbey Carpenter each drove in two runs.

Bedlam Personified... Ten minutes past minute, Kolbey Carpenter ripped a double to left that scored the go-ahead run in the top of the 18th as Oklahoma pulled away for a 12-9 win over No. 13 Oklahoma State on the road Tuesday night. The win was the longest game in OU history and first in Stillwater since 1992. RHP Kindle Ladd (3-1) pitched brilliantly in relief; scattering two hits and two walks, while striking out four over six innings of shutout relief. In the 18th, Austin O'Brien drew a one-out walk to start the rally and scored the game-winning run.

Shave for the Brave... On April 3, Oklahoma held its "Shave for the Brave" event to join the fight against childhood cancer. **The** Sooners, with a goal of \$20,000, raised over \$28,000 through the Vs. Cancer Foundation to raise money for cancer research. Half of the money donated will be dedicated to the OU Children's Hospital. The event also served as an opportunity for the Sooners in their countdown to 19 Ways.

Putting the Ball in Play... The Sooners strike out at the second lowest rate in the Big 12 at 4.80 per game; trailing Kansas at 4.79. Mac James has struck out just six times and ranks seventh in the nation in "Toughest to Strikeout" at 24.5 at-bats per strikeout. Senior shortstop **Hector Lorenzana** ranks second on the team at 12.5.

Not-So-Newcomer... Neuse claimed his second Big 12 Newcomer of the Week award on April 7. He shared the honor with K-State's Tanner DeVinny. Neuse hit .389 (7-for-18) with nine RBI, including two threerun home runs. He slugged .833, stole two bases and pitched one scoreless inning. Neuse's eight RBI in game two of the weekend marked the most RBI in a game for a Sooner since Chris Ebright had nine vs. Oklahoma City (3/28/87).

Louisville Slugger Nat'l Player of the Week: C/1B-Mac James (3/10) *Up Next...* Oklahoma plays its final home non-conference game of the season when it hosts Dallas Baptist at L. Dale Mitchell Park at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, April 29.

Back-To-Back Jacks... Last Saturday, James and Haley hit back-to-back home runs in the bottom of the first to give OU and early 3-0 lead. It marked the second set of back-to-back home runs for the Sooners on the season. Neuse and **Anthony Hermelyn** previously did so against Seton Hall (2/15/14).

#YardWork... Oklahoma has hit 23 home runs in 42 games, including 19 in the friendly confines of L. Dale Mitchell Park. Haley has hit a teamhigh six, while James and Neuse have added five and four, respectively. Each home run hit this season by Haley and Neuse have come in home games.

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 8-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-4 win over K-State (3/21/14). OU has won four of its last five conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

Playing 'em Close... Oklahoma is 6-2 in one-run games this season. The Sooners lost their first one-run game of the year in a walk-off at Kansas (3/30/14). Three of Oklahoma's one-run wins have come in extra innings. In two-run games, OU is 5-6.

Pack The Dale... Oklahoma set a series record in attendance vs. Texas (4/11-13) with a three-game total of 7,269. The previous high was 6,689 against Texas in 2004. On April 12, the Sooners hosted the second largest crowd in program history with 4,102 in attendance. Oklahoma has had four-figure attendance figures in 11 home games and are averaging 1,122 per game.

Backup Plan... The Sooner bullpen is 17-4 with a 2.73 ERA and has recorded 180 strikeouts in 194.1 innings. Oklahoma's bullpen pitched a season-best 24 shutout innings (4/1-11). For the season, OU relievers have tossed 138 shutout innings in the 182 complete innings pitched.

In the Polls... Oklahoma entered 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the USA Today/ ESPN Coaches' Poll, landing three

spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches. The Sooners are currently out of the polls, but have received votes in both the *USA Today*/ESPN Coaches' Poll and NCBWA Top-30.

Return to the Bigs... Former Sooner Jason Bartlett made the Minnesota Twins out of spring training as a reserve infielder. The nine-year MLB veteran was out of baseball in 2013 and last played in the majors in 2012 for the San Diego Padres, but was limited due to a sprained right knee. Bartlett is one of three former Sooners starting 2014 in MLB along with Greg Dobbs (MIA) and Garrett Richards (LAA). Right-hander Daniel McCutchen was recalled by the Texas Rangers on April 7, but designated for assisgnment on April 14, after spending 2013 in AAA.

Get the Ladd a Win... Senior RHP Kindle Ladd pitched just 0.1 innings against Kansas State (3/22), but was credited with the first win of his career. The win came in 49th appearance of his career. He is now 3-2 on the season and 3-4 in his career.

MAC ATTACK... James was named the Big 12 Player of the Week, on March 10, after hitting .684 (13-for-19) in five games. He slugged 1.000 and held a .714 on-base percentage. James finished the weekend with a 4-for-4 day, his second of the season, to go with his second home run of the season. James was also honored as the Louisville Slugger and NCBWA National Player of the Week.

Grand Finale... Fans were treated to some early fireworks during a March 21 win over K-State as Haley drilled a fifth-inning home run over the wall in right. The home run was the fifth of the season for Haley as well as his first career grand slam. It was the first grand slam by a Sooner since Ricky

Eisenberg against Kansas on May 8, 2011. The next day, James went deep to left for the second OU grand slam of the weekend. James' home run was his third of the season.

Making Some Noise... Freshman third baseman Sheldon Neuse was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Week on March 17, after batting .529 (9-for-17) in four games. He slugged 1.000 with a .600 on-base percentage. Neuse went 4-for-4 with two doubles against UTA at Globe Life Ballpark in Arlington on Tuesday. He tripled twice on against Belmont (3/15) and scored three times.

Winning Streaks... After an opening day loss to Seton Hall, the Sooners rattled off five consecutive wins for their first five-game win streak of the season. OU last won five or more in a row when it won eight, beginning with the 2013 regular season finale at Kansas State and finishing with a win in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional Final against Virginia Tech. Oklahoma had its second five-game win streak of the season snapped against Arkansas-Little Rock (3/19).

Lords of the Flies... Oklahoma has dropped to eighth in the country in sacrifice flies with 27. Kansas State remains in the lead of the Big 12 at 29. Redshirt-junior right fielder Taylor Alspaugh is the team-leader at six, which is the 15th most in the nation.

Crooked Numbers... On the scoreboard, Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 55 times and three or more 33 times. The Sooners scored a season-high 10 runs in the seventh inning in game one of a doubleheader vs. CSU Bakersfield (4/5/14), highlighted by three-run homers by Neuse and Austin O'Brien.

Lineup on Shuffle... Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. The Sooners have used 28 different starting lineups. Center fielder Craig Aikin was the only player to start each of the first 27 games at the same position.

Mac of All Trades... Against Abilene Christian (3/5), James made his first career start at first base. He has now started at four different positions this season; including catcher, left field and designated hitter. James made his debut at third base late in the game against Texas (4/13).

Out of the Bullpen... Sophomore right-hander Ralph Garza Jr. has made the trip from the bullpen to the mound a familiar one. He is fourth in the nation in appearances at 25 this season. Garza has locked down seven saves, which ranks 50th, and leads the team in wins with a 5-1 record.

Return of the Mac... James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared in just nine games, earning nine at-bats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, he has started games at catcher, designated hitter, left field and first base.

Opening the Gates... Oklahoma's seasonopening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face

William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Who's on First?... The Sooners have started five different first basemen. Freshman Niko Buentello made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. He leads the team with seven starts at first. Sophomore catcher Anthony Hermelyn has started 15 games there, while James and junior Keach Ballard have each started at first. Freshman Austin O'Brien made his first career start at first vs. CSU Bakersfield (4/5). Sophomore Kolbey Carpenter became the sixth Sooner to start at first when he did so against Texas (4/12). It was his first start at first since facing Dallas Baptist (4/30/13).

More Runs=More Wins... In each of Oklahoma's first seven wins, the Sooners scored at least eight runs. They are 13-1 when scoring eight or more, including a season-high 17 against CSU Bakersfield (4/5). The only loss with eight or more came vs. Texas (4/11). When scoring five runs or less, OU is 8-12.

Defending Big 12 Champs... The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman Hector Lorenzana is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

New Man on the Top Step... Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

Season Openers... Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Opening Day Starter... Sophomore lefty Jacob Evans made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since Zach Neal in 2010. Evans is also the third straight lefty to start on opening day, following Dillon Overton in 2012 and 2013.

CONFERENCE NOTES

- The Big 12 is second in the nation in conference RPI and has nine teams in the NCAA RPI top 75 as of April 15 3. Texas, 10. Texas Tech, 34. TCU, 53. West Virginia, 60. Kansas, 61. K-State, 70. Oklahoma State, 73. Baylor. Oklahoma maintains an RPI of 87.
- Oklahoma State and TCU joined Texas in this week's Baseball America rankings. The Horned Frogs check in at No. 23, while OSU is 21st. The Pokes are ranked as high as No. 9 (NCBWA) while Texas is ranked 10th in all four national polls. Texas Tech holds a No. 21 ranking on two lists.
- After winning its seventh straight Big 12 game, Oklahoma State took over first-place in the league standings last weekend and own an 11-4 record in league play. OSU leads the Big 12 in batting average and ERA for conference-only contests. The Cowboys will face third-place Texas in Austin this weekend.
- TCU earned its first sweep over Texas in 20 years last weekend as the Horned Frog pitching staff limited UT to just one run over the three games. TCU has held an opponent to one or fewer runs 20 times this season and posted a 0.25 ERA over four games last week.
- In a non-conference midweek game last Tuesday, Oklahoma and Oklahoma State played 18 innings and nearly six hours with OU winning, 12-9. It was the first Big 12 game to go past 16 innings since 2012, but seven innings short of the longest game in league history of 25 innings by Texas.
- West Virginia led the league in batting average last week and also played four games without an error. The Mountaineers are the only Big 12 team with multiple players in both the top 10 for batting and ERA for overall games on the season. WVU has three players in the top 10 for batting (Boyd, Fleming, McBroom).
- Josh Michalec (Baylor) and Brendan McCurry (Oklahoma State) are the only league closers with double-digit saves on the season with 14 and 11, respectively. The Big 12 record for saves in a single season is 20 (Jeff Bajenaru, Oklahoma, 1999).
- K-State's Blair DeBord became one of three active players with 100 or more RBI while Texas' Mark Payton broke the league's career walks chart. The senior sits in 10th place with 125 for his career. Ross Kivett (K-State) moved into 8th on the Big 12 career stolen base charts and is 20 away from the first-place spot.
- One month remains in the regular season before the 2014 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City., May 21-25. All-session and weekend session tickets are on sale through the RedHawks box office and Big12Sports.com.
