*First Pitch...* The Sooners look to end a six-game slide as they ready for a three-game home series with Baylor this weekend. Game one of the series starts at 6:00 pm at L. Dale Mitchell Park on Friday night.

About the Sooners... Oklahoma is in the midst of its longest losing streak since 2007 and has dropped 11 of its last 13. Junior catcher Mac James remains atop the squad with a .359 batting average to go with a team-leading 34 RBI. Sophomore left fielder Hunter Haley has scored a team-high 38 runs and slugged a team-high six home runs, while hitting .301. The Sooners are second in the Big 12 with 24 homers and a .405 slugging percentage and rank third with 266 runs scored. Six of eight regular starters own a batting average of .280 or better.

On the Air... Veteran OU broadcasters Toby Rowland (play-by-play) and Chris Plank (sideline) will call the action on KREF Sports Talk 1400 AM and 98.5 FM. The games will be broadcast by Sooner Sports TV with Chad McKee (p-b-p) and former major leaguer Jay Payton (color) on the call.

**OU-DBU Recap...** The Sooners totaled just three hits in a 9-1 loss to Dallas Baptist at home on Tuesday night. Sophomore LHP **Jeffrey Curran** offered one of the few highlights of the game for Oklahoma as he pitched three perfect innings of middle relief.

Scouting the Bears... Baylor is 20-26 overall and eighth in the Big 12 at 5-12 after being swept by Kansas over the weekend. The Bears, who snapped a five-game slide with an 8-4 win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, are hitting just .227 as a team. Right fielder Adam Toth leads the way with a .287 average and 26 runs scored. Saturday starter, LHP Daniel Castano (5-2) sports 2.35 ERA, while RHP Dillon Newman (3-3) and RHP Drew Tolson (2-5) round out the rotation.

**All-Time vs. Baylor...** Oklahoma leads the all-time series against Baylor, 36-31. However, Baylor leads the series in the Big 12 era, 22-21. OU completed a five-game sweep of Baylor in 2012, beating the Bears twice in the Big 12 Tournament to advance to the championship game.

### **HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES**

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98)

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Last Time They Met... Baylor took the regular season series in 2013 winning by winning the Friday and Sunday games in Waco. The Sooners has the last word however when they faced Baylor in their first game of the Big 12 Tournament. OU downed the Bears 2-0 behind a dominant performance from **Jonathan Gray**. Gray threw a complete game, three-hit shutout to help Oklahoma advance. OU got RBI knocks from Jack Mayfield and Hector Lorenzaza in game dominated by pitching.

Bedlam Personified... Ten minutes past minute, Kolbey Carpenter ripped a double to left that scored the go-ahead run in the top of the 18th as Oklahoma pulled away for a 12-9 win over No. 13 Oklahoma State on the road Tuesday night. The win was the longest game in OU history and first in Stillwater since 1992. RHP Kindle Ladd (3-1) pitched brilliantly in relief; scattering two hits and two walks, while striking out four over six innings of shutout relief. In the 18th, Austin O'Brien drew a one-out walk to start the rally and scored the game-winning run.

Shave for the Brave... On April 3, Oklahoma held its "Shave for the Brave" event to join the fight against childhood cancer. The Sooners, with a goal of \$20,000, raised over \$28,000 through the Vs. Cancer Foundation to raise money for cancer research. Half of the money donated will be dedicated to the OU Children's Hospital. The event also served as an opportunity for the Sooners in their countdown to 19 Ways.

Putting the Ball in Play... The Sooners strike out at the lowest rate in the Big 12 at 4.76 per game; ahead of TCU at 5.09. Mac James has struck out just eight times and ranks 14th in the nation in "Toughest to Strikeout" at 20.9 at-bats per strikeout. Senior shortstop Hector Lorenzana ranks second on the team at 11.4.

Not-So-Newcomer... Neuse claimed his second Big 12 Newcomer of the Week award on April 7. He shared the honor with K-State's Tanner DeVinny. Neuse hit .389 (7-for-18) with nine RBI, including two threerun home runs. He slugged .833, stole two bases and pitched one scoreless inning. Neuse's eight RBI in game two of the weekend marked the most RBI in a game for a Sooner since Chris Ebright had nine vs. Oklahoma City (3/28/87).

Back-To-Back Jacks... James and Haley hit back-to-back home runs in the bottom of the first against West Virginia (4/19) to give OU and early 3-0 lead. It marked the second set of back-to-back home runs for the Sooners on the season. Neuse and Anthony Hermelyn previously did so against Seton Hall (2/15/14).

Up Next... The Sooners are off during the midweek for finals before their last road series of the season at TCU, May 9-11.

#YardWork... Oklahoma has hit 24 home runs in 45 games, including 19 in the friendly confines of L. Dale Mitchell Park. Haley has hit a teamhigh six, while James and Neuse have added five and four, respectively. Each home run hit this season by Haley and Neuse have come in home games. Both home runs hit by Carpenter have come on the road.

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 8-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-4 win over K-State (3/21/14). OU has won four of its last five conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

Playing 'em Close... Oklahoma is 6-1 in one-run games this season. The Sooners lost their first one-run game of the year in a walk-off at Kansas (3/30/14). Three of Oklahoma's onerun wins have come in extra innings. In two-run games, OU is 5-6.

Pack The Dale... Oklahoma set a series record in attendance vs. Texas (4/11-13) with a three-game total of 7,269. The previous high was 6,689 against Texas in 2004. On April 12, the Sooners hosted the second largest crowd in program history with 4,102 in attendance. Oklahoma has had fourfigure attendance figures in 11 home games and are averaging 1,122 per game.

Scoreless Streak... Oklahoma's bullpen pitched a season-best 24 shutout innings between April 1 and 11. For the season, OU relievers have tossed 140 shutout innings. The Sooner bullpen has accounted for 17 wins.

MLB Transactions... Former Sooner Jason Bartlett retired on April 18 after a three-game stint with the Minnesota Twins marked his 10th season in Major League Baseball. Bartlett was out of baseball in 2013 and last played in the majors in 2012 for the San Diego Padres, before making the Twins out of spring training. Greg Dobbs was designated for assignment by the Miami Marlins on April 29. He was just 1-for-13 in 15 games played this season. Right-hander Daniel McCutchen was recalled by the Texas Rangers on April 7, but was designated for assignment on April 14.

MAC ATTACK... James was named the Big 12 Player of the Week, on March 10, after hitting .684 (13-for-19) in five games. He slugged 1.000 and held a .714 on-base percentage. James finished the weekend with a 4-for-4 day, his second of the season, to go with his second home run of the season. James was also honored as the Louisville Slugger and NCBWA National Player of the Week.

Grand Finale... Fans were treated to some early fireworks during a March 21 win over K-State as Haley drilled a fifth-inning home run over the wall in right. The home run was the fifth of the season for Haley as well as his first career grand slam. It was the first grand slam by a Sooner since Ricky Eisenberg against Kansas on May 8, 2011. The next day, James went deep to left for the second OU grand slam of the weekend. James' home run was his third of the season.

Making Some Noise... Freshman third baseman Sheldon Neuse was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Week on March 17, after batting .529 (9-for-17) in four games. He slugged 1.000 with a .600 on-base percentage. Neuse went 4-for-4 with two doubles against UTA at Globe Life Ballpark in Arlington on Tuesday. He tripled twice on against Belmont (3/15) and scored three times.

Winning Streaks... After an opening day loss to Seton Hall, the Sooners rattled off five consecutive wins for their first five-game win streak of the season. OU last won five or more in a row when it won eight, beginning with the 2013 regular season finale at Kansas State and finishing with a win in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional Final against Virginia Tech. Oklahoma had its second five-game win streak of the season snapped against Arkansas-Little Rock (3/19).

Lords of the Flies... Oklahoma has dropped to 10th in the country in sacrifice flies with 27. Kansas State remains in the lead of the Big 12 at 31. Redshirt-junior right fielder Taylor Alspaugh is the team-leader at six, which is the 21st most in the nation.

Crooked Numbers... On the scoreboard, Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 59 times and three or more 33 times. The Sooners scored a season-high 10 runs in the seventh inning in game one of a doubleheader vs. CSU Bakersfield (4/5/14), highlighted by three-run homers by Neuse and Austin O'Brien.

Lineup on Shuffle... Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. The Sooners have used 32 different starting lineups. Center fielder Craig Aikin was the only player to start each of the first 27 games at the same position.

Mac of All Trades... Against Abilene Christian (3/5), James made his first career start at first base. He has now started at four different positions this season; including catcher, left field and designated hitter. James made his debut at third base late in the game against Texas (4/13).

Out of the Bullpen... Sophomore right-hander Ralph Garza Jr. has made the trip from the bullpen to the mound a familiar one. He is 19th in the nation in appearances at 26 this season, including one start. Garza has locked down seven saves, which ranks 62st, and leads the team in wins at 5-2.

Return of the Mac... James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared in just nine games, earning nine at-bats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, James has started games at catcher, designated hitter, left field, first and third base.

Opening the Gates... Oklahoma's seasonopening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face

2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Who's on First?... The Sooners have started five different first basemen. Freshman Niko Buentello made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. He leads the team with seven starts at first. Sophomore catcher Anthony Hermelyn has started 15 games there, while James and junior Keach Ballard have each started at first. Freshman Austin O'Brien made his first career start at first vs. CSU Bakersfield (4/5). Sophomore Kolbey Carpenter became the sixth Sooner to start at first when he did so against Texas (4/12). It was his first start at first since facing Dallas Baptist (4/30/13).

More Runs=More Wins... In each of Oklahoma's first seven wins, the Sooners scored at least eight runs. They are 14-1 when scoring eight or more, including a season-high 17 against CSU Bakersfield (4/5). The only loss with eight or more came vs. Texas (4/11). When scoring five runs or less, OU is 9-19.

Turn the Calendar... Oklahoma looks towards May, hoping to leave behind an April in which it went just 5-12. The Sooner pitching staff owned a 5.70 collective ERA over that stretch and the offense averaged just 4.58 runs per game, down from its previous 6.48. However, during April Alspaugh came out of a slump that had his average down to .266 with a .333 (14-for-42) month. Oklahoma was hurt most by the long-ball in April; allowing 18 of the 22 its given up all season.

**Defending Big 12 Champs...** The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman **Hector Lorenzana** is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

New Man on the Top Step... Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

**Season Openers...** Since 1962, Oklahoma is 35-18 on opening day and 23-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 22-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 48-5 going back to 1962, including 32-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

**Opening Day Starter...** Sophomore lefty **Jacob Evans** made his first career start on opening day, marking the first time a Sooner pitcher made his first career start on opening day since **Zach Neal** in 2010. Evans is also the third straight lefty to start on opening day, following **Dillon Overton** in 2012 and 2013.

**Big 12 Tournament...** The 2014 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship will be held at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City, May 21-25.

**On the Hill...** The OU pitching staff looks to replace nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. The eight pitchers that remain from over a year ago combined to post a 17-7 record and a 3.31 collective ERA.

In the Polls... Oklahoma entered 2014 ranked No. 28 in the NCBWA preseason poll. The Sooners also received 66 votes in the USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll, landing three spots outside of the Top 25. OU finished 2013 ranked No. 17 by the coaches. The Sooners are currently out of the polls.

# **CONFERENCE NOTES**

- The Big 12 is the only conference with all of its teams ranked in the top 100 of the NCAA RPI (per April 22 rankings).
- Oklahoma State, TCU, Texas and Texas Tech enter the week ranked in the top 25 of four national polls. OSU maintains it highest ranking of the season at No. 9. Texas sits as high as No. 11, while TCU's best ranking is 12th. Following its third consecutive weekend series sweep, Texas Tech received a national ranking from all five national polls its highest at No. 19, which is the best ranking for the Red Raiders since 2005.
- After winning their fifth straight Big 12 series this past weekend at Texas, the Oklahoma State Cowboys remain atop the league standings with a 13-5 record. OSU plays a non-conference series against Arizona State this weekend before closing out its league schedule with Kansas State and Oklahoma.
- TCU and West Virginia posted undefeated records last week. WVU improved to 7-7 in the league standings with a sweep of K-State, while TCU recorded three shutouts in four games. The Horned Frogs tallied their second straight week with a 0.25 ERA and their 12 shutouts on the year are one shy of matching the Big 12 single-season record set in 2011 by Texas.
- K-State's Ross Kivett is nine hits shy of becoming the first Wildcat on the Big 12's career top 10 list for hits. The senior has amassed 265 over his four years and is also climbing the career charts for stolen bases, currently ranked tied for fifth with 78.
- A sweep of Baylor this past weekend gave KU head coach Ritch Price milestones wins. Saturday's victory was the 1,000th for Price between all three levels he has coached, while Sunday's win gave him his 600th at the Division I level.
- Four Big 12 teams rank in the top 20 nationally in walks Oklahoma State (4th), Texas Tech (10th), Texas (16th) and Kansas State (19th). The Red Raiders are also in the top 10 in double plays, doubles, fielding percentage, runs and triples.
- Kansas' Jordan Piché threw the Jayhawks' Big 12-leading sixth complete game last Friday night vs. Baylor. The senior allowed just one hit and was named the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week.
- Texas' Mark Payton extended his reached base streak to 84 games (dating back to 2013). Payton is chasing the Big 12 record of 93 consecutive games set by K-State's Nick Martini from 2009-11. His 2014 streak is at 45 games (Martini's single-season record is 59 games).
- Individually, WVU has the league's two leaders for multi-hit and multi-RBI games with Bobby Boyd leading the league with 22 multi-hit contests and Ryan McBroom topping the multi-RBI leaders with 14 games.
