**First Pitch...** Oklahoma enters the final stretch of the regular season with a three-game Big 12 series at TCU. Game one on Friday night is set for 6:30 pm.

About the Sooners... Oklahoma enters at 26-23 overall and 6-12 in the Big 12. Sophomore center fielder Craig Aikin is swinging a hot bat of late. He went 8-for-13 with three runs, three RBI and three extra-base hits in the Baylor series to lift his average to .296. Junior Mac James leads the team with a .356 batting average and 38 RBI, while sophomore left fielder Hunter Haley is hitting .310 with 40 runs. Six regular starters are batting .290 or better. Since moving to the bullpen, sophomore RHP Corey Copping is holding opponents to a .154 average over eight innings with a 1.12 earned run average and seven strikeouts.

On the Air... Veteran OU broadcaster Toby Rowland (play-by-play) will be joined by OU alum Ross Hubbard (color) to call the action on KREF Sports Talk 1400 AM and 98.5 FM. The games will be broadcast on the FOX Sports Network throughout the weekend.

Weekend Recap... The Sooners snapped a sevengame losing streak with a 13-7 win over Baylor on Satuday afternoon. Oklahoma used an eight-run fourth innings to erase an early deficit. Redshirtjunior RHP Robert Tasin (4-4) earned the win in five stellar innings of relief; overcoming an early two-run home run. Aikin and fellow sophomore Anthony Hermelyn each recorded the first fourhit game of their career. The Sooners dropped to opener, 3-2, and fell in the finale, 10-5.

Scouting the Horned Frogs... No. 10 TCU is 34-13 overall, 13-5 in the Big 12 and winners of 12 in a row, including conference sweeps over Texas and Kansas State. Left fielder Boomer White leads the Horned Frogs with a .364 average to go with 41 runs and 33 RBI. Second baseman Garrett Crain is a close second at .356. LHP Brandon Finnegan (7-2) is expected to throw on Friday night. He has struck out 96 in 72 innings and owns a 1.50 ERA and .191 batting average against. RHP Preston Morrison (7-3) and Tyler Alexander (6-3) fill out the rotation on Saturday and Sunday. Morrison holds a 1.27 ERA, while Alexander's is at 2.37.

#### **HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES**

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 17 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 524-385-2 (.576), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98)

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

All-Time vs. TCU... Oklahoma leads the all-time series with TCU, 53-21 after a win back in March and sweeping a three-game home series in 2013; the Horned Frogs' first year in the Big 12. Since 2008, the Sooners have won 10 out of 12 with TCU's lone wins in that stretch coming in a 2012 home-andhome sweep. The two teams traded blows with one win apiece in the 2006 Norman Regional as Oklahoma advanced to the Houston Super Regional.

Last Time They Met... The Sooners defeated the No. 24 Horned Frogs at home, 9-5, on March 18. Oklahoma overcame a seasonhigh five errors as it outhit TCU, 12-10. LHP Jacob Evans earned the win in 1.1 innings of relief, but Tasin tossed four innings; entering with two outs, bases loaded and one run scored in the top of the first. Four Sooners collected multi-hit games, including Hector Lorenzana, who went 2-for-4 with two runs scored. Derek Odell finished 3-for-4 for TCU.

Bedlam Personified... Ten minutes past minute, Kolbey Carpenter ripped a double to left that scored the go-ahead run in the top of the 18th as Oklahoma pulled away for a 12-9 win over No. 13 Oklahoma State on the road Tuesday night. The win was the longest game in OU history and first in Stillwater since 1992. RHP Kindle Ladd (3-1) pitched brilliantly in relief; scattering two hits and two walks, while striking out four over six innings of shutout relief. In the 18th, Austin O'Brien drew a one-out walk to start the rally and scored the game-winning run.

Shave for the Brave... On April 3, Oklahoma held its "Shave for the Brave" event to join the fight against childhood cancer. **The** Sooners, with a goal of \$20,000, raised over \$29,000 through the Vs. Cancer Foundation to raise money for cancer research. Half of the money donated will be dedicated to the OU Children's Hospital. The event also served as an opportunity for the Sooners in their countdown to 19 Ways.

Putting the Ball in Play... The Sooners strike out at the lowest rate in the Big 12 at 4.76 per game; ahead of TCU at 5.09. Mac James has struck out just eight times and ranks sixth in the nation in "Toughest to Strikeout" at 22.5 at-bats per strikeout. Senior shortstop Hector Lorenzana ranks second on the team at 11.3.

Not-So-Newcomer... Neuse claimed his second Big 12 Newcomer of the Week award on April 7. Neuse hit .389 (7-for-18) with nine RBI, including two three-run home runs. He slugged .833, stole two bases and pitched one scoreless inning. Neuse's eight RBI in game two of the weekend marked the most RBI in a game for a Sooner since Chris Ebright had nine vs. Oklahoma City (3/28/87).

Back-To-Back Jacks... James and Haley hit back-to-back home runs in the bottom of the first against West Virginia (4/19) to give OU and early 3-0 lead. It marked the second set of back-to-back home runs for the Sooners on the season. Neuse and Anthony Hermelyn previously did so against Seton Hall (2/15/14).

Up Next... The Sooners remain in North Texas for their final non-conference tilt of the season when they face Dallas Baptist on Tuesday, May 13 at 6:30 pm.

#YardWork... Oklahoma has hit 27 home runs in 49 games, including 22 in the friendly confines of L. Dale Mitchell Park. Haley has hit a teamhigh six, while James and Neuse have added five each. Each home run hit this season by Haley and Neuse have come in home games. Both home runs hit by Carpenter have come on the road.

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 8-9 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after an 11-4 win over K-State (3/21/14). OU has won four of its last five conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener against Kansas on March 15, 1997.

Playing 'em Close... Oklahoma is 6-2 in one-run games this season. The Sooners lost their first one-run game of the year in a walk-off at Kansas (3/30/14). Three of Oklahoma's onerun wins have come in extra innings. In two-run games, OU is 5-6.

Pack The Dale... Oklahoma set a series record in attendance vs. Texas (4/11-13) with a three-game total of 7,269. The previous high was 6,689 against Texas in 2004. On April 12, the Sooners hosted the second largest crowd in program history with 4,102 in attendance. Oklahoma has had fourfigure attendance figures in 11 home games and are averaging 1,122 per game.

Scoreless Streak... Oklahoma's bullpen pitched a season-best 24 shutout innings between April 1 and 11. For the season, OU relievers have tossed 140 shutout innings. The Sooner bullpen has accounted for 17 wins.

Getting the Call... Right-handed pitcher Chase Anderson received his Major League call-up from Double-A with the Arizona Diamondbacks on May 6.

MLB Transactions... Former Sooner Jason Bartlett retired on April 18 after a three-game stint with the Minnesota Twins marked his 10th season in Major League Baseball. Bartlett was out of baseball in 2013 and last played in the majors in 2012 for the San Diego Padres, before making the Twins out of spring training. Greg Dobbs was designated for assignment by the Miami Marlins on April 29. He was just 1-for-13 in 15 games played this season. Right-hander Daniel McCutchen was recalled by the Texas Rangers on April 7, but was designated for assignment on April 14.

Triple Nation... Oklahoma ranks fifth in the country and first in the Big 12 with 21 triples. Three players are among the top 50 in the nation, including Neuse (2nd, 7), Haley (8th, 6) and Aikin (50th, 4).

MAC ATTACK... James was named the Big 12 Player of the Week, on March 10, after hitting .684 (13-for-19) in five games. He slugged 1.000 and held a .714 on-base percentage. James finished the weekend with a 4-for-4 day, his second of the season, to go with his second home run of the season. James was also honored as the Louisville Slugger and NCBWA National Player of the Week.

Grand Finale... Fans were treated to some early fireworks during a March 21 win over K-State as Haley drilled a fifth-inning home run over the wall in right. The home run was the fifth of the season for Haley as well as his first career grand slam. It was the first grand slam by a Sooner since Ricky Eisenberg against Kansas on May 8, 2011. The next day, James went deep to left for the second OU grand slam of the weekend. James' home run was his third of the season.

Making Some Noise... Freshman third baseman Sheldon Neuse was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Week on March 17, after batting .529 (9-for-17) in four games. He slugged 1.000 with a .600 on-base percentage. Neuse went 4-for-4 with two doubles against UTA at Globe Life Ballpark in Arlington on Tuesday. He tripled twice on against Belmont (3/15) and scored three times.

Winning Streaks... After an opening day loss to Seton Hall, the Sooners rattled off five consecutive wins for their first five-game win streak of the season. OU last won five or more in a row when it won eight, beginning with the 2013 regular season finale at Kansas State and finishing with a win in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional Final against Virginia Tech. Oklahoma had its second five-game win streak of the season snapped against Arkansas-Little Rock (3/19).

Lords of the Flies... Oklahoma has dropped to 18th in the country in sacrifice flies with 27. Kansas State remains in the lead of the Big 12 at 32. Redshirt-junior right fielder Taylor Alspaugh is the team-leader at six, which is the 28th most in the nation.

Crooked Numbers... On the scoreboard, Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 64 times and three or more 34 times. The Sooners scored a season-high 10 runs in the seventh inning in game one of a doubleheader vs. CSU Bakersfield (4/5/14), highlighted by three-run homers by Neuse and Austin O'Brien.

Lineup on Shuffle... Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. The Sooners have used 33 different starting lineups. Center fielder Craig Aikin was the only player to start each of the first 27 games at the same position.

Mac of All Trades... Against Abilene Christian (3/5), James made his first career start at first base. He has now started at four different positions this season; including catcher, left field and designated hitter. James made his debut at third base late in the game against Texas (4/13).

Out of the Bullpen... Sophomore right-hander Ralph Garza Jr. has made the trip from the bullpen to the mound a familiar one. He is 12th in the nation in appearances at 28 this season, including two starts. Garza has locked down seven saves and leads the team in wins at 5-3. As a reliever, Garza is 5-1 with a 2.34 ERA and 33 strikeouts in 34.2 innings.

Return of the Mac... James, a transfer from Brookhaven College, appeared in just nine games, earning nine at-bats and two hits in his first season in Norman. This season, James has started games at catcher, designated hitter, left field, first and third base.

Opening the Gates... Oklahoma's seasonopening series against Seton Hall was the second highest opening weekend attendance total in program history as 3,754 fans passed through the gates. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Dial it Up... Freshman RHP Alec Hansen has made just one start and eight total appearances, spanning 9.1 innings. However, he has the ability to touch triple digits on the radar gun and has his fastball consistently in the 95-97 range.

Who's on First?... The Sooners have started five different first basemen. Freshman Niko Buentello made his debut anchoring first on opening day before seeing action at the DH spot in the next two games. He leads the team with seven starts at first. Sophomore catcher Anthony Hermelyn has started 15 games there, while James and junior Keach Ballard have each started at first. Freshman Austin O'Brien made his first career start at first vs. CSU Bakersfield (4/5). Sophomore Kolbey Carpenter became the sixth Sooner to start at first when he did so against Texas (4/12). It was his first start at first since facing Dallas Baptist (4/30/13).

More Runs=More Wins... In each of Oklahoma's first seven wins, the Sooners scored at least eight runs. They are 15-1 when scoring eight or more, including a season-high 17 against CSU Bakersfield (4/5). The only loss with eight or more came vs. Texas (4/11). When scoring five runs or less, OU is 9-21.

Turn the Calendar... Oklahoma looks towards May, hoping to leave behind an April in which it went just 5-12. The Sooner pitching staff owned a 5.70 collective ERA over that stretch and the offense averaged just 4.58 runs per game, down from its previous 6.48. However, during April Alspaugh came out of a slump that had his average down to .266 with a .333 (14-for-42) month. Oklahoma was hurt most by the long-ball in April; allowing 18 of the 22 its given up all season.

Defending Big 12 Champs... The Sooners are fresh off a 43-21 campaign in 2013 as they claimed the program's first Big 12 Tournament Championship since 1997. Overall, Oklahoma returns 17 letterwinners, including five position starters. Senior second baseman Hector Lorenzana is back after hitting .274 with 42 RBI and 33 runs in his first season in Norman.

New Man on the Top Step... Hughes was named the ninth head coach in program history on June 27, 2013. He comes to Norman with 17 years of NCAA head coaching experience, most recently at Virginia Tech from 2007-13. Overall, Hughes owns a career record of 526-386-2. He coached the Hokies to two NCAA Regionals in 2010 and 2013, which they hosted in Blacksburg. Hughes previous coaching stops were at Boston College (1999-06) and Trinity (1997-98).

### **CONFERENCE NOTES**

- With a 4-0 week and a sweep of Kansas State at home to extend its winning streak to 12, TCU joins Oklahoma State atop the Big 12 standings at 13-5. Oklahoma State's final two conference opponents are at K-State and vs. Oklahoma, while TCU faces OU this weekend at home before closing out the season at Baylor.
- The middle part of the standings saw a shuffle as Kansas and West Virginia jumped Texas Tech and Texas with series wins over the two teams, respectively. KU extended its winning streak to seven with a sweep of the 19th-ranked Red Raiders, while WVU won two-of-three from the 11th-ranked Longhorns. While UT and TTU are off this week for finals, West Virginia will travel to Lawrence.
- Oklahoma State, TCU and Texas are all ranked in the top 25 nationally. OSU is as high as No. 7, TCU No. 10 and Texas No. 17. TTU is also ranked in the top 25 of two polls, while Kansas and West Virginia are receiving votes in the NCBWA and USA Today Coaches' rankings.
- The Horned Frogs are 19-1 in their last 20 games the best streak since 1993 and have won 11 consecutive at home.
- KU swept back-to-back conference series for the first time since 1994 and has won six straight league games for the first time since 2009. The Jayhawks lead the league in complete games and added two more on the weekend as Jordan Piche threw his second consecutive on Friday night and Frank Duncan tossed his sixth career. Duncan is the league's active leader in complete games.
- Oklahoma State has 21 comeback victories on the season, including two from last weekend's sweep of Arizona State in Stillwater, where OSU is 21-8 this season. The Cowboys are also 10-0 in one-run games on the year.
- WVU batters did not strike out once in Sunday's finale with Texas. The last time the Longhorn's' pitching staff did not strike out an opponent in a game was over five years ago - May 3, 2008, vs. Baylor. It was only the third time in the past 10 years UT has not recorded a strikeout with April 23, 2006, vs. Nebraska being the other occasion.
- Texas' Mark Payton's single-season reached base streak is at 49 games, which is the thirdlongest in the Big 12 since 2003. Payton has reached base in 88 games dating back to 2013 - five contests shy of matching that league record (93, Nick Martini, K-State).
- TCU's Preston Morrison threw his third shutout of the season on Friday night. With one more on the season, he will match the league single-season record of four set by NU's Jamie Rodrique in 2000. Morrison is one of 13 pitchers with three or more shutouts in their careers in the Big 12.
