

- ► Lon Kruger was named Oklahoma's 14th head men's basketball coach on April 1, 2011.
- ▶ Owns a 537-342 (.611) collegiate record over 28 years and is 58-38 at Oklahoma (.604) through three seasons.
- ► Ranks 15th among active
 Division I head coaches in career victories.
- ▶ The only Division I head coach to ever take five different programs to the NCAA Tournament (Kansas State, Florida, Illinois, UNLV and Oklahoma) and has taken each at least twice.
- ▶ Named 2013-14 AP Big 12 Coach of the Year.
- ▶ Has also coached at Texas-Pan American (52-59 record from 1982-86), Kansas State (81-46 from 1986-90), Florida (104-80 from 1990-96), Illinois (81-48 from 1996-00) and UNLV (161-71 from 2004-11).
- ► Served as head coach of NBA's Atlanta Hawks from 2000-03 (69-122 record) and was an assistant for New York Knicks (2003-04 season).
- ▶ Averaged 25.4 wins at UNLV over final five years there (four NCAA appearances and one NIT trip) and won at least 21 games each of those five seasons.
- ▶ Has taken teams to 15 NCAA Tournaments (14-15 record) and four NITs (4-5 record).
- ▶ Coached Florida to the 1994 Final Four, Kansas State to the 1988 Elite Eight and UNLV to the 2007 Sweet 16.
- ▶ Is one of just three head coaches in Division I history (the only current one) to lead at least four different schools to at least one NCAA Tournament win.

FRIDAY'S GAME BASICS

The No. 19/19 Sooners play their first of two preseason exhibition games when they host Washburn on Friday at 7 p.m. CT at Lloyd Noble Center. OU, which went 23-10 last season (12-6 Big 12; second place) and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second straight year, is starting its fourth season under head coach **Lon Kruger**. The Ichabods, coached by Kruger's former Kansas State teammate **Bob Chipman**, went 17-10 last season but did not participate in postseason play. Friday's contest will air on the Sooner Radio Network (KRXO 107.7 FM "The Franchise" in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa) with **Toby Rowland** and **Mike Houck** announcing. The game will be televised by Sooner Sports TV (FS Southwest Plus and FOX College Sports Central) with **Bob Carpenter**, **Billy Tubbs** and **Jessica Coody** calling the action.

TOP FIVE STORYLINES

- ▶ Oklahoma and Washburn will meet in exhibition play for a fourth consecutive season. OU beat the Ichabods 104-76 last year, 83-66 in 2012 and 85-59 in 2011. The Sooners also won regular season games over Washburn in 1909-10 (55-20), 1930-31 (30-27) and 1972-73 (79-55).
- ▶ 0U head coach **Lon Kruger** and Washburn head coach **Bob Chipman** were Kansas State teammates in the 1970s. The pair helped the Wildcats to back-to-back Big Eight regular season titles in 1972 and 1973. Kruger was the Big Eight Player of the Year in 1973 and 1974.
- ▶ After averaging 70.6 points per game in 2012-13, last year's Sooners averaged 81.9 points to rank seventh nationally out of 351 teams. It was 0U's highest scoring average in 20 years. The Sooners scored at least 80 points 18 times last year after doing it 17 times the previous three seasons combined.
- ▶ Oklahoma returns 71 percent of its 3-point production from last season's team that averaged a school-record 8.6 treys per game. The Sooners welcome back their top three 3-point producers: **Buddy Hield** (90 makes), **Frank Booker** (42) and **Isaiah Cousins** (38).
- ▶ OU is ranked No. 19 in the AP and USA Today Coaches top-25 preseason polls, the first time it has been ranked to start a season in five years. The Sooners finished last year at No. 21 in the AP poll and at No. 20 in the last regular season USA Today poll.

RETURNING PLAYERS

- ▶ The Sooners return 68 percent of their scoring, 70 percent of their rebounding and 73 percent of their assists from last season's 23-10 squad that finished in sole possession of second place in the Big 12 (12-6). OU welcomes back four starters (each started all 33 games) in *The Sporting News* third-team preseason All-American **Buddy Hield** (16.5 ppg, 3.5 3-pointers per game), fellow juniors **Isaiah Cousins** (11.0 ppg, 4.2 rpg, .404 3FG%) and **Ryan Spangler** (9.6 ppg, Big 12-leading 9.3 rpg, team-high .584 FG%), and sophomore **Jordan Woodard** (10.3 ppg, team-high 4.6 apg).
- ▶ Also back are three scholarship reserves: sophomore guard **Frank Booker** (5.1 ppg, .368 3FG%), senior forward **D.J. Bennett** (2.8 ppg, 2.0 rpg, .569 FG%) and sophomore forward **C.J. Cole** (0.4 ppg, 1.1 rpg). Joining them are four walk-on returnees: senior guard **James Fraschilla**, sophomore forward **Austin Mankin** and sophomore guards **Daniel Harper** and **Trey Slate**.

NEW FACES

► Six of OU's 17 players have never suited up for the Sooners. Five of those six players are on scholarship. They are senior forward **TaShawn Thomas** (transfer from Houston), junior guard **Dinjiyl Walker** (junior college transfers), freshman forwards **Khadeem**

Lattin and **Dante Buford** (both top-75 national recruits) and freshman center **Jamuni McNeace**. Thomas, who led the Cougars in scoring (15.4 ppg) and rebounding (8.1 rpg), is waiting on the results of an NCAA waiver request that, if granted, would allow him to play this season. Buford will sit out the 2014-15 campaign.

▶ Also joining the squad this season is freshman walk-on guard **Bola Alade**.

SOONERS SLOTTED THIRD BY BIG 12 COACHES

Oklahoma was picked third in this year's official Big 12 preseason poll. The order of finish was selected by the league's head coaches (they were not allowed to vote on their own team). The Sooners, one of three teams to receive at least one first-place vote, were slotted in their highest preseason position in five years (the 2009-10 team was also picked third).

Kansas finished atop the poll with 78 points and six coaches picked the Jayhawks to win the league. KU was followed by Texas (74 points; three first-place votes), OU (67 points; one first-place vote), Kansas State (53 points), Iowa State (51 points), Baylor and West Virginia (36 points each), Oklahoma State (27 points), TCU (15 points) and Texas Tech (13 points).

Each of head coach **Lon Kruger's** first three Oklahoma teams finished higher than where they were picked in the Big 12 preseason poll. Last year the Sooners were picked tied for fifth and finished second. In 2012-13 0U was slotted seventh and finished tied for fourth. The season before that, OU was picked ninth and wound up eighth.

PREVIEWING WASHBURN

- ▶ Located in Topeka, Kan., NCAA Division II member Washburn University is a school of 7,002 students that competes in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association. Washburn finished 17-10 overall last year and tied for sixth in the MIAA with a 9-9 league record. It did not qualify for postseason competition. The Ichabods are picked third out of 14 teams in this year's preseason MIAA coaches poll.
- ▶ Washburn returns three starters from last season. Senior forward **Alex North** averaged team highs of 16.1 points and 10.0 rebounds while also averaging 3.3 assists and shooting a team-high .463 from 3-point range (50 makes). He was a second-team All-MIAA selection. Senior guard **Kyle Wiggins**, an honorable mention all-league pick, averaged 15.0 points and a team-high 4.0 assists. Senior forward **Stephon Drane** averaged 6.0 points and 2.5 boards a contest. **Algie Key** is a junior guard who played for Alabama last year, averaging 3.7 points and 2.3 rebounds in 15.4 minutes a game. He scored a game-high 20 points on 7 for 8 shooting for the Crimson Tide against Oklahoma when the teams opened the season in Dallas (an 82-73 0U win).
- ▶ Saturday's game will mark the second of three exhibition contest this season for Washburn, all against Big 12 teams. The Ichabods lost 85-53 at Kansas on Monday and will play at Kansas State on Sunday.
- ▶ Washburn is under the direction of longtime head coach **Bob Chipman**, who was a college teammate of OU head coach **Lon Kruger** at Kansas State in the early 1970s (the pair helped

the Wildcats to back-to-back Big Eight regular season titles in 1971-72 and 1972-73). Chipman is in his 36th season at Washburn, where he owns a 757-314 (.707) record. He has racked up 12 regular season conference championships and won the 1987 NAIA national title.

OU-WASHBURN HISTORY

Friday's game will mark the seventh between Oklahoma and Washburn, and the fourth as an exhibition. The Sooners won regular season meetings over the Ichabods in 1909-10 (55-20 in Norman under head coach **Bennie Owen**), 1930-31 (30-27 in Topeka under head coach **Hugh McDermott**) and 1972-73 (79-55 in Norman under head coach **John MacLeod**).

Last year, OU posted a 104-76 home exhibition win over Washburn (box score on page 7 of these notes) behind 23 points from thensenior **Cameron Clark** and 21 from current junior **Buddy Hield**. Suiting up for the first time in Sooners uniforms, **Jordan Woodard** finished with 15 points and five steals while **Ryan Spangler** contributed 10 points and a team-high eight boards.

Friday's contest will mark the 11th time for 0U head coach **Lon Kruger** to face a **Bob Chipman**-coached Washburn team. Kruger beat Washburn once while the head coach at Pan American and six times while the head coach at UNLV (five exhibitions and one regular season game).

EXHIBITING SUCCESS

Oklahoma has compiled a 49-2 exhibition record over the last 26 years. Last season, the Sooners beat Washburn (104-76) and Oklahoma Christian (88-76) in Norman. The last time OU lost an exhibition game was November 2003 (89-82 to Athletes First).

UP NEXT

The Sooners will play the second of two exhibition games when they host NCAA Division II foe Southwestern Oklahoma State on Tuesday at 7 p.m. CT as part of OU's Field House Series. The game will be held at McCasland Field House in the heart of OU's campus.
