First Pitch... Oklahoma baseball makes a quick turnaround this week as its attention heads back to Big 12 play with a three-game series against Kansas. Game one of the series gets underway Thursday night at 6:00 pm.

About the Sooners... Oklahoma is 19-12 overall and 3-3 in Big 12 play following a 7-0 shutout-win over Central Arkansas. Junior center fielder **Craig Aikin** is just five hits away from 200 in his career and leads the Sooners with a .357 batting average. Junior **Kolbey Carpenter** ranks second on the team at .336 with 23 RBI and a team-high .584 slugging percentage and six home runs. Redshirt-senior right fielder **Taylor Alspaugh** (.310), sophomore shortstop **Sheldon Neuse** (.308) and junior **Anthony Hermelyn** (.300) round out a group of five all hitting .300-or-better. Alspaugh is hitting .450 (9-for-20) in Big 12 games and Neuse has driven in a team-high 28 runs, while going deep five times. Sophomore right-handers **Jake Elliott** (3-3) and **Alec Hansen** (3-3) have been mainstays in the OU rotation, combining for 102 strikeouts in 97 innings of work.

On the Air... Veteran OU broadcasters **Toby Rowland** (play-by-play) and **Chris Plank** (sideline) team up to call the game on the Sooner Radio Network. The game can be heard locally on KREF 1400 or KEBC 1560 AM. Sooner Sports TV will broadcast the series on the FOX Sports Family of networks, including FSSW+ on Friday and Saturday. **Chad McKee** (pbp) and Sooner baseball alum **George Frazier** (color) will call the action.

- Kolbey Carpenter was named the Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week (2/23) and the Big 12 Player of the Week (2/23, 3/23).
- OU starting pitchers have lasted six or more innings in 16 out of 31 starts this season, including nine of seven or more innings.
- The Sooners are 2-3 against ranked opponents this season and 2-2 against top-10 teams. Both wins came against No. 10 Texas Tech (3/20-22).
- Oklahoma posted 20-plus hits for the second time this season with a 21-hit outburst at Baylor (3/29).

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 18 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 553-414-2 (.572), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Jawyhawks... Gaining his 400th win at Kansas earlier in the season against Michigan, head coach **Ritch Price** and the Jayhawks are 10-17 overall and 1-2 in conference. Outfielder **Connor McKay** leads the team with 19 runs scored and 40 hits, while hitting .364. In the power department, fellow outfielder **Blair Beck** has hit five home runs with a .584 slugging percentage. Opening up the action on Thursday, KU turns to left-hander **Ben Krauth** (5-2), who sports a 5.44 ERA.

Last Time They Met... Going to 2-1 last season against Kansas, Oklahoma lost the last meeting 4-3. Kansas gained an early 2-0 lead by the second inning that the Sooners were unable to upturn. In the ninth inning, Oklahoma tightened the gap with runs by Alspaugh and **Tyler Coolbaugh**. Kansas went on to appear in their fifth NCAA Regional where they fell 2-1 to Louisville (1) and Kentucky (2). The Sooners did claim the series with identical 2-1 wins in the first two dates of the weekend.

All-Time vs Kansas: The Sooners lead Kansas 130-70-1 in one of the oldest series in Oklahoma baseball. In 2013, Oklahoma lost their first game to the Jayhawks in five seasons, which broke a 13-game winning streak. After the loss to Kansas in the regular season that season, OU came back and beat Kansas 7-2; winning the Big 12 Championship en route to a run to the NCAA Super Regionals at LSU.

Shave for the Brave... On April 1, the Sooners will be shaving their heads to support Vs. Cancer and fight childhood cancer. OU will host a public event at L. Dale Mitchell Park beginning at 5:00 pm. The team has surpassed its goal of \$20,000 for the second straight season. Half the proceeds go to the Vs. Cancer Foundation and half to OU Children's Hospital. **In 2014, the Sooners raised over \$29,000 towards childhood cancer research.**

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 9-10 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 6-1 loss to Texas Tech (3/20/14). OU has won four of its last six conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State on March 7, 1997; 7-4.

For the Record... Single to center, single down the left field line, F7, single up the middle, three-run home run to right, double to right-center, infield-single to second. That was Aikin's record-setting day with a school-record six hits as he went 6-for-7 with four runs and six RBI in a 22-0 win over Arkansas-Little Rock (3/3). Aikin's home run was the first of his career as he set career marks in both runs scored and driven in.

Working Deep... Oklahoma pitchers have combined to pitch through the sixth 16 times this season, including nine starts through the seventh. Elliott leads the team with six six-plus inning starts and Hansen has four. Last season, OU starters pitched through the sixth 15 times in 58 games.

Kings of the K... The Sooner pitching staff leads the Big 12 with 287 strikeouts; averaging a league-best 9.31 per nine innings. Hansen struck out 10 vs. Texas Tech (3/22) and leads all Big 12 pitchers with 55. Elliott is second in the league at 47 after matching a career-high with 10 at Baylor (3/27). **OU pitchers have combined to strike out 10 or more in 18 games this season.**

Up Next... Bedlam is in sight on the calendar. The Sooners head to Stillwater for a 6:00 pm match-up with the Cowboys on Tuesday, April 7.

Player of the Week... Carpenter earned Big 12 and national recognition following an 8-for-17 week with three home runs. He was named the Big 12 Player of the Week and the Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball News* on February 23. **Carpenter is the second Sooner to earn the national award; first won by Mac James in 2014.** Carpenter added a second Big 12 award on March 23 after going 5-for-11 in the Texas Tech series with a 4-for-4 day and decisive, three-run home run in game two.

Complete Effort... Hansen tossed the first complete game of his career, at any level, against No. 10 Texas Tech (3/21). He struck out 10 and surrendered only three hits, while working through a choppy fifth after four, no-hit innings to start the day. **Hansen flashed a fastball at 101 MPH in the third and sustained a 97 MPH heater through the ninth.** His complete game was the first by a Sooner since **Jonathan Gray** vs. Coastal Carolina (5/31/13) in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional.

Neuse Statement Heard... Neuse claimed the Sooner's third weekly award from the Big 12 after being named the Player of the Week (3/9). He hit .688 (11-for-16) with a 1.375 slugging and .722 on-base percentage. Neuse homered three times and drove in 10 runs over a four-game stretch at home. He posted a perfect 4-for-4 day with a home run and a double against Purdue (3/7). As a freshman, Neuse was twice selected as the Big 12 Rookie of the Week in 2014.

Hits by Pitchers... Redshirt-senior **Robert Tasin** made 37 appearances on the mound, including five starts, in his first two seasons with OU. This year, he has pitched in 10 games with three starts across 31.1 innings. To add depth to the Sooner bench and lineup from the left side of the plate, Tasin picked up a bat this offseason and is currently hitting .225 (9-for-40) with two RBI and nine starts at DH. Junior **Jacob Evans** has also stepped to the plate for five at-bats this season and has two hits with two RBI.

True North!... Junior catcher **Chris Shaw** is the first Canadian to play for the Sooners since lefty **J.R. Robinson** (2009-10). He is the first Manitoban to ever play in the Big 12 and one of four D-I players from his home province. **A two-time MLB pick, Shaw became the highest Manitoban selected as the 14th round pick of the Cardinals in 2014.** Shaw, whose other sport as a youth was curling, attended Okotoks Dawgs Baseball Academy in high school and was also a member of Team Canada before heading to Midland College.

Turning Two... The Sooners rank 11th in the country and second in the Big 12 with 28 double plays turned; averaging 0.93 per game. Oklahoma turned a season-high four vs. BYU (2/28). In 2014, OU turned just 28, averaging 0.48 per game.

#YardWork... Oklahoma is well on its way to surpassing its 30-home run total from 2014. Through 31 games, the Sooners have gone yard 25 times, including a team-leading five from Neuse and Carpenter. **The Sooners rank second in the Big 12 with 25 home runs and 0.83 per game.** Neuse is the team's active career home run leader with 12. Junior left fielder **Hunter Haley** and Carpenter rank at 11.

Putting the Ball in Play... Oklahoma led the Big 12 in fewest strikeouts per game in 2014 at 4.86. Once again, the Sooners are at the top of the league; striking out at a rate of 5.23 per game. Kansas (5.74) is the only other team below six per game. On balls hit in play, Oklahoma is hitting .330, led by Aikin at .426. He is the third toughest to strikeout in the Big 12 with one strikeout for every 10.9 at-bats.

Starting in Center Field... Aikin has started all 31 games in center field; the only Sooner to start every game at the same position. He was the OU center fielder in 57 out of 58 games in 2014.

Fresh Records... Neuse set an OU freshman record with seven triples and was second with 27 walks behind Aikin's 32 set in 2013. He also earned top-five finishes in home runs (7), hits (73), runs (43) and RBI (47) by a Sooner freshman.

Season Openers... Since 1962, Oklahoma is 36-18 on opening day and 24-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 23-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 49-5 going back to 1962, including 33-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Slugging it Out... The Sooners are the only team in the Big 12 to hit four home runs in a game and the only team to hit four triples in a game. Oklahoma slugged four homers against BYU (2/28) in Las Vegas and tripled four times against Oregon State (2/22) in Surprise, Ariz. OU repeated its four-home run effort against Purdue (3/8).

On the Hill... The OU pitching staff was tasked with replacing nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. **This season, the Sooners return 74% of innings pitched from a year ago.**

Utility Blue Print... Junior Kolbey Carpenter has been a steady performer in two-plus seasons at OU. He has appeared in games at five different positions and has started every opening day since his freshman season at a different position; 1B, DH, 2B.

40+ Years of Head Coaching... Pete Hughes' staff has totaled 41 years of head coaching experience and 1,288 wins. **Mike Anderson** won 337 games at Nebraska, **Jamie Pinzino** 212 at Assumption, Bryant and William & Mary and **Scott Loiseau** 176 at Southern New Hampshire.

Value in Utility... Junior **Anthony Hermelyn** has seen a drastic change in his responsibilities from his freshman season when he started 48 games behind the dish. As a sophomore he split time between catcher and first base. This season he has added third base to his defensive duties as he earned starts at all three positions opening weekend.

Crooked Numbers... On the scoreboard, **Oklahoma put up two or more runs in an inning 47 times** and three-or-more 32 times in 2015. Opponents have posted a crooked number only 24 times and have scored three-or-more just 11 times. The Sooners scored a season-high eight runs in an inning at Baylor (3/29).

Lineup on Shuffle... In 2014, Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. The Sooners used 35 different starting lineups a year ago. **This season, OU has rolled out 21 different lineups in 31 games.**

Opening the Gates... Oklahoma's opening weekend attendance set a record for the first series of the season at 4,181. In 2014 vs. Seton Hall 3,754 fans passed through the gates; now ranked third all-time. The previous record was set in 2011 when 4,117 saw the Sooners face William & Mary, the season after reaching the 2010 College World Series. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

Opening Day Starter... Sophomore **Jake Eliott** became the first righty to start opening day for Oklahoma since **Michael Rocha** in 2011. He is also the third sophomore to earn the nod in the last four year after **Jacob Evans** (2014) and **Dillon Overton** (2012).

First Time Foes... SIUE was the first of four opponents on the schedule that Oklahoma has never played before. The Sooners has also taken on Utah and Purdue for the first time, amassing a record of 5-1 against first-time opponents. OU will also take on Alcorn State for the first time later this season.

Preseason Poll... Oklahoma landed fifth in the 2015 Big 12 Preseason Poll as voted on by the league's coaches for the second straight season. The Sooners received 38 points in the poll. TCU (64) was the unanimous No. 1 pick followed by Texas (55), Oklahoma State (47) and Texas Tech (46).

CONFERENCE NOTES

☞ Oklahoma State, TCU, Texas and Texas Tech all remain ranked. TCU is as high as No. 2 while OSU ranks as high as 11th, Texas at 18th and Tech at 19th. The league's four ranked teams will be in action against each other this weekend as Texas travels to Oklahoma State at Texas Tech hosts TCU.

☞ At the halfway point in the regular season, six of the league's nine teams own winning records and the conference is 114-74 in non-conference contests. Four league series along with 11 non-conference games are slated for week eight action.

☞ Oklahoma State won its ninth consecutive Big 12 series last weekend. It marks the longest streak in program history. The Cowboys won eight straight league series over the 2006-07 seasons.

☞ The Cowboys will face league-leading Texas this weekend in Stillwater - a series that features two of the top pitching squads in the conference. Saturday and Sunday's contests will be televised on ESPNU. OSU hasn't lost a home conference series since 2012 (May 16-19 vs Texas A&M).

☞ Four league pitchers threw complete games over the weekend including two consecutive from Baylor starters. Daniel Castano and Drew Tolson became the first pair of Baylor starting pitchers to post back-to-back complete games (both wins) since 2001. Oklahoma State's Michael Freeman threw his second straight complete game on Sunday against K-State, taking a no-hitter into the ninth inning.

☞ The TCU pitching staff has held its opponents to five runs or fewer in all 21 of the Frogs' wins this season. Of TCU's four losses, three have been by just one run, including a pair in extra innings.

☞ Connor McKay (KU, 15 games), Ryan Sluder (OSU, 11 games) and Blair Beck (KU, 10 games) all enter the week with active hit streaks of 10 games or more.

☞ Five conference teams rank in the top 30 nationally in average attendance - 6. Texas, 12. TCU, 14. Texas Tech, 24. K-State and 28. Baylor.

☞ Five league teams are in the top 50 nationally in ERA - 1. TCU, 15. Oklahoma State, 20. Texas, 30. Oklahoma and 44. Texas Tech.


