

About the Sooners... The No. 23 Sooners return home with an overall record of 26-16 and are 10-5 in Big 12 play. Junior center fielder Craig Aikin leads Oklahoma with a .358 batting average, 34 runs scored and 11 doubles. Junior second baseman Kolbey Carpenter, a three-time Big 12 Player of the Week, is second at .350 with a team-high seven home runs and .558 slugging percentage to go with 30 RBI. Junior Anthony Hermelyn (.313) has collected a team-leading 19-multi-hit games and a career-best 28 RBI. Redshirt-senior right fielder Taylor Alspaugh (.308) is riding a 17-game reached base streak and sophomore shortstop Sheldon Neuse (.306) rounds out a group of five hitting .300-or-better with a Big 12-leading 34 RBI to go with six home runs. Junior right-hander Corey Copping (3-0) gets the nod on Tuesday and redshirt-junior lefty Adam Choplick (2-1) goes on Wednesday. Copping sports a 1.96 earned run average with 27 strikeouts in 28.1 innings, while Choplick sits at 3.45 with 39 Ks in 28.2 innings of work.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.


Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 18 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 553-414-2 (.572), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Reaching the Charts... Last week, Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2015 as it reached No. 23 in the Collegiate Baseball News Top-30. The Sooners, who are 4-5 against ranked opponents this season, were last ranked on April 7, 2014 when they were No. 26 by CBN and No. 28 by NCBWA. The ranking marks the highest for OU under second-year head coach Pete Hughes.

Up Next... The Sooners remain at home for a non-conference series against Sam Houston State. The Bearkats come to town for game one Friday night at 6:00 pm.

Walk-Off AND a Win... On April 2, junior Jacob Evans ignited a four-run rally with a pinch-hit single to start the ninth. After the Sooners tied the game, he went to the mound and pitched a 1-2-3 top of the 10th. Evans led off the bottom half of the inning with a solo, walk-off home run to right-center on a 3-2 pitch in just his seventh career at-bat. Evans' homer was the first by an OU player that pitched in the same game since Ryan Mottern vs. Baylor (3/25/06).

Working Deep... Oklahoma pitchers have combined to pitch through the sixth 22 times this season, including 12 starts through the seventh. Elliott leads the team with eight six-plus inning starts and Hansen has five. Last season, OU starters pitched through the sixth 15 times in 58 games.

Kings of the K... The Sooner pitching staff leads the Big 12 with 372 strikeouts; averaging a 8.85 per nine innings. Sophomore RHP Alec Hansen struck out 10 vs. Texas Tech (3/22) and leads all Big 12 pitchers with 73. Fellow sophomore righty Jake Elliott is third in the league at 58. OU pitchers have combined to strike out 10-plus 21 times this season.

Bases Loaded... Carpenter earned a recordsetting third Big 12 Player of the Week honor on April 20. Carpenter became the first Sooner to ever earn the award three times in a season and just the third in league history to do so. He hit .421 (8-for-19) in a 2-2 week for Oklahoma. Carpenter slugged .684 with a .450 on-base percentage for an impressive 1.134 OPS. He hit the decisive two-run home run in a 2-0 win at West Virginia (4/17) in a two-hit night before adding a two-hit game on Saturday and a three-hit game on Sunday.

Pitcher of the Week: RHP-Jake Elliott (2/16) Raking in the Awards... Carpenter earned Big 12 and national recognition following an 8-for-17 week with three home runs. He was named the Big 12 Player of the Week and the Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball News on February 23. Carpenter is the second Sooner to earn the national award; first won by Mac James in 2014. Carpenter added a second Big 12 award on March 23 after going 5-for-11 in the Texas Tech series with a 4-for-4 day and decisive, three-run home run in game two.

Hermelyn Leads the Way... Hermelyn earned Big 12 Player of the Week on April 6 after hitting .529 (9-for-17) in a 4-0 week for the Sooners. He notched a multi-hit game in each, including three hits in the Saturday finale against Kansas (4/4). Oklahoma has claimed the Big 12 Player of the Week award four times for the first time ever.

Opening Day Roster... Former Sooner, Chase Anderson is the only OU alum to earn a roster spot for Major League Baseball opening day. A right-handed pitcher, Anderson was named to the Arizona Diamondbacks rotation. Angels right-hander Garrett Richards was activated for a start on April 19.

Complete Effort... Hansen tossed the first complete game of his career, at any level, against No. 10 Texas Tech (3/21). He struck out 10 and surrendered only three hits, while working through a choppy fifth after four, nohit innings to start the day. Hansen flashed a fastball at 101 MPH in the third and sustained a 97 MPH heater through the ninth. His complete game was the first by a Sooner since Jonathan Gray vs. Coastal Carolina (5/31/13) in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional.

For the Record... Single to center, single down the left field line, F7, single up the middle, three-run home run to right, double to right-center, infield-single to second. That was Aikin's record-setting day with a school-record six hits as he went 6-for-7 with four runs and six RBI in a 22-0 win over Arkansas-Little Rock (3/3). Aikin's home run was the first of his career as he set career marks in both runs scored and driven in.

200 Hits and Counting... In the series opener at Texas (4/10), Aikin collected the 200th hit of his career with a single in the second and later came around to score. He is the 17th player

on record at OU to reach the 200-hit mark and the first since Max White, who finished his career with 269, in 2013. Aikin's career total is up to 212 as he has passed MLB veterans Greg Norton (206) and Damon Minor (210).

Neuse Statement Heard... Neuse claimed the Sooner's third weekly award from the Big 12 after being named the Player of the Week (3/9). He hit .688 (11-for-16) with a 1.375 slugging and .722 on-base percentage. Neuse homered three times and drove in 10 runs over a four-game stretch at home. He posted a perfect 4-for-4 day with a home run and a double against Purdue (3/7). As a freshman, Neuse was twice selected as the Big 12 Rookie of the Week in 2014.

Hits by Pitchers... Redshirt-senior Robert Tasin made 37 appearances on the mound, including five starts, in his first two seasons with OU. This year, he has pitched in 13 games with six starts across 51 innings. To add depth to the Sooner bench and lineup from the left side of the plate, Tasin picked up a bat this offseason and is currently hitting .279 (17-for-61) with eight RBI. Junior Jacob Evans has also stepped to the plate for 13 at-bats this season and has five hits, including a walk-off home run.

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 9-10 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 6-1 loss to Texas Tech (3/20/14). OU has won four of its last six conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. lowa State (3/797), 7-4.

Turning Two... The Sooners rank seventh in the country and second in the Big 12 with 42 double plays turned; averaging 1.00 per game. Oklahoma turned a season-high four vs. BYU (2/28). In 2014, OU turned just 28, averaging 0.48 per game.

True North!... Junior catcher Chris Shaw is the first Canadian to play for the Sooners since lefty J.R. Robinson (2009-10). He is the first Manitoban to ever play in the Big 12 and one of four D-I players from his home province. A two-time MLB pick, Shaw became the highest Manitoban selected as the 14th round pick of the Cardinals in 2014. Shaw, whose other sport as a youth was curling, attended Okotoks Dawgs Baseball Academy in high school and was also a member of Team Canada before heading to Midland College.

#YardWork... Oklahoma is well on its way to surpassing its 30-home run total from 2014. Through 42 games, the Sooners have gone yard 29 times, including a team-leading seven from Carpenter. *The Sooners rank third in the Big 12 with 29 home runs and 0.69 per game.* Neuse is the team's active career home run leader with 13. Carpenter and junior left fielder **Hunter Haley** follow with 12 and 11, respectively.

Fresh Records... Neuse set an OU freshman record with seven triples and was second with 27 walks behind Aikin's 32 set in 2013. He also earned top-five finishes in home runs (7), hits (73), runs (43) and RBI (47) by a Sooner freshman.

Putting the Ball in Play... Oklahoma led the Big 12 in fewest strikeouts per game in 2014 at 4.86. Once again, the Sooners are at the top of the league; striking out at a rate of 5.43 per game. Kansas (5.88) is second. On balls hit in play, Oklahoma is hitting .322, led by Aikin and Carpenter at .404. Hermelyn (.336) is the third toughest to strikeout in the Big 12 with one strikeout for every 10.4 at-bats.

Season Openers... Since 1962, Oklahoma is 36-18 on opening day and 24-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 23-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 49-5 going back to 1962, including 33-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Starting in Center Field... Aikin has started all 42 games in center field; the only Sooner to start every game at the same position. Je was the OU center fielder in 57 out of 58 games in 2014.

Slugging it Out... The Sooners are the only team in the Big 12 to hit four home runs in a game and the only team to hit four triples in a game. Oklahoma slugged four homers against BYU (2/28) in Las Vegas and tripled four times against Oregon State (2/22) in Surprise, Ariz. OU repeated its four-home run effort against Purdue (3/8).

On the Hill... The OU pitching staff was tasked with replacing nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. This season, the Sooners return 74% of innings pitched from a year ago.

Utility Blue Print... Junior Kolbey Carpenter has been a steady performer in two-plus seasons at OU. He has appeared in games at five different positions and has started every opening day since his freshman season at a different position; 1B, DH, 2B.

40+ Years of Head Coaching... Pete Hughes' staff has totaled 41 years of head coaching experience and 1,304 wins. Mike Anderson won 337 games at Nebraska, Jamie Pinzino 212 at Assumption, Bryant and William & Mary and Scott Loiseau 176 at S. New Hampshire.

Value in Utility... Junior Anthony Hermelyn has seen a drastic change in his responsibilities from his freshman season when he started 48 games behind the dish. As a sophomore he split time between catcher and first base. This season he has added third base to his defensive duties as he earned starts at all three positions opening weekend.

Crooked Numbers... On the scoreboard, Oklahoma has put up two or more runs in an inning 63 times and three-or-more 40 times in 2015. Opponents have posted a crooked number only 39 times and have scored three-or-more just 22 times. The Sooners scored a season-high eight runs in an inning at Baylor (3/29).

Lineup on Shuffle... In 2014, Oklahoma did not repeat a lineup until the 14th game of the season. The Sooners used 35 different starting lineups a year ago. This season, OU has rolled out 27 different lineups in 42 games.
