**First Pitch...** The Oklahoma baseball team hosts Sam Houston State for its final non-conference weekend of the season. The three-game series gets underway Friday night at L. Dale Mitchell Park at 6:00 pm.

**About the Sooners...** The No. 23 Sooners' five-game homestand continues after a two-game sweep pushed their record to 28-16 overall. Junior second baseman **Kolbey Carpenter**, a three-time Big 12 Player of the Week honoree, has lifted his batting average to a team-high .365 over a season-best eight-game hit streak. He leads OU with seven home runs and a .565 slugging percentage to go with 32 RBI. Junior center fielder **Craig Aikin** (.358) is second on the team in hitting with a team-high 35 runs scored and 12 doubles. Red-shirt-senior right fielder **Taylor Alspaugh** (.325) has reached base in each of the last 19 games, including a three-hit, four-RBI game on Tuesday. Sophomore shortstop **Sheldon Neuse** (.311) is tops in the Big 12 with 35 RBI on six home runs, while slugging .503. Junior catcher/first baseman **Anthony Hermelyn** (.307) rounds out the group of five Sooners hitting .300-or-better.

**On the Air...** The "Voice of the Sooners" **Toby Rowland** will call all of the play-by-play action on The Sooner Sports Network. Sooner Sports TV will broadcast the entire series on the FOX Sports family of networks. **Chad McKee** (pbp) and former MLB All-Star **Mickey Tettleton** (color) will call the action from the broadcast booth.

### Leading Off

- Craig Aikin set an OU single-game record with six hits vs. UALR (3/3). Sooners had recorded five hits in a game 26 times.
- Kolbey Carpenter was named the Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week (2/23) and the Big 12 Player of the Week (2/23, 3/23).
- OU starting pitchers have lasted six or more innings in 23 out of 42 starts this season, including 12 of seven or more innings.
- The Sooners are 4-6 against ranked opponents this season and 2-2 against top-10 teams.
- Oklahoma's junior class became the first-ever to win two series against the Longhorns in Austin. Before 2013, OU last won a series at Texas in 1997.
- The Sooners won on two extra-inning walk-offs vs. Kansas. They are 4-1 in extras this year and 9-2 under second-year head coach Pete Hughes.

## HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 18 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 553-414-2 (.572), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

**Scouting the Bearkats...** Coming off a 2-1 series win against Abilene Christian, Sam Houston State is 13-8 in conference, leaving them fourth in the Southland Conference standings. At 22-20 overall, the team is led by **Spencer Rahm** with five homers, 30 RBI and a .327 batting average. **Travis Lee** is first on the team with a .330 average to go with six steals. Taking the mound on Friday, left-hander **Andrew Godail** (2-4) sports a 2.45 ERA in 10 starts..

**Last Time They Met...** Oklahoma last competed against Sam Houston in 2003 with a two-game sweep. Never losing the lead after a two-run knock from right fielder **Matt Arkison**, OU kept SHSU to four runs on five hits. With two runs in the fourth, sixth and eighth inning, OU won the second game of the series 8-4.

**All-Time vs. Sam Houston...** Beginning the series in 1987, OU leads the Bearkats 7-1 after losing only the first game. Since, OU has won four home games, two neutral and one away, their greatest win coming at home in 1999 when they beat Sam Houston 17-6. This is the first season that the two will compete against each other in three games.

**Shave for the Brave...** On April 1, the Sooners shaved their heads to support Vs. Cancer and fight childhood cancer. The team has surpassed its goal of \$20,000 for the second straight season by raising \$26,791. Half the proceeds go to the Vs. Cancer Foundation and half to OU Children's Hospital. **In 2014, the Sooners raised over \$29,000 towards childhood cancer research.**

**Reaching the Charts...** Last week, Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2015 as it reached No. 23 in the *Collegiate Baseball News* Top-30. The Sooners, who are 4-5 against ranked opponents this season, were last ranked on April 7, 2014 when they were No. 26 by CBN and No. 28 by NCBWA. The ranking marks the highest for OU under second-year head coach **Pete Hughes**.

**Up Next...** Oklahoma heads to Wichita State next Tuesday for its final road, mid-week game of the season. The Sooners and Shockers will play on ESPNU at 7:00 pm.

**Walk-Off AND a Win...** On April 2, junior **Jacob Evans** ignited a four-run rally with a pinch-hit single to start the ninth. After the Sooners tied the game, he went to the mound and pitched a 1-2-3 top of the 10th. Evans led off the bottom half of the inning with a solo, walk-off home run to right-center on a 3-2 pitch in just his seventh career at-bat. **Evans' homer was the first by an OU player that pitched in the same game since Ryan Mottern vs. Baylor (3/25/06).**

**Working Deep...** Oklahoma pitchers have combined to pitch through the sixth 23 times this season, including 12 starts through the seventh. Elliott leads the team with eight six-plus inning starts and Hansen has five. **Last season, OU starters pitched through the sixth 15 times in 58 games.**

**Kings of the K...** The Sooner pitching staff leads the Big 12 with 388 strikeouts; averaging a 8.81 per nine innings. Sophomore RHP **Alec Hansen** struck out 10 vs. Texas Tech (3/22) and leads all Big 12 pitchers with 73. Fellow sophomore righty **Jake Elliott** is third in the league at 58. **OU pitchers have combined to strike out 10-plus 21 times this season.**

**Bases Loaded...** Carpenter earned a record-setting third Big 12 Player of the Week honor on April 20. **Carpenter became the first Sooner to ever earn the award three times in a season and just the third in league history to do so.** He hit .421 (8-for-19) in a 2-2 week for Oklahoma. Carpenter slugged .684 with a .450 on-base percentage for an impressive 1.134 OPS. He hit the decisive two-run home run in a 2-0 win at West Virginia (4/17) in a two-hit night before adding a two-hit game on Saturday and a three-hit game on Sunday.

**Raking in the Awards...** Carpenter earned Big 12 and national recognition following an 8-for-17 week with three home runs. He was named the Big 12 Player of the Week and the Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball News* on February 23. **Carpenter is the second Sooner to earn the national award; first won by Mac James in 2014.** Carpenter added a second Big 12 award on March 23 after going 5-for-11 in the Texas Tech series with a 4-for-4 day and decisive, three-run home run in game two.

**Hermelyn Leads the Way...** Hermelyn earned Big 12 Player of the Week on April 6 after hitting .529 (9-for-17) in a 4-0 week for the Sooners. He notched a multi-hit game in each, including three hits in the Saturday finale against Kansas (4/4). **Oklahoma has claimed the Big 12 Player of the Week award four times for the first time ever.**

**Opening Day Roster...** Former Sooner, **Chase Anderson** earned a roster spot for Major League Baseball opening day. A right-handed pitcher, Anderson was named to the Arizona Diamondbacks rotation.

**Complete Effort...** Hansen tossed the first complete game of his career, at any level, against No. 10 Texas Tech (3/21). He struck out 10 and surrendered only three hits, while working through a choppy fifth after four, no-hit innings to start the day. **Hansen flashed a fastball at 101 MPH in the third and sustained a 97 MPH heater through the ninth.** His complete game was the first by a Sooner since **Jonathan Gray** vs. Coastal Carolina (5/31/13) in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional.

**For the Record...** Single to center, single down the left field line, F7, single up the middle, three-run home run to right, double to right-center, infield-single to second. That was Aikin's record-setting day with a school-record six hits as he went 6-for-7 with four runs and six RBI in a 22-0 win over Arkansas-Little Rock (3/3). Aikin's home run was the first of his career as he set career marks in both runs scored and driven in.

**200 Hits and Counting...** In the series opener at Texas (4/10), Aikin collected the 200th hit of his career with a single in the second and later came around to score. He is the 17th player on record at OU to reach the 200-hit mark and the first since **Max White**, who finished his career with 269, in 2013. Aikin's career total is up to 214 as he has passed MLB veterans **Greg Norton** (206) and **Damon Minor** (210).

**Neuse Statement Heard...** Neuse claimed the Sooner's third weekly award from the Big 12 after being named the Player of the Week (3/9). He hit .688 (11-for-16) with a 1.375 slugging and .722 on-base percentage. Neuse homered three times and drove in 10 runs over a four-game stretch at home. He posted a perfect 4-for-4 day with a home run and a double against Purdue (3/7). As a freshman, Neuse was twice selected as the Big 12 Rookie of the Week in 2014.

**Hits by Pitchers...** Redshirt-senior **Robert Tasin** made 37 appearances on the mound, including five starts, in his first two seasons with OU. This year, he has pitched in 13 games with six starts across 51 innings. To add depth to the Sooner bench and lineup from the left side of the plate, Tasin picked up a bat this offseason and is currently hitting .297 (19-for-64) with 10 RBI. Junior **Jacob Evans** has also stepped to the plate for 13 at-bats this season and has five hits, including a walk-off home run.

**Big 12 Openers...** The Sooners are 9-10 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 6-1 loss to Texas Tech (3/20/14). OU has won four of its last six conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/14), 7-4.

**Turning Two...** The Sooners rank seventh in the country and second in the Big 12 with 45 double plays turned; averaging 1.02 per game. Oklahoma turned a season-high four vs. BYU (2/28). In 2014, OU turned just 28, averaging 0.48 per game.

**True North!** Junior catcher **Chris Shaw** is the first Canadian to play for the Sooners since lefty **J.R. Robinson** (2009-10). He is the first Manitoban to ever play in the Big 12 and one of four D-I players from his home province. **A two-time MLB pick, Shaw became the highest Manitoban selected as the 14th round pick of the Cardinals in 2014.** Shaw, whose other sport as a youth was curling, attended Okotoks Dawgs Baseball Academy in high school and was also a member of Team Canada before heading to Midland College.

**Starting in Center Field...** Aikin has started all 44 games in center field; the only Sooner to start every game at the same position. He was the OU center fielder in 57 out of 58 games in 2014.

**#YardWork...** Oklahoma is well on its way to surpassing its 30-home run total from 2014. Through 44 games, the Sooners have gone yard 29 times, including a team-leading seven from Carpenter. Neuse is the team's active career home run leader with 13. Carpenter and junior left fielder **Hunter Haley** follow with 12 and 11, respectively.

**Fresh Records...** Neuse set an OU freshman record with seven triples and was second with 27 walks behind Aikin's 32 set in 2013. He also earned top-five finishes in home runs (7), hits (73), runs (43) and RBI (47) by a Sooner freshman.

**Putting the Ball in Play...** Oklahoma led the Big 12 in fewest strikeouts per game in 2014 at 4.86. Once again, the Sooners are at the top of the league; striking out at a rate of 5.36 per game. Kansas (5.95) is second. On balls hit in play, Oklahoma is hitting .324, led by Carpenter (.401) and Aikin (.396). Hermelyn (.329) is the third toughest to strikeout in the Big 12 with one strikeout for every 10.4 at-bats.

**Season Openers...** Since 1962, Oklahoma is 36-18 on opening day and 24-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 23-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 49-5 going back to 1962, including 33-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

**Slugging it Out...** The Sooners are the only team in the Big 12 to hit four home runs in a game and the only team to hit four triples in a game. Oklahoma slugged four homers against BYU (2/28) in Las Vegas and tripled four times against Oregon State (2/22) in Surprise, Ariz. OU repeated its four-home run effort against Purdue (3/8).

**On the Hill...** The OU pitching staff was tasked with replacing nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. **This season, the Sooners return 74% of innings pitched from a year ago.**

**Utility Blue Print...** Junior **Kolbey Carpenter** has been a steady performer in two-plus seasons at OU. He has appeared in games at five different positions and has started every opening day since his freshman season at a different position; 1B, DH, 2B.

**40+ Years of Head Coaching...** **Pete Hughes'** staff has totaled 41 years of head coaching experience and 1,306 wins. **Mike Anderson** won 337 games at Nebraska, **Jamie Pinzino** 212 at Assumption, Bryant and William & Mary and **Scott Loiseau** 176 at S. New Hampshire.

### CONFERENCE NOTES

☞ Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, TCU and Texas Tech remain ranked this week with TCU staying in the top 10 of all five national polls, including a spot as high as No. 6. Oklahoma State is also listed in the top 10 at No. 9, while Tech sits as high as No. 18 and Oklahoma held onto its No. 23 ranking.

☞ Oklahoma and Oklahoma State stay tied atop the league standings after each team won its latest conference series, 2-1. Four of the Big 12's teams ranked 1-5 in the standings will face off this weekend as Oklahoma State meets third-place Texas Tech and fourth-place TCU hosts fifth-place Texas. The Sooners are off this weekend in conference action. All five teams rank in the top 50 nationally in ERA.

☞ Texas broke out for 23 hits against Kansas last Sunday, falling two shy of the program record 25 (1998). The 23 hits matched Oklahoma for the most by a Big 12 team this season. C.J. Hinojosa batted for the cycle, marking the first time a Longhorn has accomplished the feat since 2007. It is the 15th cycle in Big 12 history and most recent since May of last season.

☞ With his next win, Kansas State head coach Brad Hill will collect victory No. 800 in his career. Hill is 799-384-3 over 21 seasons.

☞ TCU and Oklahoma State enter the week with RPIs in the top 15 as the Frogs sit at No. 9, while the Cowboys are 15th. TCU holds its top spot in the nation in ERA and is second nationally in shutouts with eight, twice as many as any other league team. Both the Frogs and Cowboys have yet to be shut out on the year. In addition to TCU leading the nation in ERA, a Big 12 pitcher also leads the individual category as TTU's Corey Taylor's 0.36 ERA is tops in the country entering the week.

☞ Kansas' Connor McKay holds a 27-game active reached base streak - the longest in the conference on the year.

☞ Kolbey Carpenter was named the Big 12 Player of the Week marking his third honor in the category on the season. He becomes one of four players in league history to claim the accolade three or more times in the same season. It was last done by KU's - Price in 2010.

☞ Texas Tech's Cameron Smith also earned his third weekly award on the year, picking up the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week. He is one of 16 pitchers to win the award three or more times in one season and the first Red
