**First Pitch...** Oklahoma baseball is on the road this weekend for a three-game, Big 12 series at Kansas State. The series gets underway Friday night at 6:00 pm.

**About the Sooners...** The Sooners snapped a five-game losing streak on Sunday with a 5-3 win over No. 11 Oklahoma State in the Bedlam Series finale. Oklahoma is now 30-21 overall and 11-7 in conference play. Junior second baseman **Kolbey Carpenter** leads the way with a .370 batting average and .565 slugging percentage on eight home runs and 36 RBI. Junior center fielder **Craig Aikin** ranks second at .348 with a team-leading 12 doubles, while he and Carpenter have each scored a team-best 41 runs. Three other Sooners are hitting .300-or-better, including sophomore shortstop **Sheldon Neuse** (.304), redshirt-senior right fielder **Taylor Alspaugh** (.302) and junior catcher/first baseman **Anthony Hermelyn** (.300). On Friday, Oklahoma looks to sophomore RHP **Jake Elliott** (4-4), who has pitched the weekend opener all 12 times this season. He owns a 2.50 earned run average and .208 batting average against. The Sooners pitching staff is first in the Big 12 and ninth in the nation with a 8.95 strikeout-per-nine-inning average.

**On the Air...** The "Voice of the Sooners" **Toby Rowland** will handle all of the play-by-play action on The Sooner Sports Network. The series can be heard locally on Sportstalk 1400 AM and 1560 Thre Franchise 2. K-State will televise games two and three on FOX College Sports-Central.

### Leading Off

- Craig Aikin set an OU single-game record with six hits vs. UALR (3/3). Sooners had recorded five hits in a game 26 times.
- Kolbey Carpenter was named the Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week (2/23) and the Big 12 Player of the Week (2/23, 3/23, 4/20).
- OU starting pitchers have lasted six or more innings in 27 out of 51 starts this season, including 12 of seven or more innings.
- The Sooners are 5-8 against ranked opponents this season and 2-2 against top-10 teams.
- Oklahoma's junior class became the first-ever to win two series against the Longhorns in Austin. Before 2013, OU last won a series at Texas in 1997.
- The Sooners won on two extra-inning walk-offs vs. Kansas. They are 4-2 in extras this year and 9-3 under second-year head coach Pete Hughes.

## HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 18 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 553-414-2 (.572), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

**Scouting the Wildcats...** Kansas State returns to conference play after a series win over Arkansas State and a midweek loss to Wichita State. The Wildcats are 23-25 overall and 7-11 in the Big 12. Catcher **Tyler Moore** leads the way at the plate with a .326 batting average to go with 27 RBI. First baseman **Shane Conlon** is second at .314, while adding 30 runs scored and eight steals. On the mound, RHP **Natie Griep**, who tossed a complete game shutout at OU last season, is 4-2 with a staff-best 2.97 ERA as he has struck out 52 across 60.2 innings of work.

**Last Time They Met...** Despite winning last season's series, OU lost to Kansas State 5-0 in the finale. The Sooners had eight hits, but were unable to create runs. Kansas State came out in the third and was able to score four runs on four hits. The Wildcats added one more run in the ninth to solidify the win.

**All-Time vs. K-State...** Oklahoma holds a strong series lead over the Wildcats, 150-56. The Sooners won the first six games of the series and have the series longest win streak with 27 straight games. In 2013, OU beat Kansas State in the Big 12 Championship and went as far as the NCAA Super Regionals.

**95 and 95...** Redshirt-senior RHP **Robert Tassin** and junior LHP **Jacob Evans** have combined for 95 at-bats and 95 innings pitched. Only 10 players have hit and pitched in the Big 12 this season, including the Sooners' Neuse. Only Texas has used as many two-way players this season, but combined for only 40 at-bats and 78.2 innings.

**OU-KSU Connection...** Sooner assistant and hitting coach **Mike Anderson** is the father of K-State infielder **Taylor Anderson**. A switch-hitter, the younger Anderson has been used primarily as a designated hitter or pinch-hitter through 16 starts and 30 total appearances.

**Shave for the Brave...** On April 1, the Sooners shaved their heads to support Vs. Cancer and fight childhood cancer. The team has surpassed its goal of \$20,000 for the second straight season by raising \$26,791. Half the proceeds go to the Vs. Cancer Foundation and half to OU Children's Hospital. **In 2014, the Sooners raised over \$29,000 towards childhood cancer research.**

**Reaching the Charts...** On April 13, Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2015 as it reached No. 23 in the *Collegiate Baseball News* Top-30. The Sooners, who are 4-6 against ranked opponents this season, were last ranked on April 7, 2014 when they were No. 26 by *CBN* and No. 28 by *NCBWA*. The ranking marks the highest for OU under second-year head coach **Pete Hughes**.

**Up Next...** Oklahoma spends the final week of the regular season at home beginning with a non-conference tilt against Stephen F. Austin on Tuesday, May 12 at 6:00 pm. The Sooners will then welcome TCU to L. Dale Mitchell Park for a Big 12 series, which starts on Thursday, May 14.

**Walk-Off AND a Win...** On April 2, junior **Jacob Evans** ignited a four-run rally with a pinch-hit single to start the ninth. After the Sooners tied the game, he went to the mound and pitched a 1-2-3 top of the 10th. Evans led off the bottom half of the inning with a solo, walk-off home run to right-center on a 3-2 pitch in just his seventh career at-bat. **Evans' homer was the first by an OU player that pitched in the same game since Ryan Mottern vs. Baylor (3/25/06).**

**Working Deep...** Oklahoma pitchers have combined to pitch through the sixth 27 times this season, including 12 starts through the seventh. Elliott leads the team with nine six-plus inning starts and Hansen has six. **Last season, OU starters pitched through the sixth 15 times in 58 games.**

**Kings of the K...** The Sooner pitching staff leads the Big 12 with 458 strikeouts; averaging a 8.95 per nine innings. Sophomore RHP **Alec Hansen** struck out 10 vs. Texas Tech (3/22) and leads all Big 12 pitchers with 85. Fellow sophomore righty **Jake Elliott** is fourth in the league at 71. **OU pitchers have combined to strike out 10-plus 26 times this season.**

**Bases Loaded...** Carpenter earned a record-setting third Big 12 Player of the Week honor on April 20. **Carpenter became the first Sooner to ever earn the award three times in a season and just the third in league history to do so.** He hit .421 (8-for-19) in a 2-2 week for Oklahoma. Carpenter slugged .684 with a .450 on-base percentage for an impressive 1.134 OPS. He hit the decisive two-run home run in a 2-0 win at West Virginia (4/17) in a two-hit night before adding a two-hit game on Saturday and a three-hit game on Sunday.

**Opening Day Roster...** Former Sooner, **Chase Anderson** earned a roster spot for Major League Baseball opening day. A right-handed pitcher, Anderson was named to the Arizona Diamondbacks rotation. Angels right-hander **Garrett Richards** was activated from the Disabled-List to make his season debut on April 19.

**Raking in the Awards...** Carpenter earned Big 12 and national recognition following an 8-for-17 week with three home runs. He was named the Big 12 Player of the Week and the Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball News* on February 23. **Carpenter is the second Sooner to earn the national award; first won by Mac James in 2014.** Carpenter added a second Big 12 award on March 23 after going 5-for-11 in the Texas Tech series with a 4-for-4 day and decisive, three-run home run in game two.

**Hermelyn Leads the Way...** Hermelyn earned Big 12 Player of the Week on April 6 after hitting .529 (9-for-17) in a 4-0 week for the Sooners. He notched a multi-hit game in each, including three hits in the Saturday finale against Kansas (4/4). **Oklahoma has claimed the Big 12 Player of the Week award four times for the first time ever.**

**Complete Effort...** Hansen tossed the first complete game of his career, at any level, against No. 10 Texas Tech (3/21). He struck out 10 and surrendered only three hits, while working through a choppy fifth after four, no-hit innings to start the day. **Hansen flashed a fastball at 101 MPH in the third and sustained a 97 MPH heater through the ninth.** His complete game was the first by a Sooner since **Jonathan Gray** vs. Coastal Carolina (5/31/13) in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional.

**For the Record...** Single to center, single down the left field line, F7, single up the middle, three-run home run to right, double to right-center, infield-single to second. That was Aikin's record-setting day with a school-record six hits as he went 6-for-7 with four runs and six RBI in a 22-0 win over Arkansas-Little Rock (3/3). Aikin's home run was the first of his career as he set career marks in both runs scored and driven in.

**200 Hits and Counting...** In the series opener at Texas (4/10), Aikin collected the 200th hit of his career with a single in the second and later came around to score. He is the 17th player on record at OU to reach the 200-hit mark and the first since **Max White**, who finished his career with 269, in 2013. Aikin's career total is up to 223 as he has passed MLB veterans **Greg Norton** (206) and **Damon Minor** (210).

**Neuse Statement Heard...** Neuse claimed the Sooner's third weekly award from the Big 12 after being named the Player of the Week (3/9). He hit .688 (11-for-16) with a 1.375 slugging and .722 on-base percentage. Neuse homered three times and drove in 10 runs over a four-game stretch at home. He posted a perfect 4-for-4 day with a home run and a double against Purdue (3/7). As a freshman, Neuse was twice selected as the Big 12 Rookie of the Week in 2014.

**Hits by Pitchers...** Redshirt-senior **Robert Tasin** made 37 appearances on the mound, including five starts, in his first two seasons with OU. This year, he has pitched in 15 games with eight starts across 60.2 innings. To add depth to the Sooner bench and lineup from the left side of the plate, Tasin picked up a bat this offseason and is currently hitting .276 (21-for-76) with 13 RBI. Junior **Jacob Evans** has also stepped to the plate for 19 at-bats this season and has seven hits, including a walk-off home run, and five RBI.

**Turning Two...** The Sooners rank 12th in the NCAA and second in the Big 12 with 49 double plays turned; averaging 0.96 per game. They turned a season-high four vs. BYU (2/28). In 2014, OU turned just 28, averaging 0.48.

**Starting in Center Field...** Aikin has started all 51 games in center field; the only Sooner to start every game at the same position. He was in center in 57 out of 58 games in 2014.

**True North!...** Junior catcher **Chris Shaw** is the first Canadian to play for the Sooners since lefty **J.R. Robinson** (2009-10). He is the first Manitoban to ever play in the Big 12 and one of four D-I players from his home province. **A two-time MLB pick, Shaw became the highest Manitoban selected as the 14th round pick of the Cardinals in 2014.** Shaw, whose other sport as a youth was curling, attended Okotoks Dawgs Baseball Academy in high school and was also a member of Team Canada before heading to Midland College.

**#YardWork...** Oklahoma surpassed its 30-home run total from 2014 with Shaw hitting the team's 31st of the season against Sam Houston State (4/25). Through 51 games, the Sooners have gone yard 33 times, including a team-leading eight from Carpenter. Neuse and Carpenter are the team's active career home run leaders with 13. Junior left fielder **Hunter Haley** follows with 11.

**Big 12 Openers...** The Sooners are 9-10 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 6-1 loss to Texas Tech (3/20/14). OU has won four of its last six conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

**Fresh Records...** Neuse set an OU freshman record with seven triples and was second with 27 walks behind Aikin's 32 set in 2013. He also earned top-five finishes in home runs (7), hits (73), runs (43) and RBI (47) by a Sooner freshman.

**Putting the Ball in Play...** Oklahoma led the Big 12 in fewest strikeouts per game in 2014 at 4.86. Once again, the Sooners are at the top of the league; striking out at a rate of 5.61 per game. Kansas (5.85) is second. On balls hit in play, Oklahoma is hitting .318, led by Carpenter (.407) and Aikin (.389). Hermelyn (.315) is the third toughest to strikeout in the Big 12 with one strikeout for every 10.7 at-bats.

**Season Openers...** Since 1962, Oklahoma is 36-18 on opening day and 24-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 23-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 49-5 going back to 1962, including 33-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

**Slugging it Out...** The Sooners are the only team in the Big 12 to hit four home runs in a game and the only team to hit four triples in a game. Oklahoma slugged four homers against BYU (2/28) in Las Vegas and tripled four times against Oregon State (2/22) in Surprise, Ariz. OU repeated its four-home run effort against Purdue (3/8).

**On the Hill...** The OU pitching staff was tasked with replacing nearly 60% of its innings pitched from 2013 after losing five pitchers to the draft. **This season, the Sooners return 74% of innings pitched from a year ago.**

### CONFERENCE NOTES

❏ Oklahoma State and TCU enter the week ranked in the top 25 of all five national polls with Texas Tech sitting at No. 25 in the NCBWA rankings. The Frogs are as high as No. 3, while OSU sits at No. 11 on two lists. TCU enters the week ranked fifth in RPI while the Cowboys are 12th.

❏ With two weeks remaining in the regular season, five of the league's nine teams have a pair of conference series left, while Baylor, Oklahoma State, Texas and Texas Tech have just one series remaining. The Cowboys will play their last conference series this weekend, hosting West Virginia.

❏ A different league team has won the regular season crown in each of the past four years (2011-14). The league's regular season champion has gone on to win the postseason title on just five occasions (last done in 2011).

❏ The final weekend of the regular season includes: K-State at Kansas, TCU at Oklahoma, Texas at Baylor and Texas Tech at West Virginia with Oklahoma State in non-conference action against Michigan.

❏ Of the 29 conference series played this season, only seven (24 percent) have resulted in sweeps with TCU the only team with multiple sweeps on the year (vs. Baylor, vs. Texas, at West Virginia).

❏ Of the 87 conference games played, 51 have been determined by three runs or less (nearly 60 percent).

❏ The league's first through fifth place teams (TCU, Oklahoma State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech and Texas) all rank in the top 50 nationally in ERA with the Frogs (third), Cowboys (13th) and Longhorns (29th) in the top 30.

❏ TCU head coach Jim Schlossnagle recorded his 500th win at TCU last week, while TTU's Tim Tadlock notched win No. 100.

❏ KU's Connor McKay extended his reached-base streak to 35 games. At 38 games, he will tie for the 12th-best streak in conference history. Only eight players have totaled a streak of 40 or more games in a single season. KU plays five games this week.

❏ The Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship will make its debut at ONEOK Field in Tulsa May 20-24, marking just the third time the event hasn't been hosted in Oklahoma City. All-session tickets are on sale now at [Big12Sports.com](http://Big12Sports.com) or at [Big12InTulsa.com](http://Big12InTulsa.com). Wednesday through Saturday's contests will be telecast on FOX College Sports with Sunday's noon championship game on FOX Sports 1.
