HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 18 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 553-414-2 (.572), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Horned Frogs... Winners of six in a row, No. 3 TCU is 40-9 overall and 15-5 in the Big 12. Designated hitter Connor Wanhanen (.364) and center fielder Cody Jones (.362) leads the Horned Frogs lineup in hitting. Wanhanen has driven in 30 runs and scored 28, while Jones has scored a team-high 46 to go with 24 stolen bases. Right-hander Preston Morrison leads a staff of aces with an 11-1 record, while holding a 1.87 ERA. Out of the bullpen, righty Riley Ferrell has locked down 12 saves with a 0.73 ERA and 39 strikeouts in 24.2 innings.

Last Time They Met... The Sooners lost to the No. 4 Horned Frogs in Fort Worth on March 24, 4-3, in 10 innings. Trailing 3-1 in the eighth, OU forced extras after Carpenter and Alspaugh singled and scored on a sacbunt/error and a balk. Jeremie Fagnan delivered the game-winning, pinch-hit single in the 10th for TCU after entering as an injury replacement and inheriting a 1-2 count.

All-Time vs. TCU... Oklahoma leads the series against TCU with a 54-24 all-time record. The series started in 1974 with a 12-8 Sooner victory. In 2014, OU went 2-2 in the regular season, including a 9-5 win at home in a non-conference tilt.

95 and 95... Redshirt-senior RHP Robert Tasin and junior LHP Jacob Evans have combined for 102 at-bats and 104 innings pitched. Only 10 players have hit and pitched in the Big 12 this season, including the Sooners' Neuse. Only Texas has used as many two-way players this season, but combined for only 40 at-bats and 88.2 innings.

Winning in the Big 12... Tasin has entered rare company for an OU pitcher in recent years with his fifth conference win. He became the first Sooner to win five Big 12 starts since Michael Rocha and Burch Smith did so in 2011. Tasin, who has won four of his six league starts plus one relief win, will have an opportunity to match Zach Neal (2010) with six Big 12 wins in one season when he pitches against TCU.

Back-Up Plan... Evans and junior righthander Ralph Garza Jr. have been as solid as any lefty/righty combo at the back-end of the bullpen in the Big 12. The two have combined for a 1.80 ERA in 22 appearances in league games. It is the second best ERA for a pair of Big 12 relievers with at least 30 total relief innings behind Texas Tech's Corey Taylor and Dominic Moreno at 0.44. Bryce Wiid and Corey Fischer of K-State rank third at 1.87, while Trey Cobb and Tyler Buffett of OSU rank fourth at 2.02. On the season. Evans and Garza have combined for seven wins and 10 saves, including three and seven in Big 12 play. Garza is currently tied for fourth all-time at OU with 80 games pitched and Evans eighth at 75.

Pitcher of the Week: RHP-Jake Elliott (2/16) Sooners in the Outfield... Aikin (center field), junior Hunter Haley (left) and redshirt-senior Taylor Alspaugh (right) have combined to start 79 games together in the Sooner outfield. All three players have been on the Oklahoma roster since 2013, but did not see the field together until opening day 2014. The trio started 41 games together in 2014 and 38 in 2015. They have played the most games together in the outfield since Cody Reine, Erik Ross and Max White started 47 together from 2010-12.

Shave for the Brave... On April 1, the Sooners shaved their heads to support Vs. Cancer and fight childhood cancer. The team has surpassed its goal of \$20,000 for the second straight season by raising \$26,791. Half the proceeds go to the Vs. Cancer Foundation and half to OU Children's Hospital. In 2014, the Sooners raised over \$29,000 towards childhood cancer research.

Reaching the Charts... On April 13, Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2015 as it reached No. 23 in the Collegiate Baseball News Top-30. The Sooners, who are 4-6 against ranked opponents this season, were last ranked on April 7, 2014 when they were No. 26 by CBN and No. 28 by NCBWA. The ranking marks the highest for OU under second-year head coach Pete Hughes.

Up Next... The Sooners hit the road to Tulsa for the Big 12 Championship at ONEOK Field. The action gets underway Wednesday, May 20. Seeding for the tournament will be determined following this weekend's contests.

Walk-Off AND a Win... On April 2, junior Jacob Evans ignited a four-run rally with a pinch-hit single to start the ninth. After the Sooners tied the game, he went to the mound and pitched a 1-2-3 top of the 10th. Evans led off the bottom half of the inning with a solo, walk-off home run to rightcenter on a 3-2 pitch in just his seventh career at-bat. Evans' homer was the first by an OU player that pitched in the same game since Ryan Mottern vs. Baylor (3/25/06).

Working Deep... Oklahoma pitchers have combined to pitch through the sixth 28 times this season, including 12 starts through the seventh. Elliott leads the team with nine six-plus inning starts and Hansen has six. Last season, OU starters pitched through the sixth 15 times in 58 games.

Kings of the K... The Sooner pitching staff leads the Big 12 with 481 strike-outs; averaging a 8.90 per nine innings. Sophomore RHP Alec Hansen struck out 10 vs. Texas Tech (3/22) and leads all Big 12 pitchers with 89. Fellow sophomore righty Jake Elliott is fourth in the league at 75. OU pitchers have combined to strike out 10-plus 26 times this season.

Bases Loaded... Carpenter earned a record-setting third Big 12 Player of the Week honor on April 20. Carpenter became the first Sooner to ever earn the award three times in a season and just the third in league history to do so. He hit .421 (8-for-19) in a 2-2 week for Oklahoma. Carpenter slugged .684 with a .450 on-base percentage for an impressive 1.134 OPS. He hit the decisive two-run home run in a 2-0 win at West Virginia (4/17) in a two-hit night before adding a two-hit game on Saturday and a three-hit game on Sunday.

Raking in the Awards... Carpenter earned Big 12 and national recognition following an 8-for-17 week with three home runs. He was named the Big 12 Player of the Week and the Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball News on February 23. Carpenter is the second Sooner to earn the national award; first won by Mac James in 2014. Carpenter added a second Big 12 award on March 23 after going 5-for-11 in the Texas Tech series with a 4-for-4 day and decisive, three-run home run in game two.

Hermelyn Leads the Way... Hermelyn earned Big 12 Player of the Week on April 6 after hitting .529 (9-for-17) in a 4-0 week for the Sooners. He notched a multi-hit game in each, including three hits in the Saturday finale against Kansas (4/4). Oklahoma has claimed the Big 12 Player of the Week award four times for the first time ever.

Complete Effort... Hansen tossed the first complete game of his career, at any level, against No. 10 Texas Tech (3/21). He struck out 10 and surrendered only three hits, while working through a choppy fifth after four, nohit innings to start the day. Hansen flashed a fastball at 101 MPH in the third and sustained a 97 MPH heater through the ninth. His complete game was the first by a Sooner since Jonathan Gray vs. Coastal Carolina (5/31/13) in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional.

For the Record... Single to center, single down the left field line, F7, single up the middle, three-run home run to right, double to rightcenter, infield-single to second. That was Aikin's record-setting day with a school-record six hits as he went 6-for-7 with four runs and six RBI in a 22-0 win over Arkansas-Little Rock (3/3). Aikin's home run was the first of his career as he set career marks in both runs scored and driven in.

200 Hits and Counting... In the series opener at Texas (4/10), Aikin collected the 200th hit of his career with a single in the second and later came around to score. He is the 17th player on record at OU to reach the 200-hit mark and the first since Max White, who finished his career with 269, in 2013. Aikin's career total is up to 226 as he has passed MLB veterans Greg Norton (206) and Damon Minor (210).

Neuse Statement Heard... Neuse claimed the Sooner's third weekly award from the Big 12 after being named the Player of the Week (3/9). He hit .688 (11-for-16) with a 1.375 slugging and .722 on-base percentage. Neuse homered three times and drove in 10 runs over a four-game stretch at home. He posted a perfect 4-for-4 day with a home run and a double against Purdue (3/7). As a freshman, Neuse was twice selected as the Big 12 Rookie of the Week in 2014.

Starting in Center Field... Aikin has started all 54 games in center field; the only Sooner to start every game at the same position. He was in center in 57 out of 58 games in 2014.

True North!... Junior catcher Chris Shaw is the first Canadian to play for the Sooners since lefty J.R. Robinson (2009-10). He is the first Manitoban to ever play in the Big 12 and one of four D-I players from his home province. A two-time MLB pick, Shaw became the highest Manitoban selected as the 14th round pick of the Cardinals in 2014. Shaw, whose other sport as a youth was curling, attended Okotoks Dawgs Baseball Academy in high school and was also a member of Team Canada before heading to Midland College.

#YardWork... Oklahoma surpassed its 30home run total from 2014 with Shaw hitting the team's 31st of the season against Sam Houston State (4/25). Through 54 games, the Sooners have gone yard 35 times, including a team-leading eight from Carpenter. Neuse and Carpenter are the team's active career home run leaders with 13. Junior left fielder Hunter Haley follows with 12.

Big 12 Openers... The Sooners are 9-10 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 6-1 loss to Texas Tech (3/20/14). OU has won four of its last six conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/797), 7-4.

Fresh Records... Neuse set an OU freshman record with seven triples and was second with 27 walks behind Aikin's 32 set in 2013. He also earned top-five finishes in home runs (7), hits (73), runs (43) and RBI (47) by a Sooner freshman.

Putting the Ball in Play... Oklahoma led the Big 12 in fewest strikeouts per game in 2014 at 4.86. Once again, the Sooners are at the top of the league; striking out at a rate of 5.56 per game. Kansas (5.71) is second. On balls hit in play, Oklahoma is hitting .316, led by Carpenter (.400) and Aikin (.389). Hermelyn (.316) is the toughest to strikeout in the Big 12 with one strikeout for every 11.3 at-bats.

Season Openers... Since 1962, Oklahoma is 36-18 on opening day and 24-2 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 23-1 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 49-5 going back to 1962, including 33-1 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Slugging it Out... The Sooners are the only team in the Big 12 to hit four home runs in a game and the only team to hit four triples in a game. Oklahoma slugged four homers against BYU (2/28) in Las Vegas and tripled four times against Oregon State (2/22) in Surprise, Ariz. OU repeated its four-home run effort against Purdue (3/8).

- TCU enters the week ranked in the top five of all five national polls. Oklahoma State is also ranked on every list, checking in as high as No. 13 in three different rankings.
- The final weekend of the regular season will put the conference crown on the line as 15-5 TCU visits 13-8 Oklahoma. The Frogs need just one win to claim the title, while OU would need to sweep to win the regular season. Oklahoma has just one loss in conference play at home on the season, where it is 5-1 against Big I2 opponents.
- TCU looks to become the ninth team to win the conference regular season title the year after winning the postseason crown. Oklahoma has yet to win the Big I2 regular season, but has claimed two postseason crowns.
- A different league team has won the regular season each of the past four years (20II-I4). The league's regular season champion has gone on to win the postseason title on just five occasions (last done in 20II). The regular season champion has advanced to the Big I2 Championship finale I0 times.
- Of the 32 conference series played this season, only seven (22 percent) have resulted in three-game sweeps with TCU the only team with multiple sweeps on the year (vs. Baylor, vs. Texas, at West Virginia).
- Of the 93 conference games played, 56 have been determined by three runs or less (60 percent).
- The Frogs lead the league in batting average, ERA and fielding percentage. On only two occasions has the same team finished the season leading the conference in all three categories Nebraska, 2000, and Oklahoma State, 2008.
- The league's first through fifth place teams (TCU, Oklahoma State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech and Texas) all rank in the top 50 nationally in ERA with the Frogs (first) and Cowboys (13th) in the top 15.
- Kansas' Connor McKay has reached base in 39 consecutive games. At 40, he will become one of nine players to hold a single-season streak of 40 or more games.
- The Phillips 66 Big I2 Baseball Championship will make its debut at ONEOK Field in Tulsa May 20-24, marking just the third time the event hasn't been hosted in Oklahoma City. All-session tickets are on sale now at BigI2Sports.com or at BigI2InTulsa.com. Wednesday through Saturday's contests will be telecast on FOX College Sports with


