**Tourney Time...** The Oklahoma baseball team earned the three-seed, its highest since 2011, and is set to open the Big 12 Championship against six-seed Kansas State. The Sooners and the Wildcats face off at 4:00 pm Wednesday at Tulsa's ONEOK Field.

**About the Sooners...** Oklahoma closed out the regular season with a sweep at the hands of No. 3 TCU to enter the postseason at 32-25 overall and 13-11 in the Big 12. Junior **Kolbey Carpenter** leads the Sooners with a .363 batting average and .549 slugging percentage on 10 doubles and eight home runs. Junior center fielder **Craig Aikin** is second on OU at .349 with a team-high 47 runs scored and 14 doubles. Riding a 10-game hit streak, junior catcher **Anthony Hermelyn** has lifted his average to .316, while leading the Sooners in RBI at 47. Sophomore right-hander **Jake Elliott** has held the top spot in the rotation all season. He is 4-5 with a 2.92 earned run average, while ranking second on the team with 80 strikeouts. As a team, Oklahoma is hitting .283, while holding its opponents to a .246 average.

**On the Air...** Veteran OU broadcasters **Toby Rowland** (play-by-play) and **Chris Plank** (sideline) will handle all of the action on The Sooner Radio Network. The series can be heard in Norman on 1400 and 1560 AM and in Tulsa on 1430 AM. Sooner Sports TV will broadcast the series on FCS-Central. **Bill Doleman** (pbp) and former MLB and Oklahoma alum **George Frazier** (color) are on the call.

### Leading Off

- Craig Aikin set an OU single-game record with six hits vs. UALR (3/3). Sooners had recorded five hits in a game 26 times.
- Kolbey Carpenter was named the Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week (2/23) and the Big 12 Player of the Week (2/23, 3/23, 4/20).
- OU starting pitchers have lasted six or more innings in 28 out of 54 starts this season, including 12 of seven or more innings.
- The Sooners are 5-8 against ranked opponents this season and 2-2 against top-10 teams.
- Oklahoma's junior class became the first-ever to win two series against the Longhorns in Austin. Before 2013, OU last won a series at Texas in 1997.
- The Sooners won on two extra-inning walk-offs vs. Kansas. They are 4-2 in extras this year and 9-3 under second-year head coach Pete Hughes.

## HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 18 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 553-414-2 (.572), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

**Scouting the Wildcats...** Kansas State comes into Tulsa after taking two games of the three game series against in-state rival Kansas over the weekend to improve to 26-28 overall and 10-14 in league. Catcher **Tyler Moore** is hitting .302 with a team-high four home runs to go with 29 RBI. First baseman **Shane Conlon** is first on the team at .308 with 36 runs scored. Right-hander **Colton Kalmus** is expected to get the ball on Wednesday. He is 1-4 with a 4.20 ERA across 55.2 innings of work.

**Last Time They Met...** Oklahoma took two of three games in the series two weeks ago in Manhattan. The Sooners fought back after dropping the series opener to win 5-3 and 4-3 in two hard fought games. Juniors **Hunter Haley** and **Chris Shaw** both homered in Saturday's game to boost OU to a victory. Freshman infielder **Kyle Mendenhall** went 2-for-4 on Sunday with a double to help lead Oklahoma to a series win.

**All-Time vs. K-State...** Oklahoma leads the series against Kansas State with a 152-57 all-time record. The Sooners won the first six games of the series and have the series longest win streak with 27 straight games. In 2013, OU beat Kansas State in the Big 12 Championship and went as far as the NCAA Super Regionals.

**Throw it and Hit it...** Redshirt-senior RHP **Robert Tasin** and junior LHP **Jacob Evans** have combined for 109 at-bats and 112 innings pitched. Only 10 players have hit and pitched in the Big 12 this season, including the Sooners' Neuse. Only Texas has used as many two-way players this season, but combined for only 40 at-bats and 88.2 innings.

**Sooners in the Tourney...** All-time, the Sooners are 32-29 in the Big 12 Championship. Against K-State, OU is 2-2. This season marks the fourth time the Sooners are seeded third. They most recently were the three-seed in 2011. Oklahoma has claimed Big 12 Championship titles in 1997 and 2013.

**2014 Tournament Recap...** The eight-seed Sooners went 1-2 last year with a walk-off over Texas Tech in an elimination game. **Sheldon Neuse** provided the game-winning hit in the bottom of the ninth as the Sooners rallied from five down to win 9-8. Neuse and Aikin were both named to the All-Tournament Team.

**Championship Experience...** Oklahoma features six players, plus Haley who injured during the 2013 championship, who played a major role on the title team two years ago. In seven career games, Aikin is a .438 hitter in the tournament after two four-hit games last season. Hermelyn, a 2013 All-Tournament Team selection, is hitting .333 with five RBI in seven games.

**This Side of the Bracket...** Oklahoma has totaled a 5-5 record against Kansas State, Oklahoma State and West Virginia, including a non-conference loss to the Cowboys. In 2014, the Sooners lost to OSU in its championship opener and were eliminated by the Cowboys two days later. Oklahoma and West Virginia, who joined the Big 12 in 2013, have never met in the postseason.

**Winning in the Big 12...** Tasin entered rare company for an OU pitcher in recent years with his fifth conference win. He became the first Sooner to win five Big 12 starts since **Michael Rocha** and **Burch Smith** did so in 2011. **Zach Neal** won six Big 12 games for Oklahoma in 2010.

**Sooners in the Outfield...** Aikin (center field), junior **Hunter Haley** (left) and redshirt-senior **Taylor Alspaugh** (right) have combined to start 82 games together in the Sooner outfield. All three players have been on the Oklahoma roster since 2013, but did not see the field together until opening day 2014. The trio started 41 games together in 2014 and 38 in 2015. They have played the most games together in the outfield since **Cody Reine**, **Erik Ross** and **Max White** started 47 together from 2010-12.

**Working Deep...** Oklahoma pitchers have combined to pitch through the sixth 30 times this season, including 12 starts through the seventh. Elliott leads the team with 10 six-plus inning starts and Hansen has six. **Last season, OU starters pitched through the sixth 15 times in 58 games.**

**Kings of the K...** The Sooner pitching staff leads the Big 12 with 501 strikeouts; averaging a 8.78 per nine innings. Sophomore RHP **Alec Hansen** leads all Big 12 pitchers with 93. Elliott is fourth in the league at 80. **OU pitchers have combined to strike out 10-plus 26 times this season.** The Sooners surpassed the 500-strikeout mark for the fifth time in program history and third time in four years.

**Shave for the Brave...** On April 1, the Sooners shaved their heads to support Vs. Cancer and fight childhood cancer. The team has surpassed its goal of \$20,000 for the second straight season by raising \$26,791. Half the proceeds go to the Vs. Cancer Foundation and half to OU Children's Hospital. **In 2014, the Sooners raised over \$29,000 towards childhood cancer research.**

**Reaching the Charts...** On April 13, Oklahoma became ranked for the first time in 2015 as it reached No. 23 in the *Collegiate Baseball News* Top-30. The Sooners, who are 4-6 against ranked opponents this season, were last ranked on April 7, 2014 when they were No. 26 by *CBN* and No. 28 by *NCBWA*. The ranking marks the highest for OU under second-year head coach **Pete Hughes**.

**Walk-Off AND a Win...** On April 2, junior **Jacob Evans** ignited a four-run rally with a pinch-hit single to start the ninth. After the Sooners tied the game, he went to the mound and pitched a 1-2-3 top of the 10th. Evans led off the bottom half of the inning with a solo, walk-off home run to right-center on a 3-2 pitch in just his seventh career at-bat. **Evans' homer was the first by an OU player that pitched in the same game since Ryan Mottern vs. Baylor (3/25/06).**

**Bases Loaded...** Carpenter earned a record-setting third Big 12 Player of the Week honor on April 20. **Carpenter became the first Sooner to ever earn the award three times in a season and just the third in league history to do so.** He hit .421 (8-for-19) in a 2-2 week for Oklahoma. Carpenter slugged .684 with a .450 on-base percentage for an impressive 1.134 OPS. He hit the decisive two-run home run in a 2-0 win at West Virginia (4/17) in a two-hit night before adding a two-hit game on Saturday and a three-hit game on Sunday.

**Raking in the Awards...** Carpenter earned Big 12 and national recognition following an 8-for-17 week with three home runs. He was named the Big 12 Player of the Week and the Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball News* on February 23. **Carpenter is the second Sooner to earn the national award; first won by Mac James in 2014.** Carpenter added a second Big 12 award on March 23 after going 5-for-11 in the Texas Tech series with a 4-for-4 day and decisive, three-run home run in game two.

**Hermelyn Leads the Way...** Hermelyn earned Big 12 Player of the Week on April 6 after hitting .529 (9-for-17) in a 4-0 week for the Sooners. He notched a multi-hit game in each, including three hits in the Saturday finale against Kansas (4/4). **Oklahoma has claimed the Big 12 Player of the Week award four times for the first time ever.**

**Complete Effort...** Hansen tossed the first complete game of his career, at any level, against No. 10 Texas Tech (3/21). He struck out 10 and surrendered only three hits, while working through a choppy fifth after four, no-hit innings to start the day. **Hansen flashed a fastball at 101 MPH in the third and sustained a 97 MPH heater through the ninth.** His complete game was the first by a Sooner since **Jonathan Gray** vs. Coastal Carolina (5/31/13) in the NCAA Blacksburg Regional.

**For the Record...** Single to center, single down the left field line, F7, single up the middle, three-run home run to right, double to right-center, infield-single to second. That was Aikin's record-setting day with a school-record six hits as he went 6-for-7 with four runs and six RBI in a 22-0 win over UALR (3/3). Aikin's homer was the first of his career as he set career marks in both runs scored and driven in.

**#YardWork...** Oklahoma surpassed its 30-home run total from 2014 with Shaw hitting the team's 31st of the season against Sam Houston State (4/25). Through 57 games, the Sooners have gone yard 37 times, including a team-leading eight from Carpenter. Oklahoma's 37 long balls are the most since 41 in 2011. Neuse and Carpenter are the team's active career home run leaders with 13.

**Starting in Center Field...** Aikin has started all 57 games in center field; the only Sooner to start every game at the same position. He was in center in 57 out of 58 games in 2014.

**Opening Day Starter...** Elliott became the first righty to start opening day for Oklahoma since **Michael Rocha** in 2011. He is also the third sophomore to earn the nod in the last four year after Evans (2014) and **Dillon Overton** (2012). **Elliott will start his second Big 12 Championship opener and is the first to start the season and Big 12 Championship opener since Overton in 2012.**

**Back-End Aces...** Evans and junior right-hander **Ralph Garza Jr.** have each bounced back after a sophomore slump. Evans resumed his role as the closer, which earned him Freshman All-America in 2013, and Garza earned back the eight-inning setup role this year. **Garza is fourth all-time at OU with 82 career appearances, while Evans is eighth with 77.** Evans recently became the third Sooner all-time with 15 career wins and saves. He is currently at 17 saves. Garza has 12 career wins and nine saves.

**200 Hits and Counting...** In the series opener at Texas (4/10), Aikin collected the 200th hit of his career with a single in the second and later came around to score. He is the 17th player on record at OU to reach the 200-hit mark and the first since **Max White**, who finished his career with 269, in 2013. Aikin's career total is up to 232 as he has passed MLB veterans **Greg Norton** (206) and **Damon Minor** (210).

**Neuse Statement Heard...** Neuse claimed the Sooner's third weekly award from the Big 12 after being named the Player of the Week (3/9). He hit .688 (11-for-16) with a 1.375 slugging and .722 on-base percentage. Neuse homered three times and drove in 10 runs over a four-game stretch at home. He posted a perfect 4-for-4 day with a home run and a double against Purdue (3/7). As a freshman, Neuse was twice selected as the Big 12 Rookie of the Week in 2014.

**True North!...** Junior catcher **Chris Shaw** is the first Canadian to play for the Sooners since lefty **J.R. Robinson** (2009-10). He is the first Manitoban to ever play in the Big 12 and one of four D-I players from his home province. **A two-time MLB pick, Shaw became the highest Manitoban selected as the 14th round pick of the Cardinals in 2014.** Shaw, whose other sport as a youth was curling, attended Okotoks Dawgs Baseball Academy in high school and was also a member of Team Canada before heading to Midland College.

**Putting the Ball in Play...** Oklahoma led the Big 12 in fewest strikeouts per game in 2014 at 4.86. Once again, the Sooners are at the top of the league; striking out at a rate of 5.58 per game. Kansas (5.60) is second. On balls hit in play, Oklahoma is hitting .318, led by Carpenter (.400) and Aikin (.395). Hermelyn (.324) is the second toughest to strikeout in the Big 12 with one strikeout for every 11.4 at-bats.

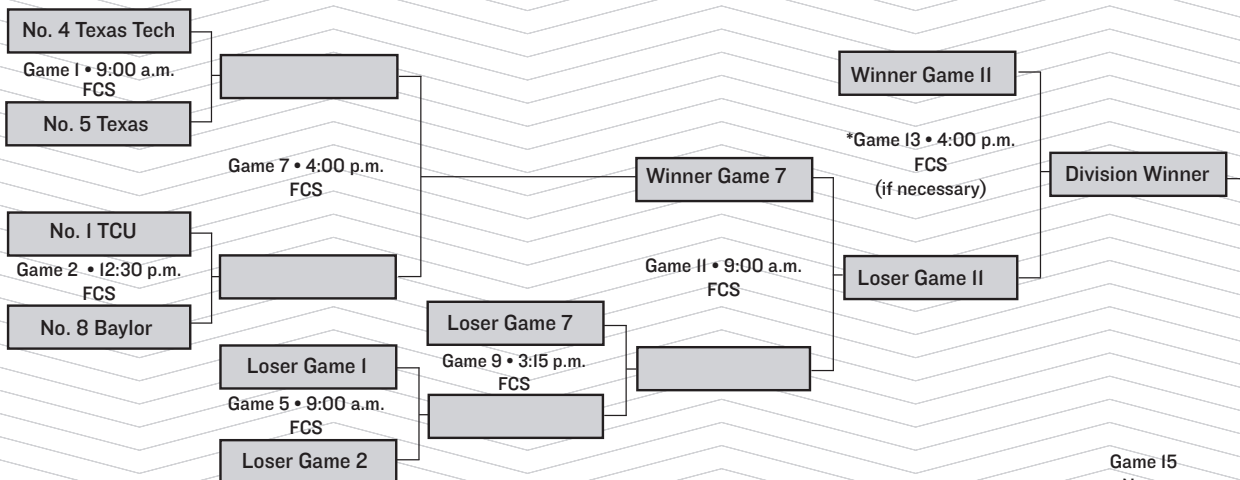

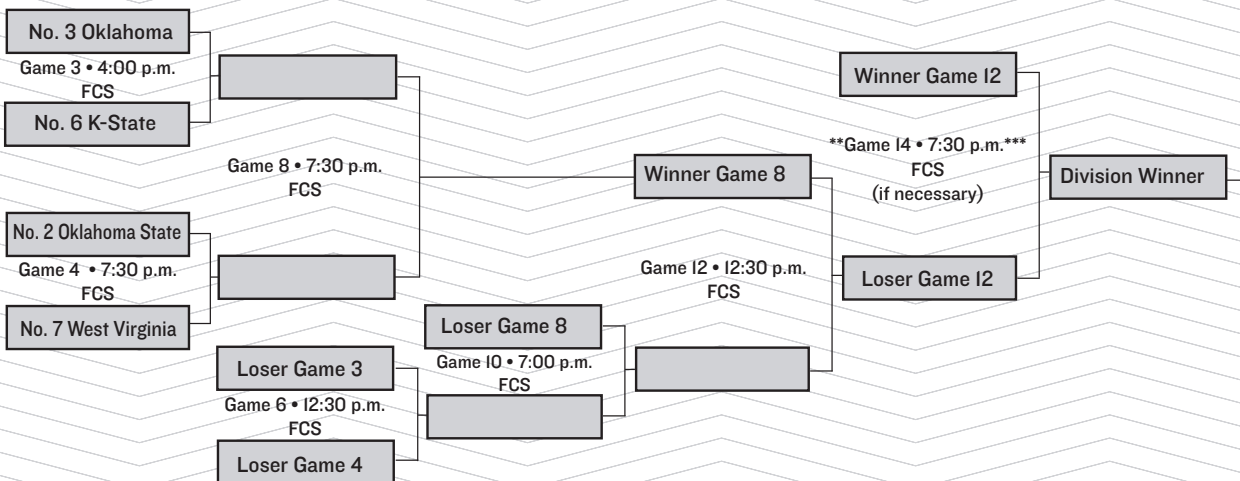
