### First Pitch...

Eight consecutive weekends of Big 12 play starts on the road for the University of Oklahoma baseball team. The Sooners open the conference season on Thursday night at 6:30 pm against Texas Tech at Rip Griffin Park.

### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma saw its season-best six-game win streak come to an end on Tuesday night at Oral Roberts and head towards Big 12 action and Texas Tech at 11-10-1 overall. Junior shortstop **Sheldon Neuse** leads the Sooners' lineup with a .377 average after recording the 10th multi-hit game of his season on Tuesday. Neuse is slugging .688 and has driven in 18 runs. Junior **Jack Flansburg**, who has made multiple starts at all four infield positions, is second on the team at .308 with a team-high 19 runs scored. Freshman third baseman **Cade Harris** and senior right fielder **Alex Wise** have given the offense a boost of late. Harris has seen his average climb to .295, while making starts at the top of the OU batting order. Wise is hitting .289, including a .364 average over an 11-game hit streak, with 14 runs scored. Junior right-hander **Alec Hansen** (0-3) gets the ball for the Sooners in game one. He has struck out 28 batters in just 19.1 innings, but sports a 6.05 earned run average. In game two, Oklahoma turns to freshman right-hander **Chris Andritsos** (3-1), who pitched seven scoreless at CSU Bakersfield last Saturday.

All weekend long, the action can be heard across the Sooner Sports Radio Network and locally at Sportstalk 1400 AM and 98.5 FM. OU baseball communications director **Brendan Flynn** will call the play-by-play alongside Sooner baseball alum **Ross Hubbard** on color. Thursday night's game will be televised on FOX Sports-Southwest Plus.

### Leading Off

• Juniors Alec Hansen and Sheldon Neuse each earned Louisville Slugger Preseason All-America honors from *Collegiate Baseball News* and are on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List.

• Oklahoma's 3-2 win at Fresno State (3/15) was its first road win of the season and first one-run victory in five such games.

• Hunter Haley lifted the Sooners with a walk-off, three-run home run against Long Beach State (3/13). Haley followed with a two-double, two-stolen base game at CSU Bakersfield (3/17).

• The Sooners recorded their first tie since 2008 with a 5-5 decision against Mississippi State (3/6) at Dodger Stadium.

• Oklahoma's win streak ended at six games at Oral Roberts (3/22); the longest such streak since Pete Hughes took over as head coach for 2014.

• Six of the Sooners' 10 losses have come by two runs or less. In 2015, OU went 14-12 in games decided by one or two runs.

• Oklahoma boasted a program-best 3.27 GPA in the fall 2015 semester; the highest for a men's sport at OU.

### HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 19 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 593-450-3 (.571), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children: Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

### Scouting the Red Raiders...

Texas Tech is 13-7 overall and 2-1 in the Big 12 after taking a series on the road at Baylor last weekend. Earlier this season, the Red Raiders posted a 2-1 weekend down at Minute Maid Park with wins over No. 6 Louisiana-Lafayette and No. 9 Houston. Center fielder Tanner Gardner leads Tech's offense with a .469 batting average to go with 16 runs scored. Right fielder Stephen Smith is hitting at .366 with 15 RBI, while first baseman Eric Gutierrez is hitting .338 with a team-high 21 driven in. Right-hander Davis Martin got the win in his first career Big 12 start at Baylor last Friday. He is 2-0 with a 2.18 ERA and 15 strikeouts in 20.2 innings pitched.

### Last Time They Met...

The Sooners took two out of three from the No. 10 Red Raiders at home to open conference play in 2015. Oklahoma bounced back from a 6-1 loss in the opener to win the next two by scores of 5-2 and 3-2. **Alec Hansen** was dominant in the Saturday start as he went the distance and struck out 10, while allowing just three hits. **Robert Tasin** bailed the Sooners out on Sunday as he entered in the top of the first with a run in, the bases loaded and nobody out. Tasin left all three aboard and OU tied the game in the bottom half. **Taylor Allspaugh** led the Sooner offense with a 4-for-4 afternoon.

### All-Time vs. Tech...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series with Texas Tech, 44-32-1, including a 31-26-1 mark in Big 12 regular season games and a 12-17 record on the road. In **Pete Hughes'** first two seasons, the Sooners went 3-4 against the Red Raiders, including a 9-8 walk-off win to eliminate Tech at the 2014 Big 12 Championship. Prior to the formation of the Big 12 in 1997, the two teams faced nine times beginning in 1976 as OU led the series 6-3.

### Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 9-10 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 6-1 loss to Texas Tech (3/20/15). OU has won four of its last six conference openers. Oklahoma won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

### Cody Returns to Tech...

Junior outfielder Cody Thomas made his first road trip to Lubbock as a freshman on the Sooner baseball team in 2014. He would make two pinch-hit appearances and drive in a run on the weekend. Roughly seven months later, Thomas returned to Texas Tech as he led the OU football team on to the field for his first career start as the Sooner quarterback. He led Oklahoma to a 42-30 victory as he threw and ran for a touchdown, while totaling 133 yards in the air and 108 on the ground.

### Sooners Bat Around California...

Oklahoma extended its win streak to six games with five wins coming in a five-day span in California. The Sooners started with a narrow 3-2 win at Fresno State (3/15) followed by a four-game sweep over CSU Bakersfield. OU lifted its season batting average by 19 points over the week with a collective .306 as a team. The Sooners posted double-digit hits in three games and scored double-figure runs in two, while matching a season-high 13 in the finale against the Roadrunners (3/19). **Sheldon Neuse** (.450) and **Austin O'Brien** (.438) led the Oklahoma offense in hitting.

### #YardWork...

Oklahoma posted its best home run total since 2011 with 39 in 2015. The Sooners are tied for first in the Big 12 with TCU at 16 through five weekend of action. **Sheldon Neuse** is OU's active career leader with 17 followed by **Hunter Haley** at 13.

## Iron Man Streak Ended...

At Fresno State (3/15), head coach **Pete Hughes** wrote out his lineup card without **Sheldon Neuse** on it for the first time since the two arrived at OU together for the 2014 season. Neuse had a stretch of 135 consecutive games started snapped. It is the longest streak on record at Oklahoma (2003-present). The previous record was held by **Jack Mayfield** at 120 (5/7/12-6/8/13). Neuse's former teammate, **Craig Aikin** was left out of the lineup just once in his career and had separate 91-game streak to start and end his career.

## A Bunt and a Blast Key Walk-Off...

Looking to avoid their fourth one-run loss of the season, the Sooners rallied in the ninth against Long Beach State (3/13) to win 6-3 on a walk-off, three-run homer by senior left fielder **Hunter Haley**. Trail-ing 3-2 entering the bottom of the ninth, Oklahoma got back-to-back singles from senior right fielder **Alex Wise** and freshman center fielder **Steele Walker** to set the table with runners at the corners. In a pinch-hit appearance, junior **Ben Hollas** put down a bunt to score Wise from third on a suicide-squeeze that tied the game. Haley then blasted a 2-2 pitch to right-center for his first home run of the season. It was Oklahoma's first win of the year when trailing after the sixth inning or later.

## Keepin' it 100...

Across the nation, **Sheldon Neuse** ranks in the top-100 of five of-fensive statistical categories as well as 67th in the country with three saves. He peaks in the national rankings at 18th with three triples, which is tied for the Big 12 lead.

## Triple Nation...

Oklahoma ranks second in the Big 12 and 43rd in the NCAA with seven triples. **Sheldon Neuse** is the team leader at three. He is tied for the Big 12 lead and 18th in the country. He recorded the 13th of his career at CSU Bakersfield (3/19/16-Gm2). Neuse has the fifth most career triples among active players in the NCAA and is now tied for ninth all-time at OU with **Jim Richardson** (1985-86) and **Derek Wathan** (1996-98).

## Bullpen Bagels...

The OU bullpen owns a 2.15 ERA with seven saves and seven wins on the season, while holding opponents to a .231 batting average. Sooner relievers have totaled 76 shutout innings in 89 complete in-nings pitched. Oklahoma relievers had a stretch of 13 consecutive scoreless innings snapped on against Long Beach State (3/12).

## Hog Tied...

Due to travel restrictions, Oklahoma's game with Mississippi State (3/6) at Dodger Stadium ended after nine innings in a 5-5 tie. It marked the 12th tie in OU history and first since a 5-5, 11-inning game at Nebraska (3/22/08). The Sooners overcame a 5-1 deficit after the third inning.

## Up Next...

The Sooners are on the road for the final game of a 10-game road swing over a 15-day stretch as they visit Little Rock on Tuesday, March 29.

## The Big Inning...

The Sooners have scored more than two runs in an inning 11 times this season after doing so five times at CSU Bakersfield (3/17-19). Oklahoma scored a season-high six runs in the third inning in a win against Northeastern (2/21) and later matched that total against the Roadrunners (3/19) in the seventh inning of game two. In its come-back win over Long Beach State (3/13), Oklahoma brought in four runs in the ninth. OU pitchers have limited the opposition to scoring more than twice in an inning eight times. The Sooners have allowed three runs in the first or second inning four times this season.

## Fresh Faces...

Coach Hughes started a season-high six freshmen in the lineup against Wichita State (3/8), including RHP **Kyle Tyler** making his first career start. The Sooners have started three or more freshmen in 11 of the last 12 games and 13 times overall this season.

## Oh man, oh man, oh man, not again...

**Sheldon Neuse** smashed his second home run of the season vs. Mississippi State (3/6) at Dodger Stadium and followed with a home run against Wichita State (3/8). All four of his home runs came in a seven-game stretch. Neuse has homered in back-to-back games three times in his career. He did so twice in 2015 against BYU (2/28) and Little Rock (3/3) and later against Purdue (3/7-8). His 17 career home runs are the most among active Sooners and are tied for the most at OU since the introduction of the BBCOR bats in 2011; with **Matt Oberste** (2012-13).

## One-Hit Shutout...

In his second career start, freshman RHP **Chris Andritsos** threw seven innings of shutout, one-hit ball. He retired the first eight Cen-tral Arkansas (3/1) batters of the game before allowing the only hit of the day in the third. The Sooners totaled six hits in the win, including solo home runs from **Sheldon Neuse** and **Cody Thomas**. Fresh-man RHP **Connor Berry** finished the game with two-scoreless in-nings of relief to earn the first save of his career, while tallying three strikeouts. The win marked the first shutout for OU since beating Alcorn State (4/22/15), 8-0. The Sooners have shutout UCA in back-to-back seasons by a score of 10-0. Andritsos has totaled 12 innings and 11 strikeouts in two starts with only two hits against and one run.

## Playing Horseshoes...

Six of Oklahoma's 10 losses have come by two runs or less. The Sooners are 1-4 in one-run games and 2-2 in two-run games. In 2015, OU won 10 one-run games and went 14-12 when games were decided by two runs or less.

## Against the West...

Under head coach Pete Hughes, the Sooners are 10-4 against schools from California. When playing against teams from the Pacific or Ha-waii Time Zones, OU is 16-9. When playing in the Pacific of Hawaii Time Zones, Oklahoma is 13-4-1. In the last two seasons, the Sooners have played seven of the 11 Pac-12 schools and posted a 3-4 record.

## Turf and Turf...

Through nine games, Oklahoma had played every game on a synthe-tic turf field. The Sooners are 6-4 at home on L. Dale Mitchell Park's new AstroTurf® surface. The first road trip of the season saw OU play on Sam Houston State's newly resurfaced Don Sander Stadium. The Sooners played their first game on natural grass this season last at USC and are 5-3-1 on natural surfaces.

### Road Test...

Gearing the schedule toward the RPI, Oklahoma plays 30 games away from L. Dale Mitchell Park, which includes the Bedlam Series hosted by Oklahoma State and a game at Dodger Stadium against Mississippi State. It is the most for the Sooners since 1999 when they played 32 games away from home. The last three times that Oklahoma went on the road 28 times or more in a season, the Sooners hosted a regional in Norman in 2006, 2009 and 2010.

### Major League Diamonds...

Since the Big 12 Championship was last hosted in Arlington at Globe Life Park (Ameritrust Field at the time) in 2004, Oklahoma has played at a Major League Baseball park five times. The Sooners are 3-1-1 in such games following a tie vs. Mississippi State (3/6). OU most recently defeated UT-Arlington (3/11/14), 3-2 in 10 innings, in Arlington. In 2008, Oklahoma went 2-1 at the Houston College Classic at Minute Maid Park. The Sooners lost the opener to Rice (2/29/08), 7-2, before picking ups wins over Houston (3/1/08) and Tennessee (3/2/08) by scores of 8-5 in 10 innings and 2-0.

### Power and Speed...

Senior **Hunter Haley** has 13 home runs and 30 stolen bases in his career. Over the last decade, he is one of just three players at OU to record 10 homers and 25 steals in a career. **Max White** (2010-13) and **Jamie Johnson** (2008-09) are the other two. White hit 23 homers and swiped 29 bags, while Johnson posted 18 and 38.

### 19 Ways Moves Beyond OU...

Head coach **Pete Hughes** started the 19 Ways community service initiative while at Virginia Tech as a tribute to his late mother, Alice. Since bringing the program to OU, 19 Ways has expanded to eight programs across the country. This offseason, Northeastern became the eighth program to start its own 19 Ways. Opening day marks the second time Oklahoma has faced another program with a 19 Ways initiative; the first being Notre Dame on opening weekend 2015.

### New Field; Same Tradition...

Completion of the new synthetic turf field at L. Dale Mitchell Park on January 15 made OU the sixth team in the Big 12 with a turf playing surface. The surface is made of AstroTurf® 3D Xtreme and covers 150,000 square feet. The turf holds 351,000 lbs. of sand, 180,400 lbs. of rubber, covers 4,100 linear feet of drainage and can handle 4-6 inches of rain per hour. Among 61 power conference teams, 26 play on a turf field. Since 2011, 21 NCAA Regionals have been hosted on a turf playing field, while 12 teams with a home field of synthetic turf have appeared in the College World Series over that time.

### Big League Pitchers...

In 2015, Sooner baseball alums combined to start 68 games on the mound in Major League Baseball. That total ranks the second highest among NCAA teams: second only to Long Beach State (70). **Garrett Richards** (32), **Chase Anderson** (27) and **Jon Gray** (9) each took to the hill in 2015 with Gray making his MLB debut on August 4.

## Oklahoma is Home...

The Sooner roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and 11 from Texas. This season marks the most Oklahoma born players at OU since 12 in 2012 and the first time with as many or more players from Oklahoma than Texas since 2006. In 2006, 13 Sooner players called Oklahoma home, while just five were from Texas.

## Opening the Gates...

Oklahoma broke its own opening weekend attendance record set in 2015 with 4,466 passing through the gates at L. Dale Mitchell Park to see the Sooners face Northeastern in 2016. The 2015 opening weekend attendance set a record for the first series of the season at 4,181. The single-game attendance record on opening day was set after the 1994 CWS National Championship team returned home to face Missouri Southern in front of a crowd of 2,183 in 1995.

### CONFERENCE NOTES

**TCU** The conference season is in full swing this weekend following a pair of league series last week. TCU swept West Virginia and travels to Texas with a 3-0 conference mark, while Texas Tech defeated Baylor, 2-1.

**TCU** This weekend features four conference series, three of which start on Thursday with the Easter Sunday holiday, along with 13 non-conference games. A pair of weekend league games are slated for FSI national coverage - Oklahoma State at K-State on Thursday and TCU at Texas on Saturday.

**TCU** For the first time this season, TCU is in the top five of five national polls, checking in as high as No. 5. Oklahoma State is in the top 25 on four lists, including a No. 19 ranking, while Texas Tech is receiving votes on the USA Today Coaches' poll.

**TCU** Oklahoma enters the week on a six-game winning streak after five road wins last week. The Sooners' next five contests are also away from Norman as they continue a 10-game road trip. OU is one of 14 teams nationally with a win streak of six or more games.

**TCU** TCU (7 wins) and Oklahoma (5) both hold road winning streaks that rank in the top eight nationally.

**TCU** Big 12 teams continue to compete in close contests with seven of the league's 12 non-conference losses last week determined by two runs or less. On the year, of the Big 12's 70 losses in non-league play, 31 have been by a margin of three runs or less.

**TCU** Kansas (8), Oklahoma (9), Texas (9) and Oklahoma State (13) all have at least eight games which have been determined by one run or two runs with the 10 of the Cowboys' contests decided by one run and seven of UT's.

**TCU** Each of the nine league squads has faced at least one ranked opponent on the season at the time of the meeting for a combined 43 games against ranked non-conference competition.

**TCU** TCU leads the league and is the top 10 nationally in batting (10th), on-base percentage (8th) and slugging percentage (9th) with Elliott Barzilli the league leader in multi-hit and multi-RBI games. The Frogs have five batters with five or more multi-RBI games this season.

**TCU** Austin Hansen (Oklahoma) and Brian Howard (TCU) are among 43 pitchers who have at least four wins and are undefeated on the season. Hansen is one of four freshmen
