#### First Pitch...

The Oklahoma baseball team plays the final game of its 10-game. 15-day road swing with a 6:00 pm first pitch at Little Rock on Tuesday, March 29.

#### About the Sooners...

The Sooners were swept in their Big 12-opening series at Texas Tech over the weekend to run their streak to four straight losses after six consecutive wins. Oklahoma is 11-13-1 overall and led offensively by junior shortstop **Sheldon Neuse** at .398. Neuse is slugging .693 with a .505 on-base percentage and a team-leading 20 runs batted in. Junior first baseman **Austin O'Brien** is hitting at .308 and slugging .487 since entering the lineup on a regular basis over the last three weeks. Freshman center fielder **Steele** Walker has seen his batting average rise 99 points over his 10game hit streak, which he is hitting .325 (13-for-14), to .247 overall.

#### On the Air...

Veteran OU broadcaster **Chris Plank** will call the game for the Sooner Sports Radio Network. The game can be heard locally on Sportstalk 1400 AM and 98.5 FM. A video stream will be available at LRTroians.com.

#### Scouting the Trojans...

Little Rock is 12-11 overall, riding a six-game win streak and 9-4 at home under second-year head coach Chris Curry. Left fielder **Ryan Scott** is hitting a team-high .489 with seven home runs, 34 RBI and 30 runs scored with a .844 slugging percentage. Right fielder Dalton Thomas is second at .400 and slugging .547, while catcher Cameron Knight is at .347. The Trojans' pitching staff owns a collective 5.79 earned run average and allowed 15 home runs to the Little Rock offense's 12.

#### **HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES**

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 19 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 593-450-3 (.571), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children: Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

#### **Last Time They Met...**

Craig Aikin collected a school-record six hits as Oklahoma rolled to a 22-0 win over Little Rock on March 3, 2015. The Sooners totaled 23 hits on the day to produce its highest offensive output since 2011. Aikin went 6-for-7 with six RBI and four runs scored with his only career home run. Oklahoma jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the first inning and never looked back. Right-hander Corey Copping got the win in five-scoreless innings with a career-high seven strikeouts. Sheldon Neuse went 3-for-3 with five RBI, including a three-run homer.

#### All-Time vs. Little Rock...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series with Little Rock, 23-6, and snapped a three-game losing streak to the Trojans with a 22-0 win at home in 2015. The Sooners, who have played Little Rock on the road only once, are 22-6 at home and 8-4 against the Trojans since 2004.

#### Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 9-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 5-0 loss at Texas Tech (3/24/15). Oklahoma lost the series to the Red Raiders to mark the first series loss in the first Big 12 weekend since 2012 against Texas. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. lowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

#### Sooners Bat Around California...

Oklahoma extended its win streak to six games with five wins coming in a five-day span in California. The Sooners started with a narrow 3-2 win at Fresno State (3/15) followed by a four-game sweep over CSU Bakersfield. OU lifted its season batting average by 19 points over the week with a collective .306 as a team. The Sooners posted double-digit hits in three games and scored double-figure runs in two, while matching a season-high 13 in the finale against the Roadrunners (3/19). **Sheldon Neuse** (.450) and **Austin O'Brien** (.438) led the Oklahoma offense in hitting.

#### #YardWork...

Oklahoma posted its best home run total since 2011 with 39 in 2015. The Sooners are tied for first in the Big 12 with TCU at 16 through five weekend of action. **Sheldon Neuse** is OU's active career leader with 17 followed by **Hunter Haley** at 13.

#### Iron Man Streak Ended...

At Fresno State (3/15), head coach **Pete Hughes** wrote out his lineup card without **Sheldon Neuse** on it for the first time since the two arrived at OU together for the 2014 season. Neuse had a stretch of 135 consecutive games started snapped. It is the longest streak on record at Oklahoma (2003-present). The previous record was held by **Jack Mayfield** at 120 (5/1/12-6/8/13). Neuse's former teammate, **Craig Aikin** was left out of the lineup just once in his career and had separate 91-game streak to start and end his career.

#### A Bunt and a Blast Key Walk-Off...

Looking to avoid their fourth one-run loss of the season, the Sooners rallied in the ninth against Long Beach State (3/13) to win 6-3 on a walk-off, three-run homer by senior left fielder **Hunter Haley**. Trailing 3-2 entering the bottom of the ninth, Oklahoma got back-to-back singles from senior right fielder **Alex Wise** and freshman center fielder **Steele Walker** to set the table with runners at the corners. In a pinch-hit appearance, junior **Ben Hollas** put down a bunt to score Wise from third on a suicide-squeeze that tied the game. Haley then blasted a 2-2 pitch to right-center for his first home run of the season. It was Oklahoma's first win of the year when trailing after the sixth inning or later.

#### Up Next...

The Sooners return home for a three-game, Big 12 series against Texas. Game one will air nationally on FS1 at 7:00 pm.

#### Triple Nation...

Oklahoma ranks second in the Big 12 and 43rd in the NCAA with seven triples. **Sheldon Neuse** is the team leader at three. He is tied for the Big 12 lead and 18th in the country. He recorded the 13th of his career at CSU Bakersfield (3/19/16-Gm2). Neuse has the fifth most career triples among active players in the NCAA and is now tied for ninth all-time at OU with **Jim Richardson** (1985-86) and **Derek Wathan** (1996-98).

#### Hog Tied...

Due to travel restrictions, Oklahoma's game with Mississippi State (3/6) at Dodger Stadium ended after nine innings in a 5-5 tie. It marked the 12th tie in OU history and first since a 5-5, 11-inning game at Nebraska (3/22/08). The Sooners overcame a 5-1 deficit after the third inning.

#### The Big Inning...

The Sooners have scored more than two runs in an inning 13 times this season after doing so in back-to-back innings at Texas Tech (3/26). Oklahoma scored a season-high six runs in the third inning in a win against Northeastern (2/21) and later matched that total at CSU Bakersfield (3/19) in the seventh inning of game two. In its comeback win over Long Beach State (3/13), Oklahoma brought in four runs in the ninth. OU pitchers have limited the opposition to scoring more than twice in an inning 13 times. The Sooners have allowed three runs in the first or second inning five times this season.

#### Fresh Faces...

Coach Hughes started a season-high six freshmen in the lineup against Wichita State (3/8), including RHP **Kyle Tyler** making his first career start. The Sooners have started three or more freshmen in 13 of the last 15 games and 15 times overall this season.

#### Oh man, oh man, oh man, not again...

**Sheldon Neuse** smashed his second home run of the season vs. Mississippi State (3/6) at Dodger Stadium and followed with a home run against Wichita State (3/8). All four of his home runs came in a seven-game stretch. Neuse has homered in back-to-back games three times in his career. He did so twice in 2015 against BYU (2/28) and Little Rock (3/3) and later against Purdue (3/7-8). His 17 career home runs are the most among active Sooners and are tied for the most at OU since the introduction of the BBCOR bats in 2011; with **Matt Oberste** (2012-13).

#### One-Hit Shutout...

In his second career start, freshman RHP **Chris Andritsos** threw seven innings of shutout, one-hit ball. He retired the first eight Central Arkansas (3/1) batters of the game before allowing the only hit of the day in the third. The Sooners totaled six hits in the win, including solo home runs from **Sheldon Neuse** and **Cody Thomas**. Freshman RHP **Connor Berry** finished the game with two-scoreless innings of relief to earn the first save of his career, while tallying three strikeouts. The win marked the first shutout for OU since beating Alcorn State (4/22/15), 8-0. The Sooners have shutout UCA in back-to-back seasons by a score of 10-0. Andritsos has totaled 12 innings and 11 strikeouts in two starts with only two hits against and one run.

#### Against the West...

Under head coach Pete Hughes, the Sooners are 10-4 against schools from California. When playing against teams from the Pacific or Hawaii Time Zones, OU is 16-9. When playing in the Pacific of Hawaii Time Zones, Oklahoma is 13-4-1. In the last two seasons, the Sooners have played seven of the 11 Pac-12 schools and posted a 3-4 record.

#### Turf and Turf...

Through nine games, Oklahoma had played every game on a synthetic turf field. The Sooners are 6.4 at home on L. Dale Mitchell Park's new AstroTurf® surface. The first road trip of the season saw OU play on Sam Houston State's newly resurfaced Don Sander Stadium. The Sooners played their first game on natural grass this season last at USC and are 5-3-1 on natural surfaces and 6-10 on turf.

#### Road Test...

Gearing the schedule toward the RPI, Oklahoma plays 30 games away from L. Dale Mitchell Park, which includes the Bedlam Series hosted by Oklahoma State and a game at Dodger Stadium against Mississippi State. It is the most for the Sooners since 1999 when they played 32 games away from home. The last three times that Oklahoma went on the road 28 times or more in a season, the Sooners hosted a regional in Norman in 2006, 2009 and 2010.

#### Major League Diamonds...

Since the Big 12 Championship was last hosted in Arlington at Globe Life Park (Ameriquest Field at the time) in 2004, Oklahoma has played at a Major League Baseball park five times. The Sooners are 3-1-1 in such games following a tie vs. Mississippi State (3/6). OU most recently defeated UT-Arlington (3/11/14), 3-2 in 10 innings, in Arlington. In 2008, Oklahoma went 2-1 at the Houston College Classic at Minute Maid Park. The Sooners lost the opener to Rice (2/29/08), 7-2, before picking ups wins over Houston (3/1/08) and Tennessee (3/2/08) by scores of 8-5 in 10 innings and 2-0.

#### Power and Speed...

Senior **Hunter Haley** has 13 home runs and 30 stolen bases in his career. Over the last decade, he is one of just three players at OU to record 10 homers and 25 steals in a career. **Max White** (2010-13) and **Jamie Johnson** (2008-09) are the other two. White hit 23 homers and swiped 29 bags, while Johnson posted 18 and 38.

#### 19 Ways Moves Beyond OU...

Head coach **Pete Hughes** started the 19 Ways community service initiative while at Virginia Tech as a tribute to his late mother, Alice. Since bringing the program to OU, 19 Ways has expanded to eight programs across the country. This offseason, Northeastern became the eighth program to start its own 19 Ways. Opening day marks the second time Oklahoma has faced another program with a 19 Ways initiative; the first being Notre Dame on opening weekend 2015.

#### New Field; Same Tradition...

Completion of the new synthetic turf field at L. Dale Mitchell Park on January 15 made OU the sixth team in the Big 12 with a turf playing surface. The surface is made of AstroTurf® 3D Xtreme and covers 150,000 square feet. The turf holds 351,000 lbs. of sand, 180,400 lbs. of rubber, covers 4,100 linear feet of drainage and can handle 4-6 inches of rain per hour. Among 61 power conference teams, 26 play on a turf field. Since 2011, 21 NCAA Regionals have been hosted on a turf playing field, while 12 teams with a home field of synthetic turf have appeared in the College World Series over that time.

#### Big League Pitchers...

In 2015, Sooner baseball alums combined to start 68 games on the mound in Major League Baseball. Oklahoma broke its own opening weekend attendance record set in 2015 with 4,466 passing through the gates at L. Dale Mitchell Park to see the Sooners face Northeastern in 2016.
