First Pitch...

The Oklahoma baseball team welcomes Baylor to L. Dale Mitchell Park for a three-game, Big 12 series to finish a seven-game, 10-day homestand. Game one is set for Friday night at 6:00 pm. Saturday's game will begin at 5:00 pm after the OU football spring game at Memorial Stadium.

About the Sooners...

The Sooners have won four out of five, including a 2-1 series win over Texas last weekend. Oklahoma, fresh off a 12-2 drubbing of Dallas Baptist, is a game over .500 at 15-14-1 overall and 2-4 in the Big 12. Junior shortstop **Sheldon Neuse** possessed a blistering hot bat in the first half of the season and has continued to crush as he went yard for his sixth home run of the year on Tuesday. Neuse is hitting .396 with 23 runs driven in, 19 scored and slugging .706 with a .504 on-base percentage. Junior infielder **Jack Flansburg** is second on the team at .286 as the OU clean-up hitter. He has scored 22 runs and knocked in 19. Freshman third baseman **Cade Harris** is up to a .284 average as he has hit first or second in the Sooner lineup in each of his last nine starts. Freshman right-hander **Chris Andritsos** (4-2) owns a 2.65 earned run average and 0.76 WHIP after making his first Big 12 start last Friday; a 7.2-inning, one-run effort against Texas.

On the Air...

Sooner Sports TV will broadcast games one (FOX Sports Oklahoma) and three (FCS-Central), while game two will be streamed at SoonerSports.tv. **Chad McKee** will call the play-by-play action alongside OU baseball and MLB alum **George Frazier** providing the color commentary. The series will air on the Sooner Sports Radio Network and can be heard locally at Sportstalk 1400 AM and 98.5 FM. The voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will have the call along with OU baseball alum **Ross Hubbard**.

- Sheldon Neuse has homered in each of the last two games. He has gone deep in back-to-back games four times in his career.
- Freshman pitchers have accounted for 11 of Oklahoma's 15 wins. Overall, OU newcomers have totaled 13 this season. Neuse and Shawn Hunter are the only returning pitchers with a win. Austin Hansen and Chris Andritsos are tied for third in the Big 12 with four wins.
- The Sooners last claimed a series win over Baylor in 2012 when they swept the Bears at home.
- Oklahoma recorded its first home series win over Texas since 1998 last weekend. The Sooners, who have taken three of the last four series with the Longhorns, won their first home game in the rivalry since 2008 on Friday night.
- Neuse moved in to 10th in the Big 12 era (1997-present) for RBI at OU with the 113th of his career on Tuesday. He is the Sooners' leader in triples at 13 over that span and is 11th with 36 doubles.
- Oklahoma boasted a program-best 3.27 GPA in the fall 2015 semester; the highest for a men's sport at OU.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 19 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 602-455-3 (.571), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98)

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children; Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Bears...

Baylor is 15-14 overall and 3-3 in the Big 12, following a series win over Kansas, under first-year head coach Steve Rodriguez. Left fielder **Darryn Sheppard** is the Bears' top hitter at .351 with three home runs 27 RBI. Two others are hitting over .300, including first baseman Kameron Esthay (.330) and catcher Matt Menard (.328). Lefty **Daniel Castano** (2-4) and righty **Drew Tolson** (3-1) return to anchor Baylor's weekend rotation. Castano has struck out 40 in 44.1 innings with a 4.87 ERA, while Tolson has fanned 33 in 43.2 innings to the tune of a 4.12 ERA.

Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma salvaged the series with a Sunday win in Waco last season. The Sooner offense struggled in 3-0 and 7-2 losses to start the series, but came to life for a dominant 13-3 showing in the finale. OU totaled 21 hits, including a game-high four from Craig Aikin. Anthony Hermelyn and Alex Wise each recorded three hits and three RBI. Right-hander **Robert Tasin** got the win in a six-inning start. In the first two games, Daniel Castano and Drew Tolson pitched back-to-back complete games. The Sooners left 11 runners on base in the shutout loss to Castano and the Bears. Alec Hansen struck out eight and gave up just two earned runs in 6.1 innings for OU on Saturday.

All-Time vs. BU...

Despite having lost each of the last three series against the Bears, the Sooners lead the all-time series, 38-35. Oklahoma has gone 1-2 in each of the last three regular seasons against Baylor plus a 2-0 complete-game, 12-strikeouts performance from Jon Gray in the 2013 Big 12 Championship opener. The last time the Bears visited Norman, the Sooners won the Saturday game, 13-7, behind three home runs between Sheldon Neuse. Anthony Hermelyn and Hector Lorenzana.

The 2016 Sooners vs. the Bears...

Three Sooners are hitting .300 or better in their career against Baylor, including **Hunter Haley** at a team-best .429 (12-for-28). **Aus**tin O'Brien is hitting .316 (6-for-19) in his career against BU, while **Sheldon Neuse** adds a .308 (8-for-26) average.

Powering Past the Patriots...

The Sooners snapped an eight-game losing streak in the all-time series against non-conference opponent Dallas Baptist on Tuesday. Oklahoma's offense exploded for five runs in the first and six in the third en route to a 12-2 win at home. It marked the first win for the Sooners over the Patriots since April 27, 2010, Sheldon Neuse went 2-for-4 with a home run and freshman center fielder Steele Walker added a three-hit night. Freshman right-hander Jake Irvin struck out five, worked out of a bases loaded jam in the first and lasted five innings to earn his first career win.

Sooners Turn Down Horns...

Oklahoma won back-to-back series over Texas for the first time in program history and has now won three of the last four. The Sooners recorded their first home win over Texas (4/1) since April 5, 2008. Freshman RHP Chris Andritsos struck out five in 7.2 innings of one run ball. OU went deep three times, including a three-run shot from junior Jack Flansburg in a 6-1 victory. Oklahoma bounced back from a Saturday defeat to walk off the Longhorns on Sunday, 4-3. Flansburg tied the game in the sixth with a two-run single. In the ninth, the Sooners loaded the bases with one out. Junior Ben **Hollas** delivered the game-winning hit; a line drive single to right. The win marked the first home series win for Oklahoma over Texas since 1998; when OU swept UT. Senior outfielder Hunter Haley is the only player in program history to have played in three series wins over the Longhorns.

Making Noise at the Plate and on the Mound...

In a walk-off win over Texas (4/3), junior **Sheldon Neuse** made an impact at the plate and on the mound. As the starting shortstop, he gave Oklahoma its first lead of the day in the bottom of the first inning with a towering home run off the scoreboard in left-center. Neuse later moved to the mound with two runners on and only one out in the top of the eighth. He stranded both before pitching a 1-2-3 top of the ninth. After retiring all five batters faced, including a pair of strikeouts. Neuse was credited with the win. He became the first player at OU to homer and earn the win on the mound since **Jacob Evans** did so with a walk-off home run against Kansas (4/2/15).

The Sooners head back out on the road Tuesday night to face Wichita State for the second time this season. Oklahoma will then head south down I-35 for a Big 12, weekend series at TCU.

The Long and Winding Road...

Oklahoma went 6-4 in its recent 10-game stretch away from L. Dale Mitchell Park. It marked the longest road swing since 1999, which was also 10 games and included a three-game Bedlam series in OKC and Tulsa. OU's longest stretch away from home in 2015 was nine games, including a four-game series against BYU in Las Vegas that was originally scheduled to be played in Norman. In the Sooners National Championship season of 1994, they were also on the road for 10 in a row with a 7-3 record. Oklahoma regularly had 10-game road trips under head coach **Enos Semore**, including 14 times in 16 seasons and a program-high 21 in a row on the road to open the 1976 season ahead of the Sooners' fifth-consecutive College World Series appearance.

Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 9-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 5-0 loss at Texas Tech (3/24/15). Oklahoma lost the series to the Red Raiders to mark the first series loss in the first Big 12 weekend since 2012 against Texas. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

#YardWork...

Oklahoma posted its best home run total since 2011 with 39 in 2015. The Sooners hit a season-high three in a 6-1 win over Texas (4/1). It was the most since OU went yard four times against Purdue (3/8/15). **Sheldon Neuse** is OU's active career leader with 19, which is second among active Big 12 players, followed by **Hunter Haley** at 13.

Shave for the Brave...

On April 7, the Sooners will shaved their heads to fight childhood cancer at their third annual "Shave for the Brave". The team is accepting donations that will benefit the Vs. Cancer Foundation and OU Children's Hospital. In the past two season, OU baseball has raised more than \$58,000 and in 2015 ranked first among 63 participating teams. The game following Shave for the Brave will be the team's annual "Go Mitch Go" game against Baylor. Mitchell Whitaker was a friend of the program that passed in 2007 from Leukemia. The Sooners award one player each year in his honor.

Triple Nation...

Oklahoma ranks second in the Big 12 and 97th in the NCAA with seven triples. **Sheldon Neuse** is the team leader at three. He is second in Big 12 lead and 46th in the country. He recorded the 13th of his career at CSU Bakersfield (3/19/16-Gm2). Neuse has the fifth most career triples among active players in the NCAA and is now tied for ninth all-time at OU with Jim Richardson (1985-86) and Derek Wathan (1996-98). His 13 are the most at OU in the Big 12 era.

Fresh Faces...

Coach Hughes started a season-high six freshmen in the lineup against Wichita State (3/8), including RHP Kyle Tyler making his first career start. The Sooners have started three or more freshmen in 18 of the last 20 games and 19 times overall this season.

Keepin' it 100...

Entering the week, **Sheldon Neuse** ranked in the top-100 of seven offensive statistical categories as well as 79th in the country with four saves. He peaks in the national rankings at 32nd with a .689 slugging percentage. **Chris Andritsos** ranks highest among all Sooners with a 0.76 WHIP that is 10th in the nation and first in the Big 12. He is second on the team with four top-100 rankings. As a team, Oklahoma ranks 19th in the country with a .978 fielding percentage, which is the best in the conference.

Sooners Bat Around California...

Oklahoma extended its win streak to six games with five wins coming in a five-day span in California. The Sooners started with a narrow 3-2 win at Fresno State (3/15) followed by a four-game sweep over CSU Bakersfield. OU lifted its season batting average by 19 points over the week with a collective .306 as a team. The Sooners posted doubledigit hits in three games and scored double-figure runs in two. while matching a season-high 13 in the finale against the Roadrunners (3/19). **Sheldon Neuse** (.450) and **Austin O'Brien** (.438) led the Oklahoma offense in hitting.

Iron Man Streak Ended...

At Fresno State (3/15), head coach Pete Hughes wrote out his lineup card without **Sheldon Neuse** on it for the first time since the two arrived at OU together for the 2014 season. Neuse had a stretch of 135 consecutive games started snapped. It is the longest streak on record at Oklahoma (2003-present). The previous record was held by Jack Mayfield at 120 (5/7/12-6/8/13). Neuse's former teammate. Craig Aikin was left out of the lineup just once in his career and had separate 91-game streak to start and end his career.

A Bunt and a Blast Key Walk-Off...

Looking to avoid their fourth one-run loss of the season, the Sooners rallied in the ninth against Long Beach State (3/13) to win 6-3 on a walk-off, three-run homer by senior left fielder **Hunter Haley**. Trailing 3-2 entering the bottom of the ninth, Oklahoma got back-to-back singles from senior right fielder Alex Wise and freshman center fielder **Steele Walker** to set the table with runners at the corners. In a pinch-hit appearance, junior Ben Hollas put down a bunt to score Wise from third on a suicide-squeeze that tied the game. Haley then blasted a 2-2 pitch to right-center for his first home run of the season. It was Oklahoma's first win of the year when trailing after the sixth inning or later.

Hog Tied...

Due to travel restrictions, Oklahoma's game with Mississippi State (3/6) at Dodger Stadium ended after nine innings in a 5-5 tie. It marked the 12th tie in OU history and first since a 5-5, 11-inning game at Nebraska (3/22/08). The Sooners overcame a 5-1 deficit after the third inning.

The Big Inning...

The Sooners have scored more than two runs in an inning 18 times this season after matching their season-high with six runs in the third against Dallas Baptist (4/5). Oklahoma had previously scored six runs in the third inning in a win against Northeastern (2/21) and later matched that total at CSU Bakersfield (3/19) in the seventh inning of game two. In its comeback win over Long Beach State (3/13), Oklahoma brought in four runs in the ninth. OU pitchers have limited the opposition to scoring more than twice in an inning 14 times. The Sooners have allowed three runs or more in the first or second inning six times this season.

Oh man, oh man, oh man, not again...

Sheldon Neuse smashed his second home run of the season vs. Mississippi State (3/6) at Dodger Stadium and followed with a home run against Wichita State (3/8). He later homered against Texas (4/3) and Dallas Baptist (4/5) in back-to-back games. Neuse has homered in back-to-back games four times in his career. He did so twice in 2015 against BYU (2/28) and Little Rock (3/3) and later against Purdue (3/7-8). His 19 career home runs are the most among active Sooners and are the most at OU since the introduction of the BBCOR bats in 2011; passing Matt Oberste's (2012-13) 17.

One-Hit Shutout...

In his second career start, freshman RHP **Chris Andritsos** threw seven innings of shutout, one-hit ball. He retired the first eight Central Arkansas (3/1) batters of the game before allowing the only hit of the day in the third. The Sooners totaled six hits in the win, including solo home runs from **Sheldon Neuse** and **Cody Thomas**. Freshman RHP **Connor Berry** finished the game with two-scoreless innings of relief to earn the first save of his career, while tallying three strikeouts. The win marked the first shutout for OU since beating Alcorn State (4/22/15), 8-0. The Sooners have shutout UCA in back-to-back seasons by a score of 10-0. Andritsos has totaled 12 innings and 11 strikeouts in two starts with only two hits against and one run.

Against the West...

Under head coach Pete Hughes, the Sooners are 10-4 against schools from California. When playing against teams from the Pacific or Hawaii Time Zones, OU is 16-9. When playing in the Pacific of Hawaii Time Zones, Oklahoma is 13-4-1. In the last two seasons, the Sooners have played seven of the 11 Pac-12 schools and posted a 3-4 record.

Turf and Turf...

Through nine games, Oklahoma had played every game on a synthetic turf field. The Sooners are 8-5 at home on L. Dale Mitchell Park's new AstroTurf® surface. The first road trip of the season saw OU play on Sam Houston State's newly resurfaced Don Sander Stadium. The Sooners played their first game on natural grass this season last at USC and are 5-3-1 on natural surfaces and 10-11 on turf.

Road Test...

Gearing the schedule toward the RPI, Oklahoma plays 30 games away from L. Dale Mitchell Park, which includes the Bedlam Series hosted by Oklahoma State and a game at Dodger Stadium against Mississippi State. It is the most for the Sooners since 1999 when they played 32 games away from home. The last three times that Oklahoma went on the road 28 times or more in a season, the Sooners hosted a regional in Norman in 2006, 2009 and 2010.

Major League Diamonds...

Since the Big 12 Championship was last hosted in Arlington at Globe Life Park (Ameriquest Field at the time) in 2004, Oklahoma has played at a Major League Baseball park five times. The Sooners are 3-1-1 in such games following a tie vs. Mississippi State (3/6). OU most recently defeated UT-Arlington (3/11/14), 3-2 in 10 innings, in Arlington. In 2008, Oklahoma went 2-1 at the Houston College Classic at Minute Maid Park. The Sooners lost the opener to Rice (2/29/08), 7-2, before picking ups wins over Houston (3/1/08) and Tennessee (3/2/08) by scores of 8-5 in 10 innings and 2-0.

Power and Speed...

Senior **Hunter Haley** has 13 home runs and 30 stolen bases in his career. Over the last decade, he is one of just four players at OU to record 10 homers and 25 steals in a career. Max White (2010-13) and Jamie Johnson (2008-09) are the other two. White hit 23 homers and swiped 29 bags, while Johnson posted 18 and 38. Junior Sheldon Neuse joined that group (18 HR, 25 SB) at Little Rock (3/29).

MLB Opening Day 2016...

Two former Sooners made opening day big league rosters out of camp. Right-handers Garrett Richards (Angels) and Chase An**derson** (Brewers) will each start in their respective club's rotation. Fellow right-hander Jon Gray (Rockies) was moved to the disabledlist to start the season after a bicep injury late in spring training. Richards was tabbed as the opening day starting pitcher for the Angels. He is the first OU player to start on opening day since Jason Bartlett (Padres, shortstop) in 2012. Richards becomes the first OU pitcher to start opening day since Russ Ortiz (Braves) in 2004 and the sixth different OU pitcher to start 11 opening days.

19 Ways Moves Beyond OU...

Head coach **Pete Hughes** started the 19 Ways community service initiative while at Virginia Tech as a tribute to his late mother. Alice. Since bringing the program to OU, 19 Ways has expanded to eight programs across the country. This offseason, Northeastern became the eighth program to start its own 19 Ways. Opening day marks the second time Oklahoma has faced another program with a 19 Ways initiative; the first being Notre Dame on opening weekend 2015.

New Field; Same Tradition...

Completion of the new synthetic turf field at L. Dale Mitchell Park on January 15 made OU the sixth team in the Big 12 with a turf playing surface. The surface is made of AstroTurf® 3D Xtreme and covers 150,000 square feet. The turf holds 351,000 lbs. of sand, 180,400 lbs. of rubber, covers 4,100 linear feet of drainage and can handle 4-6 inches of rain per hour. Among 61 power conference teams, 26 play on a turf field. Since 2011, 21 NCAA Regionals have been hosted on a turf playing field, while 12 teams with a home field of synthetic turf have appeared in the College World Series over that time.

Oklahoma is Home...

The Sooner roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and 11 from Texas. This season marks the most Oklahoma born players at OU since 12 in 2012 and the first time with as many or more players from Oklahoma than Texas since 2006. In 2006, 13 Sooner players called Oklahoma home, while just five were from Texas.
