First Pitch...

The University of Oklahoma baseball team welcomes West Virginia to L. Dale Mitchell Park for a three-game, Big 12 series this weekend. Play begins Friday night with a 6:00 pm first pitch.

About the Sooners...

The Sooners are in a four-game slump after a narrow 4-3 non-conference loss to Oklahoma State on home on Wednesday night. Oklahoma is 18-19-1 overall and 4-8 in the Big 12. Junior shortstop **Sheldon Neuse** leads an OU offense that is hitting just .252 with a .378 batting average, which ranks third in the Big 12. He is slugging .667 with 20 extra-base hits, including 11 doubles, five triples and six home runs. Neuse also fills the Sooners' closer role and has made 11 relief appearances. In 17 innings, he has struck out 17 with a 3-1 record, four saves and held opponents to a .164 average. Freshman center fielder **Steele Walker** enters the weekend having lifted his season average to .267, while hitting .419 (11-for-31) over a nine-game stretch. He is tied for second on the team with 10 doubles and has added 17 runs and 15 RBI. Senior **Alex Wise** has settled in to the everyday right fielder with a team-leading six outfield assists. Offensively, he is second on the team with a .282 average and 10 doubles. Freshman right-hander **Chris Andritsos** (4-3) toes the rubber in game one for Oklahoma. He owns a 3.38 earned run average and leads the Big 12 with a 0.91 WHIP.

The entire series can be heard across the Sooner Sports Radio Network and locally on Sportstalk 1400 AM. The voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will call all of the play-by-play action alongside Sooner alum **Ross Hubbard**. Sooner Sports TV will broadcast games two and three on FSOK+ and FCS-Central. **Chad McKee** (pbp) and Sooner alum **George Frazier** (color) will have the call.

- Oklahoma pitchers have struck out 10 or more in a game 10 times, including a season-high 14 vs. Oklahoma State (4/20).
- The Sooners have won four walk-offs this season, including twice against Baylor.
- Hunter Haley became the third Sooner to be honored as a Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week (4/11) in the last three seasons after a three-home run, eight-RBI week.
- Sheldon Neuse ranks in the top 100 of five offensive statistical categories in the country, including ninth with five triples.
- Jake Elliott last earned a win on April 17, 2015 at West Virginia as he struck out eight in 7.1 scoreless innings.
- Freshman pitchers have accounted for 12 of Oklahoma's 18 wins. Overall, OU newcomers have totaled 14 this season. Neuse and Shawn Hunter are the only returning pitchers with a win.
- Oklahoma boasted a program-best 3.27 GPA in the fall 2015 semester: the highest for a men's sport at OU.

HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 19 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 605-460-3 (.571), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children: Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

Scouting the Mountaineers...

West Virginia is 19-16 overall and 5-6 in the Big 12 under fourth-year head coach **Randy Mazey**. The Mountaineers are hitting .276 as a team with a .417 slugging percentage. Right fielder **Darius Hill** is hitting a team-high .353, while slugging .566 with 14 doubles. WVU has managed to keep a steady rotation throughout the season with all three pitchers making three starts this season. Right-hander **Chad Donato** (1-3) gets the start in game one followed by lefty **Ross Vance** (4-3) and righty **BJ Myers** (4-3). Donato sports a 3.86 ERA and has struck out 70; the second highest total in the Big 12

Last Time They Met...

Right-hander **Robert Tasin** pitched Oklahoma past West Virginia in an elimination game at the 2015 Big 12 Championship in Tulsa end the Mountaineers season with a 6-1 Sooner win. Tasin allowed one run on seven hits with five strikeouts in seven innings. **Anthony Hermelyn** went 3-for-4 at the dish, while **Sheldon Neuse** drove in four runs, including a bases-loaded double in the eighth. In the regular season, OU took two out of three from WVU in Morgantown last year. Right-hander **Jake Elliott** struck out eight in 7.1 scoreless inning with just two hits against him to win the opener. A two-run home run from **Kolbey Carpenter** stood up for a 2-0 Oklahoma win. A three-run seventh game West Virginia a come-from-behind win on Saturday before the Sooners pounded out a 10-2 win on Sunday. Tasin got the win in 7.2 innings of work as Neuse and Carpenter picked up three hits and **Craig Aikin** tallied four.

All-Time vs. West Virginia...

Since West Virginia joined the Big 12 in 2013, the series is even between the two sides, 5-5, with the Mountaineers holding a 5-4 edge in regular season match-ups. All-time, Oklahoma holds a narrow 6-5 advantage; having won the first ever meeting on March 10, 2012 in Eugene, Ore. at the NIKE Showcase. No. 16 OU beat WVU, 6-2, behind a complete game from **Dillon Overton**.

Milestone Tracker...

Senior left fielder **Hunter Haley** enters the weekend with 98 runs scored and 99 runs driven in over the course of his Sooner career. He looks to become the first OU player to reach 100 runs and 100 RBI in a career since his one-time teammate **Max White** (2010-13). Beginning with **Jackson Williams** (2005-07), seven Sooners reached the milestone over the next seven years. Haley would become the first to join the group having done so entirely in the BBCOR era. All-time, 39 players have reached the 100-run, 100-RBI mark as a Sooner. The first to do so was **Keith Drumright** (1974-76) with 147 runs and 114 RBI.

Wild Walk Offs the Norm for Norman Nine...

Oklahoma has won four games in walk-off fashion this season, including each of the last three home Sunday contests. The Sooners added to their total with two to claim a series win over Baylor this past weekend. Oklahoma did not lead in either game until the winning run touched home. **Sheldon Neuse** singled and **Jack Flansburg** walked in the ninth of game one. **Renae Martinez** came in to pinch-hit and put down a sacrifice bunt that was thrown away and allowed Neuse to score the walk-off run in a 4-3 win. On Sunday, in a game that featured four home runs by each side, it was three-straight singles that decided the game in extra innings. In the 11th, **Cade Harris** and **Ben Hollas** singled with two down to set up the game-winning hit for Flansburg; a 7-6 final. It marked the first series win for Oklahoma over Baylor since a 2012 sweep at home.

Up Next...

Oklahoma is off in the midweek before hitting the road for a Big 12 series. The Sooners visit Kansas for a three-game set beginning Friday, April 29 in Lawrence.

Young Arms...

Sooner freshmen pitchers have combined for 12 of the team's 18 wins, which is the second highest total among Big 12 staffs. Collectively, OU freshmen have posted a 3.78 ERA, 7.37 K/9 average and 1.88 K-to-BB ratio. **Chris Andritsos** and **Austin Hansen** have each won four games, while **Jake Irvin** has struck out a class-leading 35.

Keepin' it 100...

Entering the week, **Sheldon Neuse** ranked in the top-100 of five offensive statistical categories. He peaks in the national rankings at ninth with five triples. **Chris Andritsos** ranks highest among Sooner pitchers with a 1.05 walks-per-nine-innings average that is 23rd in the nation and first in the Big 12. He is second on the team with three top-100 rankings. As a team, Oklahoma ranks 14th in the country with a .979 fielding percentage, which is the best in the conference. The Sooners are also 14th in the country with 38 double plays turned.

Powering Past the Patriots...

The Sooners snapped an eight-game losing streak in the all-time series against non-conference opponent Dallas Baptist last Tuesday. Oklahoma's offense exploded for five runs in the first and six in the third en route to a 12-2 win at home. It marked the first win for the Sooners over the Patriots since April 27, 2010. **Sheldon Neuse** went 2-for-4 with a home run and freshman center fielder **Steele Walker** added a three-hit night. Freshman right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out five, worked out of a bases loaded jam in the first and lasted five innings to earn his first career win.

National Player of the Week...

For his efforts in the series win over Baylor, senior left fielder **Hunter Haley** was named a Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball News* on April 11. He hit .429 (6-for-14) in a 3-1 week for the Sooners and totaled eight RBI and three home runs; all of which came at the expense of the Bears. An OU player has earned the honor in each of the last three seasons as Haley joins former teammates **Kolbey Carpenter** (2/23/15) and **Mac James** (3/10/14).

Sooners Turn Down Horns...

Oklahoma won back-to-back series over Texas for the first time in program history and has now won three of the last four. The Sooners recorded their first home win over Texas (4/1) since April 5, 2008. Freshman RHP **Chris Andritsos** struck out five in 7.2 innings of one run ball. OU went deep three times, including a three-run shot from junior **Jack Flansburg** in a 6-1 victory. Oklahoma bounced back from a Saturday defeat to walk off the Longhorns on Sunday, 4-3. Flansburg tied the game in the sixth with a two-run single. In the ninth, the Sooners loaded the bases with one out. Junior **Ben Hollas** delivered the game-winning hit: a line drive single to right. The win marked the first home series win for Oklahoma over Texas since 1998; when OU swept UT. Senior outfielder **Hunter Haley** is the only player in program history to have played in three series wins over the Longhorns.

Double Down on Steele...

Freshman center fielder **Steele Walker** has been in the OU lineup for 36 of 38 games this season and is tied for second on the team with 10 doubles. His 10 doubles are tied for ninth most by a freshman on record (1993-present) with **Kolbey Carpenter** (2013). In 2014, **Sheldon Neuse** doubled 17 times, which ranks second by a Sooner freshman. **Matt Bose** (2002) owns the record at 18.

#YardWork...

Oklahoma posted its best home run total since 2011 with 39 in 2015. The Sooners hit a season-high four in a 7-6 win over Baylor (4/10). It was the most since OU went yard four times against Purdue (3/8/15). **Sheldon Neuse** is OU's active career leader with 19, which is second among active Big 12 players, followed by **Hunter Haley** at 16.

Making Noise at the Plate and on the Mound...

In a walk-off win over Texas (4/3), junior **Sheldon Neuse** made an impact at the plate and on the mound. As the starting shortstop, he gave Oklahoma its first lead of the day in the bottom of the first inning with a towering home run off the scoreboard in left-center. Neuse later moved to the mound with two runners on and only one out in the top of the eighth. He stranded both before pitching a 1-2-3 top of the ninth. After retiring all five batters faced, including a pair of strikeouts, Neuse was credited with the win. He became the first player at OU to homer and earn the win on the mound since **Jacob Evans** did so with a walk-off home run against Kansas (4/2/15).

The Long and Winding Road...

Oklahoma went 6-4 in its recent 10-game stretch away from L. Dale Mitchell Park. It marked the longest road swing since 1999, which was also 10 games and included a three-game Bedlam series in OKC and Tulsa. OU's longest stretch away from home in 2015 was nine games, including a four-game series against BYU in Las Vegas that was originally scheduled to be played in Norman. In the Sooners National Championship season of 1994, they were also on the road for 10 in a row with a 7-3 record. Oklahoma regularly had 10-game road trips under head coach **Enos Semore**, including 14 times in 16 seasons and a program-high 21 in a row on the road to open the 1976 season ahead of the Sooners' fifth-consecutive College World Series appearance.

Shave for the Brave...

On April 7, the Sooners shaved their heads to fight childhood cancer at their third annual "Shave for the Brave". Donations benefited the Vs. Cancer Foundation and OU Children's Hospital. In the three seasons, OU baseball has raised more than \$80,000 and in 2015 ranked first among 63 participating teams. The game following Shave for the Brave was the team's seventh annual "Go Mitch Go" game against Baylor. **Mitchell Whitaker** was a friend of the program that passed in 2007 from Leukemia. The Sooners award one player each year in his honor. **Austin O'Brien** earned the award in 2016.

Triple Nation...

Oklahoma ranks second in the Big 12 and 57th in the NCAA with 10 triples. **Sheldon Neuse** is the team leader at five. He is first in Big 12 and fifth in the country. He recorded the 15th of his career against Baylor (4/9). Neuse has the fifth most career triples among active players in the NCAA and is now tied for fourth all-time at OU with **Bill Severns** (1972-75) and **Baine Brooks** (1986-87). His 15 are the most at OU in the Big 12 era.

Fresh Faces...

Coach Hughes started a season-high six freshmen in the lineup against Wichita State (3/8), including RHP **Kyle Tyler** making his first career start. The Sooners have started three or more freshmen in 24 of the last 28 games and 25 times overall this season.

Iron Man Streak Ended...

At Fresno State (3/15), head coach **Pete Hughes** wrote out his lineup card without **Sheldon Neuse** on it for the first time since the two arrived at OU together for the 2014 season. Neuse had a stretch of 135 consecutive games started snapped. It is the longest streak on record at Oklahoma (2003-present). The previous record was held by **Jack Mayfield** at 120 (5/7/12-6/8/13). Neuse's former teammate, **Craig Aikin** was left out of the lineup just once in his career and had separate 91-game streak to start and end his career.

Big 12 Openers...

The Sooners are 9-11 in the first Big 12 match-up of the season after a 5-0 loss at Texas Tech (3/24/15). Oklahoma lost the series to the Red Raiders to mark the first series loss in the first Big 12 weekend since 2012 against Texas. OU won its first Big 12 game in the league opener vs. Iowa State (3/7/97), 7-4.

The Big Inning...

The Sooners have scored more than two runs in an inning 21 times this season after scoring a season-high eight in the third at Wichita State (4/12). Oklahoma had previously scored six runs in an inning three times: vs. Dallas Baptist (4/5), at CSU Bakersfield (3/19) and vs. Northeastern (2/21). In its comeback win over Long Beach State (3/13), Oklahoma brought in four runs in the ninth. OU pitchers have limited the opposition to scoring more than twice in an inning 17 times. The Sooners have allowed three runs or more in the first or second inning six times this season.

Oklahoma is Home...

The Sooner roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and 11 from Texas. This season marks the most Oklahoma born players at OU since 12 in 2012 and the first time with as many or more players from Oklahoma than Texas since 2006. In 2006, 13 Sooner players called Oklahoma home, while just five were from Texas.

Sooners Bat Around California...

Oklahoma extended its win streak to six games with five wins coming in a five-day span in California. The Sooners started with a narrow 3-2 win at Fresno State (3/15) followed by a four-game sweep over CSU Bakersfield. OU lifted its season batting average by 19 points over the week with a collective .306 as a team. The Sooners posted double-digit hits in three games and scored double-figure runs in two, while matching a season-high 13 in the finale against the Roadrunners (3/19). **Sheldon Neuse** (.450) and **Austin O'Brien** (.438) led the Oklahoma offense in hitting.

A Bunt and a Blast Key Walk-Off...

Looking to avoid their fourth one-run loss of the season, the Sooners rallied in the ninth against Long Beach State (3/13) to win 6-3 on a walk-off, three-run homer by senior left fielder **Hunter Haley**. Trailing 3-2 entering the bottom of the ninth, Oklahoma got back-to-back singles from senior right fielder **Alex Wise** and freshman center fielder **Steele Walker** to set the table with runners at the corners. In a pinch-hit appearance, junior **Ben Hollas** put down a bunt to score Wise from third on a suicide-squeeze that tied the game. Haley then blasted a 2-2 pitch to right-center for his first home run of the season. It was Oklahoma's first win of the year when trailing after the sixth inning or later.

Power and Speed...

Senior **Hunter Haley** has 16 home runs and 30 stolen bases in his career. Over the last decade, he is one of just four players at OU to record 10 homers and 25 steals in a career. **Max White** (2010-13) and **Jamie Johnson** (2008-09) are the other two. White hit 23 homers and swiped 29 bags, while Johnson posted 18 and 38. Junior **Sheldon Neuse** joined that group (19 HR, 25 SB) at Little Rock (3/29).

Oh man, oh man, oh man, not again...

Sheldon Neuse smashed his second home run of the season vs. Mississippi State (3/6) at Dodger Stadium and followed with a home run against Wichita State (3/8). He later homered against Texas (4/3) and Dallas Baptist (4/5) in back-to-back games. Neuse has homered in back-to-back games four times in his career. He did so twice in 2015 against BYU (2/28) and Little Rock (3/3) and later against Purdue (3/7-8). His 19 career home runs are the most among active Sooners and are the most at OU since the introduction of the BBCOR bats in 2011; passing **Matt Oberste's** (2012-13) 17.

Hog Tied...

Due to travel restrictions, Oklahoma's game with Mississippi State (3/6) at Dodger Stadium ended after nine innings in a 5-5 tie. It marked the 12th tie in OU history and first since a 5-5, 11-inning game at Nebraska (3/22/08). The Sooners overcame a 5-1 deficit after the third inning.

One-Hit Shutout...

In his second career start, freshman RHP **Chris Andritsos** threw seven innings of shutout, one-hit ball. He retired the first eight Central Arkansas (3/1) batters of the game before allowing the only hit of the day in the third. The Sooners totaled six hits in the win, including solo home runs from **Sheldon Neuse** and **Cody Thomas**. Freshman RHP **Connor Berry** finished the game with two-scoreless innings of relief to earn the first save of his career, while tallying three strikeouts. The win marked the first shutout for OU since beating Alcorn State (4/22/15), 8-0. The Sooners have shutout UCA in back-to-back seasons by a score of 10-0. Andritsos has totaled 12 innings and 11 strikeouts in two starts with only two hits against and one run.

Against the West...

Under head coach Pete Hughes, the Sooners are 10-4 against schools from California. When playing against teams from the Pacific or Hawaii Time Zones, OU is 16-9. When playing in the Pacific of Hawaii Time Zones, Oklahoma is 13-4-1. In the last two seasons, the Sooners have played seven of the 11 Pac-12 schools and posted a 3-4 record.

Turf and Turf...

Through nine games, Oklahoma has played every game on a synthetic turf field. The Sooners are 8-5 at home on L. Dale Mitchell Park's new AstroTurf® surface. The first road trip of the season saw OU play on Sam Houston State's newly resurfaced Don Sander Stadium. The Sooners played their first game on natural grass this season last at USC and are 5-6-1 on natural surfaces and 13-13 on turf.

Road Test...

Gearing the schedule toward the RPI, Oklahoma plays 30 games away from L. Dale Mitchell Park, which includes the Bedlam Series hosted by Oklahoma State and a game at Dodger Stadium against Mississippi State. It is the most for the Sooners since 1999 when they played 32 games away from home. The last three times that Oklahoma went on the road 28 times or more in a season, the Sooners hosted a regional in Norman in 2006, 2009 and 2010.

Major League Diamonds...

Since the Big 12 Championship was last hosted in Arlington at Globe Life Park (Ameritrust Field at the time) in 2004, Oklahoma has played at a Major League Baseball park five times. The Sooners are 3-1-1 in such games following a tie vs. Mississippi State (3/6). OU most recently defeated UT-Arlington (3/11/14), 3-2 in 10 innings, in Arlington. In 2008, Oklahoma went 2-1 at the Houston College Classic at Minute Maid Park. The Sooners lost the opener to Rice (2/29/08), 7-2, before picking ups wins over Houston (3/1/08) and Tennessee (3/2/08) by scores of 8-5 in 10 innings and 2-0.

NEXT WEEK'S SCHEDULE

✂ Texas Tech owns the nation's longest winning streak at nine games, while its 12-game home winning streak is the third-longest in the nation.

✂ The top four teams in the Big 12 standings face off this weekend as first-place Texas Tech hosts Texas in a sold-out series and Oklahoma State takes on second-place TCU.

✂ Picked to finish fifth in the coaches preseason poll, the Red Raiders hold a 10-game conference win streak. The 10 straight Big 12 wins is tied for the fifth longest single-season win streak in conference history as TTU is the sixth team since 2000 to win 10 or more consecutive Big 12 games.

✂ The Frogs and Red Raiders remain highly ranked entering the week with TCU in the top 10 of five national polls including as high as No. 4 and TTU in the top 16 on five lists with a No. 7 ranking its highest on the week.

✂ In the 53 conference games thus far, 27 have been decided by three runs or less with 18 by just one run. Forty-six percent (41 of 90) of the league's non-conference losses have been by a margin of three runs or less.

✂ Oklahoma State won its fifth Pitcher of the Week honor on the season this week, bringing its season total up to five. The Pokes are only the seventh team in conference history to record five or more Pitcher of the Week honors in a single season and the first since Oklahoma in 2013.

✂ With its sweep last weekend, TCU now has nine three-game Big 12 series sweeps since joining the league in 2013. Texas Tech totals the next highest since the '13 season with seven, while Oklahoma State has six in that span.

✂ The league's top two teams (TCU and Texas Tech) feature young rotations as four of Tech's hurlers with six or more starts are freshman while two-thirds of TCU's weekend starters are also rookies - Luken Baker and Dalton Horton.

✂ Texas' Travis Duke is closing in on becoming the all-time leader in career appearances at UT. Duke has made 106, which is tied for second on the Texas list and tied for seventh on the Big 12 list.

✂ Of the eight league players with nine or more multi-RBI games this season, five are Horned Frogs. This season has seen the TCU post a +165 run differential.

✂ All-session tickets for the 2016 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship are on sale now - \$69 (terrace seats), \$99 (field) and \$169 (club) - and can be purchased by visiting Big12Sports.com/BuyTickets.

✂ A different league team has won the Big 12 regular season each of the past five seasons. The conference championship has also been won by a different
