### First Pitch...

The University of Oklahoma baseball team hits the road for a non-conference series at Austin Peay to close out the regular season. The series starts on Thursday night at 6:00 pm from Raymond C. Hand Park in Clarksville, Tenn.

### About the Sooners...

The Sooner offense has poured in 75 runs in the last eight games. Oklahoma is fresh off a Bedlam series win after taking the opener from the Cowboys, 9-1, and the finale, 3-1. Overall, the Sooners enter the weekend at 26-24-1 overall and wrapped up Big 12 play with an 11-13 record with five series victories. Junior shortstop **Sheldon Neuse**, who picked up his fifth save of the year on Sunday, leads OU with a .383 batting average, .471 on-base percentage and .6863 slugging percentage; all of which rank in the top three in the Big 12. He has driven in 46 runs on 15 doubles, 10 home runs and five triples to go with 12 stolen bases. An everyday player over recent weeks, junior outfielder and designated hitter **Cody Thomas** has seen his average jump to .304. The reigning Big 12 Player of the Week has driven in 15 runs, including seven in the Bedlam series, and hit .455 (20-for-44) since April 12. Senior right fielder **Alex Wise** is third on the team with a .302 average. He is riding a 13-game hitting streak; the longest active streak in the Big 12. Freshman right-hander **Jake Irvin** (5-1) was the OU midweek starter four weeks ago and has risen to opening night starter. He owns a 4.24 earned run average with 44 strikeouts in 46.2 innings.

- Oklahoma pitchers have struck out 10 or more in a game 15 times, including a season-high 14 vs. Oklahoma State (4/20).
- The Sooners claimed their first Bedlam series win since 2010 and has won its Big 12 series over OSU and Texas in the same season for the first time since 1998.
- Sheldon Neuse has been named to the midseason watch list for both the Golden Spikes (Player of the Year) Award and John Olerud (Two-Way Player of the Year) Award.
- Neuse and Domenic DeRenzo became the first OU teammates to hit two HRs in a game (KU, 4/30) since Casey Johnson, Jamie Johnson and J.T. Wise all hit two each at Kansas State (3/22/09).
- Freshman pitchers have accounted for 17 of Oklahoma's 26 wins. Overall, OU newcomers have totaled 18 this season. Alec Hansen became the third returner to win a game on Sunday.
- Six Sooners earned Academic All-Big 12 First Team, including seniors Hunter Haley, Keaton Hernandez, Shawn Hunter and Alex Wise and juniors Austin O'Brien and Cody Thomas.

### HEAD COACH PETE HUGHES

Pete Hughes was named the ninth head baseball coach in program history on June 27, 2013.

Twice named both the New England Coach of the Year and the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, as well as the 2000 American Baseball Coaches Association Northeast Region Coach of the Year, Hughes owns a well-deserved reputation for setting new standards of excellence at every stop during his 17-year coaching career.

Hughes recorded five straight 30-win seasons at Virginia Tech, including a pair of 40-win campaigns that culminated with NCAA Tournament berths in 2010 and 2013. He inherited a club that hadn't reached the NCAA Tournament since 2000 and went on to compile a 222-174 (.561) record in seven seasons with the Hokies from 2007-13.

In 20 seasons as a head coach, Hughes owns a career record of 613-465-3 (.569), including his stints at Boston College (1999-2006) and Trinity University (1997-98).

Hughes graduated from Davidson College in 1990 where he played third base on the baseball team and quarterback for the Wildcats' football team.

A native of Brockton, Mass., Hughes and his wife Debby reside in Norman with their five children: Thomas, Hal, Dominic, Grace and P.J.

### Scouting the Governors...

Austin Peay is 27-19 overall and 17-9 in the OVC under first-year head coach **Travis Janssen**. The Governors are hitting .308 as a team with six regulars hitting over .300; led by left fielder **Logan Gray** at .370 with 12 home runs and 35 RBI. Center fielder **Patrick Massoni** is second at .350. Right fielder **Chase Hamilton** is tied for the team-lead in home runs with 12 to go with 41 RBI and a .333 average. Right-hander **Alex Robles** (9-4) is the Austin Peay Friday starter with a 4.25 ERA and 72 strikeouts in 84.2 innings. At the plate, Robles is hitting .331 with 37 RBI and 33 runs scored. In the field, he plays first base.

### Crimson Over Orange; Twice as Nice...

Oklahoma won its Big 12 series over Texas and Oklahoma State for the first time since 1998; the only other time it has happened. The **Larry Cochell**-led Sooners took two out of three from the No. 16 Cowboys in the Bedlam Series. OU won the opener at Driller Stadium and then split the next two at All Sports Stadium. Oklahoma then swept the Longhorns at home to close out the regular season. This season, **Pete Hughes** and the Sooners picked up a home series win over Texas and took the opener from OSU at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark then split at ONEOK Field.

### Irvin's Rise...

Freshman right-hander **Jake Irvin** opened the season in the rotation for the Sooners in a four-game series against Northeastern. From there, he moved to the bullpen and pitched in spot duty or long relief. At Texas Tech (3/26), Irvin struck out the side in one inning of work and followed with two-scoreless frames at Little Rock (3/29). He earned the start in Oklahoma's next midweek; a 12-2 win over Dallas Baptist (4/5) in which he got the win in five innings with five strikeouts. Irvin pitched OU to another midweek win over Wichita State (4/12) and struck out 10 in 5.1 innings against Oklahoma State (4/20). He has since risen through the Sooner rotation; pitching on Sunday at Kansas (5/1), Saturday against Kansas State (5/7) and Friday night vs. Oklahoma State (5/13).

### Cody at the Bat...

Former OU football quarterback **Cody Thomas** has emerged as a middle of the lineup threat for the Sooners late in the season. He earned Big 12 Player of the Week (5/16) after hitting .417 (5-for-12) with seven RBI as he hit for the cycle in the series against Oklahoma State. Since a spot start at Wichita State (4/12) in which he drove in two and hit a solo home run, Thomas is hitting .455 (20-for-44) with seven multi-hit games in nine starts.

### Neuse Hits New Career Marks...

Against Kansas State (5/7), **Sheldon Neuse** became the 40th player in program history to score 100 runs with 100 RBI in a Sooner career. In Sunday's finale against the Wildcats (5/8), Neuse launched his 23rd career home run, which went for the 200th hit of his career. He became the 18th player in OU history to reach the 200-hit mark and the first since former teammate **Craig Aikin** did so in 2015. He enters this weekend with 206 hits, 136 RBI and 106 runs. Neuse's 80 career extra-base hits rank 10th all-time at OU and 42 doubles ranks 15th.

### Hansen Returns to the Rotation...

Junior right-hander **Alec Hansen** made his first start in the Sooner rotation since March 24 at Texas Tech with a six-inning start against Kansas State (5/8). He took a no-hitter into the sixth, which was broken up by a leadoff, bunt-single, and finished six shutout innings with nine strikeouts. Hansen earned his first win of the season and first since beating the Wildcats in Manhattan (5/10/15). For his effort, Hansen was named Big 12 Co-Pitcher of the Week.

## 2500 Wins in OU History...

The Sooners' 12-0 win over Kansas State (5/8) marked the 2,500th in program history. Oklahoma owns an all-time mark of 2,502-1,444-12 in 116 seasons. OU's win total ranks the third most among teams currently in the Big 12.

## Rare Run-Rules...

Oklahoma picked up its second run-rule of the season with a 12-0, seven-inning decision over Kansas State (5/8). The Sooners previously defeated Kansas (5/1) in seven, 17-6. Prior to that, OU had last won by run-rule against New Orleans (4/21/13). Oklahoma had last won by run-rule twice in a season in 2013 as it first defeated Arkansas-Pine Bluff (2/19/13). The win against the Wildcats this season marked the first time the OU baseball and softball teams won on a run-rule on the same day since Sooner baseball defeated Western Illinois (2/21/09).

## Freshmen Lead OU Past ORU...

In its last four meetings with Oral Roberts, Oklahoma had managed just one run in four losses. The Sooners quickly put that record behind them with a dominant, 12-3 win over the Golden Eagles (5/3) on Tuesday. Freshman RHP **Dylan Grove** made his first career start and took a no-hitter into the sixth. He finished with six strikeouts in six shutout innings. Freshman catcher **Domenic DeRenzo** provided the power at the bottom of the OU order with two home runs, including a grand slam.

## Wild Walk Offs the Norm for Norman Nine...

Oklahoma has won five games in walk-off fashion this season, including four in Big 12 play and three coming on Sundays. The Sooners added to their total with two to claim a series win over Baylor (4/8, 4/10). Oklahoma did not lead in either game until the winning run touched home. **Sheldon Neuse** singled and **Jack Flansburg** walked in the ninth of game one. **Renee Martinez** came in to pinch-hit and put down a sacrifice-bunt that was thrown away and allowed Neuse to score the walk-off run in a 4-3 win. In the second walk-off vs. Baylor, a game that featured four home runs by each side, it was three-straight singles that decided the game in extra innings. In the 11th, **Cade Harris** and **Ben Hollas** singled with two down to set up the game-winning hit for Flansburg; a 7-6 final. It marked the first series win for Oklahoma over Baylor since a 2012 sweep at home.

## Pair of Jacks...

**Sheldon Neuse** and **Domenic DeRenzo** each went yard twice in the Sooners' 9-8 loss at Kansas (4/30). They became the first OU teammates to hit a pair of home runs in a game since **Casey Johnson**, **Jamie Johnson** and **J.T. Wise** all hit two each at Kansas State (3/22/09). Oklahoma totaled a program-record 11 home runs in a 29-4 win over the Wildcats in that game.

## Double Down on Steele...

Freshman center fielder **Steele Walker** has been in the OU lineup for 48 of 51 games this season and leads the Sooners with 16 doubles with 12 in the last 21 games. His 16 doubles are tied for third most by a freshman on record (1993-present) with **Aaron Baker** (2007) and **Richard Park** (1997). In 2014, **Sheldon Neuse** doubled 17 times, which ranks second by a Sooner freshman. **Matt Bose** (2002) owns the record at 18.

## Big 12 Returns to OKC...

The Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship returns to Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City after a one-year stint in Tulsa. Day one of the tournament is Wednesday, May 25.

## Cool Ranch Andritsos...

Freshman **Chris Andritsos** has emerged as one of the top two-way players in the Big 12. On the mound, he is 4-5 with a team-leading 4.05 ERA and 1.07 WHIP, which ranks third in the Big 12. In limited action at the plate as the OU designated hitter or first baseman, Andritsos is hitting .255 (12-for-47) with five runs scored and six driven in. Against West Virginia (4/22), he had a no-hitter through six and went on to strike out eight in 7.2 shutout innings in an eventual, 1-0 win. Andritsos then beat the Mountaineers (4/23) with his bat in game two as he went 3-for-5 and drove in the game-tying and go-ahead runs in the eighth inning.

## Home Field Notes...

Oklahoma finished its home slate by winning all four Big 12 series at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners posted a .640 win percentage with a 16-9 record; the best since 2013 (.806). OU averaged 1,211 in home attendance; marking a rise in each of the past three seasons and the highest since 2012 (1,283).

## Young Arms...

Sooner freshmen pitchers have combined for 17 of the team's 26 wins; one behind Texas Tech's 18 for most in the Big 12. Collectively, OU freshmen have posted a 3.75 ERA, 7.10 K/9 average and 1.81 K-to-BB ratio. **Jake Irvin**, who has struck out a class-leading 44, has won five games, while **Chris Andritsos** and **Austin Hansen** have each won four.

## April Brings Spring to Wise's Bat...

In the month of April, senior Alex Wise hit .396 (24-for-65). After dropping to a .253 batting average on March 26, Wise busted out of a slump with a 2-for-4, two-double game at Little Rock (3/29) and has lifted his average to .308. Since that game, he has hit successfully in 23 of 26 games with 10 multi-hit games and seven doubles.

## Keepin' it 100...

Entering the week, **Sheldon Neuse** ranked in the top-100 of six offensive statistical categories. He peaks in the national rankings at 19th in slugging percentage (.683). **Chris Andritsos** ranks highest among OU pitchers with a 1.03 WHIP that is 87th in the NCAA and third in the Big 12. As a team, Oklahoma ranks 18th with a .977 fielding percentage, which is tops in the Big 12. The Sooners are also 24th in the country with 49 double plays turned.

### #YardWork...

Oklahoma has posted its highest home run total of the BBCOR era with 42 this season; besting its 41 in 2011. The Sooners hit a season-high four in a 7-6 win over Baylor (4/10). It was the most since OU went yard four times against Purdue (3/8/15). **Sheldon Neuse** is OU's active career leader with 23, which is second among active Big 12 players, followed by **Hunter Haley** at 16.

### Triple Nation...

Oklahoma ranks second in the Big 12 and 48th in the NCAA with 16 triples. **Sheldon Neuse** is the team leader at five. He is first in Big 12 and 24th in the country. He recorded the 15th of his career against Baylor (4/9). Neuse has the fifth most career triples among active players in the NCAA and is now tied for fourth all-time at OU with **Bill Severns** (1972-75) and **Baine Brooks** (1986-87). His 15 are the most at OU in the Big 12 era.

### Five-Down to Six-Up...

Oklahoma overcame a five-run deficit to win in a 12-6 decision over West Virginia (4/23). It marked the first come-from-behind win of five runs or more since defeating BYU (2/28/15) in Las Vegas. The Sooners trailed 6-1 and chipped away with a three-run sixth and pulled within one on a home run by freshman catcher **Domenic DeRenzo**. Oklahoma then turned the game upside down with a seven-run inning in the eighth to clinch the series.

### National Player of the Week...

For his efforts in the series win over Baylor, senior left fielder **Hunter Haley** was named a Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball News* on April 11. He hit .429 (6-for-14) in a 3-1 week for the Sooners and totaled eight RBI and three home runs; all of which came at the expense of the Bears. An OU player has earned the honor in each of the last three seasons as Haley joins former teammates **Kolbey Carpenter** (2/23/15) and **Mac James** (3/10/14).

### Making Noise at the Plate and on the Mound...

In a walk-off win over Texas (4/3), junior **Sheldon Neuse** made an impact at the plate and on the mound. As the starting shortstop, he gave Oklahoma its first lead of the day in the bottom of the first inning with a towering home run off the scoreboard in left-center. Neuse later moved to the mound with two runners on and only one out in the top of the eighth. He stranded both before pitching a 1-2-3 top of the ninth. After retiring all five batters faced, including a pair of strikeouts, Neuse was credited with the win. He became the first player at OU to homer and earn the win on the mound since **Jacob Evans** did so with a walk-off home run against Kansas (4/2/15).

### Fresh Faces...

Coach Hughes started a season-high six freshmen in the lineup against Wichita State (3/8), including RHP **Kyle Tyler** making his first career start. Oklahoma matched that total against Oral Roberts (5/3) with RHP Dylan Grove making his first career start. The Sooners have started three or more freshmen in 37 of 51 games this season.

### Shave for the Brave...

On April 7, the Sooners shaved their heads to fight childhood cancer at their third annual "Shave for the Brave". Donations benefited the Vs. Cancer Foundation and OU Children's Hospital. In the three seasons, OU baseball has raised more than \$80,000 and in 2015 ranked first among 63 participating teams. The game following Shave for the Brave was the team's seventh annual "Go Mitch Go" game against Baylor. **Mitchell Whitaker** was a friend of the program that passed in 2007 from Leukemia. The Sooners award one player each year in his honor. **Austin O'Brien** earned the award in 2016.

## Powering Past the Patriots...

The Sooners snapped an eight-game losing streak in the all-time series against non-conference opponent Dallas Baptist last Tuesday. Oklahoma's offense exploded for five runs in the first and six in the third en route to a 12-2 win at home. It marked the first win for the Sooners over the Patriots since April 27, 2010. **Sheldon Neuse** went 2-for-4 with a home run and freshman center fielder **Steele Walker** added a three-hit night. Freshman right-hander **Jake Irvin** struck out five, worked out of a bases loaded jam in the first and lasted five innings to earn his first career win.

## Sooners Turn Down Horns...

Oklahoma won back-to-back series over Texas for the first time in program history and has now won three of four. The Sooners recorded their first home win over Texas (4/1) since April 5, 2008. Freshman RHP **Chris Andritsos** struck out five in 7.2 innings of one run ball. OU went deep three times, including a three-run shot from junior **Jack Flansburg** in a 6-1 victory. Oklahoma bounced back from a Saturday defeat to walk off the Longhorns on Sunday, 4-3. Flansburg tied the game in the sixth with a two-run single. In the ninth, the Sooners loaded the bases with one out. Junior **Ben Hollas** delivered the game-winning hit: a line drive single to right. The win marked the first home series win for Oklahoma over Texas since 1998: when OU swept UT. Senior outfielder **Hunter Haley** is the only player in program history to have played in three series wins over the Longhorns.

## Iron Man Streak Ended...

At Fresno State (3/15), head coach **Pete Hughes** wrote out his lineup card without **Sheldon Neuse** on it for the first time since the two arrived at OU together for the 2014 season. Neuse had a stretch of 135 consecutive games started snapped. It is the longest streak on record at Oklahoma (2003-present). The previous record was held by **Jack Mayfield** at 120 (5/7/12-6/8/13). Neuse's former teammate, **Craig Aikin** was left out of the lineup just once in his career and had separate 91-game streak to start and end his career.

## The Big Inning...

The Sooners have scored more than two runs in an inning 40 times this season, including a season-high eight in the third at Wichita State (4/12). Oklahoma had previously scored six runs in an inning three times: vs. Dallas Baptist (4/5), at CSU Bakersfield (3/19) and vs. Northeastern (2/21). In its comeback win over Long Beach State (3/13), Oklahoma brought in four runs in the ninth. OU pitchers have limited the opposition to scoring more than twice in an inning 25 times. The Sooners have allowed three runs or more in the first or second inning eight times this season.

## Oh man, oh man, oh man, not again...

**Sheldon Neuse** smashed his second home run of the season vs. Mississippi State (3/6) at Dodger Stadium and followed with a home run against Wichita State (3/8). He later homered against Texas (4/3) and Dallas Baptist (4/5) in back-to-back games. Neuse homered in back-to-back games for a third time at Kansas (4/30-5/1). He has homered in back-to-back games five times in his career. Neuse did so twice in 2015 against BYU (2/28) and Little Rock (3/3) and later against Purdue (3/7-8). His 22 career home runs are the most among active Sooners and are the most at OU since the introduction of the BBCOR bats in 2011: passing **Matt Oberste's** (2012-13) 17.

## Oklahoma is Home...

The Sooner roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and 11 from Texas. This season marks the most Oklahoma born players at OU since 12 in 2012 and the first time with as many or more players from Oklahoma than Texas since 2006. In 2006, 13 Sooner players called Oklahoma home, while just five were from Texas.

### CONFERENCE NOTES

☞ Oklahoma State, TCU and Texas Tech enter the week ranked in the top 15 on three national lists. The Red Raiders check in as high as No. 5, the Frogs at No. 11 and the Cowboys at No. 14. The Big 12 is one of three conferences nationally with three or more teams ranked in the top 15.

☞ The trio is also ranked in the RPI top 25 entering the week - 10. Texas Tech, 19. TCU and 23. Oklahoma State - making the Big 12 one of three conferences with three-plus teams in the top 30 (ACC, SEC).

☞ Texas Tech has clinched the Big 12 regular season title, becoming the fifth team to win multiple regular season crowns in the league's 20-year history.

☞ Picked to finish fifth in the coaches preseason poll, TTU is the conference champion for the second time in league history after winning the inaugural title in 1997. It marks just the second time a team picked to finish fifth or lower has gone on to win the regular season (2013, Kansas State - 7th and 1999, Texas A&M - 5th).

☞ Entering the year, the Big 12 was the only "Power Five" conference in which a different league team has won the regular season each of the past five seasons. The Conference can boast the same feat in its postseason championship as the event has produced a different winner each of the past five years, which can not be said for the league's peer conferences.

☞ The Red Raiders will be the No. 1 seed in the conference postseason championship next week in Oklahoma City. The regular season champion has gone on to win the league tournament in the same year on five occasions (2011 - TAMU, '09 & '02 - UT and '05 & '01 - NU).

☞ West Virginia enters the week on a nine-game winning streak, tied for the longest in the country. It is the longest win streak for the Mountaineers since the 2008 season.

☞ In rivalry conference series last weekend, K-State took the Sunflower Showdown for the sixth time in the past seven seasons. Oklahoma was victorious in the Bedlam series for the first time since 2010, and Baylor won its first three-game series over TCU since 2000.

☞ Oklahoma State and Texas Tech both finished with 10-2 conference records away from home, marking just the third time in Big 12 history that multiple teams have had double-digit win totals on the road in conference play. It was done by the same two teams in 1997 and also by Missouri and Texas in 2007.

☞ The 2016 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship will be held Wednesday, May 25 through Sunday, May 29, at Oklahoma City's Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark. Seeding determinations will be announced following the final games of the regular season this Saturday, May 21.
