CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- The Big 12 has been the No. 1 conference in the RPI in four of the last seven years, including three seasons in a row.
- The Big 12 as a whole has won 36 of its last 47 and 49 of its last 63 non-conference contests overall. The league entered conference play in 2015-16 with five teams with one loss or less - the most of any league at the time.
- The Big 12 has had at least four teams in the top 25 for 39 consecutive weeks. Nine of the 10 teams in the Big 12 have been ranked in the top 25 at some point since January 1, 2014.
- Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among current conferences with a .607 mark.
- Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament during their respective careers.
- Seven coaches have career win percentages of .700 or better and the group of all 10 coaches boasts 3,530 career victories.
- The head coaches in the Big 12 have made 95 NCAA appearances, with 33 showings in the Sweet 16.
- The RPI for the Big 12 on Selection Sunday (.5884) last season ranked as the best in college basketball history since the NCAA adjusted the RPI formula to account for game location in 2004-05.
- Five Big 12 teams were ranked in the final top 25 polls for 2015-16. Nine of 10 squads in the Big 12 were ranked or received votes last season.
- The Big 12 boasted the nation's best non-conference winning percentage (.792) in 2015-16.
