GAMEDAY STORYLINES

► The Sooners hit the road for the first time in the 2016-17 season, playing three games in Orlando, Fla., as part of the Tire Pros Invitational. Oklahoma opens tournament play against Tulane on Nov. 17 at 6 p.m. CT. OU is 12-4 when playing in-season tournaments games under **Lon Kruger**, including 5-0 in opening round games. The Sooners have won at least two games and finished in third place or better in all five in-season tournaments under Kruger. Last year, OU claimed first place at the Diamond Classic in Honolulu, Hawaii, defeating Washington State, Hawaii and Harvard.

► Oklahoma is 58-14 in non-conference games under Kruger, including 22-9 when played at a neutral site. The Sooners have won 15 consecutive regular season non-conference games, with its last loss coming to Washington (67-69) on Dec. 20, 2014.

► OU looks for continued production from its group of newcomers and young players. The Sooner roster features 11 underclassmen - the most of any roster in the Kruger era. Six newcomers made their OU debut in Sunday's season-opening win over Northwestern State (97-61), totaling 40 points.

► **Khadeem Lattin** is coming off of a career performance in the Sooners' season opener. Lattin, who had only six previous games of double-digit scoring in his career, scored a career-high 19 points to go with 11 rebounds and a pair of blocks. The double-double was the third of his career and included a career-high-tying six offensive boards. As a team, the Sooners scored 52 points in the paint against Northwestern State. Oklahoma surpassed 50 paint points on just one occasion last season (53 vs. Incarnate Word on Nov. 24).

NORTHERN IOWA SERIES HISTORY

Oklahoma has never faced Northern Iowa.

GAME OVERVIEW

Oklahoma (1-0) opens the 2016 Tire Pros Invitational in Orlando, Fla., against Tulane (1-1). The first-round matchup will tip at 6 p.m. CT at the HP Field House at Disney's Wide World of Sports Complex. Thursday's contest will air on the Sooner Radio Network (KRXO 107.7 FM "The Franchise" in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** announcing. The game will be televised nationally on ESPNU with **Rich Hollenberg** and **LaPhonso Ellis** calling the action.

OKLAHOMA VS. TULANE SERIES HISTORY

► The Sooners' opening-round matchup with Tulane is their third overall meeting. The all-time series is tied 1-1 with the Sooners defeating the Green Wave, 83-69, in their most recent matchup (Nov. 25, 2001 at the Big Island Invitational in Hilo, Hawaii).

► Oklahoma is 3-1 against current members of the American Athletic Conference under Kruger. The Sooners have won three straight games against AAC schools, defeating Tulsa twice (101-91, Dec. 14, 2013 and 87-68, Dec. 13, 2014) and besting Memphis in last year's season opener (84-78, Nov. 17, 2015).

► Thursday will be Tulane head coach Mike Dunleavy Sr.'s third career game as a collegiate head coach. While it will be the first meeting between Dunleavy and **Lon Kruger** at the collegiate level, the two coaches have faced one another twice as NBA head coaches. Kruger (Atlanta Hawks) and Dunleavy (Portland Trail Blazers) split the pair of matchups, 1-1, during the 2000-01 season.

► First-year OU assistant coach **Carlin Hartman** graduated from Tulane in 1994. At the conclusion of his career with the Green Wave, Hartman ranked 10th in scoring (1,180 points), third on the program's career field goal percentage list (.528) and seventh in career steals (146). In 2011, Hartman was named to Tulane's 1990s All-Decade Team.

► Oklahoma opened the season with a 97-61 win over Northwestern State. The 36-point victory was the Sooners' largest margin of victory in a season opener since defeating Norfolk State, 99-36, at the start of the 2006-07 season. With the win, OU improved to 6-0 in season openers under head coach **Lon Kruger**.

► The Sooners shot 37-of-63 (.587) from the field and 9-of-18 (.500) from 3-point range. OU's field goal percentage marked its best shooting performance in a season opener since shooting 33-for-55 (.600) in 1996 against Northeast Louisiana.

► **Khadeem Lattin** led the Sooners with a career-high 19 points, 11 rebounds and two blocks. Lattin shot 7-of-9 from the field in his 24 minutes of action.

► OU led by double digits for 36 minutes after using an 18-2 run to open the game. The Sooners made nine of their first 11 shots while forcing four NSU turnovers in the first three minutes.

► Six Sooners made their OU debut on Sunday, totaling 40 points. The newcomers were led by redshirt freshman forward Matt Freeman. The 6-10 forward from New Zealand shot 6-of-7 from the field and 3-of-4 from 3-point range. His 15 points are the most by a Sooner freshman in a season opener since Steven Pledger scored 21 to begin the 2009-10 season.

► Senior guard **Jordan Woodard** recorded 16 points with five rebounds and three assists. Sophomore guard **Christian James** notched double-figure scoring for the fifth time in his career - scoring 12 points on 5-of-7 shooting to go with three assists and three rebounds.



UP NEXT

► Oklahoma continues play at the Wide World of Sports Complex with the second round of the the Tire Pros Invitational. The Sooners will play either Arizona State or Northern Iowa in the tournament's second round on Friday, Nov. 18. Potential opponents for Oklahoma's final Tire Pros Invitational game on Sunday, Nov. 20 are Clemson, Davidson, Missouri and Xavier.

► The Sooners are 1-1 all time against Arizona State. Oklahoma won the most recent meeting, 89-76, in 1983. The two schools have never met at a neutral site.

► Should OU match up with Northern Iowa, it would be the first meeting between the two programs.

KRUGER KEEPS BUILDING

Lon Kruger has made his mark in college basketball as one of – if not the best – program rebuilders. Want proof? Look no further than what he's done with Oklahoma.

► In the two seasons before his hiring, the Sooners went 27-36 (.429) – capped by a 10th-place finish in the Big 12 in 2010-11. Since being brought on in 2011, Kruger has led the program to a 112-57 (.663) record, including a 97-41 (.703) mark over the past five seasons.

► Kruger's OU teams keep improving and have surpassed their win total from each subsequent season, with the 2015-16 squad finishing with a 29-8 record and making a trip to the Final Four. Before his arrival at OU, the Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.

► In five full seasons at Oklahoma, Kruger has produced four NCAA Tournament appearances, three top-three finishes in the Big 12, a national player of the year in Buddy Hield and a trip to the 2016 Final Four. Oklahoma was ranked in the top 10 of the AP Top 25 poll for every week of the 2015-16 season and made its first appearance as the poll's No. 1 team for the first time in more than 25 years.

► With 111 wins in his first five seasons at OU, Kruger owns the second most victories in the first five seasons of coaching the Sooners. Only Billy Tubbs accumulated more wins (115) in his first five years at OU. Kruger is the first coach in OU history to win six NCAA tournament games within his first five seasons.

KRUGER CHASING 600

► With 591 career victories, Kruger ranks 10th in Division 1 wins among active coaches and 38th overall in NCAA Division I history.

► Kruger is the only coach to take five different programs to the NCAA Tournament (Kansas State, Florida, Illinois, UNLV and OU), and he has won at least two tourney games at each.

► In 2015 he became the first coach since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams (1985) to take four programs to the Sweet 16 or beyond (Kansas State, Florida, UNLV and OU).

► Kruger's 16 NCAA tournament appearances are the 10th most among active coaches.

WATCHING WOODARD

► Senior guard **Jordan Woodard** enters Thursday's game with 106 consecutive collegiate starts. A 2015-16 All-Big 12 honorable mention selection, Woodard was the team's second-leading scorer last season with averages of 13.0 points (10th in Big 12), 3.4 assists (9th), 3.0 rebounds and 1.6 steals (5th) in 29.8 minutes. The Big 12 coaches voted Woodard a preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention selection ahead of the 2016-17 season.

► Woodard has seen remarkable development from season to season – particularly from behind the 3-point arc. After shooting 17-for-67 (.254) from 3-point range in 2014-15, Woodard sunk 80 treys on 176 attempts (.455) his junior year to finish second in the Big 12 in 3-point shooting.

► In addition to his refined shooting abilities, Woodard boasts a career assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.9. His 3.4 assists per game in 2015-16 ranked ninth in the Big 12 while he limited himself to 60 total turnovers on the season. He was one of just five Big 12 players to dish out at least 120 assists while maintaining an assist-to-turnover ratio of under 2.0.

► With three seasons of experience in the Sooner starting lineup under his belt, Woodard has already made a dent in the OU record book. With his senior season remaining, the guard aims to climb higher on career leaderboards.

LATTIN BLOCK PARTY

► Junior forward **Khadeem Lattin** has already proven himself as one of the top shot blockers in Oklahoma program history. After just 72 career games for the Sooners, Lattin ranks sixth in the OU record book in career blocks with 108.

► Owning a 7-foot-2 wingspan, Lattin averaged a Big 12-best 2.1 blocks per game in 2015-16, including 2.7 rejections in conference play. His efforts did not go unnoticed throughout the league, as he was voted to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team by conference coaches.

► His 77 in 2015-16 total blocks ranked 17th in the nation and fifth among players at Power Five schools. The forward registered at least six blocks on five occasions, including a career-best eight blocked shots vs. Texas Tech on Jan. 26.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

It's known as the house Alvan Adams built and Wayman Tisdale filled. It's also where Billy Tubbs resurrected Oklahoma basketball, where Blake Griffin flew high and where Buddy Hield became Buddy Buckets. Now, Lon Kruger is continuing the remarkable run of Sooner success inside the Lloyd Noble Center.

► Oklahoma has gone 55-7 (.887) at home in the past five years, including 29-2 (.935) in the last three seasons. Overall, the Sooners are 66-12 (.846) at the LNC in the Kruger era.

► The Sooners have won 434 of their last 500 home encounters, good for a remarkable .868 winning percentage. Included in the stretch was a school-record 51-game winning streak (ended in 1990-91). The Sooners also recorded a Big 12 Conference-record 37-game home court winning streak (ended in 2003).

► OU is 13-6 at home against AP Top 25 opponents in the Kruger era and has won 12 of the last 14 such contests.

► Oklahoma has won 123 of its last 128 non-conference games at LNC, including 57 of its last 59. The Sooners are 31-2 at home against non-conference opponents under Kruger.

► Overall, the Sooners own a 529-93 (.850) record in the LNC since the building opened in 1975.

► Student interest in OU basketball has continued to grow through Kruger's tenure. Student attendance has increased by more than 100 percent from Kruger's first season (2011-12). This year, OU student season tickets sold out in less than 24 hours – the fastest rate in the OU era.

IT'S NOT WHERE YOU START...

For the first time since 2013, the Sooners will start the season unranked in both the AP and Coaches preseason polls. Oklahoma was also voted sixth in the Big 12 Conference's preseason poll – it's lowest preseason projection since 2012. Despite the preseason rankings, OU looks to continue an upward trend of surpassing expectations under Kruger.

► Oklahoma has finished as well or better than predicted in four of the five seasons under Kruger. In the only exception (2015-16), the Sooners were picked to finish second in the Big 12. While OU ended the 2015-16 regular season with the third best record in the Big 12, the Sooners advanced to the 2016 Final Four – the deepest NCAA Tournament run by a Big 12 team that season.

► The Sooners have also finished the past three seasons with a better ranking in the final AP and Coaches Polls compared to where each poll had pegged them at the start of the year.

► Prior to the 2016 AP preseason poll, the Sooners had received a Top-25 ranking for 36 consecutive weeks. Oklahoma has been ranked in the top 25 in 44 of the past 49 AP polls.

SOONER TIP-INS

► **Christian James** will look to continue the upward trend he saw in the 2016 postseason. James averaged 2.9 points and 1.7 rebounds in 9.4 minutes on the season while shooting .426 (29-68) from the floor and .500 (17-34) from beyond the arc. In five NCAA Tournament games, James averaged 4.8 points and 3.6 rebounds in 17.0 minutes, highlighted by a career-high 10 rebounds in the NCAA West Regional Final vs. Oregon on March 26. He opened the season with 12 points on 5-of-7 shooting against Northwestern State (Nov. 13).

► Oklahoma's starting lineup in Sunday's season opener included freshman forward **Kristian Doolittle**, the first freshman to start for the Sooners since **Jordan Woodard** in the 2013-14 season. Doolittle finished his debut with five points and three rebounds in 19 minutes. Doolittle and Woodard played together for one season at Edmond Memorial High School (Edmond, Okla.), winning the Oklahoma 6A title. The duo is the first pair of former high school teammates to start in a game for the Sooners since **Blake and Taylor Griffin** (Oklahoma Christian School in Edmond, Okla.) in 2008-09.

KRUGER'S SOONER TURNAROUND

- Kruger has been leaving his trademark rebuilding stamp on college basketball programs throughout his career. He is the only Division I coach to ever take five different schools to the NCAA Tournament. In 2015 he became the first coach since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985 to take four programs to the Sweet 16 or beyond.
- After inheriting a program that went 27-36 (.429) in the two seasons prior to his arrival, Kruger has coached the Sooners to a 112-57 (.661) record in six seasons. Over the last four full campaigns, OU posted a 96-41 (.701) mark and advanced to the NCAA Tournament each season, capped by a trip to the 2016 Final Four in Houston. The Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- With a career college coaching record of 591-361 (.621), Kruger owns the 10th most wins among active Division I coaches. He owns a 20-17 record in NCAA Tournament games and has compiled 16 20-plus-win seasons, including nine in the last 10 years. His collegiate teams have made postseason appearances in 21 of the last 26 years.
- Under Kruger, Sooner players have earned First-Team All-Big 12 selections on three occasions and racked up 14 Academic All-Big 12 honors. Buddy Hield, who played four seasons for Kruger (2012-16), was named the winner of the 2016 Wooden Award, Naismith Trophy and the Oscar Robertson Trophy as the national player of the year (first consensus player of the year for OU since Blake Griffin in 2009).
- Three Sooners have been drafted into the NBA during Kruger's tenure. Buddy Hield was selected as the sixth overall pick in the 2016 NBA Draft while Isaiah Cousins (2016) and Romero Osby (2013) were chosen in the second round of their respected drafts.
