## CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

**Big 12 men's basketball teams have posted a 14-1 record to open the 2016-17 campaign, defeating opponents by an average of 28.1 points.**

**The Big 12 as a whole has won 50 of its last 62 and 63 of its last 78 non-conference contests overall. The league entered conference play in 2015-16 with five teams with one loss or less - the most of any league at the time.**

**The Big 12 has been the No. 1 conference in the RPI in four of the last seven years, including three seasons in a row.**

**The Big 12 has had at least four teams in the top 25 for 40 consecutive weeks. Nine of the 10 teams in the Big 12 have been ranked in the top 25 at some point since January 1, 2014.**

**Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among current conferences with a .607 mark.**

**Five head coaches in the Big 12 have led teams to the Final Four, while every head coach has guided a team to the NCAA Tournament during their respective careers.**

**BAYLOR (1-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Baylor extended its season-opener win streak to 11 with the victory over Oral Roberts. The Bears are 12-1 in the first game of the year under head coach Scott Drew and are 6-0 all-time against ORU.
- ✎ BU has 126 wins since 2011-12, the second-most in the Big 12 behind Kansas (148). The Bears are 56-11 (.836) in November games under Drew, who is the all-time wins leader in program history with 251 victories.
- ✎ Junior guard Manu Lecomte had a double-double in his Baylor debut with 13 points, 11 assists and zero turnovers. He logged a team-best 35 minutes while adding three steals in the contest.

**IOWA STATE (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Head coach Steve Prohm won his 25th game at Iowa State with the win over Mount St. Mary's. He is the second-fastest in school history to reach the mark, following Tim Floyd's 25 victories in his first 36 contests.
- ✎ Senior guard Monté Morris has led ISU in scoring in each of the first two contests and has 14 assists with only two turnovers. He has 12 double-digit assist efforts in his career, three times more than the rest of the Big 12 combined.
- ✎ Iowa State has won 36 consecutive non-conference games at home, the third-longest streak in the nation. Senior guard Matt Thomas has made a 3-pointer in 27 straight games, tying for the second-longest string in school history.

**KANSAS (0-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Senior guard Frank Mason III finished with a career-high 30 points versus Indiana to go along with seven rebounds. He scored the Jayhawks' final 11 points in regulation and posted 19 of his points in the second half and overtime.
- ✎ KU's streak of 14 consecutive season-opening victories ended with the loss to IU. The Jayhawks have not started a season with an 0-2 record since the 1972-73 campaign.
- ✎ The Kansas game with Duke will match the two teams with the longest active streaks for NCAA Tournament appearances. The Jayhawks have made 27 in a row (tied for the NCAA record), while the Blue Devils have earned 21 straight bids.

**KANSAS STATE (1-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Kansas State is 88-25 (.778) in season-opening contests, including a 23-2 (.920) mark at Bramlage Coliseum. The Wildcats are 80-5 (.941) in non-conference play at home dating back to 2006-07, including wins in 69 of the last 72 outings.
- ✎ Four Wildcats scored in double figures in the win over Western Illinois, led by sophomore guard Barry Brown. It was his 13th double-digit scoring output dating back to last season.
- ✎ K-State shot 62.5 percent (15-of-24) from the field versus the Leathernecks, limiting WIU to just 36.5 percent shooting after halftime. Head coach Bruce Weber improved to 17-2 in career season openers with the victory.

**OKLAHOMA (1-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Junior forward Khadeem Lattin had a career-high 19 points to go along with 11 rebounds and two blocks in the win over Northwestern State. It was the third double-double of his career.
- ✎ Forward Matt Freeman finished with 15 points on 6-of-7 shooting versus the Demons. It was the most points by a Sooner freshman in a season opener since 2009-10 (Steven Pledger, 21).
- ✎ Oklahoma has won 123 of its last 128 non-conference games at Lloyd Noble Center, including 57 of the past 59. The Sooners are 58-14 (.806) against non-league foes under coach Lon Kruger, including 31-2 (.939) at home.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Senior guard Phil Forte recorded his second career 30-point outing in the win over Central Arkansas and was 11-of-11 from the free throw line. He has made 19 consecutive free throws dating back to last season.
- ✎ Oklahoma State has topped the 100-point plateau in back-to-back games to open a season for the first time since 1993-94. Forte, Jawun Evans and Jeffrey Carroll have combined to score 152 of OSU's 204 points in the first two contests.
- ✎ OSU has started 2-0 overall for the ninth consecutive season and is 199-7 (.966) in non-conference games at Gallagher-Iba Arena since 1989. The Cowboys have also won 22 straight season openers dating back to 1995-96.

**TCU (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Freshman Desmond Bane paced five players in double figures in the win over Alabama State with a career-high 19 points. It marked the second straight outing that at least five Horned Frogs had scored in double digits.
- ✎ TCU limited Alabama State to 15 first-half points, the ninth-fewest by any opponent in any half in school history. The Frogs are limiting their foes to 63.0 points per game and have allowed more than 40 points in one of four halves this year.
- ✎ Head coach Jamie Dixon boasts a 14-0 record during his career in season openers as a head coach. The Frogs are 55-13 in home openers all-time and have a 69-37 mark in season-opening contests.

**TEXAS (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Sophomore Tevin Mack led four Longhorns in double figures with 14 points on 5-of-9 shooting in the win over ULM. It was his sixth career double digit scoring output and first since February 16.
- ✎ UT improved to 7-2 all-time in Legends Classic games in three appearances. No Longhorn player saw more than 24 minutes of action during the contest and seven different players scored at least seven points.
- ✎ Texas is 207-29 (.877) at the Frank Erwin Center over the last 15 years, dating back to the start of the 2002-03 campaign. The 'Horns are 479-112 (.810) all-time at the venue and 16-3 at home under head coach Shaka Smart.

**TEXAS TECH (1-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Junior guard Keenan Evans poured in a career-high 28 points, including 18 in the first half, in the win over Houston Baptist. He was 9-of-12 from the floor and converted a career-best five 3-point field goals.
- ✎ The Red Raiders shot 61.1 percent from the field versus HBU, the best shooting performance by any Big 12 squad during opening weekend. TTU was 10-of-17 from 3-point range, one of three league squads to make 10 shots from beyond the arc.
- ✎ Senior forward Aaron Ross finished with 13 points on 5-of-9 shooting against the Huskies. He has scored in double digits in 15 of his last 19 outings dating back to last season.

**WEST VIRGINIA (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Senior forward Nathan Adrian recorded his first career double-double with 15 points and 14 rebounds versus Mississippi Valley State. He has scored double digits in each of the first two games and is shooting 52.9 percent from the field.
- ✎ West Virginia forced 26 turnovers that turned into 34 points in the win over MVSU. The Mountaineers 60 points over turnovers in the first two contests and have forced at least 20 opponent miscues in four of their past five games dating back to 2015-16.
- ✎ The Mountaineers have won 50 of 54 non-conference games at home under head coach Bob Huggins. He needs just seven victories overall to record the 800th of his 35-year career.
