CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Big 12 men's basketball teams have posted a 21-1 record to open the 2016-17 campaign, defeating opponents by an average of 26.1 points.
- Big 12 squads have a 13-game winning streak overall and haven't lost since November 11.
- For the first time in Big 12 history, the league has beaten two top five non-conference opponents on the same day. Kansas topped No. 1 Duke and Baylor defeated No. 4 Oregon on November 15.
- Big 12 teams boast a .955 (21-1) winning percentage so far this season - the best percentage and fewest losses of any conference in the nation.
- The Big 12 as a whole has won 57 of its last 69 and 70 of its last 85 non-conference contests overall.
- Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .608 mark.
- The Big 12 has been the No. 1 conference in the RPI in four of the last seven years, including three seasons in a row.

**BAYLOR (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Baylor recorded its first win over a top five non-conference opponent in Waco with the victory over Oregon. The Bears have defeated 13 nationally-ranked teams over the last two-plus seasons.
- ✎ Junior guard Manu Lecomte has scored in double figures in each of his first two contests, adding 18 assists with just three turnovers. He has played exactly 35 minutes in each of the first two outings.
- ✎ Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. had seven blocked shots versus the Ducks, the 10th-best total in a game in Baylor history. He also grabbed double-digit rebounds (14) for the first time in his BU career.

**IOWA STATE (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Head coach Steve Prohm won his 25th game at Iowa State with the win over Mount St. Mary's. He is the second-fastest in school history to reach the mark, following Tim Floyd's 25 victories in his first 36 contests.
- ✎ Senior guard Monté Morris has led ISU in scoring in each of the first two contests and has 14 assists with only two turnovers. He has 12 double-digit assist efforts in his career, three times more than the rest of the Big 12 combined.
- ✎ Iowa State has won 36 consecutive non-conference games at home, the third-longest streak in the nation. Senior guard Matt Thomas has made a 3-pointer in 27 straight games, tying for the second-longest string in school history.

**KANSAS (1-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Senior guard Frank Mason III recorded the final five points for KU in the win over Duke, including the game-winning jumper with 1.8 seconds left. He has led the Jayhawks in scoring in both games this year, averaging 25.5 points.
- ✎ Kansas has won three of the last four matchups against Duke, including two in a row. The victory marked the eighth for the Jayhawks over the No. 1 team in the nation, including three under head coach Bill Self.
- ✎ Freshman center Udoka Azubuike grabbed a season-high 12 rebounds in 15 minutes of action against the Blue Devils. He was the first Jayhawk to record double-figure rebounds in a game this season.

**KANSAS STATE (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Sophomore guard Barry Brown has led the Wildcats in scoring in each of the first two games after finishing with 15 points versus Omaha. He is shooting 54.5 percent with eight assists in the first two contests.
- ✎ Kansas State has won 10 consecutive outings at home over non-conference opposition. The Wildcats are 81-5 (.942) in non-conference play at home dating back to 2006-07, including wins in 70 of the last 73 outings.
- ✎ K-State is 17-of-38 (.447) from 3-point range so far this season, the second-best percentage in the conference. Seven different Wildcats have hit from beyond the arc so far in 2016-17.

**OKLAHOMA (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Oklahoma is 13-4 when playing in-season tournaments under head coach Lon Kruger, including 6-0 in opening round contests. The Sooners are also 23-9 when playing at a neutral site in non-conference games under Kruger.
- ✎ OU made 32-of-62 (.516) from the field versus Tulane after shooting 58.7 percent in its season-opening win over Northwestern State. It is the first time since 2008 that OU has shot above 50 percent in its first two outings of the season.
- ✎ Senior guard Jordan Woodard had 22 points, seven assists and six rebounds against the Green Wave. It was the first time in his career he has surpassed 20 points, five boards and five assists in the same game.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (3-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Oklahoma State is the only team in the nation to have reached the 100-point plateau in each of its first three contests. The Cowboys' 117 points versus New Orleans tied for the sixth-most in program history.
- ✎ OSU had six players reach double-figures against UNO, the first time since November 12, 2013 it has accomplished the feat. Senior forward Leyton Hammonds posted his second career double-double with 15 points and a career-high 13 boards.
- ✎ Sophomore guard Jawun Evans (34 points vs. Campbell) and senior guard Phil Forte (31 points vs. Central Arkansas) have recorded the two highest-scoring games by any Big 12 player this season.

**TCU (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Freshman Desmond Bane paced five players in double figures in the win over Alabama State with a career-high 19 points. It marked the second straight outing that at least five Horned Frogs had scored in double digits.
- ✎ TCU limited Alabama State to 15 first-half points, the ninth-fewest by any opponent in any half in school history. The Frogs are limiting their foes to 63.0 points per game and have allowed more than 40 points in one of four halves this year.
- ✎ Head coach Jamie Dixon boasts a 14-0 record during his career in season openers as a head coach. The Frogs are 55-13 in home openers all-time and have a 69-37 mark in season-opening contests.

**TEXAS (3-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Sophomore Tevin Mack led five Longhorns in double figures with 19 points in 21 minutes off the bench in the win over Eastern Washington. The point total was one short of his career high and seventh time he has reached double digits in his career.
- ✎ UT improved to 8-2 all-time in Legends Classic games in three appearances. No Longhorn player saw more than 28 minutes of action during the contest and seven different players scored at least six points.
- ✎ Texas is 208-29 (.878) at the Frank Erwin Center over the last 15 years, dating back to the start of the 2002-03 campaign. The 'Horns are 480-112 (.811) all-time at the venue and 17-3 at home under head coach Shaka Smart.

**TEXAS TECH (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Junior forward Zach Smith recorded his third career double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds in the win over North Texas. He is shooting 63.6 percent from the field this season.
- ✎ The Red Raiders have won 21 consecutive non-conference home games dating back to the 2013-14 campaign. Tech has outscored its opponents by 26.5 points in two games and has allowed only 11 field goals from 3-point range.
- ✎ Senior forward Aaron Ross has had 13 points in each of the first two contests of 2016-17 and has scored in double digits in 16 of his last 20 outings dating back to last season.

**WEST VIRGINIA (2-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Senior forward Nathan Adrian recorded his first career double-double with 15 points and 14 rebounds versus Mississippi Valley State. He has scored double digits in each of the first two games and is shooting 52.9 percent from the field.
- ✎ West Virginia forced 26 turnovers that turned into 34 points in the win over MVSU. The Mountaineers 60 points over turnovers in the first two contests and have forced at least 20 opponent miscues in four of their past five games dating back to 2015-16.
- ✎ The Mountaineers have won 50 of 54 non-conference games at home under head coach Bob Huggins. He needs just seven victories overall to record the 800th of his 35-year career.
