GAMEDAY STORYLINES

- ▶ After taking third place in the Tire Pros Invitational in Orlando, Fla., the Sooners are back at home for the second time this season. Oklahoma has won 123 of its last 128 non-conference games at Lloyd Noble Center, including 57 of its last 59. The Sooners are 31-2 at home and 60-15 overall against non-conference opponents under Kruger. OU is 20-1 at the LNC in out-of-conference play since 2013.
- ▶ After a prolific season of 3-point shooting in 2015-16 that included hitting a program-record 382-of-906 (.422) shots from behind the arc, the Sooners are off to another hot start from deep. Oklahoma ranks 10th nationally and third in the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage (.459), sinking an average of 8.5 treys per game. OU has been paced by Christian James and Jordan Woodard with 10 3-pointers each through four games. In his most recent game (Nov. 20 vs. Clemson), James went 5-of-5 from 3-point range and was the first Sooner to shoot 100 percent from 3-point range on at least five attempts since Buddy Hield went 7-for-7 against Southeastern Louisiana in 2014. James is shooting 10-for-14 (.714) from behind the arc this season and is eight 3-point field goals away from surpassing his 2015-16 season total (17-of-34 in 35 games).
- ▶ Through four games, the Sooners have seen numerous newcomers contribute to their 3-1 start. An OU freshman has scored in double figures in three of the Sooners' four games. Matt Freeman opened the season with 15 points against Northwestern State (Nov. 13), Kristian Doolittle tallied 13 points against Northern Iowa (Nov. 18) and Kameron McGusty scored 14 versus Clemson (Nov. 20). All five of OU's scholarship newcomers (Doolitte, Freeman, McGusty, Jordan Shepherd and Darrion Strong-Moore) are averaging at least 10 minutes per game and collectively average 26.3 points per contest

Oklahoma (3-1) returns to the Lloyd Noble Center for a holiday weekend matinee against Abilene Christian (2-1) on Friday, Nov. 25. The Sooners host the Wildcats for the first time since 1982 at 2 p.m. Oklahoma aims to start the season 4-1 for the sixth consecutive season under Lon Kruger. OU has began the year by winning four of its first five games in each season under Kruger, including a 5-0 start in 2015-16. The Sooners have won 13 straight non-conference games at Lloyd Noble Center. Friday's contest will air on the Sooner Radio Network (KRXO 107.7 FM "The Franchise" in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** announcing. The game will be televised on Fox Sports Oklahoma with **Chad McKee** and **Bryndon Manzer** calling the action.

OKLAHOMA VS. ABILENE CHRISTIAN SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ 0U is 2-0 all time against ACU, with both games being played in Norman. Friday's meeting will be the first game between the Sooners and Wildcats since 1982.
- ▶ The Sooners won their two previous matchups with ACU by an average of 36.5 points.
- ▶ The last time the Sooners and Wildcats met (Dec. 6, 1982), Wayman Tisdale led Oklahoma to a 110-61 rout. Tisdale scored 51 points on 22-of-27 shooting while adding 17 rebounds. Tisdale's scoring performance was the third highest of his career and fourth most in OU history.

- ▶ Oklahoma (3-1) claimed third place in the Tire Pros Invitational by defeating Clemson (2-2), 70-64, on Sunday at HP Field House in Orlando, Fla. The Sooners have finished in third place or better in all six in-season tournaments under Lon Kruger. OU is 14-5 when playing in-season tournaments games in the Kruger era.
- ▶ The Sooners bounced back after an overtime loss to Northern Iowa in the semifinals on Friday. Since 2013, Oklahoma is 23-5 in games after a loss.
- ▶ Senior guard Jordan Woodard totaled 21 points, nine assists, five rebounds and four steals. It is the second time this season that Woodard has produced at least 20 points, five assists and five rebounds and the first game in Woodard's career that he dished out nine assists while scoring at least 20 points.
- ▶ Sophomore guard Christian James scored 14 second-half points on 5-of-7 shooting, knocking down all four of his 3-point attempts. All of James's second-half 3-pointers came when Clemson was within 8 or less points of the Sooners and the guard scored 14 of Oklahoma's final 19 points.
- ▶ James finished the night with a career-best 17 points and 5-of-5 shooting from 3-point range. He is the first Sooner to shoot 100 percent from 3-point range on at least five attempts since Buddy Hield went 7-for-7 on Nov. 16, 2014 vs. Southeastern Louisiana.

UP NEXT

- ▶ Oklahoma hosts Northern Colorado on Tuesday, Nov. 29. The Sooners own a 2-0 all-time record against the Bears. The contest will tip at 7 p.m. CT on Fox Sports Oklahoma.
- ▶ Tuesday's game will be the first meeting between Oklahoma and Northern Colorado since 2009 when UNC fell to the Sooners by just one point (80-79).
- ▶ The Sooners play five of their next six games in Oklahoma with LNC matchups against Abilene Christian (Nov. 25), Northern Colorado (Nov. 29), Oral Roberts (Dec. 7) and Memphis (Dec. 17). OU hosts Wichita State at Oklahoma City's Chesapeake Energy Arena on Dec. 10 in the All-College Classic. Oklahoma's lone road game in the month of December is at Wisconsin on Dec. 3. The Sooners also face Auburn in a neutral-site game in Uncasville, Conn., on Dec. 21.

KRUGER KEEPS BUILDING

Lon Kruger has made his mark in college basketball as one of – if not the best – program rebuilders. Want proof? Look no further than what he's done with Oklahoma.

- ▶ In the two seasons before his hiring, the Sooners went 27-36 (.429) capped by a 10th-place finish in the Big 12 in 2010-11. Since being brought on in 2011, Kruger has led the program to a 114-58 (.663) record, including a 99-42 (.702) mark over the past five seasons
- ▶ Kruger's OU teams keep improving and have surpassed their win total from each subsequent season, with the 2015-16 squad finishing with a 29-8 record and making a trip to the Final Four. Before his arrival at OU, the Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- ▶ In five full seasons at Oklahoma, Kruger has produced four NCAA Tournament appearances, three top-three finishes in the Big 12, a national player of the year in Buddy Hield and a trip to the 2016 Final Four. Oklahoma was ranked in the top 10 of the AP Top 25 poll for every week of the 2015-16 season and made its first

appearance as the poll's No. 1 team for the first time in more than 25 years.

- ▶ With 111 wins in his first five seasons at OU, Kruger owns the second most victories in the first five seasons of coaching the Sooners. Only Billy Tubbs accumulated more wins (115) in his first five years at OU. Kruger is the first coach in OU history to win six NCAA tournament games within his first five seasons.
- ▶ With 593 career victories, Kruger ranks 10th in Division 1 wins among active coaches and 37th overall in NCAA Division I history.

WATCHING WOODARD

- ▶ Senior guard **Jordan Woodard** enters Friday's game with 109 consecutive collegiate starts, tied for the most among current NCAA Division I players. Woodard is one of just four players in NCAA Division I to hold a current starting streak of at least 105 games.
- ▶ A 2015-16 All-Big 12 honorable mention selection, Woodard was the team's second-leading scorer last season with averages of 13.0 points (10th in Big 12), 3.4 assists (9th), 3.0 rebounds and 1.6

steals (5th) in 29.8 minutes. The Big 12 coaches voted Woodard a preseason All-Big 12 Honorable Mention selection ahead of the 2016-17 season.

▶ Woodard has seen remarkable development from season to season — particularly from behind the 3-point arc. After shooting 17-for-67 (.254) from 3-point range in 2014-15, Woodard sunk 80 treys on 176 attempts (.455) his junior year to finish second in the Big 12 in 3-point shooting.

▶ In addition to his refined shooting abilities, Woodard boasts a career assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.0. His 3.4 assists per game in

- ▶ With three seasons of experience in the Sooner starting lineup under his belt, Woodard has already made a dent in the OU record book. With his senior season remaining, the guard aims to climb higher on career leaderboards. He ranks in the top 10 of four statistical categories (free throws, free throw percentage, assists, steals) and is 27th on OU's all-time scoring list.
- ▶ Woodard enters Friday's game eight made free throws shy of hitting 400 career makes from the foul line. He ranks eighth in program history in both free throws made (392) and free throw percentage (.808). No Sooner has ever finished his career with over 400 made free throws at a rate of over .800.

- ▶ Junior forward **Khadeem Lattin** has already proven himself as one of the top shot blockers in Oklahoma program history. After just 75 career games for the Sooners, Lattin ranks fifth in the OU record book in career blocks with 116.
- ▶ Owning a 7-foot-2 wingspan, Lattin averaged a Big 12-best 2.1 blocks per game in 2015-16, including 2.7 rejections in conference

play. His efforts did not go unnoticed throughout the league, as he was voted to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team by conference coaches.

▶ His 77 total blocks in 2015-16 ranked 17th in the nation and fifth among players at Power Five schools. The forward registered at least six blocks on five occasions, including a career-best eight blocked shots vs. Texas Tech on Jan. 26.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

It's known as the house Alvan Adams built and Wayman Tisdale filled. It's also where Billy Tubbs resurrected Oklahoma basketball, where Blake Griffin flew high and where Buddy Hield became Buddy Buckets. Now, Lon Kruger is continuing the remarkable run of Sooner success inside the Lloyd Noble Center.

- ▶ Oklahoma has gone 55-7 (.887) at home in the past five years, including 29-2 (.935) in the last three seasons. Overall, the Sooners are 66-12 (.846) at the LNC in the Kruger era.
- ▶ The Sooners have won 434 of their last 500 home encounters, good for a remarkable .868 winning percentage. Included in the stretch was a school-record 51-game winning streak (ended in 1990-91). The Sooners also recorded a Big 12 Conference-record 37-game home court winning streak (ended in 2003).
- ▶ OU is 13-6 at home against AP Top 25 opponents in the Kruger era and has won 12 of the last 14 such contests.
- ▶ Oklahoma has won 123 of its last 128 non-conference games at LNC, including 57 of its last 59. The Sooners are 31-2 at home against non-conference opponents under Kruger.
- ▶ Overall, the Sooners own a 529-93 (.850) record in the LNC since the building opened in 1975.
- ▶ Student interest in OU basketball has continued to grow through Kruger's tenure. Student attendance has increased by more than 100 percent from Kruger's first season (2011-12). This year, OU student season tickets sold out in less than 24 hours the fastest rate in the OU era.

IT'S NOT WHERE YOU START...

For the first time since 2013, the Sooners will start the season unranked in both the AP and Coaches preseason polls. Oklahoma was also voted sixth in the Big 12 Conference's preseason poll – it's lowest preseason projection since 2012. Despite the preseason rankings, OU looks to continue an upward trend of surpassing expectations under Kruger.

- ▶ Oklahoma has finished as well or better than predicted in four of the five seasons under Kruger. In the only exception (2015-16), the Sooners were picked to finish second in the Big 12. While OU ended the 2015-16 regular season with the third best record in the Big 12, the Sooners advanced to the 2016 Final Four the deepest NCAA Tournament run by a Big 12 team that season.
- ▶ The Sooners have also finished the past three seasons with a better ranking in the final AP and Coaches Polls compared to where each poll had pegged them at the start of the year.
- ▶ Prior to the 2016 AP preseason poll, the Sooners had received a Top-25 ranking for 36 consecutive

SOONER TIP-INS

- ▶ Oklahoma's starting lineup in the first four games included freshman forward **Kristian Doolittle**, the first freshman to start for the Sooners since **Jordan Woodard** in the 2013-14 season. Doolittle finished his debut with five points and three rebounds in 19 minutes. Doolittle and Woodard played together for one season at Edmond Memorial High School (Edmond, Okla.), winning the Oklahoma 6A title. The duo is the first pair of former high school teammates to start in a game for the Sooners since **Blake and Taylor Griffin** (Oklahoma Christian School in Edmond, Okla.) in 2008-09.
- Sooner forward **Khadeem Lattin** received an off-the-court honor by being named to the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee. One of two student-athletes on the 16-person committee, Lattin will serve as a non-voting member in a two-year term that begins immediately. The Men's Basketball Oversight Committee ensures that appropriate oversight of men's basketball is maintained, enhances the development and public perception of the sport and make recommendations related to regular-season and postseason men's basketball. The committee is tasked with prioritizing enhancement of the student-athlete educational experience (academically and athletically), and in doing so, promote student-athletes' personal growth and leadership development.

KRUGER'S SOONER TURNAROUND

- ▶ Kruger has been leaving his trademark rebuilding stamp on college basketball programs throughout his career. He is the only Division I coach to ever take five different schools to the NCAA Tournament. In 2015 he became the first coach since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985 to take four programs to the Sweet 16 or beyond.
- ▶ After inheriting a program that went 27-36 (.429) in the two seasons prior to his arrival. Kruger has coached the Sooners to a 114-58 (.663) record in six seasons. Over the last four full campaigns, OU posted a 96-41 (.701) mark and advanced to the NCAA Tournament each season, capped by a trip to the 2016 Final Four in Houston. The Sooners had previously not been to the postseason since 2009 when they advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- ▶ With a career college coaching record of 593-362 (.621). Kruger owns the 10th most wins among active Division I coaches. He owns a 20-17 record in NCAA Tournament games and has compiled 16 20-plus-win seasons, including nine in the last 10 years. His collegiate teams have made postseason appearances in 21 of the last 26 years.
- ▶ Under Kruger, Sooner players have earned First-Team All-Big 12 selections on three occasions and racked up 14 Academic All-Big 12 honors. Buddy Hield, who played four seasons for Kruger (2012-16), was named the winner of the 2016 Wooden Award, Naismith Trophy and the Oscar Robertson Trophy as the national player of the year (first consensus player of the year for OU since Blake Griffin in 2009).
- ▶ Three Sooners have been drafted into the NBA during Kruger's tenure. Buddy Hield was selected as the sixth overall pick in the 2016 NBA Draft while Isaiah Cousins (2016) and Romero Osby (2013) were chosen in the second round of their respected drafts.
