CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

Big 12 men's basketball teams have posted a 48-9 record to open the 2016-17 campaign. Six of the losses were by single digits, including two in overtime.

Big 12 teams boast a .842 winning percentage so far this season - the best record of any conference in the nation.

A total of 90 percent of the teams in the Big 12 have one loss or less - the best mark of any conference.

The nine combined losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 15 (Big East).

The Big 12 as a whole has won 84 of its last 104 and 97 of its last 120 non-conference contests overall.

Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .608 mark.

For the first time in Big 12 history, the league beat two top five non-conference opponents on the same day. Kansas topped No. 1 Duke and Baylor defeated No. 4 Oregon on November 15.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

This upcoming week will feature two standout basketball players. Nathan Adrian from West Virginia has dedicated his life to two things, his education and West Virginia basketball. Being the first player in over 50 years from Morgantown to earn a scholarship playing for the home team is something he takes tremendous pride in, almost as much pride as his achievement of graduating in three years and pursuing and currently pursuing his masters. Jamie Carey of Texas always knew her life would center around basketball, but when injury ended her career earlier than anticipated, Jamie focused on her education and knew she would eventually be lead back to her first passion. **BAYLOR (6-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Baylor improved to 3-0 this season versus nationally-ranked teams with the win over No. 10 Louisville. The Bears have posted a 15-14 record against Associated Press top 25 foes since the start of the 2014-15 campaign.
- ✎ BU faced a halftime deficit in all three games at the Battle 4 Atlantis before rallying to win each contest. The Bears held all three opponents to 27 or fewer second half points while scoring at least 42 points after halftime each time.
- ✎ Junior forward Johnathan Motley has scored in double figures in all five outings this year and averaged 20.0 points and 7.3 rebounds in the Battle 4 Atlantis. He has 30 career double-digit scoring efforts and Baylor is 24-6 in those games.

**IOWA STATE (5-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Senior guard Deonte Burton scored a career-high 29 points in the loss to Gonzaga, his fifth career 20-point outing. He averaged 20.0 points and 8.7 rebounds in three games at the Advocare Invitational, shooting 45.5 percent from the field.
- ✎ Iowa State is 25-3 under head coach Steve Prohm when leading at halftime, including 11 consecutive victories. The Cyclones are also 16-0 in the Prohm era when holding their opponent to under 70 points.
- ✎ Iowa State has won 37 consecutive non-conference games at home, tied for the second-best active streak in the nation. ISU will host Cincinnati in Ames for the first time, with the previous five meetings being at road or neutral sites.

**KANSAS (5-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Senior guard Frank Mason III has led KU in scoring in five of six outings this season, including 21 points on 8-of-10 shooting in the win over UNC Asheville. He has recorded four of his eight career 20-point games this season.
- ✎ Freshman Josh Jackson was named the Most Valuable Player of the CBE Classic after averaging 18.5 points and 9.0 rebounds in the two wins. He leads the Jayhawks in rebounding (5.8 rpg) and has scored in double digits in five straight contests.
- ✎ Kansas has won 45 consecutive home games, the longest active streak in the nation. The Jayhawks are 208-9 (.959) at Allen Fieldhouse under head coach Bill Self - the most victories by any KU mentor in the venue in program history.

**KANSAS STATE (5-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Senior forward D.J. Johnson finished with a career-high 26 points on 10-of-18 shooting against Maryland. It was his third career 20-point effort, with all three performances coming in the past 11 contests dating back to last season.
- ✎ Senior guard Wesley Iwundu has scored 14 points or more in four of the six outings this season and is shooting 49.1 percent on the year. He has also dished out multiple assists in every outing.
- ✎ Kansas State has won 11 consecutive outings at home over non-conference opposition and is 82-5 (.943) in non-conference play at Bramlage Coliseum dating back to the 2006-07 campaign.

**OKLAHOMA (4-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Senior guard Jordan Woodard led Oklahoma in scoring for the fourth straight game with 16 points in the win over Abilene Christian. He has 13 steals in the past four outings and has dished out nine assists in his last two contests.
- ✎ Sophomore guard Rashard Odomes has scored in double digits three times in his last four games. He is shooting 53.3 percent from the field during that span while making 6-of-8 from the free throw line over the last three outings.
- ✎ Oklahoma claimed third place in the Tire Pros Invitational with the victory over Clemson. The Sooners have finished third or better in all six in-season events under Lon Kruger, posting a 14-5 tournament record during that time.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (5-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Oklahoma State tied the school record for steals with 19 against Georgetown. The Cowboys had 46 in three contests at the Maui Invitational and have notched double-digit theft totals in four of six outings in 2016-17.
- ✎ Sophomore guard Jawun Evans was named to the Maui Invitational All-Tournament team after averaging 26.0 points, 4.3 assists and 2.7 steals. He has scored 30 points or more three times this year and has shot 52.0 percent or better four times.
- ✎ Senior guard Phil Forte has connected on 258 career 3-pointers, which ranks third in OSU history. He has 1,399 points in his career and needs 41 field goals from beyond the arc to match the school record.

**TCU (6-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Junior guard Alex Robinson finished with a career-best 24 points in the win over Washington. He has scored in double digits four times in 2016-17 and has recorded at least three assists in every contest.
- ✎ Head coach Jamie Dixon is 76-6 (.927) in the month of November during his career. He is the first coach in TCU history to open his debut campaign with a 5-0 record - the ninth time overall in school history the Frogs have started at least 5-0.
- ✎ Junior Kenrich Williams grabbed a career-high 18 rebounds in the victory over UNLV, the most by any Big 12 player this season. He has grabbed 35 boards over the past three games and leads the Horned Frogs in boards (9.3 rpg).

**TEXAS (3-2, 0-0)**

- ✎ Sophomore guard Kerwin Roach Jr. has scored in double digits in three of four outings this season and 12 times in his career. He has increased his minutes in every outing this year, matching his career-best in minutes with 30 versus Colorado.
- ✎ Sophomore Tevin Mack has scored 14 points or more in three of his four outings in 2016-17. He leads the Longhorns in scoring with 13.5 points per game and 3-pointers, connecting on 12-of-26 (.462) from beyond the arc.
- ✎ Senior forward Shaquille Cleare recorded a career-high 32 minutes against the Buffaloes. He has logged 22 minutes or better in two of five contests after having reached that mark only three times all of last season.

**TEXAS TECH (5-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Junior guard Keenan Evans led five Red Raiders in double figures with 16 points in the victory over Idaho State. He has scored in double digits four times in 2016-17 and has 11 assists with just two turnovers in his past two outings.
- ✎ Junior forward Zach Smith was named to the Cancun Challenge All-Tournament Team after posting 31 points with 15 rebounds in two games at the event. He has shot 62.5 percent or better in all but one contest this season.
- ✎ Texas Tech has won 23 straight non-conference home games dating back to the 2013-14 season. The Red Raiders have outscored opponents by 19 points or more in their five victories and have outscored all six foes by double digits in the second half.

**WEST VIRGINIA (4-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Sophomore Esa Ahmad finished with a career-high 19 points on 8-of-13 shooting in the loss to Temple. He also grabbed six rebounds with three assists and is shooting 55.6 percent over the last three outings.
- ✎ Senior forward Nathan Adrian is the only Mountaineer that has scored in double figures in all five games this season. He leads West Virginia in both scoring and rebounding and is shooting 44.0 percent on the year.
- ✎ The Mountaineers have won 51 of 55 non-conference games at home under head coach Bob Huggins. He needs just five victories overall to record the 800th win of his 35-year career.
