CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Big I2 men's basketball teams have posted a 56-II record to begin the 20I6-I7 campaign. Seven of the losses were by single digits, including three in overtime.
- Big I2 teams boast a .836 winning percentage so far this season the best record of any conference in the nation.
- A total of 80 percent of the teams in the Big I2 have one loss or less the best mark of any conference.
- The II combined losses by the Big I2 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has I6 (Big East).
- The Big I2 as a whole has won 92 of its last II4 and IO5 of its last I30 nonconference contests overall.
- Big I2 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .609 mark.
- For the first time in Big I2 history, the league beat two top five nonconference opponents on the same day. Kansas topped No. I Duke and Baylor defeated No. 4 Oregon on November I5.


CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

BAYLOR (7-0, 0-0)

- Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. matched his career high with 14 rebounds versus Sam Houston State. He has at least seven boards in five games this season and leads the Big I2 with 29 blocks - more than double the next-closest player.
- The Bears have I32 wins overall since 20II-I2, a total that is the second-highest in the Big I2 (Kansas, I52). BU is I63-62 (.724) overall at home under head coach Scott Drew, with I2 or more home victories each season.



IOWA STATE (5-2, 0-0)

Senior guard Monte Morris led Iowa State with 15 points against Cincinnati, his 71st career game in double figures. He also notched his 592nd career assist, moving into a tie for fourth on the all-time school list (Jacy Holloway).

- ISU's 54 points versus the Bearcats were its fewest since Jan. 23, 2013 (51 at Texas Tech), fewest in Hilton Coliseum since Feb. 21, 2009 (46 vs. Kansas State), and fewest in an overtime game since Jan. 22, 2005 (52 vs. Colorado).
- Iowa State is 25-3 under head coach Steve Prohm when leading at halftime, including II consecutive victories. The Cyclones are also I6-I in the Prohm era when holding their opponent to under 70 points.



KANSAS (6-1, 0-0)

- Kansas recorded its fifth win in the last I2 days with the victory over Long Beach State. The Jayhawks have posted back-to-back 30-point wins and have four double-digit victories in a row.
- Sophomore guard Lagerald Vick was 9-for-9 from the floor versus LBSU, tying for the most field goals without a miss by a player in the Bill Self era. He is 15-of-16 (.938) over his last two outings with II rebounds.
- XX Kansas has won 45 consecutive home games, the longest active streak in the nation. The Jayhawks are 209-9 (.959) at Allen Fieldhouse under head coach Bill Self - the most victories by any KU mentor in the venue in program history.



- Sophomore guard Barry Brown led K-State with 18 points on 7-of-II shooting in the win over Green Bay. He has scored in double digits in every outing and is shooting 52.0 percent for the year.
- Kansas State has eclipsed the 80-point mark four times this season and is shooting nearly 50 percent (.494) from the field. The Wildcats have dished out double-figure assists in every contest and outrebounded all but one opponent.
- The 'Cats have won I2 consecutive outings at home over non-conference opposition and are 83-5 (.943) in non-conference play at Bramlage Coliseum dating back to the 2006-07 campaign.



OKLAHOMA (5-1, 0-0)

- Freshman forward Kristian Doolittle scored a career-best 17 points on 7-of-8 shooting in the win over Northern Colorado. He has grabbed at least five rebounds in five consecutive outings.
- Senior guard Jordan Woodard had I4 points, nine rebounds and seven assists versus the Bears, the second time in his career he has reached those all three marks in one game. He has scored in double digits in every contest this year.
- Oklahoma has started 5-I or better in five of six campaigns under head coach Lon Kruger. The Sooners have won 59 of their last 61 non-conference games at Lloyd Noble Center and are 62-15 (.805) overall versus non-league foes under Kruger.



- Sophomore guard Jawun Evans led OSU with 25 points and five steals in the win over Rogers State. He has at least 13 points in every game this year and leads the conference in scoring with 24.7 points per game, a mark that is third nationally.
- in 2016-17. The Cowboys have recorded a Big 12-best 98.9 points per game, an average that ranks second in the nation.
- Senior guard Phil Forte became the 17th player in Oklahoma State history to score I,400 career points with IO points versus Rogers State. He has 260 career 3-pointers, just 39 behind the all-time school leader (Keiton Page).



TCU TCU (7-0, 0-0)

- TCU forced a season-high 25 turnovers and came back from a 22-5 deficit in the first half with an 18-0 run against Washington. The Horned Frogs have forced double-digit miscues in every game, including 21 or more on three occasions.
- Junior guard Alex Robinson led TCU with I6 points, seven assists and just two turnovers off the bench. He has scored in double digits five times in 2016-17 and has recorded at least three assists in every contest.
- Head coach Jamie Dixon is 77-6 (.928) in the month of November during his career and the Frogs improved to 45-16 (.738) since 2008 during that month. Dixon is the first coach in TCU history to open his debut campaign with a 7-0 record.



- Sophomore Tevin Mack led UT with 19 points on 8-of-14 shooting and seven rebounds versus UT Arlington. He has scored I4 points or more in four of his five outings in 2016-17 and leads the Longhorns in scoring with 14.6 points per game.
- Freshman forward Jarrett Allen posted his second career double-double with I3 points and I2 boards against the Mavericks. He has 28 points and I8 rebounds in his last two outings while shooting 52.6 percent from the floor.
- Sophomore guard Kerwin Roach Jr. has reached double digits in scoring four times this year and on I3 occasions in his career. He has increased his minutes in every contest this season and ranks second on the team in scoring (I2.2 ppg).



TEXAS TECH (6-1, 0-0)

- Junior forward Justin Gray has 25 points and nine rebounds over his last two outings while shooting 71.4 percent (10-of-14) from the floor. He is shooting 60.4 percent for the season, one of six Tech players connecting at 53 percent or better.
- Junior forward Zach Smith has scored IO or more points in four consecutive games, the second-longest double-digit scoring streak of his career. He has shot 62.5 percent or better in all but one contest this season.
- Texas Tech has won 24 straight non-conference home games dating back to the 2013-14 season. The Red Raiders have outscored opponents by 20 points or more in five of their six victories this season.



WEST VIRGINIA (5-1, 0-0)

- Sophomore Esa Ahmad made all seven of his field goal attempts and finished with 19 points for the second consecutive game in the win over Manhattan. He has shot 50 percent or better in four straight outings, including .750 over the past two contests.
- West Virginia forced a school record 40 turnovers against the Jaspers. Every Mountaineer opponent has had at least 19 miscues this year, including two with more than 30. WVU has I5 or more steals four times in 2016-17.
- The Mountaineers have won 52 of 56 non-conference games at home under head coach Bob Huggins. He needs just four victories overall to record the 800th win of his 35-year career.

Postseason Awards
