CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

Big 12 men's basketball teams have posted a 56-11 record to begin the 2016-17 campaign. Seven of the losses were by single digits, including three in overtime.

Big 12 teams boast a .836 winning percentage so far this season - the best record of any conference in the nation.

A total of 80 percent of the teams in the Big 12 have one loss or less - the best mark of any conference.

The 11 combined losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 16 (Big East).

The Big 12 as a whole has won 92 of its last 114 and 105 of its last 130 non-conference contests overall.

Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .609 mark.

For the first time in Big 12 history, the league beat two top five non-conference opponents on the same day. Kansas topped No. 1 Duke and Baylor defeated No. 4 Oregon on November 15.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

This upcoming week will feature two standout basketball players. Nathan Adrian from West Virginia has dedicated his life to two things, his education and West Virginia basketball. Being the first player in over 50 years from Morgantown to earn a scholarship playing for the home team is something he takes tremendous pride in, almost as much pride as his achievement of graduating in three years and currently pursuing his masters. Jamie Carey of Texas always knew her life would center around basketball, but when injury ended her career earlier than anticipated, Jamie focused on her education and knew she would eventually be lead back to her first passion. BAYLOR (7-0, 0-0)

- ✎ Baylor has started a season 7-0 for the first time since 2011-12 and is one of 17 remaining unbeaten Division I squads. The Bears have won 38 consecutive non-conference home games dating back to Dec. 12, 2012.
- ✎ Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. matched his career high with 14 rebounds versus Sam Houston State. He has at least seven boards in five games this season and leads the Big 12 with 29 blocks - more than double the next-closest player.
- ✎ The Bears have 132 wins overall since 2011-12, a total that is the second-highest in the Big 12 (Kansas, 152). BU is 163-62 (.724) overall at home under head coach Scott Drew, with 12 or more home victories each season.


KANSAS (8-1, 0-0)

- ✎ Kansas recorded its fifth win in the last 12 days with the victory over Long Beach State. The Jayhawks have posted back-to-back 30-point wins and have four double-digit victories in a row.
- ✎ Sophomore guard Lagerald Vick was 9-for-9 from the floor versus LBSU, tying for the most field goals without a miss by a player in the Bill Self era. He is 15-of-16 (.938) over his last two outings with 11 rebounds.
- ✎ Kansas has won 45 consecutive home games, the longest active streak in the nation. The Jayhawks are 209-9 (.959) at Allen Fieldhouse under head coach Bill Self - the most victories by any KU mentor in the venue in program history.


OKLAHOMA (5-1, 0-0)

- ✎ Freshman forward Kristian Doolittle scored a career-best 17 points on 7-of-8 shooting in the win over Northern Colorado. He has grabbed at least five rebounds in five consecutive outings.
- ✎ Senior guard Jordan Woodard had 14 points, nine rebounds and seven assists versus the Bears, the second time in his career he has reached those all three marks in one game. He has scored in double digits in every contest this year.
- ✎ Oklahoma has started 5-1 or better in five of six campaigns under head coach Lon Kruger. The Sooners have won 59 of their last 61 non-conference games at Lloyd Noble Center and are 62-15 (.805) overall versus non-league foes under Kruger.


TCU (7-0, 0-0)

- ✎ TCU forced a season-high 25 turnovers and came back from a 22-5 deficit in the first half with an 18-0 run against Washington. The Horned Frogs have forced double-digit miscues in every game, including 21 or more on three occasions.
- ✎ Junior guard Alex Robinson led TCU with 16 points, seven assists and just two turnovers off the bench. He has scored in double digits five times in 2016-17 and has recorded at least three assists in every contest.
- ✎ Head coach Jamie Dixon is 77-6 (.928) in the month of November during his career and the Frogs improved to 45-16 (.738) since 2008 during that month. Dixon is the first coach in TCU history to open his debut campaign with a 7-0 record.


TEXAS TECH (8-1, 0-0)

- ✎ Junior forward Justin Gray has 25 points and nine rebounds over his last two outings while shooting 71.4 percent (10-of-14) from the floor. He is shooting 60.4 percent for the season, one of six Tech players connecting at 53 percent or better.
- ✎ Junior forward Zach Smith has scored 10 or more points in four consecutive games, the second-longest double-digit scoring streak of his career. He has shot 62.5 percent or better in all but one contest this season.
- ✎ Texas Tech has won 24 straight non-conference home games dating back to the 2013-14 season. The Red Raiders have outscored opponents by 20 points or more in five of their six victories this season.


IOWA STATE (5-2, 0-0)

- ✎ Senior guard Monte Morris led Iowa State with 15 points against Cincinnati, his 71st career game in double figures. He also notched his 592nd career assist, moving into a tie for fourth on the all-time school list (Jacy Holloway).
- ✎ ISU's 54 points versus the Bearcats were its fewest since Jan. 23, 2013 (51 at Texas Tech), fewest in Hilton Coliseum since Feb. 21, 2009 (46 vs. Kansas State), and fewest in an overtime game since Jan. 22, 2005 (52 vs. Colorado).
- ✎ Iowa State is 25-3 under head coach Steve Prohm when leading at halftime, including 11 consecutive victories. The Cyclones are also 16-1 in the Prohm era when holding their opponent to under 70 points.


KANSAS STATE (6-1, 0-0)

- ✎ Sophomore guard Barry Brown led K-State with 18 points on 7-of-11 shooting in the win over Green Bay. He has scored in double digits in every outing and is shooting 52.0 percent for the year.
- ✎ Kansas State has eclipsed the 80-point mark four times this season and is shooting nearly 50 percent (.494) from the field. The Wildcats have dished out double-figure assists in every contest and outrebounded all but one opponent.
- ✎ The 'Cats have won 12 consecutive outings at home over non-conference opposition and are 83-5 (.943) in non-conference play at Bramlage Coliseum dating back to the 2006-07 campaign.


OKLAHOMA STATE (6-1, 0-0)

- ✎ Sophomore guard Jawun Evans led OSU with 25 points and five steals in the win over Rogers State. He has at least 13 points in every game this year and leads the conference in scoring with 24.7 points per game, a mark that is third nationally.
- ✎ Oklahoma State has reached the 100-point plateau in all four of its home games in 2016-17. The Cowboys have recorded a Big 12-best 98.9 points per game, an average that ranks second in the nation.
- ✎ Senior guard Phil Forte became the 17th player in Oklahoma State history to score 1,400 career points with 10 points versus Rogers State. He has 260 career 3-pointers, just 39 behind the all-time school leader (Keiton Page).


TEXAS (3-3, 0-0)

- ✎ Sophomore Tevin Mack led UT with 19 points on 8-of-14 shooting and seven rebounds versus UT Arlington. He has scored 14 points or more in four of his five outings in 2016-17 and leads the Longhorns in scoring with 14.6 points per game.
- ✎ Freshman forward Jarrett Allen posted his second career double-double with 13 points and 12 boards against the Mavericks. He has 28 points and 18 rebounds in his last two outings while shooting 52.6 percent from the floor.
- ✎ Sophomore guard Kerwin Roach Jr. has reached double digits in scoring four times this year and on 13 occasions in his career. He has increased his minutes in every contest this season and ranks second on the team in scoring (12.2 ppg).


WEST VIRGINIA (5-1, 0-0)

- ✎ Sophomore Esa Ahmad made all seven of his field goal attempts and finished with 19 points for the second consecutive game in the win over Manhattan. He has shot 50 percent or better in four straight outings, including .750 over the past two contests.
- ✎ West Virginia forced a school record 40 turnovers against the Jaspers. Every Mountaineer opponent has had at least 19 miscues this year, including two with more than 30. WVU has 15 or more steals four times in 2016-17.
- ✎ The Mountaineers have won 52 of 56 non-conference games at home under head coach Bob Huggins. He needs just four victories overall to record the 800th win of his 35-year career.
