WISCONSIN VS. OKLAHOMA: ROUND THREE

- For the third-consecutive season, Wisconsin and Oklahoma will meet in the non-conference season, but this time OU comes to Madison. The Badgers and Sooners split games in 2014 (Bahamas) and 2015 (Norman, Okla.), and round three on Dec. 3 will tip at Noon on BTN.
- Up next, the Badgers wrap up a four-game homestand against Idaho State on Wednesday, Dec. 7. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m. on ESPN3.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT WISCONSIN

■ QUITE A DEBUT: Wisconsin is in its first full season under Greg Gard, who coached the final 23 games last season after the Dec. 15, 2015 retirement of Bo Ryan. Gard led the Badgers to wins in 11 of the final 13 regular-season games and a trip to the 2016 Sweet 16, winning the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award.



An All-Maui Invitational selection, Ethan Happ is averaging 16.8 ppg and 10.6 rpg over the last 5

- GANG'S ALL HERE: UW returns each of the top 9 scorers from last season. In fact, the Badgers bring back all but 20 minutes played (99.8%) and all but 6 points (99.7%).
- TERRIFIC TRIO: Senior Nigel Hayes was named Big Ten Preseason Player of the Year, as well as a consensus member of the Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Fellow senior Bronson Koenig and sophomore **Ethan Happ** were also selected for the Preseason All-Big Ten team.
- **GETTING DEFENSIVE:** Wisconsin has held 7 of their 8 opponents to season-low point totals. According to KenPom.com, the Badgers rank 10th in the NCAA in adjusted defensive efficiency.
- **OWNING THE GLASS:** The Badgers are 4th in the nation with a +14.6 rebounding margin and rank 5th in the NCAA in both defensive (79.5%) and offensive (41.2%) rebounding percentage.
- MAKING IT HAPP-EN: Ethan Happ posted 24 points (10-12 FGs) and 13 rebounds vs. Syracuse (11/29) and now ranks 2nd in the B1G in rpg (9.9), 1st in offensive boards (3.6 per game), 3rd in FG% (.687) and 3rd in steals (1.8 spg).
- HANDY HAYES: The NCAA's only active player with 1,400 points, 600 rebounds and 200 assists, Nigel Hayes showed off his versatility vs. Syracuse (11/29) coming one point shy of the 2nd tripledouble in school history (9 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists).
- KOENIG KOUNTER: Matching a career-high six 3-pointers vs. Syracuse, UW's leading scorer Bronson Koenig is now 7th on UW's all-time list for made triples (187 3FGs).
- PROTECT THIS HOUSE: The Badgers have won 10 in a row at home. UW's .871 all-time win percentage (263-39) at the Kohl Center ranks 5th among all active arenas in the NCAA.



#17 UW 77, #22 SYRACUSE 60

Nov. 29, 2016 | Madison, Wis.

- Wisconsin led for all but 1:09 on its way to a 77-60 win over No. 22 Syracuse in the 2016 Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- UW improved to 9-9 all-time in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, equaling Minnesota and Purdue for the most Challenge wins among Big Ten teams.
- The Badgers shot a season-high 47.8% (11-23) from 3-point range and held the Orange to just 38.2% shooting overall and 26.1% from deep.
- Wisconsin out-rebounded Syracuse by a margin of 40-25, including 25-9 in the second half. The Badgers also owned a 14-7 edge on the offensive glass turning into an 18-8 advantage in second-chance points.
- The Badgers dished out a season-high 21 assists on 29 made field goals.
- Senior Nigel Hayes distributed a career-high 10 assists, making him the first Badger to post a double-figure assist total since Jordan Taylor had 10 vs. Green Bay on Dec. 7, 2011.
- Hayes finished with 11 rebounds to go with his 10 assists, his second double-double of the season and the ninth of his career. It's the second rebounds/assists double-double in Badgers history (Josh Gasser had 12 rebounds and 10 assists as part of UW's only triple-double on Jan. 23, 2011).
- Senior Bronson Koenig matched his career high with six 3-pointers (6-9 3FGs), finishing with 20 points.
- Sophomore Ethan Happ tallied his third double-double of the season and the 13th of his career with a season-high 24 points and 13 rebounds.

NON-CON SUCCESS

- UW has won 42 of its last 51 (.824) regularseason, non-conference games dating back to
- Since 2001-02, UW is 157-38 (.805) in nonconference games, including a mark of 114-11 (.912) at the Kohl Center.
- Over the last 15 seasons, the Badgers have gone 21-19 (.525) in non-conference road games. That includes wins in 6 of last 8 true road games.
- Since 2003-04, Wisconsin is 97-5 (.951) at home vs. unranked non-con opponents, with 3 such setbacks last season.
- Last season, Wisconsin dropped 5 nonconference games for just the 2nd time since 1997-98 and the first time since starting the 2001-02 season with a record of 7-6 in Bo Ryan's first season in Madison.

ALL-TIME VS. OKLAHOMA

Saturday's game will mark the 9th all-time meeting between Wisconsin and Oklahoma with the overall series tied at 4 wins apiece. The Badgers and Sooners are facing off for the third-consecutive season, having split a pair of matchups in 2014 and 2015.

- Wisconsin claimed a 69-56 win over OU in the championship game of the 2014 Battle 4 Atlantis in the Bahamas, but the Sooners claimed a 65-48 win a year ago in Norman, Oklahoma. The Sooners haven't visited Madison since 1953.
- Senior Nigel Hayes has averaged 15.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in 2 meetings with Oklahoma, including a 20-point, 11-rebound effort last season.



- Wisconsin hit its first shot of the game, taking a 3-0 lead on a Nigel Hayes 3-pointer, but No. 7 Oklahoma would answer with a 15-0 run and pull away for a 65-48 win in Norman, Okla.
- ▶ UW shot just 23.5% (16-for-68), the Badgers' lowest FG% since 2006. UW also hit just 7-of-33 (21.2%) from 3-point range. OU finished 42.6% from the field.
- ► The Badgers out-rebounded Oklahoma 46-44, including a 21-12 margin on the offensive glass. But the Sooners owned a 34-10 scoring edge in the paint.

UW FINISHES SECOND IN MAUI

Making their 3rd all-time appearance in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational, the Badgers advanced to their first-ever championship game, claiming runner-up.



Ethan Happ earned All-Tournament honors after averaging 16.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg, 2.0 apg, 1.3 bpg and 2.7 spg.

#16 UW 74, TENN 62 | Nov. 21 | Opening Rd.

- ▶ Wisconsin defeated Tennessee, 72-62, in the opening round on Monday. **Bronson Koenig** (21), **Nigel Hayes** (17) and **Ethan Happ** (16) combined for 54 points, as UW shot a season-high 56.3% from the field.
- ▶ UW jumped to a 12-0 lead to open the game, but the Vols took a 2-point lead early in the 2nd half. The Badgers responded with a 12-2 run midway through the 2nd half to seize control.

#16 UW 73, GTOWN 57 | Nov. 22 | Semifinals

- ► Ethan Happ had 19 points and 15 rebounds, Bronson Koenig scored 20 points and No. 16 Wisconsin overwhelmed Georgetown, 73-57.
- ▶ Wisconsin out-rebounded the Hoyas by a 50-21 margin, including 20-1 on the offensive glass. The +29 rebounding edge is the Badgers' largest margin since owning a +35 advantage against Prairie View A&M (11/14/10).
- ▶ UW owned a 19-1 edge in second-chance points and a dominant 38-16 advantage scoring in the paint. Both were season highs.

#4 UNC 56, #16 UW 56 | Nov. 23 | Championship

- ▶ Wisconsin missed its first 11 shots and fell behind 8-0 and never recovered in a 71-56 loss to North Carolina. Senior **Vitto Brown** led UW with 15 points (4-5 3FGs), while **Ethan Happ** added 13 points.
- ▶ UW shot just 38.2% and was out-rebounded for the first time this season, 38-26. The Tar Heels also dominated the paint, scoring 36 points compared to just 16 for the Badgers.

WRECKING THE RANKED

- ► Since Greg Gard joined the UW staff in 2001 under Bo Ryan, the Badgers are 38-15 (.717) against the AP Top-25 at the Kohl Center.
- ► The Badgers are 1-2 against the AP Top-25 overall this season and have gone 21-12 against the AP Top-25 over the last 4 seasons.
- ► Under Greg Gard, UW is 6-6 against ranked teams. Here are a look at Gard's "Big Wins":

GETTING DEFENSIVE

► The Badgers have held 7 of their 8 opponents to their (at the time) lowest point total of the season.

On average, Wisconsin is holding opponents to just 75.1% of their scoring average. Badgers opponents are averaging 79.4 ppg overall this season, but just 59.6 when facing Wisconsin.

- ► UW's scoring defense (59.6 ppg) ranks 2nd in the Big Ten and 18th in the NCAA.
- ▶ UW ranks 10th in Ken Pomeroy's Adjusted Defensive Efficiency, averaging 91.0 points per 100 possessions.

The Badgers also rank 12th in Offensive Efficiency, becoming one of just 6 teams to rank among the top 15 in both offense and defense.

- ▶ Wisconsin has been closing out defensive possessions with the best in the country. UW leads the Big Ten and ranks 5th in the NCAA in defensive rebounding percentage, grabbing 79.5% of opponent missed shots. The Badgers are allowing an average of just 6.1 second-chance points per game.
- ▶ UW has led the Big Ten in scoring defense in 10 of the past 14 seasons and finished among the nation's top 10 in 9 of the past 14 years. Last year, the Badgers allowed 63.9 points per game, the top mark in the Big Ten and 18th nationally.

► The Badgers have out-rebounded 7 of their 8 opponents this season and own an impressive +14.6 average rebounding margin (41.0 to 26.4), which ranks 2nd in the Big Ten and 4th in the nation (Indiana +15.7).

- ▶ Wisconsin ranks 5th in the NCAA in both offensive and defensive rebounding percentage.
 - OFF REBOUNDING: UW is rebounding 41.2% of its missed shots (107 of 245)
 - DEF. REBOUNDING: UW is rebounding 79.5% of opponent missed shots
- ▶ UW has had a commanding advantage on the offensive glass, grabbing 107 offensive boards compared to just 57 for its opponents. UW's 13.4 offensive rpg is 3rd in the Big Ten.
- ► The Badgers have out-scored opponents 104 to 49 on second-chance points this season. UW is averaging 13.0 second-chance points per game whlie surrendering just 6.1 per game.
- ▶ Individually, **Ethan Happ** is 2nd in the Big Ten with 9.9 rebounds per game and leads the B1G with 29 offensive boards (3.6 per game). Nigel Hayes is 19th in the conference at 6.1 rpg.

WHAT'S TRENDING

▶ UW is 6-0 when shooting at least 42.0% from the field this season. The Badgers are 18-2 under Gard when shooting at least 42.0%.

Conversely, the Badgers are 6-0 when limiting opponents below 45.0% shooting this season. The Badgers are also 18-2 under Gard when keeping foes below 45.0% from the field.

- ▶ UW is averaging 19.4 ppg from its bench, with 4 reserves averaging double-digit minutes and another at 9.0 mpg. In fact, the Badgers' roster features 10 players who have recorded a double-digit scoring game.
- ▶ Wisconsin is 93-for-135 (.689) from the free throw line through 8 games, an average of 16.9 FTAs per game. Last season, the Badgers led the Big Ten with 20.8 FTAs per game. **Nigel Hayes** led the Big Ten in FTAs (258) and was second in made FTs (190).
- ► The Badgers are committing an average of 15.1 fouls per game, 8th-fewest in the NCAA.
- ▶ UW is 6-0 this season when leading or tied with 5:00 remaining continuing a Mariano Rivera-like string of closing games. Dating back to February of 2011, UW is 143-5 (.966) when leading or tied with 5:00 left, including a mark of 21-1 last season.

KINGS OF THE ROAD

UW is renowned for its incredible home success, but it has been almost as good on the road lately.

- ▶ Wisconsin is 48-18 (.727) away from home over the last 4 seasons. Last season, the Badgers went 9-8 away from the Kohl Center, going 6-5 in true road games and 3-3 in neutral settings.
- ▶ In 2015-16, Wisconsin posted 3 road wins over ranked opponents for the first time in school history. UW and Kansas (3) were the nation's only schools with at least 3 ranked road wins.

Last season also marked the first time the Badgers had multiple top-10 road wins since 1955.

Among major conference teams, UW ranks 3rd in both wins and win percentage away from home over the last 4 seasons.

KLUTCH KOENIG

A preseason All-Big Ten pick, senior **Bronson Koenig** earned the nickname "Klutch Koenig" a year ago with his late-game heroics and has been a steady force in the Wisconsin backcourt his entire career.

- ► Koenig leads Wisconsin with 15.1 ppg. He scored at least 20 points 4 times this season. He entered the year with 4 career games with 20+ points.
- ▶ Against Syracuse (11/29), Koenig matched his career high with six 3-pointers, finishing with 20 points (6-9 3FGs) in 27 minutes.
- ▶ With 21 points against Tennessee (11/21), the La Crosse, Wis., native surpassed the 1,000-point milestone, becoming Wisconsin's 43rd member of the century club. He currently ranks 40th on UW's all-time scoring chart with 1,058 points.
- ▶ Koenig hit the game-winning 3-pointer to beat Xavier and advance to the Sweet 16 of the 2016 NCAA Tournament (3/20/16). He also made the game-winning shot on a spinning, left-handed layin with 5.9 seconds remaining in UW's 74-73 win over VCU (11/22/16) at Madison Square Garden.
- ► An the final 5:00 (and overtime) of games last season, Koenig shot 54.8% (17-31) from 3-point range.
- ► Koenig went 83-for-213 from 3-point range last season, tallying the second-most triples in school history. For his career, Koenig's 187 3-pointers are tied with Devin Harris for 7th in UW annals. Ben Brust holds the school record with 235 trevs.
- ▶ Last season, Koenig set a Wisconsin record by hitting at least one 3-pointer in 43 straight games. It was snapped with an 0-for-2 effort vs. Pitt in the 2016 NCAA Tournament.

3TTO BROWN

In his first 2 years on campus, senior **Vitto Brown** did not attempt a single 3-point field goal. Since then, he has turned into the Badgers' most reliable 3-point marksman.

- ► On the season, Brown is shooting 43.3% from 3-point range, hitting 13-of-30 from downtown. During the 3-game Maui Invitational, Brown went 7-for-10 from outside the arc. In the championship game against North Carolina, Brown led the Badgers with 15 points, matching his career high with 4 triples (4-for-5).
- ► Last season, Brown led the Badgers in 3-point FG percentage, hitting 38-of-95 (.400) from long range.
- ► For his career, Brown is shooting 40.8% from 3-point range (51-for-125), a figure that ranks 10th on UW's all-time 3-point shooting list.

HAYES BUILDING LEGACY AT UW

The preseason Big Ten Player of the Year, **Nigel Hayes** returned for his senior season after testing the NBA Draft waters and is poised to leave a legacy as one of the best in Wisconsin history.

▶ Against Syracuse, Hayes tallied 9 points, 13 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists, coming one point short of authoring just the 2nd triple-double in UW history (Josh Gasser had 10 pts, 12 reb, 10 ast at Northwestern in 2011).

Hayes did become the first Badger to post a double-figure assist total since Jordan Taylor had 10 vs. Green Bay on Dec. 7, 2011. Hayes recorded the second rebounds/assists double-double in Badgers history (Gasser's triple-double).

- ▶ With 1,430 career points, Hayes passed Devin Harris (2002-04) to move into 11th place on Wisconsin's all-time scoring list. He is 25 points away from passing Kirk Penney (2000-03) to move into UW's top 10.
- ► Hayes also owns 606 career rebounds and 247 career assists, becoming just the 4th player in UW history to accumulate 1,300 points, 500 rebounds and 200 assists.

Last season, Hayes set UW single-season records for free throws (190) and free throw attempts (258). He led the Big Ten in FTAs and ranked second to Illinois' Malcolm Hill in FTs (193).

For his career, Hayes ranks 4th in school history for made FTs (432) and 2nd in FTAs (622).

Hayes also equaled UW's single-game record with 17 made FTs when he went 17-for-22 against Indiana (1/26/16).

- ► Among the Big Ten, Hayes leads all active players in career points and rebounds, while ranking 8th in assists, 2nd in steals and 8th in blocks.
- ► A 2016 First-Team All-Big Ten selection, Hayes was one of just 3 players in the Big Ten to average 15.0 ppg, 5.0 rpg and 3.0 apg, joining Denzel Valentine (MSU) and Malcolm Hill (ILL).

ETHAN HAPP 2.0

Coming off a breakout freshman campaign, preseason All-Big Ten pick **Ethan Happ** has his sights set on even bigger things in 2016-17.

► Through 8 games, Happ is filling up the box score, averaging 13.4 ppg, 9.9 rpg, 2.5 apg, 0.8 bpg and 1.8 spg in 25.6 minutes per game.

His 9.9 rebounds per game rank 2nd in the Big Ten (PUR's Caleb Swanigan - 11.9). Wisconsin hasn't had a player average at least 9.0 rpg since Rashard Griffith had 10.8 per game in 1995.

▶ Happ enjoyed one of the best games of his young career vs. Syracuse (11/29). Happ posted his 13th career double-double with 24 points (10-12 FGs) and 13 rebounds (6 offensive). He also added 4 assists, 1 block and 1 steal.

Happ also did not commit a foul in the game for the first time in his career.

► Happ enjoyed a fine 3-game stretch at the Maui Invitational, earning All-Tournament honors after averaging 16.0 points and 9.0 rebounds.

He scored in double figures in all 3 games on the islands, highlighted by a 19-point, 15-rebound effort in the semifinals against Georgetown. That matched his career high for rebounds and marked the 11th double-double of his career (first this season).

- ► Happ leads the Big Ten in offensive rebounds (29, 3.6 per game), ranks 3rd in FG% (.687) and 3rd in steals (1.8 per game).
- ► Happ was named consensus 2016 Big Ten Freshman of the Year. He is Wisconsin's first FOY winner since Sam Okey in 1996. Happ was also named to the Big Ten's All-Defensive Team and third-team All-Conference.
- ► An all-around talent, Happ was the only player in the Big Ten to average at least 11.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg, 1.0 apg, 1.0 spg and 0.5 bpg.
- ► Over the last 15 years, Happ is just the 3rd NCAA freshman to score 400 points, have 60 steals and 30 blocks, joining Texas' Kevin Durant and Pitt's DuJuan Blair.
- ► The Milan ("MY-lin"), III. native ranked 4th in the Big Ten with 9 double-doubles last season.
- ▶ A 2016 Big Ten All-Defensive Team selection, Happ led the Big Ten averaging 1.8 steals per game, and raised that during conference play averaging a league-best 2.4 per game in Big Ten affairs. He was the first freshman to lead the conference in steals since Ohio State's Aaron Craft did it in 2011.

SHOWY-TIME

- ► A former walk-on, senior guard **Zak Showalter** has made his way into a valuable piece of the Badgers' rotation. In his 5th year in the program, Showalter is averaging 6.9 ppg, 2.6 rpg with a team-best 2.4 assist-to-turnover ratio (19 assists to 8 turnovers).
- ► Showalter made just four 3-pointers in his first two seasons at UW, but knocked down 35 percent (37-107) from long range as a junior.
- ► Showalter averaged 7.5 ppg and 3.8 rpg while ranking third on UW with 36 steals.

TRICE IS NICE

Freshman **D'Mitrik Trice** has made an immediate impact during his first year in Madison. The Huber Heights, Ohio, native has been a steadying force off the UW bench, playing valuable minutes at the point guard position.

- ► Trice scored a career-high 10 points against PVAMU and leads UW's reserves in points (5.6 ppg), assists (1.6 apg) and minutes (16.0) per game.
- ► The younger brother of former Michigan State marksman, Travis Trice, D'Mitrik is a pretty decent shot in his own right. Owning the highest 3-point FG percentage on the team, Trice has hit 9-of-16 (.563) from deep, a number that ranks 4th in the Big Ten.

Travis Trice finished 6th on Michigan State's all-time 3-point field goal list with 202 career triples.

PRESEASON NOTES

Starters Returning/Lost: 5/0 Letterwinners Returning/Lost: 13/4

- ▶ UW returns all 5 starters for the first time since 1988-89. In fact, the Badgers return each of the top 9 scorers from last season.
- ► Overall, Wisconsin brings back all but 20 minutes played (99.8%) and all but 6 points (99.7%).
- ▶ UW finished last season in a tie for third place in the 2016 Big Ten standings extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).
- ► The Badgers are currently enjoying a streak of 18 consecutive NCAA tournament appearances, tied for the fifth-longest streak in tournament history. Last season, Wisconsin reached the Sweet 16, becoming the nation's only team to reach the Sweet 16 in five of the last six years.

Gard became the first coach to take his team to the Sweet 16 in his inaugural head coaching season since Chris Mack led Xavier in 2010.

- ▶ Wisconsin is enjoying a streak of at least 20 wins for 10 consecutive seasons and has tallied at least 12 Big Ten wins in 7 straight (longest in conference).
- ▶ Including **Nigel Hayes** last season, a total of 9 different Badgers have been named first-team All-Big Ten over the last 15 years, combining for 13 first-team all-conference honors. No other Big Ten program has more during that era.
- ► The Badgers have recorded at least 30 wins in four of the last 10 seasons, the most of any team in the Big Ten. In fact, Ohio State (3), Michigan State (1) and Michigan (1) are the only other Big Ten schools to win 30 games in a season over that span.

Nationally, only Kansas (7), Duke (5) and North Carolina (5) have more 30-win seasons than Wisconsin over the last 10 years.

- ▶ Wisconsin will play 12 regular season games vs. teams in the 2016 NCAA Tournament field, with 7 of those coming at home and 5 on the road. During the non-conference schedule, the Badgers host 2016 Final Four participants Oklahoma and Syracuse, as well as Green Bay. UW also faced national runner-up North Carolina at the Maui Invitational.
- ▶ The Badgers return key reserves Jordan
 Hill (junior guard 15.6 mpg), Khalil Iverson
 (soph. guard 13.0 mpg), Alex Illikainen (soph.
 forward 9.8 mpg) and Charles Thomas, IV (soph.
 forward 9.1 mpg). Wisconsin will also regain the

2015-16 LOOK BACK

Record: 22-13, Big Ten: 12-6 (T-3rd)

- ▶ Wisconsin reached the NCAA tournament for the 18th-consecutive season in 2015-16, the 5th-longest streak in NCAA history. The Badgers have won 15 NCAA tournament games since 2011. Only Kentucky (20) has won more games in the Big Dance over that time frame.
- ▶ On Jan. 13, 2016, Wisconsin was 9-9 overall and 1-4 in the Big Ten with an RPI of 110. Since then, the Badgers won 13 of their final 17 games, climbed to 3rd place in the league, into the RPI top 40 and reached the Sweet 16 for the 5th time in the last 6 seasons.

- ▶ With wins over Maryland (2), Michigan St. (4), Iowa (8) and Xavier (9), the Badgers were 1 of 4 teams to own 4 top-10 wins last season (with Texas, Kansas and Villanova). UW and Villanova were the only teams to tally 3 of those away from home.
- ▶ With a Big Ten record of 12-6, the Badgers secured a top-4 conference finish for the 16th-consecutive season, the longest such streak in Big Ten history. Wisconsin won at least 12 Big Ten games for the 7th-consecutive season (the longest active streak in the league).
- ▶ Ethan Happ became the second Big Ten Freshman of the Year in UW history, joining Sam Okey (1996). Happ was also named to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team and All-Defensive team, as well as taking home third-team All-Big Ten honors.
- ▶ With **Nigel Hayes** earning first-team All-Big Ten honors, a total of nine different UW players have been named first-team All-Big Ten over the past 15 seasons, combining for 13 first-team allconference honors. No other Big Ten program has more during that era.
- Junior **Bronson Koenig** was named to the All-Big Ten third team.
- ► UW also had 5 players earn 2016 Academic All-Big Ten honors: Vitto Brown (2x honoree), Matt Ferris, Nigel Hayes (2x honoree), Aaron Moesch (2x honoree) and Zak Showalter.
- ▶ Wisconsin led the Big Ten in scoring defense (63.8 ppg) and TO percentage (forcing more than one TO per every 5 possessions), having held a total of 10 teams to their season-low point total.
- ▶ UW led the Big Ten, averaging 20.8 FTAs per game last season. That mark ranked as the Badgers' 2nd-highest average in the last 9 years.
- No team in the nation had more freshmen than Wisconsin (8) last season and that group played 29.0% of UW's minutes. The quartet of Ethan Happ, Alex Illikainen, Khalil Iverson and Charles Thomas, IV averaged 19.5 ppg and 13.3 rpg.

BIG TEN, BIG RESULTS

- Since 2002, UW has won 7 Big Ten championships (4 regular season and 3 tourn.). Only OSU (10; 5 regular season, 5 tourn.) has won more titles during Ryan's tenure. MSU has 6 and ILL has 5, but no other school has more than 3 over that span.
- Bo Ryan's teams posted a 172-68 (.717) Big Ten record, the best mark in the conference over his 14 seasons. Michigan St. was second at 161-79 (.671) and Ohio St. was third at 156-84 (.650).
- Last season, Wisconsin finished 3rd in the Big Ten with a record of 12-6. The Badgers have notched double-digit conference wins in 14 of the last 15 years and have never finished lower than 4th place in the Big Ten standings over that span.

UW has posted a winning conference record in each of the last 15 seasons. Among the 6 major conferences, only Kansas (23 seasons) has a longer active streak of finishing above .500 in league play.

- UW has made 18 consecutive NCAA tourneys - the 5th-longest streak in NCAA history.
- UW has reached the Sweet 16 or better in 4 of the last 5 years. No team in the nation has gone more frequently over that span.
- Since 2002, Wisconsin has won 27 NCAA tournament games. Among Big Ten teams, only MSU (28) has won more NCAA tourney games than UW since 2001-02.

HEAD COACH GREG GARD

Long considered one of the best assistant coaches in all of college basketball, Greg Gard was named head coach at the University of Wisconsin on March 7, 2016. A coaching veteran of more than 20 years, Gard is in his 15th season on the Badgers basketball staff, having served as the team's associate head coach since July of 2008.

"It's an honor and a privilege to be named the head coach at the University of Wisconsin," Gard said. "I'm extremely thankful for this incredible opportunity to lead my home-state program into the future. It's a role and a responsibility that I cherish and take extremely seriously.

"I'm looking forward to building on the great tradition at Wisconsin and representing my home state in a manner that can make Badger fans proud."

In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award.

Gard, 45, took over as the Badgers' interim head coach following the retirement of longtime head coach Bo Ryan on Dec. 15. A week later, having begun installation of the Swing offense that had brought UW much success in the past, Gard led the Badgers to an 84-79 win over Green Bay in his head coaching debut.

The transition to Gard's leadership began with a 1-4 start to the Big Ten Conference season, leaving UW at 9-9 overall, but it didn't take long for the Badgers to adjust. Wisconsin proceeded on a run that saw them become one of the nation's hottest teams down the stretch of the regular season, winning 11 of their final 13 games.

A 77-76 victory over fourth-ranked Michigan State at the Kohl Center on Jan. 17 was the beginning of a seven-game win streak that also featured a home win over No. 19 Indiana and an impressive road triumph at No. 2 Maryland. The Badgers later added another road win over No. 8 Iowa on Feb. 24.

Over the season's final seven weeks, Wisconsin lost just twice — on the road at the hands of No. 8 Michigan State and No. 15 Purdue.

"It became clear to me as the season wore on and I was able to observe Greg both on and off the court that he was the right person to lead our men's basketball team," UW Director of Athletics Barry Alvarez said. "I was extremely excited to be able to offer him the job and fully believe that the program is in good hands for years to come."

UW finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).



In 15 total seasons on the Badgers' bench, Gard has never seen the Badgers finish lower than fourth while amassing a mark of 184-74 (.713) in Big Ten play.

As associate head coach, Gard served as the Badgers' recruiting coordinator in addition to on-floor coaching duties, opponent scouting and game preparation, and the constructing of future game schedules. He was also the director of the Badger Boys Basketball Summer Camps.

In November of 2015, Gard was ranked as the fourth-best "X&O" assistant coach in college basketball by coachstat.net. The rankings were made upon receipt of votes from a panel of national college basketball media, scouts and coaches.

In 2012, Gard was named No. 3 on the list of top assistant coaches in college basketball according to Bleacher Report. Fox Sports also listed Gard No. 10 on its list of the nation's top 25 assistant coaches.

Gard's 13th and 14th seasons in Madison were some of the program's most memorable. He helped guide the Badgers to back-to-back Final Four appearances in 2014 and 2015, and in 2015 UW reached its first national championship game since 1941. Wisconsin shattered the school's single-season wins record (36) in 2015 and became one of just 10 teams with at least 36 wins in Division I history. In 2014, UW finished 30-8 and won at least 30 games for just the third time in school history.

In fact, Gard has been on the bench for each of the top 11 winningest seasons at Wisconsin.

Gard helped pilot the Badgers to four Big Ten regular season titles and three Big Ten tournament championships, most recently winning both crowns in 2015. UW has made the NCAA tournament in each of Gard's first 14 seasons, advancing to seven Sweet 16s three Elite Eights and two Final Fours.

Gard came to the Badgers after spending

the previous two seasons as Ryan's assistant at UW-Milwaukee, where he had responsibilities in scouting, summer basketball camp operations and on-floor coaching, as well as involvement with recruiting.

Previously, Gard served as an assistant coach to Ryan at UW-Platteville from 1993-99. During Gard's years on the Pioneer staff, UW-Platteville compiled a 161-13 (.925) record and won three NCAA Division III titles, five straight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) championships and appeared in six consecutive NCAA tournaments. In his final year at UW-Platteville, Gard served as Ryan's top assistant in charge of recruiting, camp operations and scouting. He also worked as an advisor in the university's admissions office.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School and one at Platteville High School, where he served in junior high and assistant varsity coaching capacities.

Gard is a 1995 graduate of UW-Platteville with a degree in physical and health education. He received a master's degree in counselor education from Platteville in 2007. Gard and his wife, Michelle, have two daughters Mackenzie and Peyton and a son. Isaac.
