CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Big 12 men's basketball teams have a 64-13 record during the 2016-17 campaign. Eight losses were by single digits, including three in overtime.
- Big 12 teams boast a .831 winning percentage this season - the best record of any conference in the nation.
- The 13 combined losses by the Big 12 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 18 (Big East).
- The Big 12 has two of the 11 remaining undefeated teams in the nation (Baylor, TCU).
- The Big 12 is the No. 1 conference in the RPI. Entering this year, the league has been No. 1 in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.
- The Big 12 as a whole has won 100 of its last 124 and 113 of its last 140 non-conference contests overall.
- Big 12 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .609 mark.
- For the first time in Big 12 history, the league beat two top five non-conference opponents on the same day. Kansas topped No. 1 Duke and Baylor defeated No. 4 Oregon on November 15.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

This week, two stellar basketball players are highlighted as Champions for Life. Oklahoma State sophomore basketball player Davon Dillard recognizes the importance of balancing basketball with his academics and credits his mother for helping to keep him focused on putting his all in to whatever he does. For Oklahoma's Maddie Manning, learning who she was off the basketball court was just as important to her as who she was on the court. **BAYLOR (8-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Baylor has defeated three top 10 teams for the first time in program history after the win over Xavier. The Bears have a four-game winning streak overall versus foes in the Associated Press top 25, matching the longest in school history.
- ✎ BU is 8-0 for the first time since 2011-12, tying for the fifth-best start in the history of the program. The Bears are 18-1 in December contests since 2013 and have 35 wins versus ranked foes since the 2007-08 campaign.
- ✎ Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. has 16 blocked shots in the past three outings, including two versus top 10 opponents. He leads the Big 12 with 35 blocks - nearly double that of the next closest player.

**IOWA STATE (6-2, 0-0)**

- ✎ Iowa State connected on a season-high 15 field goals from 3-point range against Omaha, its most under head coach Steve Prohm. It was the first time this year ISU has reached double-digit 3-pointers and tied for the third-most in school history.
- ✎ Senior guard Deonte Burton finished with 20 points versus Omaha, his sixth 20-point effort of the season. He is averaging 19.8 points in his last four contests while shooting 51.6 percent from the field.
- ✎ Senior guard Monté Morris has moved into 23rd on the all-time ISU scoring list with 1,251 points. He also became the sixth player in Big 12 history to reach 600 career assists (601), with his total ranking third on the school career chart.

**KANSAS (7-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Kansas connected on 12-of-22 (.545) shots from 3-point range versus Stanford, the third straight contest the Jayhawks have shot 50 percent or better from beyond the arc. KU has made double-digit 3-pointers in four of its past five outings.
- ✎ Senior guard Frank Mason III has 18 assists over the past three games, with just five turnovers. He has also shot 50 percent or better in five straight contests, shooting 61.9 percent from 3-point range during that span.
- ✎ Kansas has won 46 consecutive home games, the longest active streak in the nation. The Jayhawks are 210-9 (.959) at Allen Fieldhouse under head coach Bill Self - the most victories by any KU mentor in the venue in program history.

**KANSAS STATE (7-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Senior forward D.J. Johnson notched his second career double-double with 21 points and 10 rebounds in the win at Saint Louis. He missed just one field goal (10-of-11) and has shot 50 percent or better in five straight games.
- ✎ The 31-point win at SLU was the largest in a non-conference road victory since December 21, 1965 (92-58 at Oregon). The Wildcats have scored 80 points or more five times this year and held an opponent to less than 55 points on four occasions.
- ✎ K-State is 7-1 for the second consecutive season and third time under coach Bruce Weber. The 'Cats are 24-2 under Weber when scoring 80 points or more and are 83-5 (.943) in non-conference play at Bramlage Coliseum since 2006-07.

**OKLAHOMA (5-2, 0-0)**

- ✎ Sophomore guard Rashard Odomes led Oklahoma with a career-high 17 points on 7-of-10 shooting at Wisconsin. He is averaging 9.7 points this season after recording just 1.9 per game a year ago.
- ✎ Freshman guard Kameron McGusty came off the bench to post 11 points in 12 minutes versus the Badgers. It was his second double-digit scoring output of 2016-17 and one point less than he had in the previous two outings combined.
- ✎ Oklahoma shot 49.0 percent against UW and has now connected at a 51.8 percent clip over the past two contests. The Sooners have shot 47 percent or better in five of their seven games this season.

**OKLAHOMA STATE (6-2, 0-0)**

- ✎ Junior Jeffrey Carroll finished with 15 points and a career-high 12 rebounds at Maryland. He has shot 54 percent or better in all but one outing this season and is one of two Big 12 players averaging at least 16 points and eight rebounds.
- ✎ The Cowboys forced the Terrapins into 18 turnovers and have caused at least 15 miscues by every opponent this season. OSU ranks third nationally in turnovers forced with 20.4 per contest.
- ✎ Oklahoma State has reached the 100-point plateau in all four of its home games in 2016-17. The Cowboys have recorded a Big 12-best 95.3 points per game, an average that ranks third in the nation.

**TCU (8-0, 0-0)**

- ✎ Junior forward Vladimir Brodziansky scored 13 of his team-high 18 points after halftime to lead TCU in the win over Arkansas State. He has scored in double digits in four of his last five outings, shooting 65.8 percent from the floor during that span.
- ✎ Head coach Jamie Dixon is 81-11 (.880) in the month of December during his career and is the first coach in TCU history to open his debut campaign with a 8-0 record. The Frogs have beaten six of their eight opponents by at least 13 points.
- ✎ Junior Kenrich Williams has grabbed double-figure rebounds in four of his last five contests and is the only Big 12 player averaging 10 or more per game (10.0). He is tied for the conference lead with three double-doubles in 2016-17.

**TEXAS (4-3, 0-0)**

- ✎ The Longhorns rallied from a 12-point halftime deficit in the win over Alabama, its largest comeback of the season. UT improved to 8-4 all-time versus the Crimson Tide in the first series meeting since 1971.
- ✎ Texas held a 35-27 edge on the glass versus Alabama, just the third time it has outrebounded its opponent in 2016-17. Sophomore Tevin Mack matched his career rebounding high and freshman Andrew Jones set a career best with seven apiece.
- ✎ Sophomore guard Kerwin Roach Jr. has reached double digits in scoring five times this year and on 14 occasions in his career. He is averaging 16.0 points over his last three outings with nine rebounds and six assists.

**TEXAS TECH (7-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ Senior Anthony Livingston had a career-high 33 points, including three free throws with two seconds remaining, in the win over Rice. The scoring total was the highest by a Tech player since Jan. 26, 2011 (Mike Singletary, 33 points at Iowa State).
- ✎ Against the Owls, the Red Raiders notched their 25th straight non-conference home win dating back to the 2013-14. The game was played before 10,048 fans, the largest TTU non-conference home crowd since Dec. 27, 2011 (Cal State Bakersfield).
- ✎ Junior guard Keenan Evans has scored in double figures in six of eight outings this season. He is shooting 48.6 percent over his last three contests and has also recorded 14 assists and six steals during that span.

**WEST VIRGINIA (6-1, 0-0)**

- ✎ WVU's win at No. 6 Virginia was the first over a ranked non-conference opponent since beating No. 8 Maryland in the 2015 NCAA Tournament. It was the first regular-season road victory over a top 10 team since 1957 (at No. 5 Kentucky).
- ✎ The Mountaineers were 16-of-19 (.842) from the free throw line against the Cavaliers, its best percentage from the charity stripe this season. West Virginia has converted 46 free throws over its last two contests.
- ✎ WVU is ranked first nationally in turnovers forced (25.43 pg) and turnover margin (+14.7). The Mountaineers are also sixth nationally in scoring (90.3 ppg) and have the 15th-fewest turnovers per game (10.7).
