CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Big I2 men's basketball teams have a 69-16 record during the 2016-17 campaign. Nine losses were by single digits, including three in overtime.
- Big I2 teams boast a .812 winning percentage this season the best record of any conference in the nation.
- The Big I2 has 80 percent of its teams with a .750 winning percentage or better, the highest total of any conference.
- The I6 combined losses by the Big I2 are the fewest of any conference in America. The next-closest league has 20 (Big East).
- The Big I2 has been the No. I and No. 2 (currently) conference in the RPI this year. Entering 2016-17, it has been No. I in four of the last seven seasons, including three in a row.
- The Big I2 as a whole has won I05 of its last I32 and II8 of its last I48 nonconference contests overall.
- Big I2 men's basketball has the second-best all-time winning percentage among active conferences with a .609 mark.
- For the first time in Big I2 history, the league beat two top five nonconference opponents on the same day. Kansas topped No. I Duke and Baylor defeated No. 4 Oregon on November I5.

CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE



TEAM NEWS & NOTES

BAYLOR (8-0, 0-0)

- BU is 8-0 for the first time since 2011-12, tying for the fifth-best start in the history of the program. The Bears are 18-1 in December contests since 2013 and have 35 wins versus ranked foes since the 2007-08 campaign.
- Junior forward Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. has 16 blocked shots in the past three outings, including two versus top IO opponents. He leads the Big I2 with 35 blocks - nearly double that of the next closest player.



IOWA STATE (G-6, 0-0)

Iowa State has committed fewer turnovers than its opponent in all nine games this season. The Cyclones have had single-digit miscues three times and have not had more than II turnovers in a contest since the first game of the year.

- Senior guard Matt Thomas led ISU with I4 points at Iowa. He connected on two shots from 3-point range and moved into a tie (Fred Hoiberg) for fifth place with 183 field goals made from beyond the arc.
- Senior guard Monté Morris has moved into 21st on the all-time ISU scoring list with 1,261 points. He is the sixth player in Big 12 history to reach 600 career assists (606), with his total ranking third on the school career chart.



KANSAS (8-1, 0-0)

- Bill Self is the ninth-fastest coach in NCAA history to reach 600 career wins and the 46th to achieve the mark all-time. The IO5-point output versus UMKC was the 19th time in the Self era the Jayhawks have reached the 100-point plateau.
- Senior guard Frank Mason matched his career-high with 30 points against the Kangaroos. He moved into 29th place on the KU all-time scoring list with 1,319 points and has scored 18 or more in eight of nine outings this year.
- Junior guard Devonte' Graham has shot 50 percent or better from 3-point range in each of the last four contests. He made six 3-pointers versus UMKC, moving him into 20th on the Kansas all-time list.



- Head coach Bruce Weber earned his 400th career victory with the win over Prairie View A&M. The Wildcats have started 8-I for the first time under Weber and the first season since the 2011-12 campaign.
- K-State has shot 50 percent or better five times this year and is connecting at a .502 clip on the season. The Wildcats have also dished out 20 or more assists in three consecutive games and double figures in every outing. .
- Sophomore forward Dean Wade led four scorers in double digits with 19 points, his second straight game in double figures. He is shooting 66.7 percent from the field over the past three contests.



OKLAHOMA (6-2, 0-0)

- Oklahoma had I6 steals versus Oral Roberts, the most by the Sooners under head coach Lon Kruger. OU forced 20 Golden Eagle turnovers en route to posting its best steals total since December 2, 2012.
- Senior guard Jordan Woodard reached 400 career free throws in the win over ORU. He has an .803 career free throw percentage and could become the first Sooner with 400+ free throws made to finish with a percentage over the .800 mark.
- The Sooners have won I26 of their last I3I non-conference games at Lloyd Noble Center, including 60 of the last 62. Oklahoma is 23-I at home in non-conference play since 2013, including 16 straight home non-league victories.



- xxx Junior Jeffrey Carroll finished with 15 points and a career-high 12 rebounds at Maryland. He has shot 54 percent or better in all but one outing this season and is one of two Big I2 players averaging at least I6 points and eight rebounds.
- The Cowboys forced the Terrapins into I8 turnovers and have caused at least I5 miscues by every opponent this season. OSU ranks third nationally in turnovers forced with 20.4 per contest.
- Oklahoma State has reached the IOO-point plateau in all four of its home games in 2016-17. The Cowboys have recorded a Big 12-best 95.3 points per game, an average that ranks third in the nation.



TCU (3-1, 0-0)

- Junior guard Alex Robinson notched his first double-double of the year with 12 points and IO assists against just two turnovers versus SMU. The IO assists were the most for a Horned Frog since Hank Thorns had II at Air Force in 2011.
- Freshman guard Jaylen Fisher has scored in double digits in four straight contests and all but two games this season. He has shot 40 percent or better from the floor in six of eight outings.
- Junior Kenrich Williams has grabbed double-figure rebounds in five of his last six contests, including three in a row. He is the only Big I2 player averaging IO or more per game (IO.O4 rpg) and ranks I3th nationally in offensive boards (4.0 rpg).



- Sophomore Tevin Mack posted a game-high 18 points to go along with five rebounds at Michigan. He has reached double figures in scoring in seven of eight outings this year and I2 times in his career.
- The Longhorns held a 31-28 advantage on the glass at Michigan, the first time this season it has outrebouned its opponent in back-to-back outings. Mack has grabbed 19 rebounds in his past three games.
- TI UT has three of its next four non-conference games at home. The Longhorns are 209-30 (.874) at the Erwin Center over the past I5 seasons (since 2002-03) and are I8-4 (.818) at home in the Shaka Smart era.



TEXAS TECH (8-1, 0-0)

- XXX Five players scored in double digits for the fourth time this season as Texas Tech recorded its largest margin of victory on the year in the win over UTSA. The win was the 26th straight non-league win at home for the Red Raiders.
- Senior Anthony Livingston has 43 points over his last two outings and is averaging 16.8 points in the past five contests. He is shooting 58.3 percent over the two-game stretch and has shot 50 percent or better four times in 2016-17.
- Junior guard Keenan Evans has seven double-figure scoring outputs this season, more than any other Texas Tech player. Over the last four games, he is shooting 53.3 percent with I7 assists.



WEST VIRGINIA (7-1, 0-0)

- Bob Huggins needs two victories to become the eighth Division I head coach in history to reach the 800-win plateau. His current victory total ranks third among active coaches and he boasts 27 seasons with 20 wins or more to his credit.
- **West Virginia forced 34 turnovers against Western Carolina and had a season-high** 2I steals. It was the third time this year that WVU has forced at least 30 miscues as the Mountaineers continue to lead the nation in turnover margin (+15.5).
- WVU's win at No. 6 Virginia was the first over a ranked non-conference opponent since beating No. 8 Maryland in the 2015 NCAA Tournament. It was the first regularseason road victory over a top IO team since I957 (at No. 5 Kentucky).

Postseason Awards

The Big I2 presents the only official all-conference awards at the end of the egular season. Major award winners are chosen, along with the All-Big I2 teams.
